DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe bottom showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

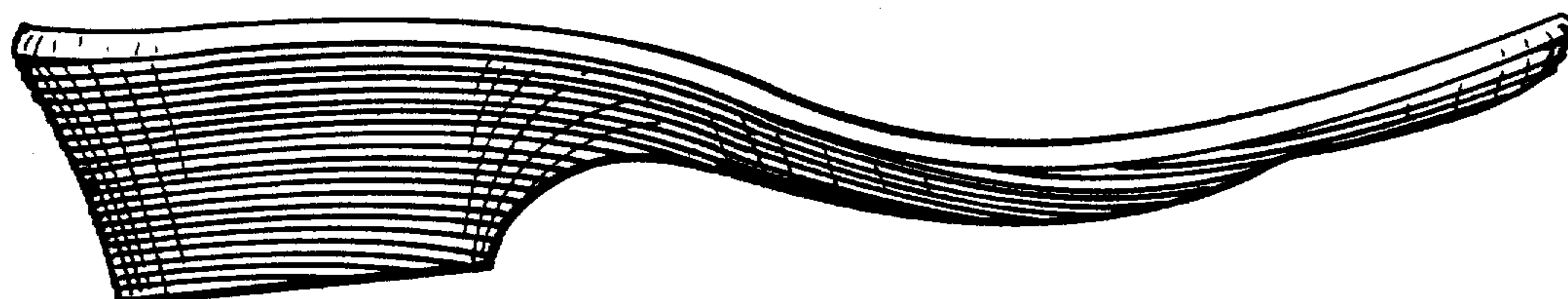

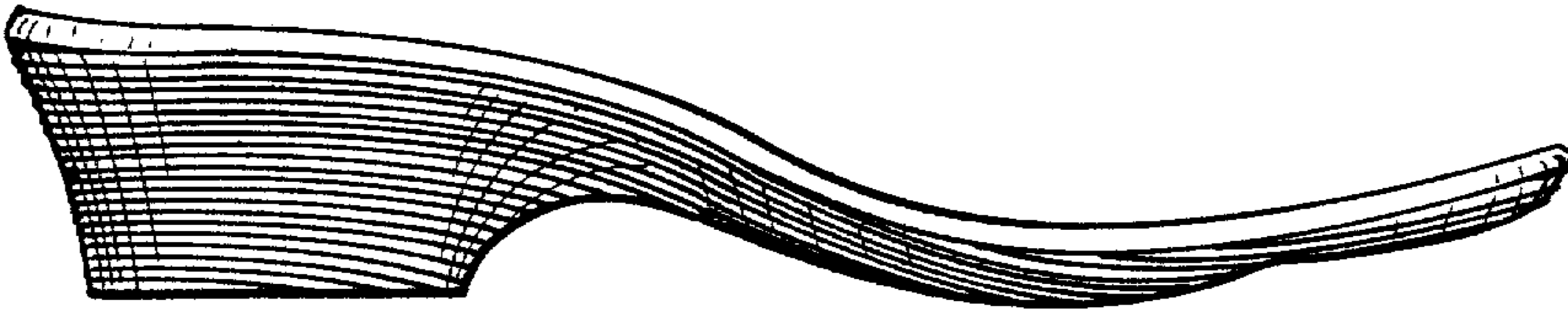

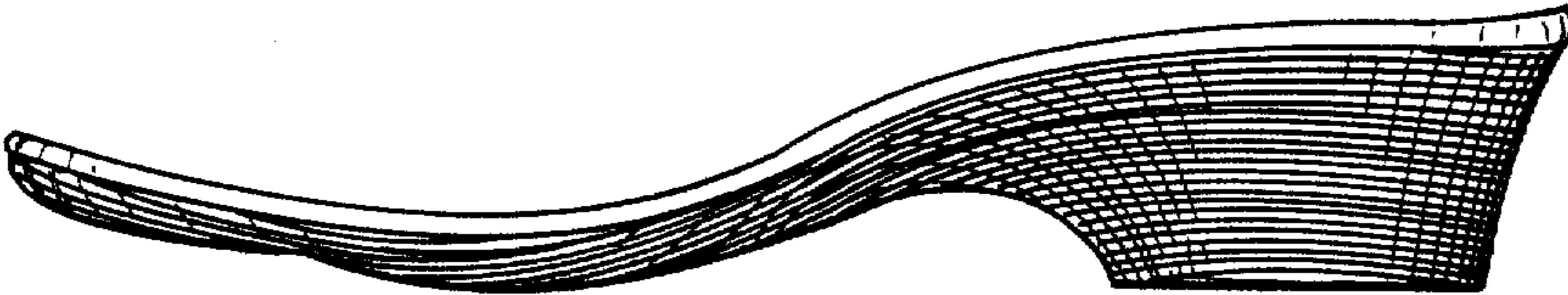

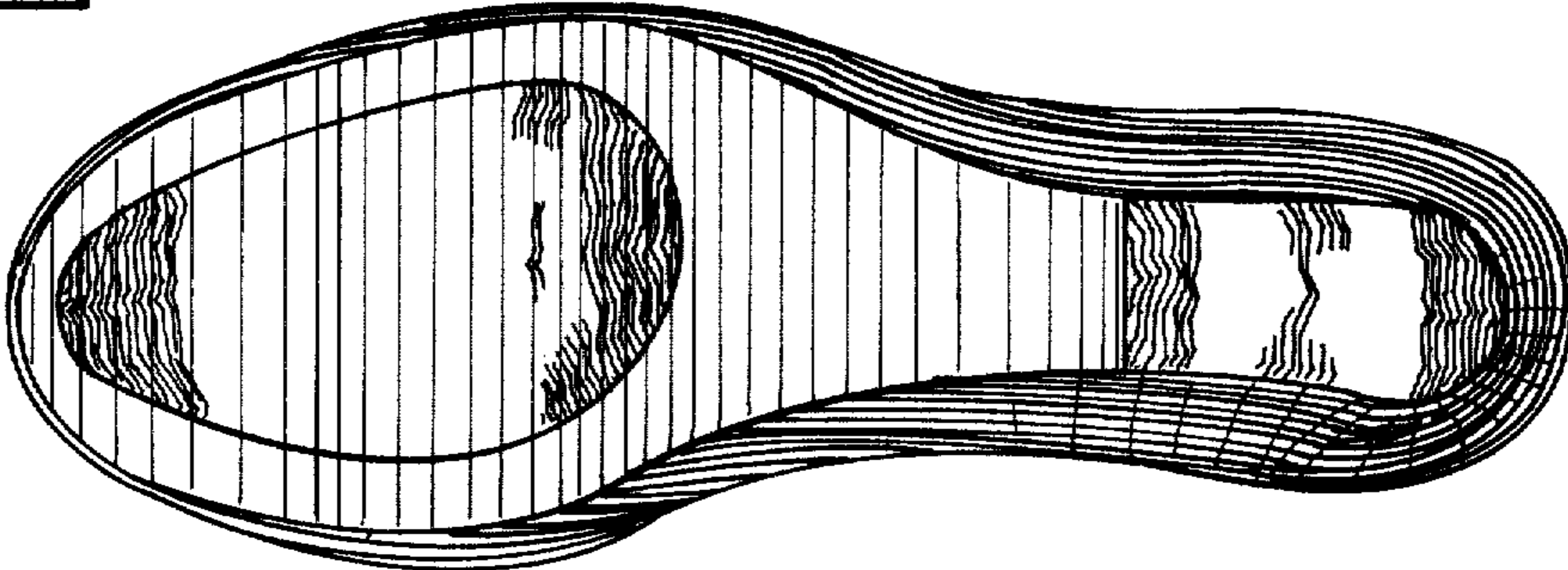

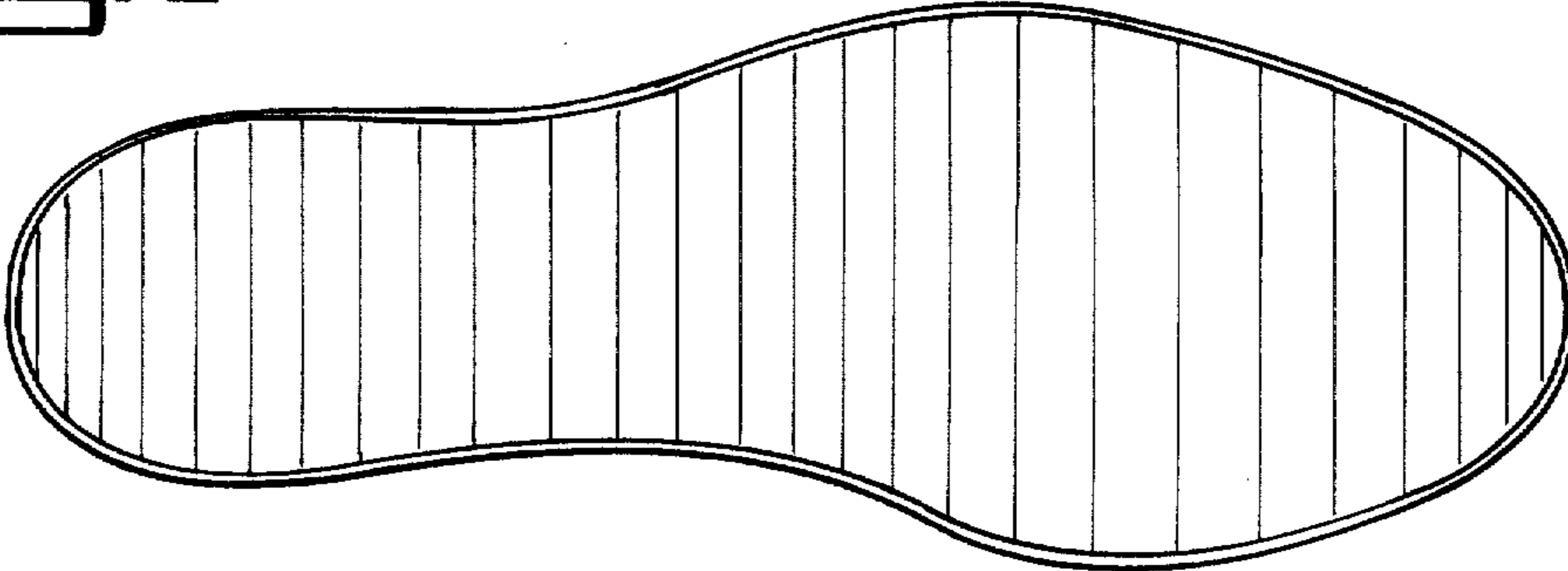

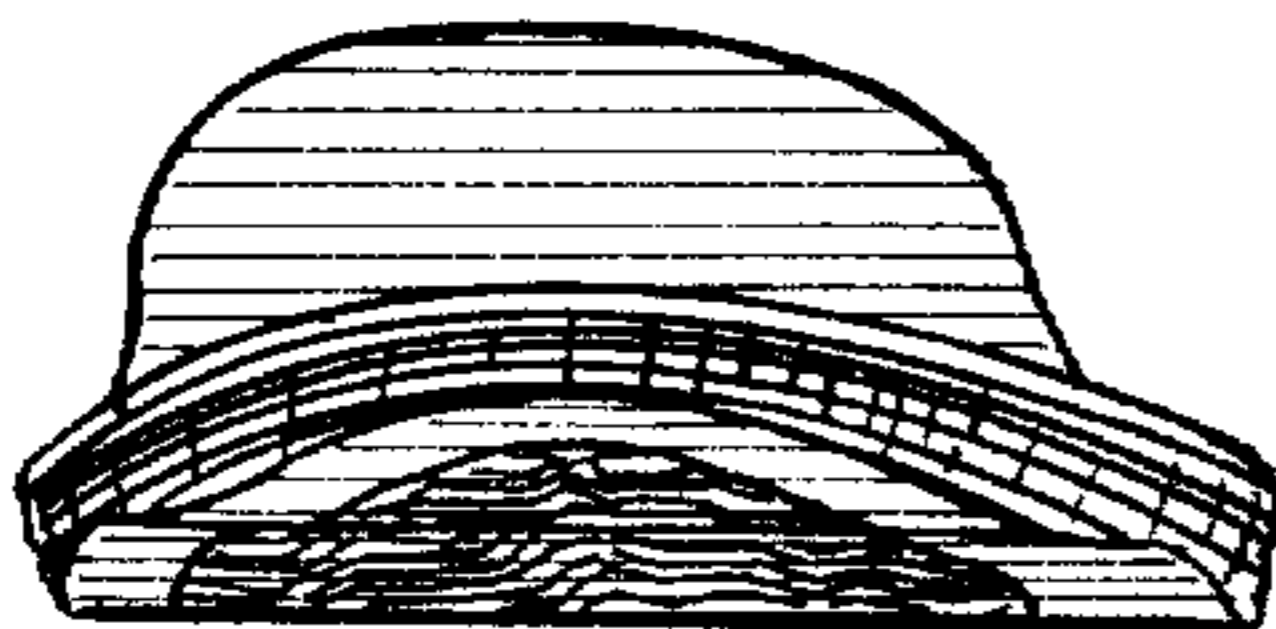
