FIG. 4 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1.

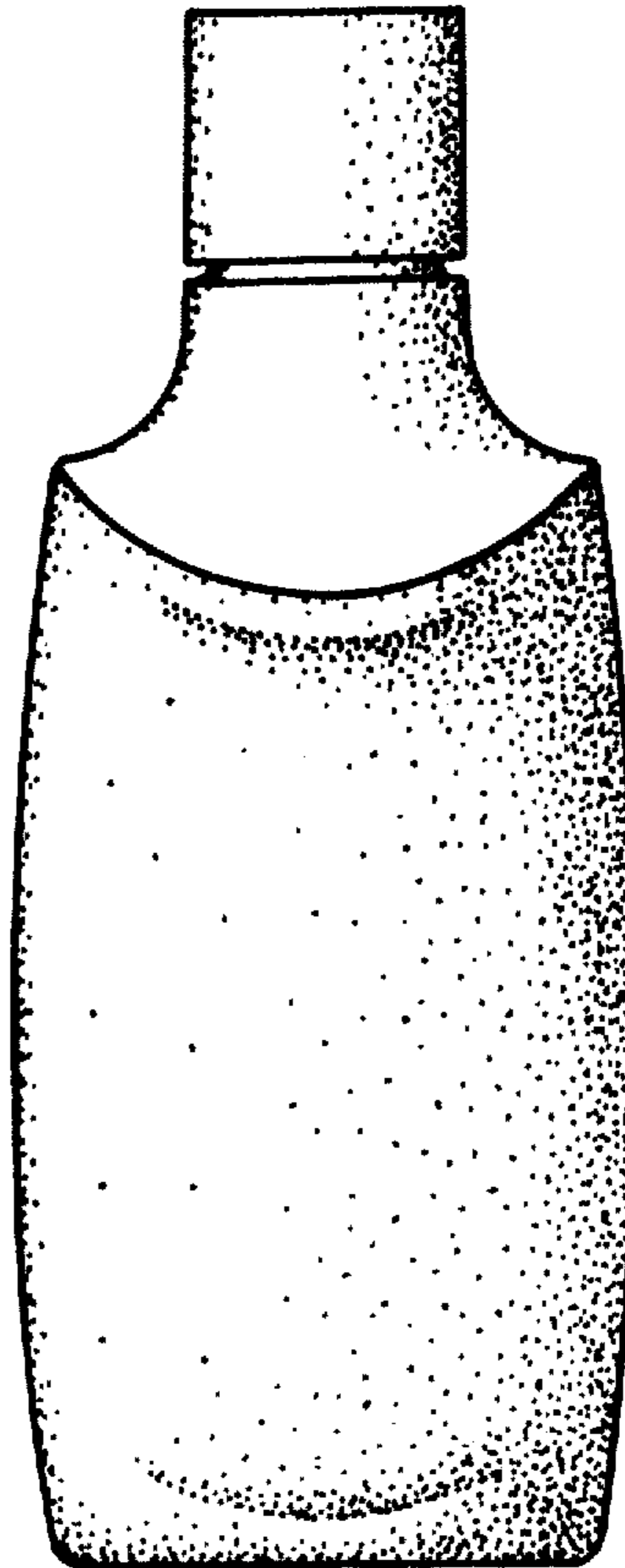

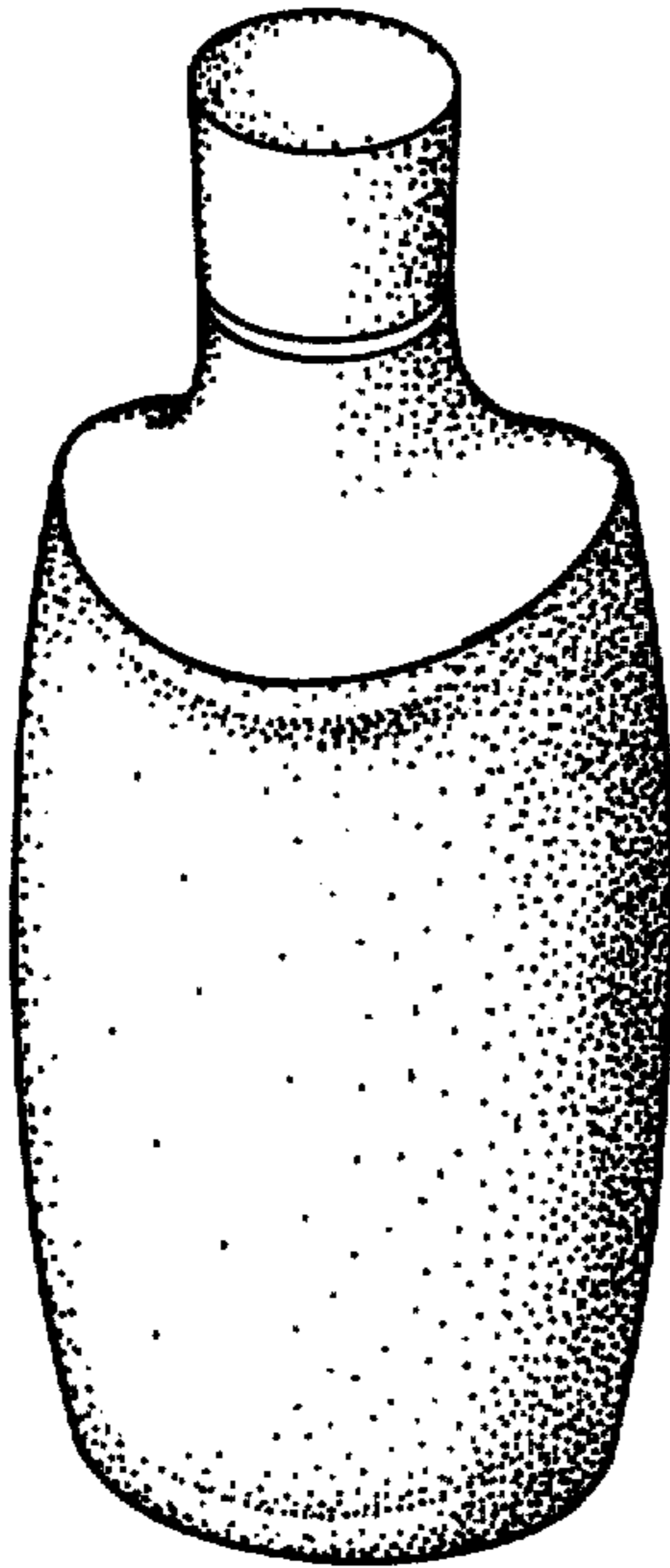

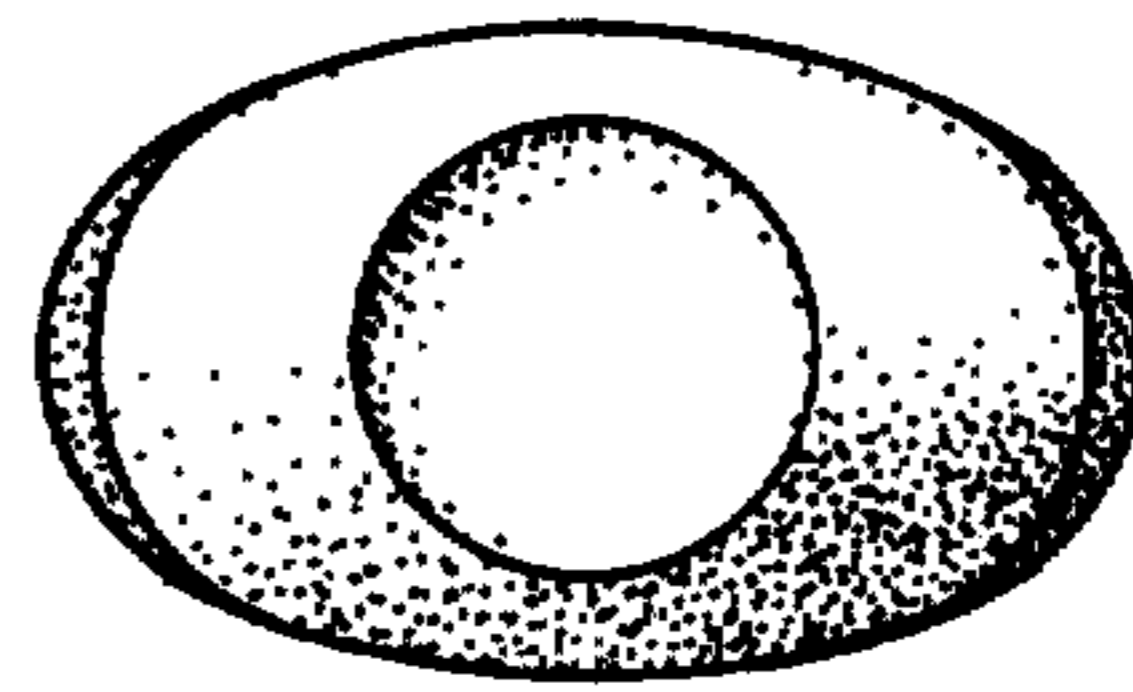

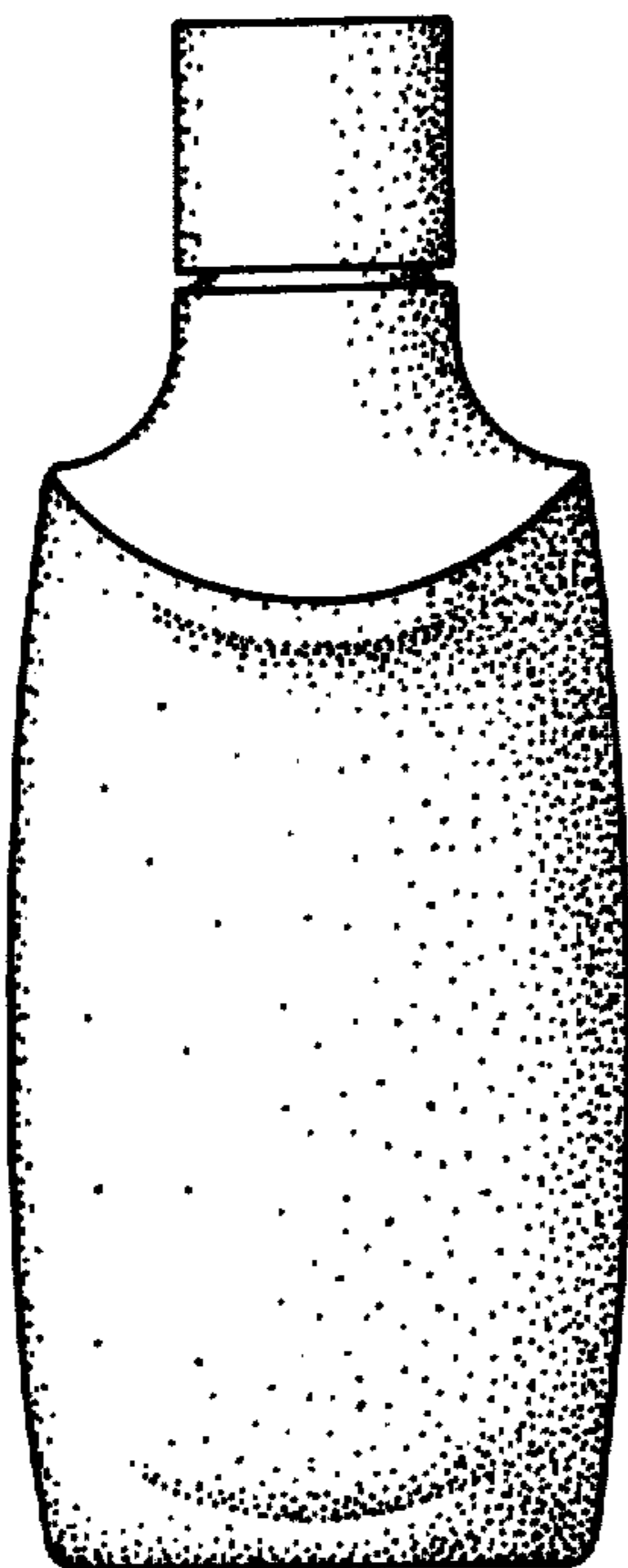
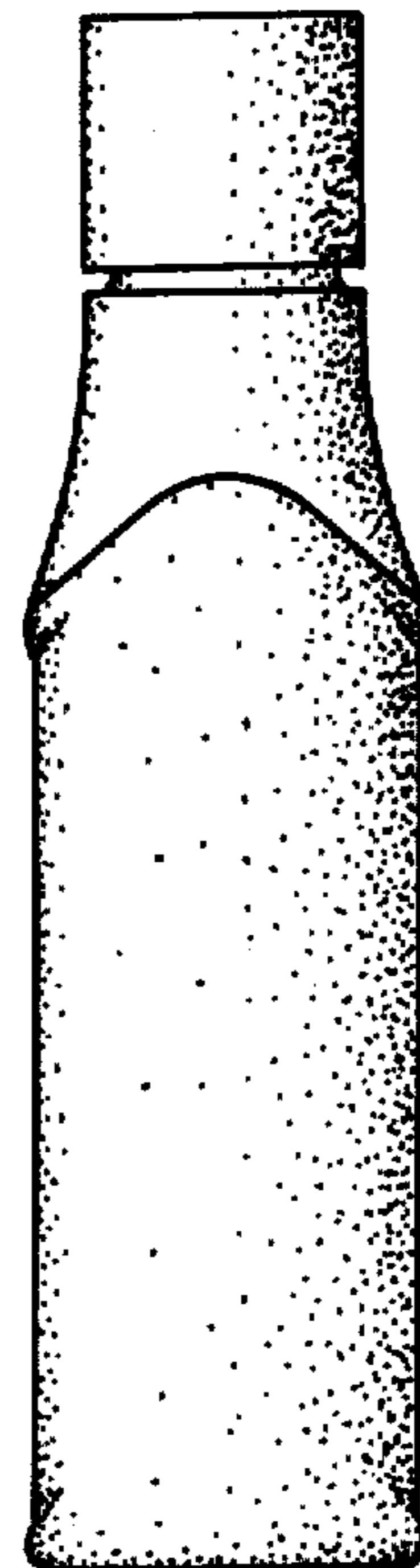
