The ornamental design for a toy space vehicle, as shown and described.

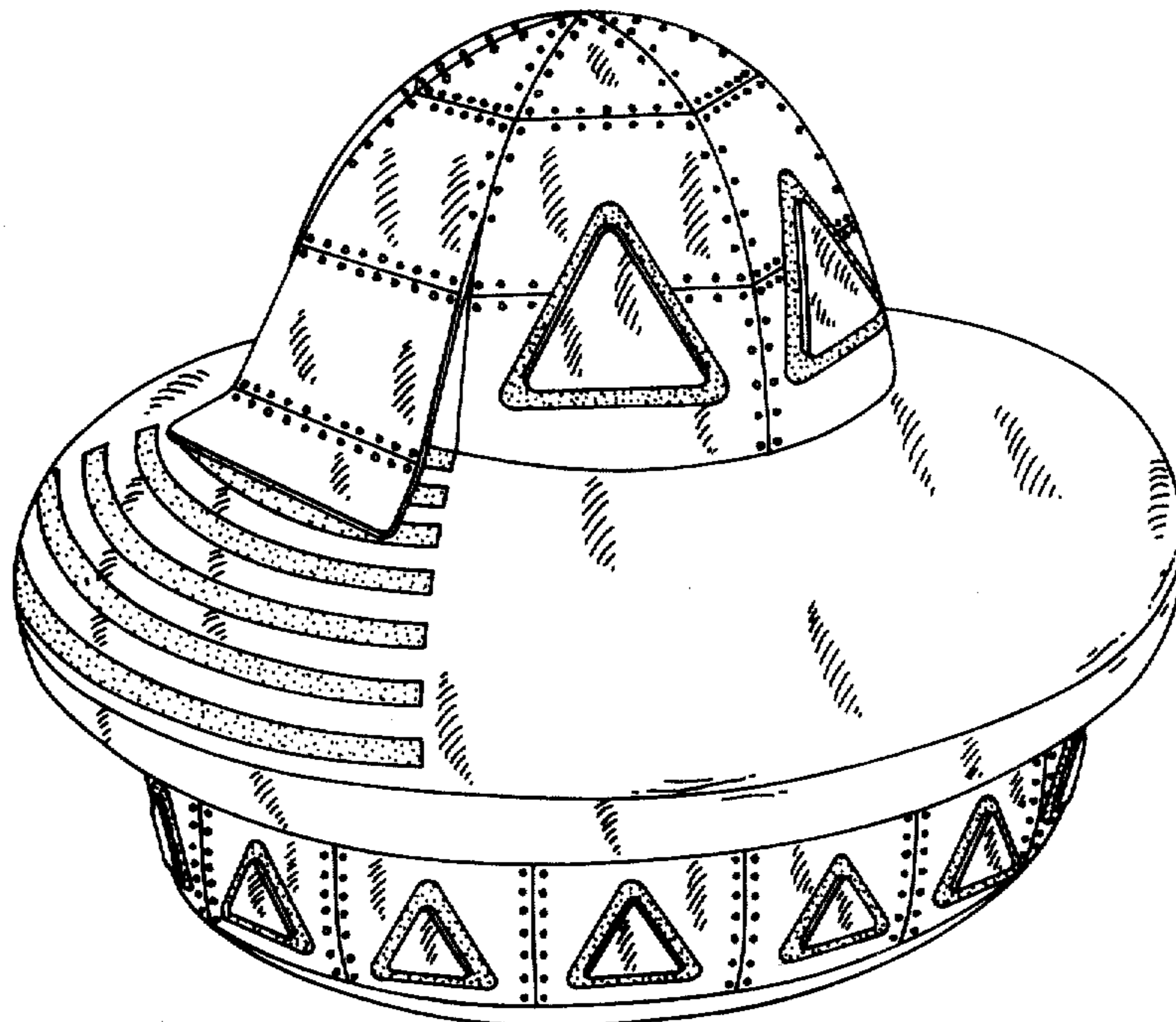
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 4-4 in FIG. 2.



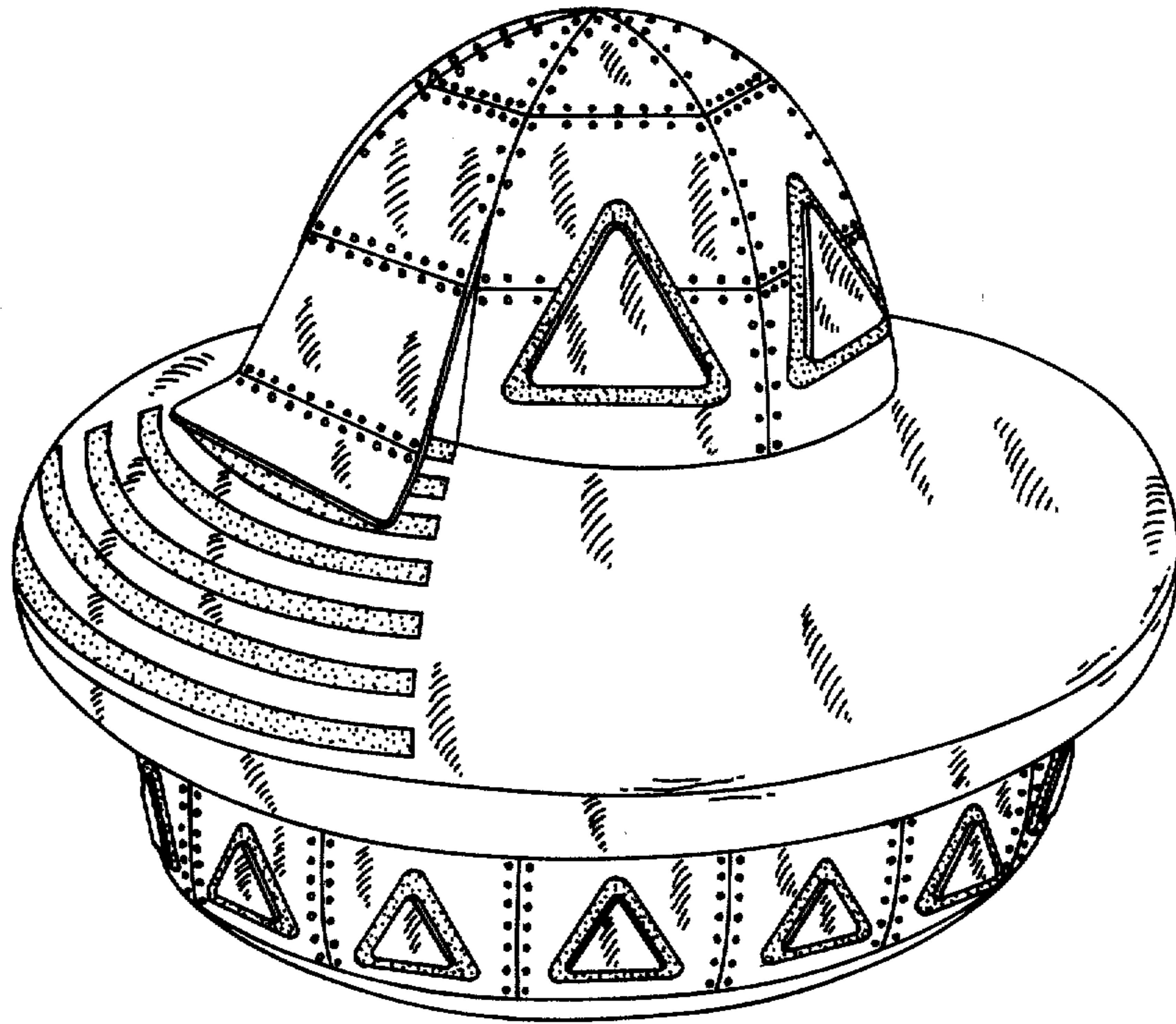
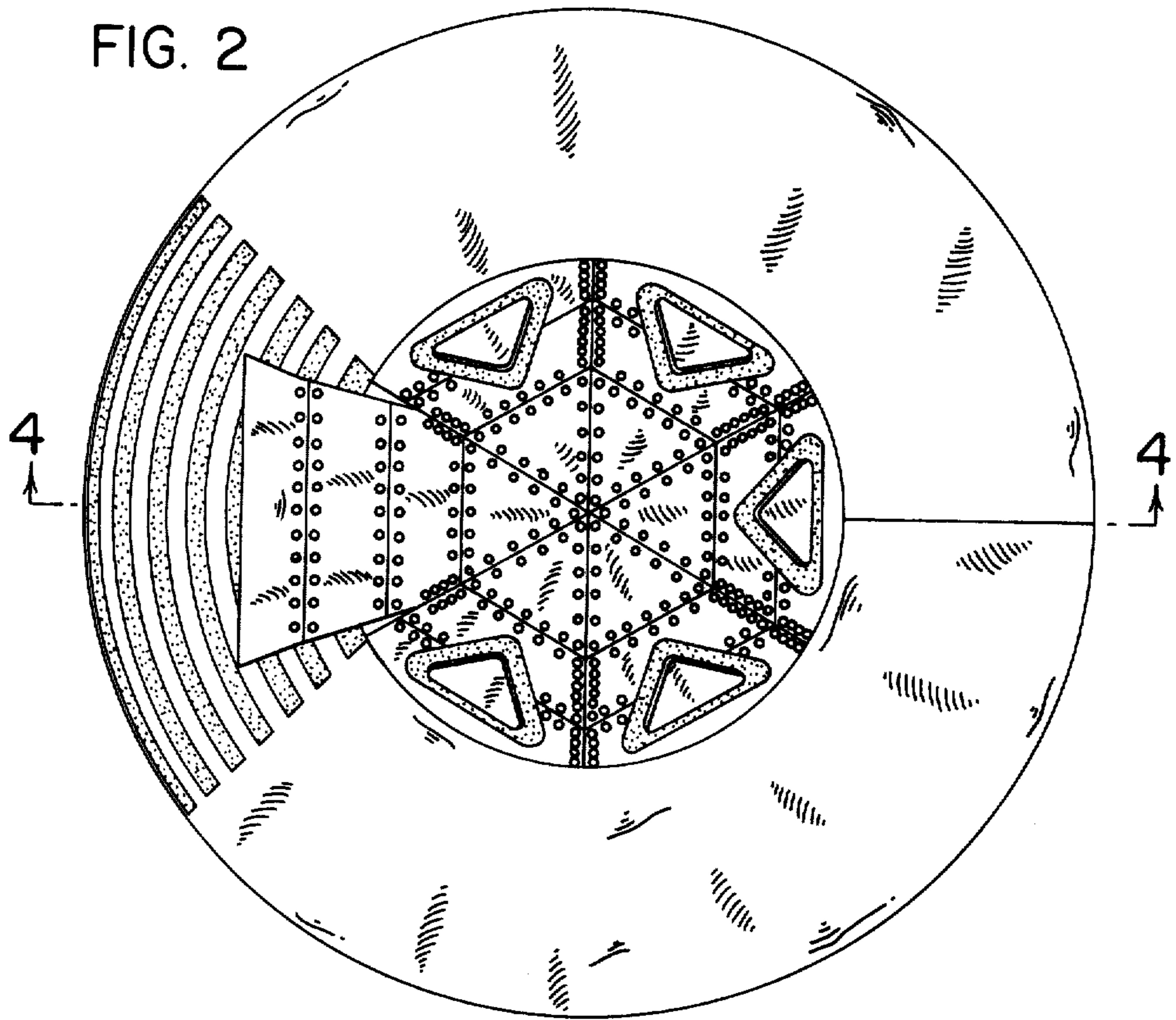

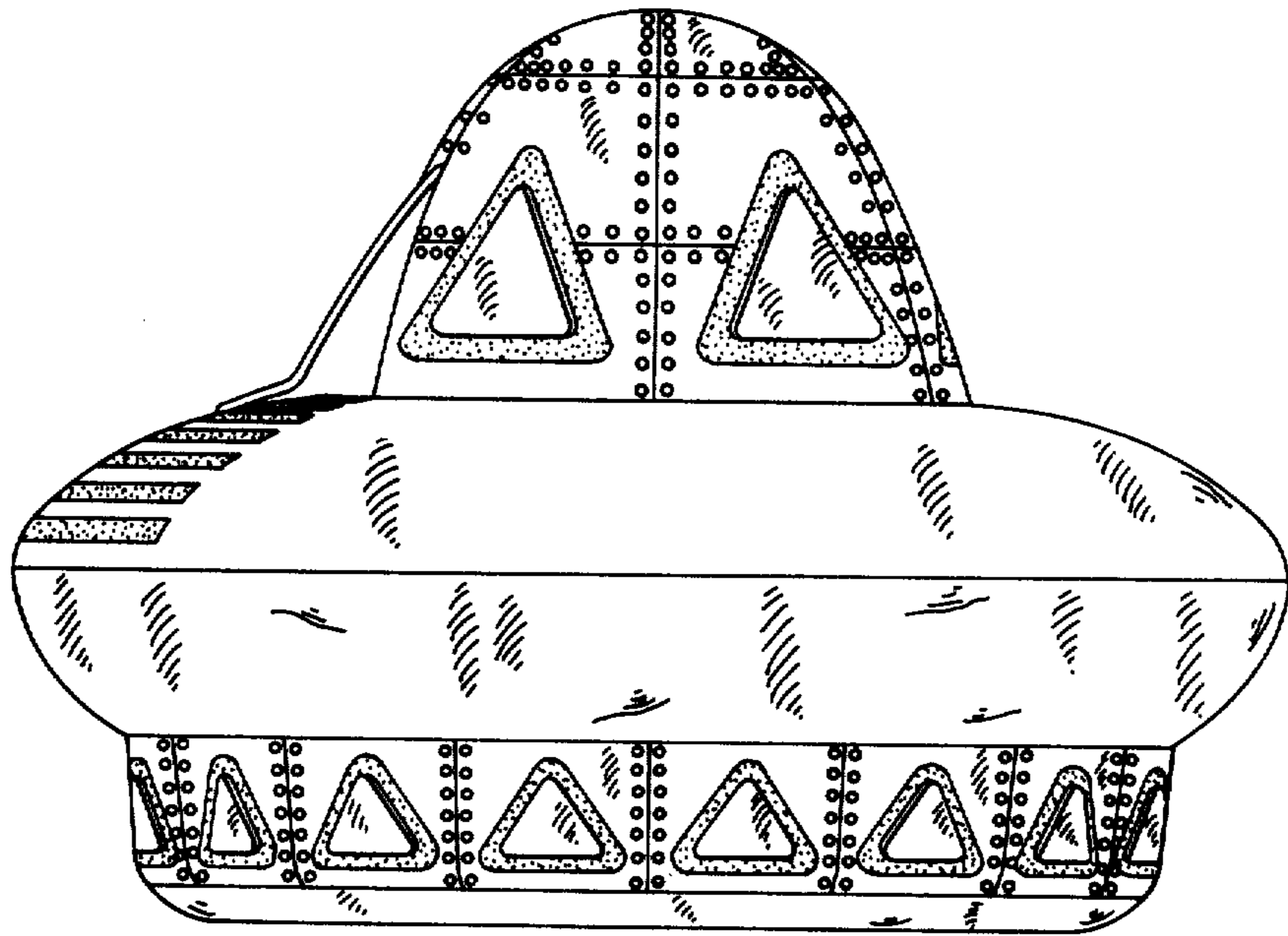

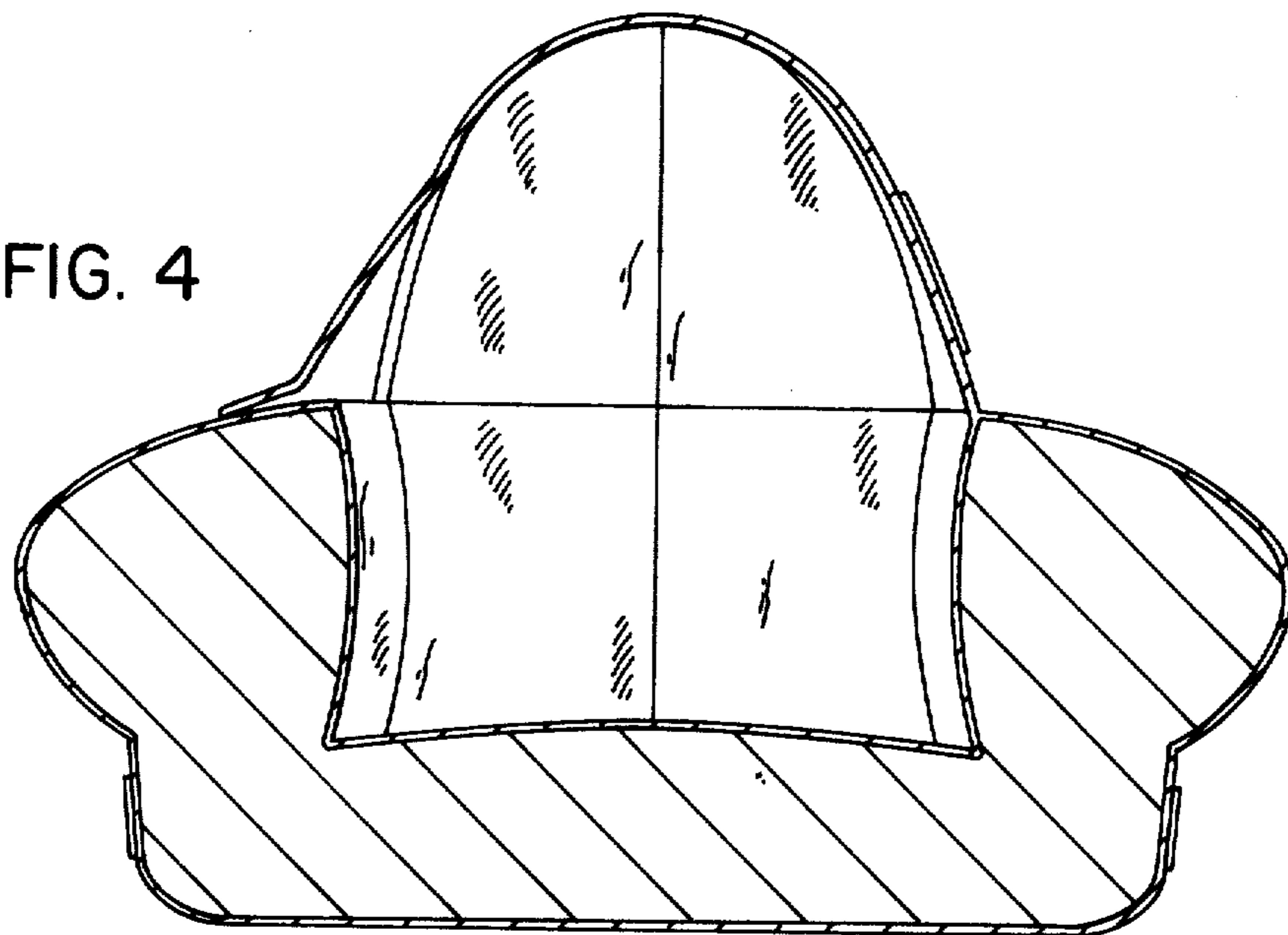
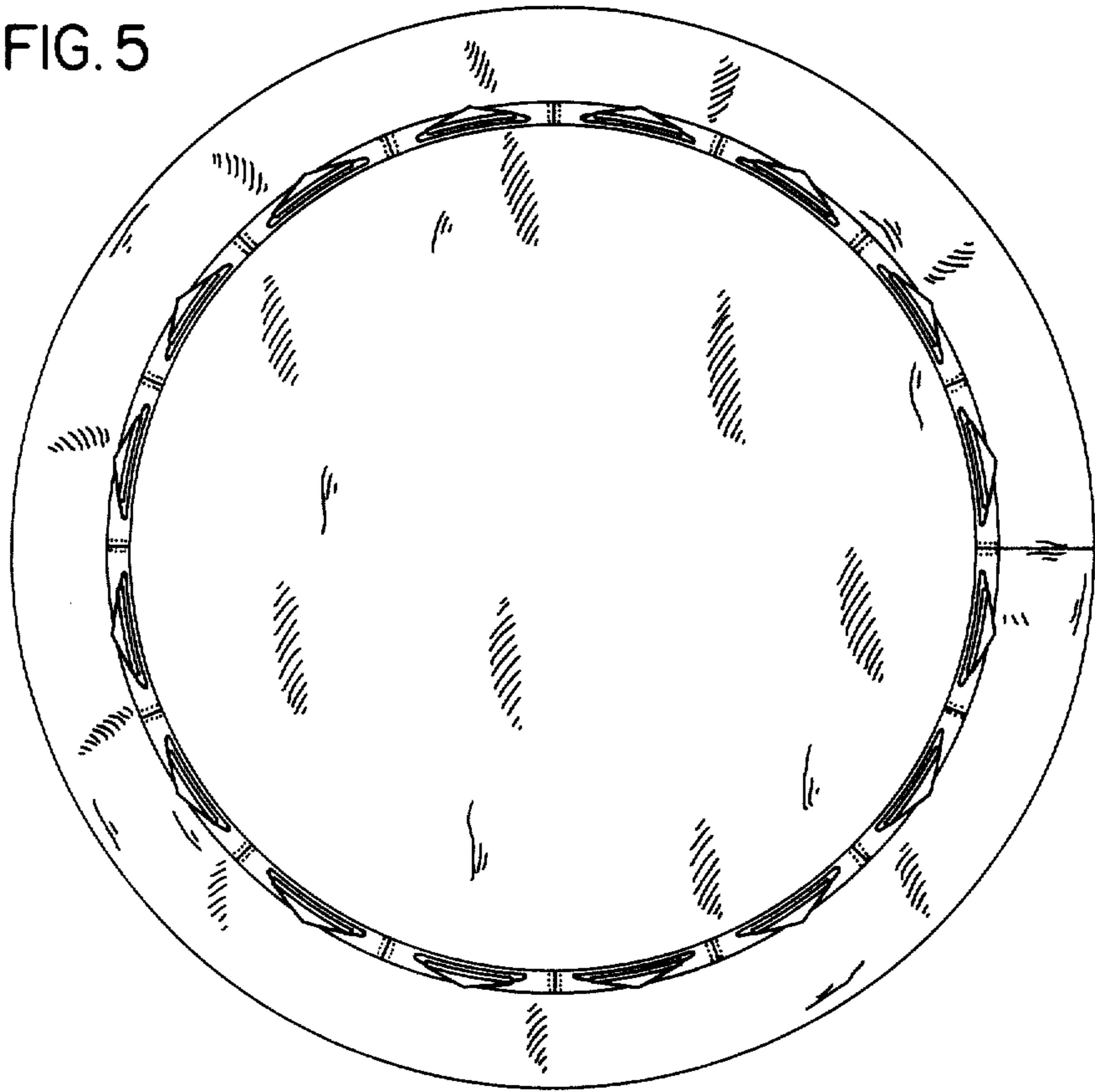
