FIG. 2 is a rear, bottom and left side perspective view thereof.

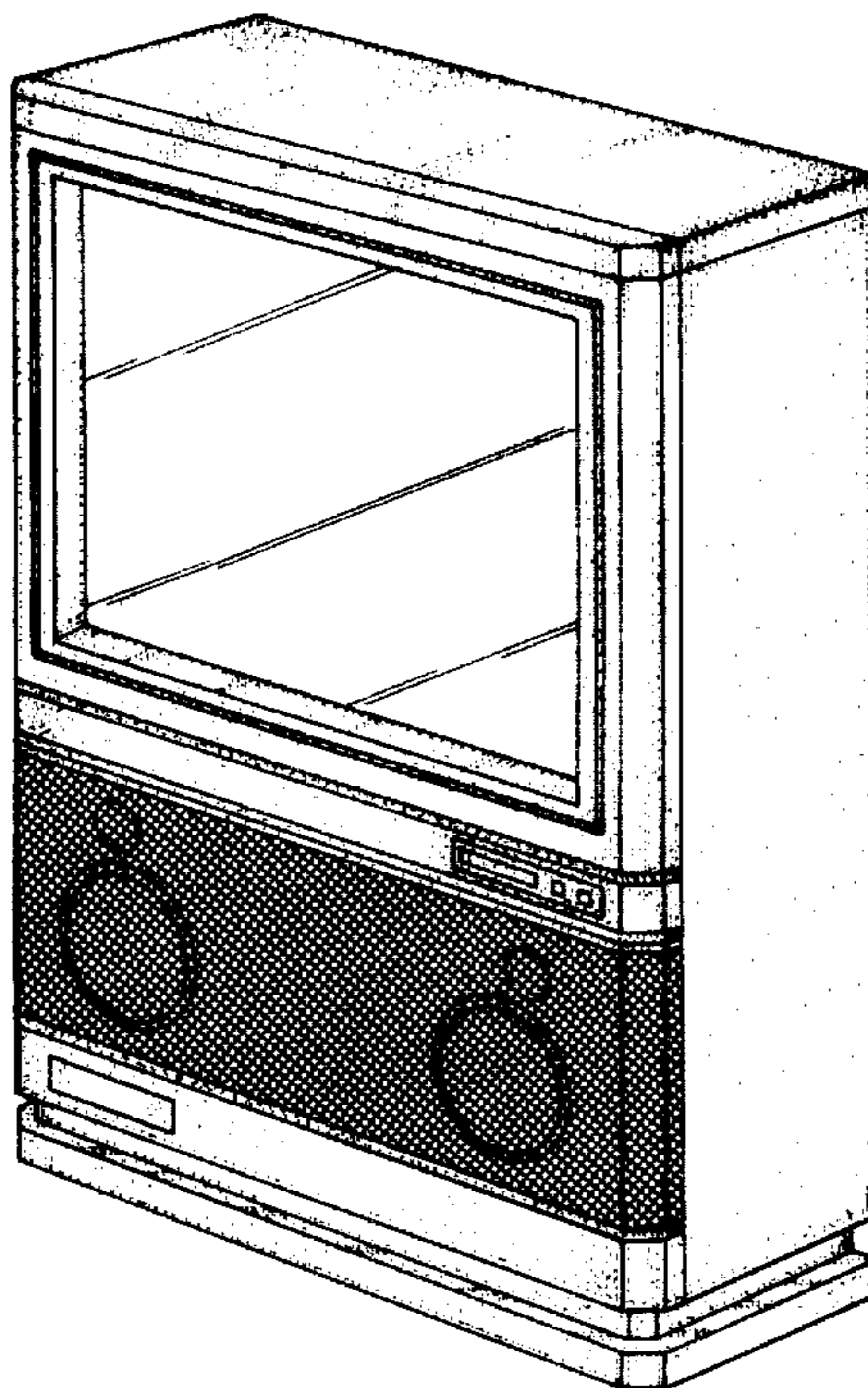

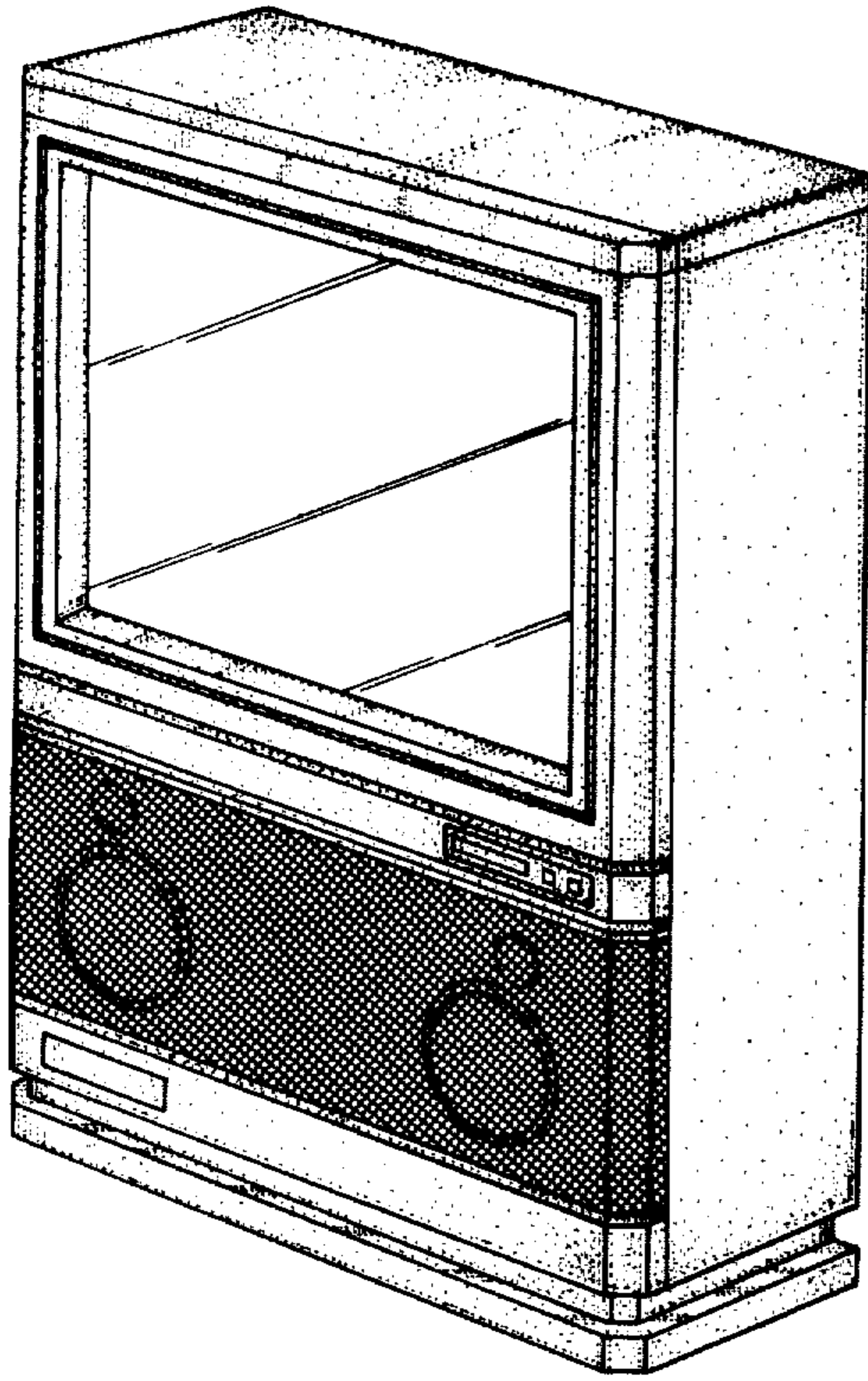
