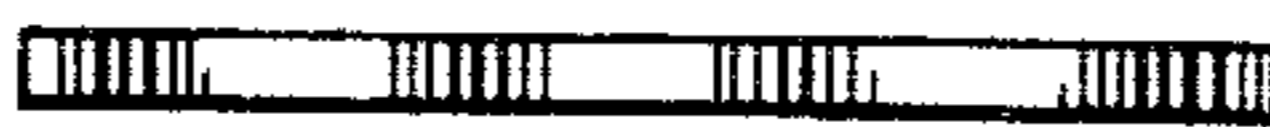
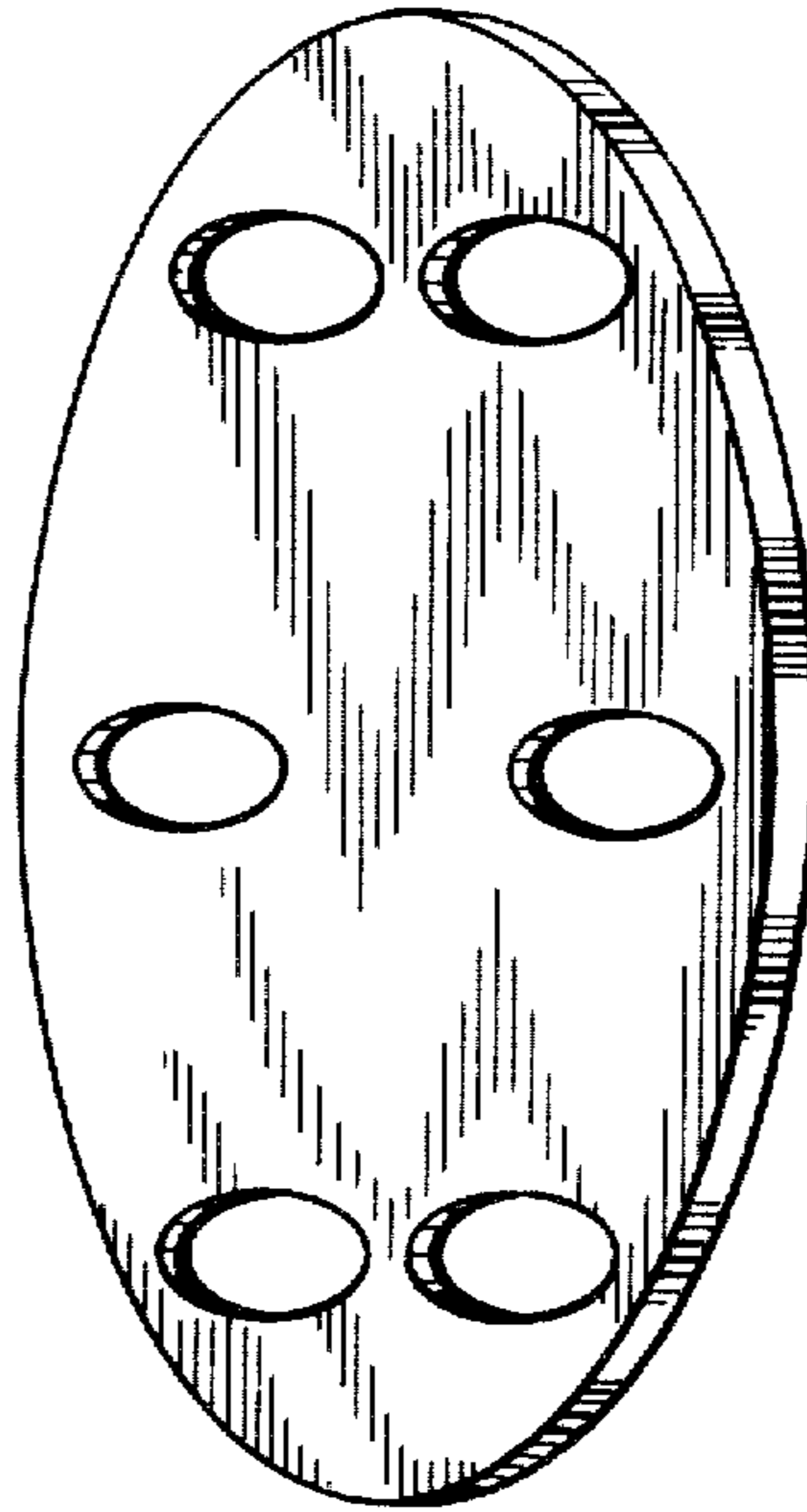
The ornamental design for a jewelry chain arranger, shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a side view of the invention the opposite side comprising a mirror image thereof.



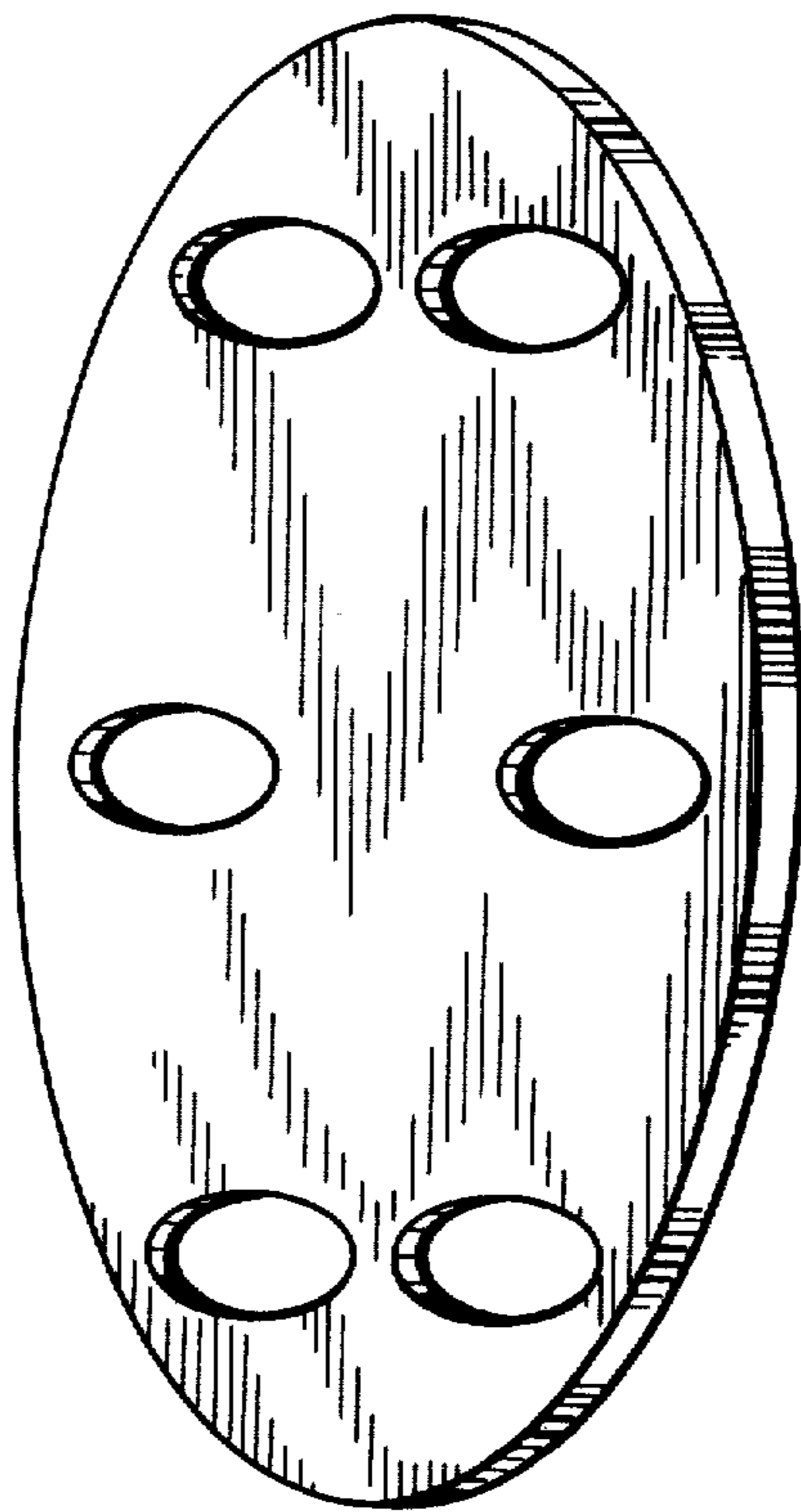

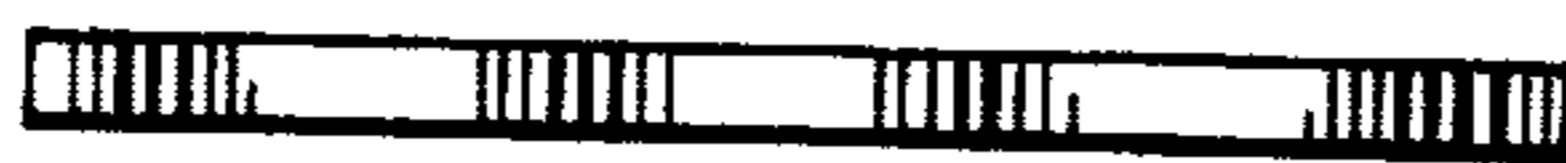
