FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a food processor showing my new design;

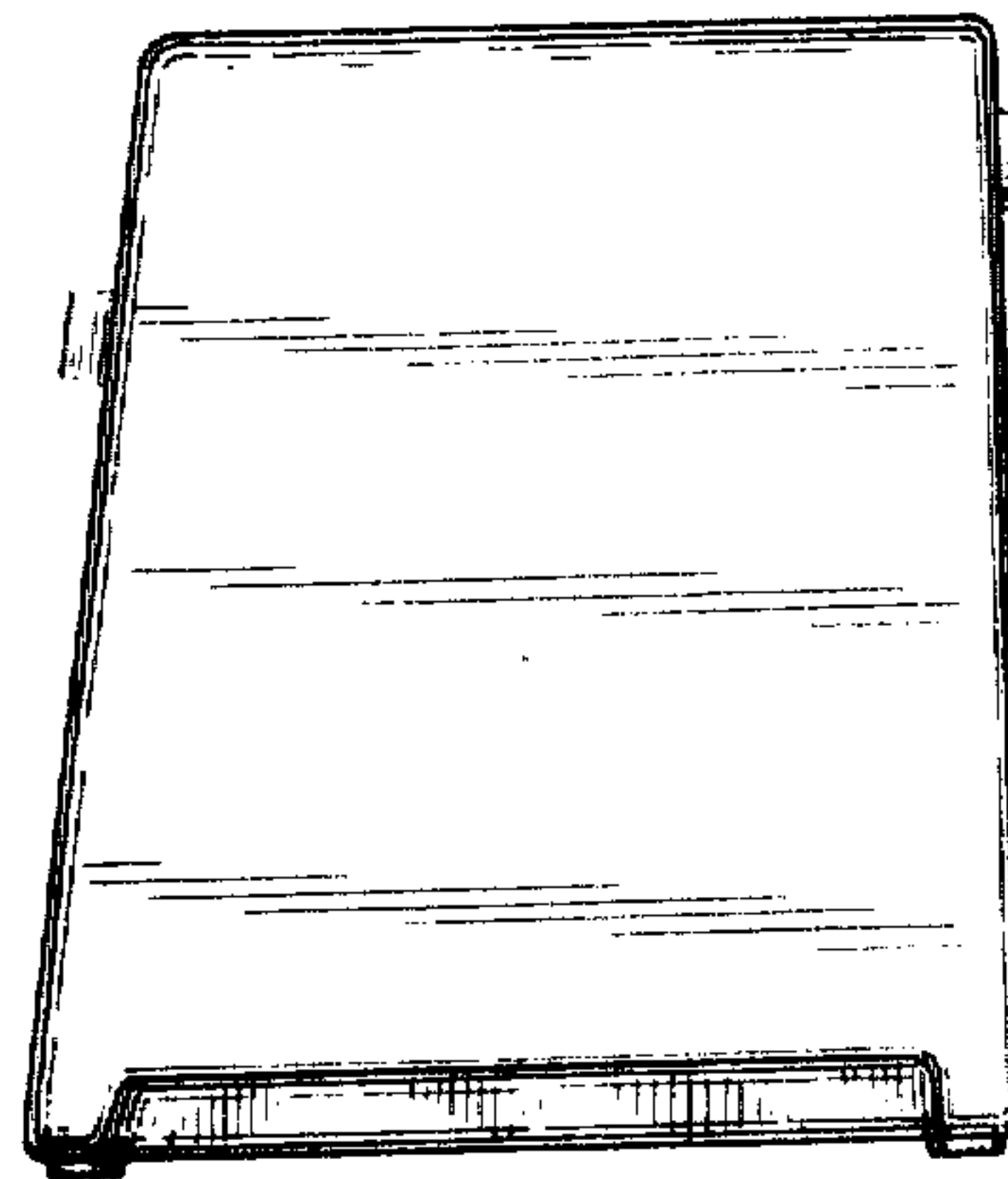
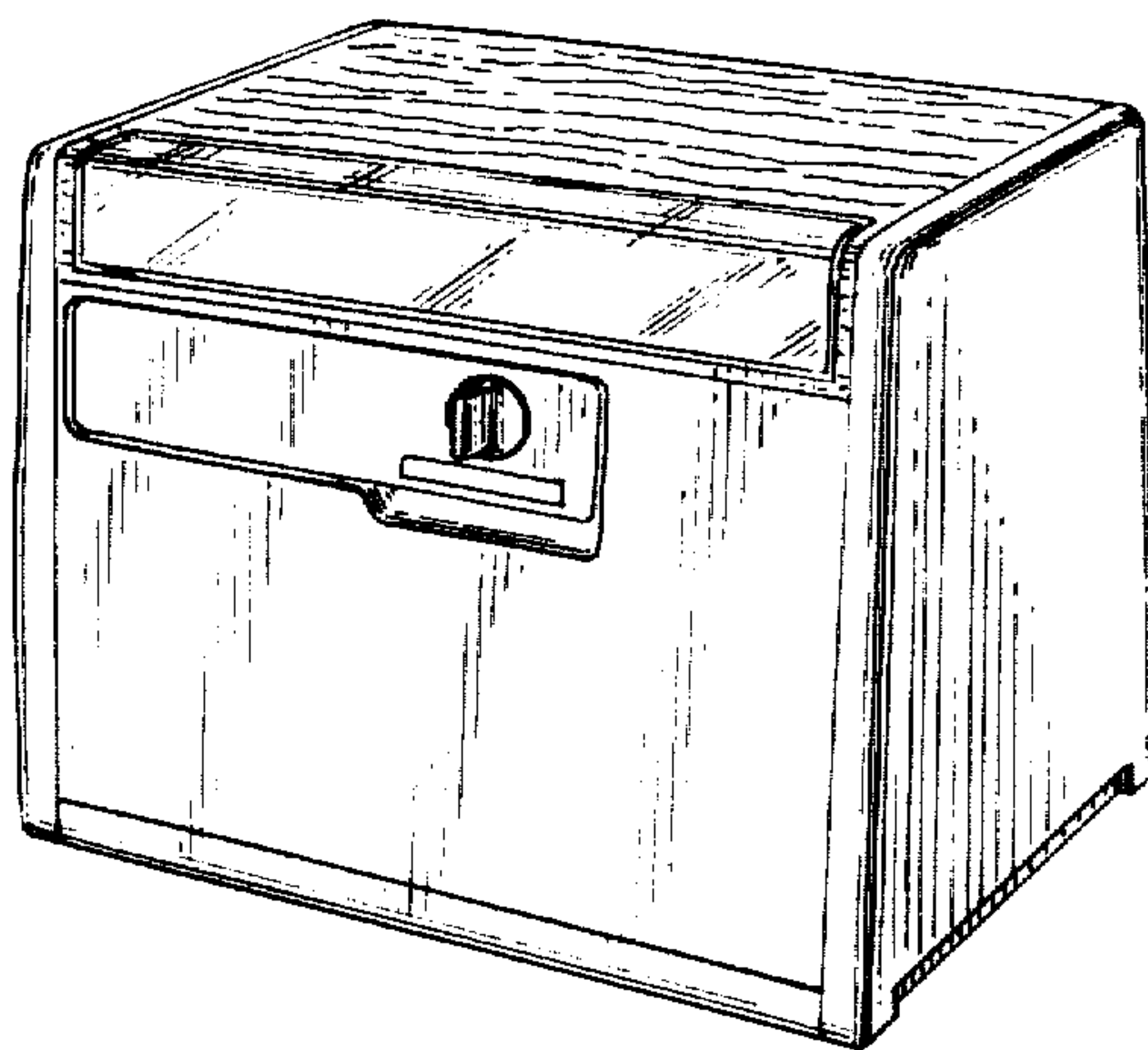
FIG. 2 is a right side elevation thereof, the left side elevation is a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevation thereof.



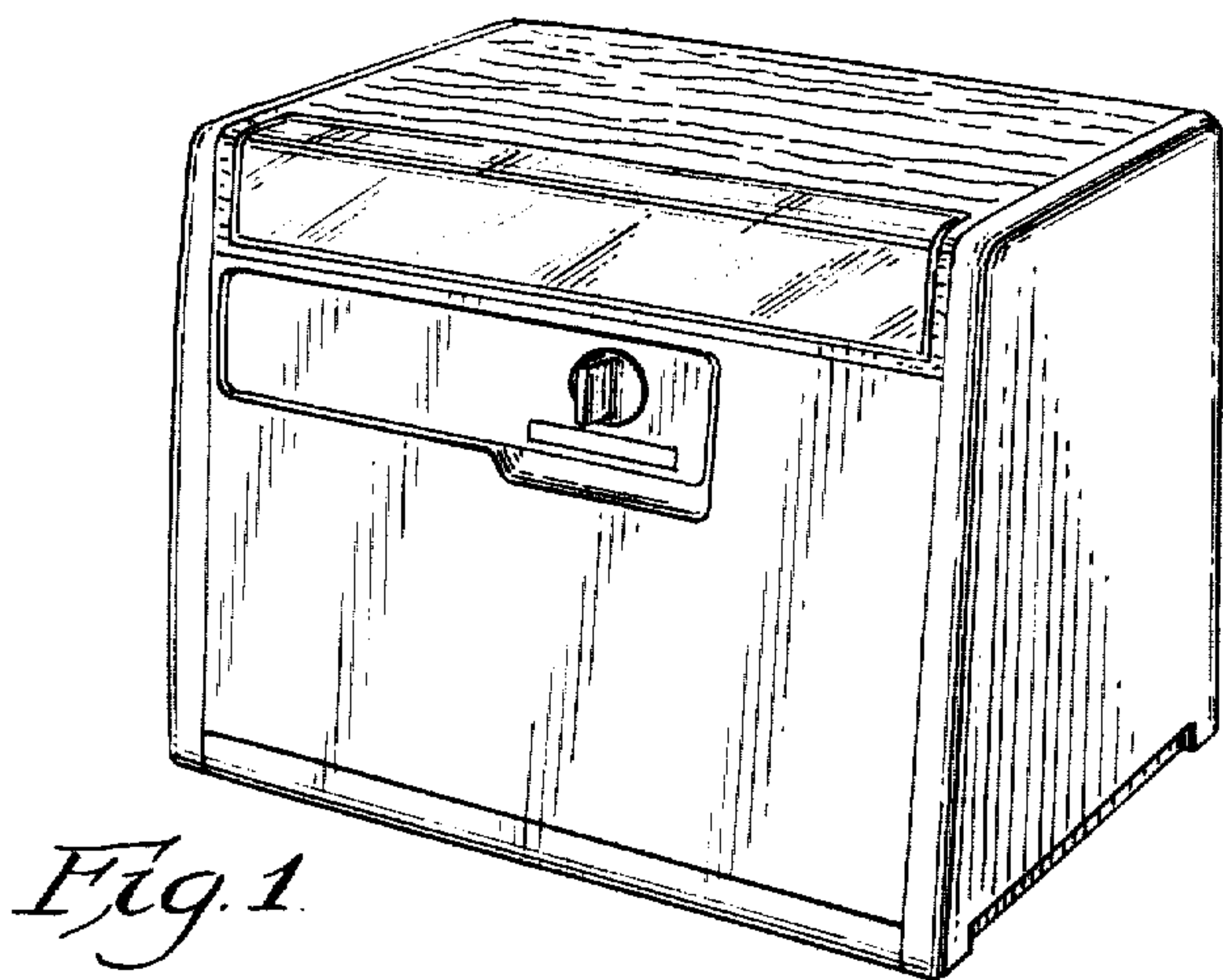

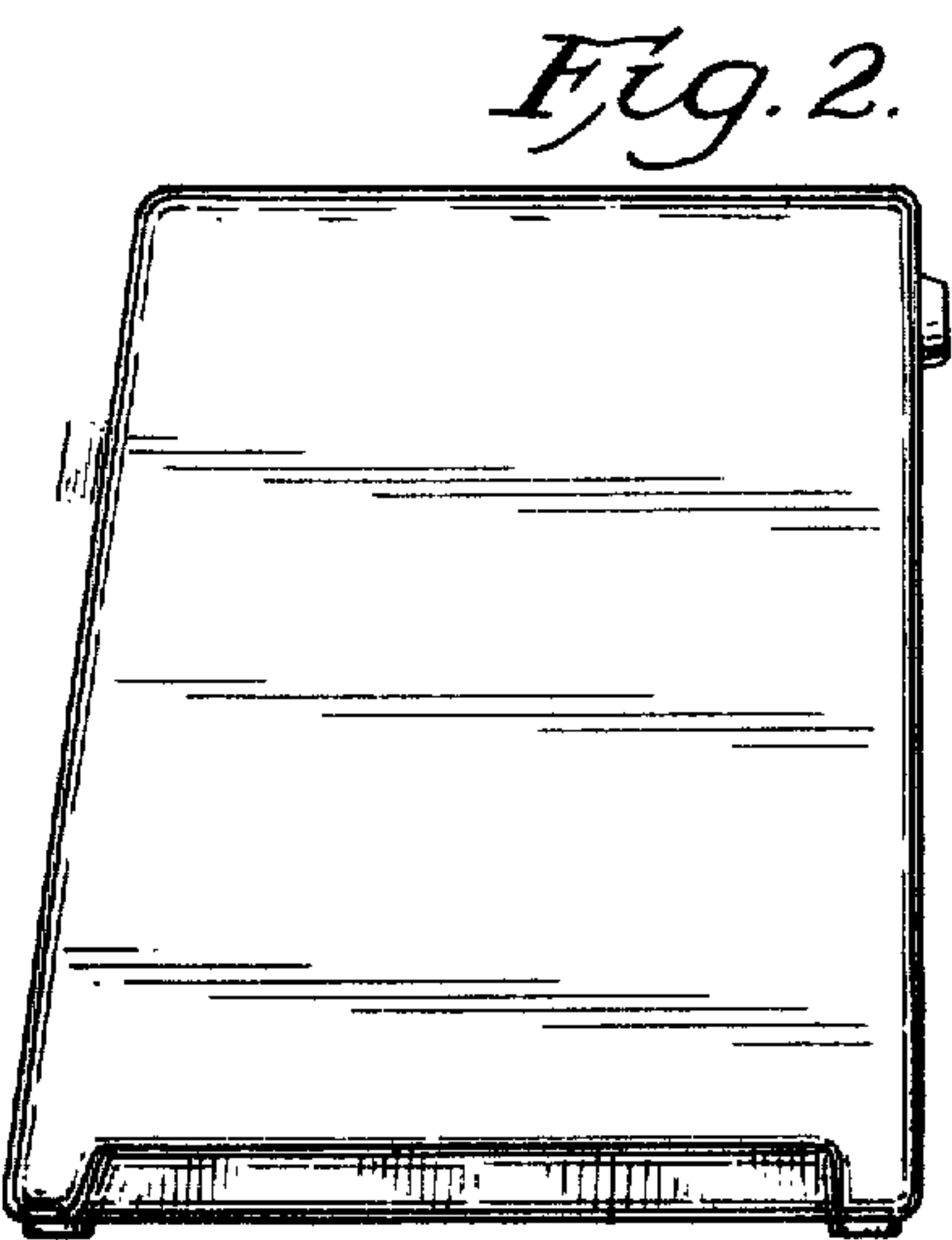

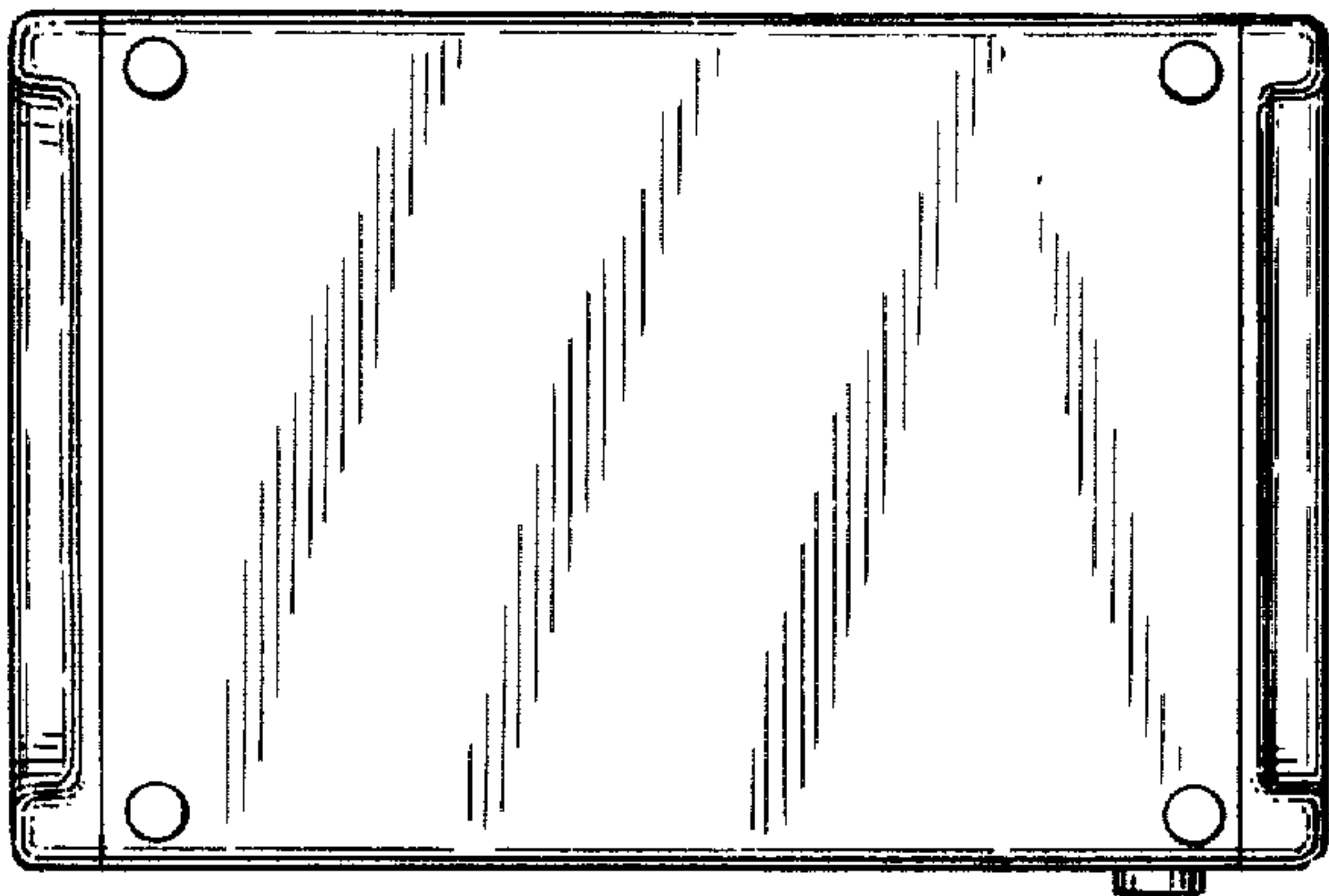

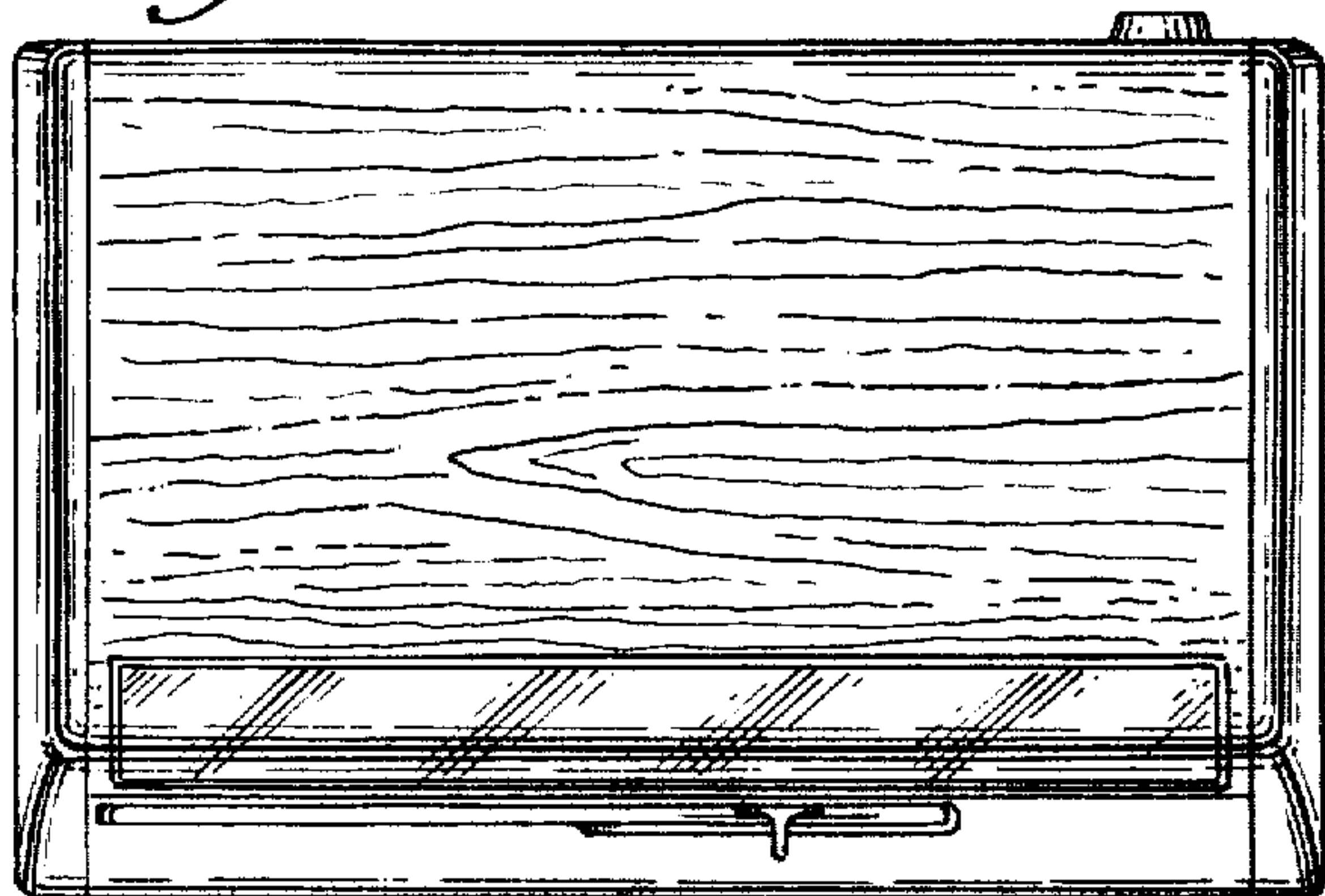

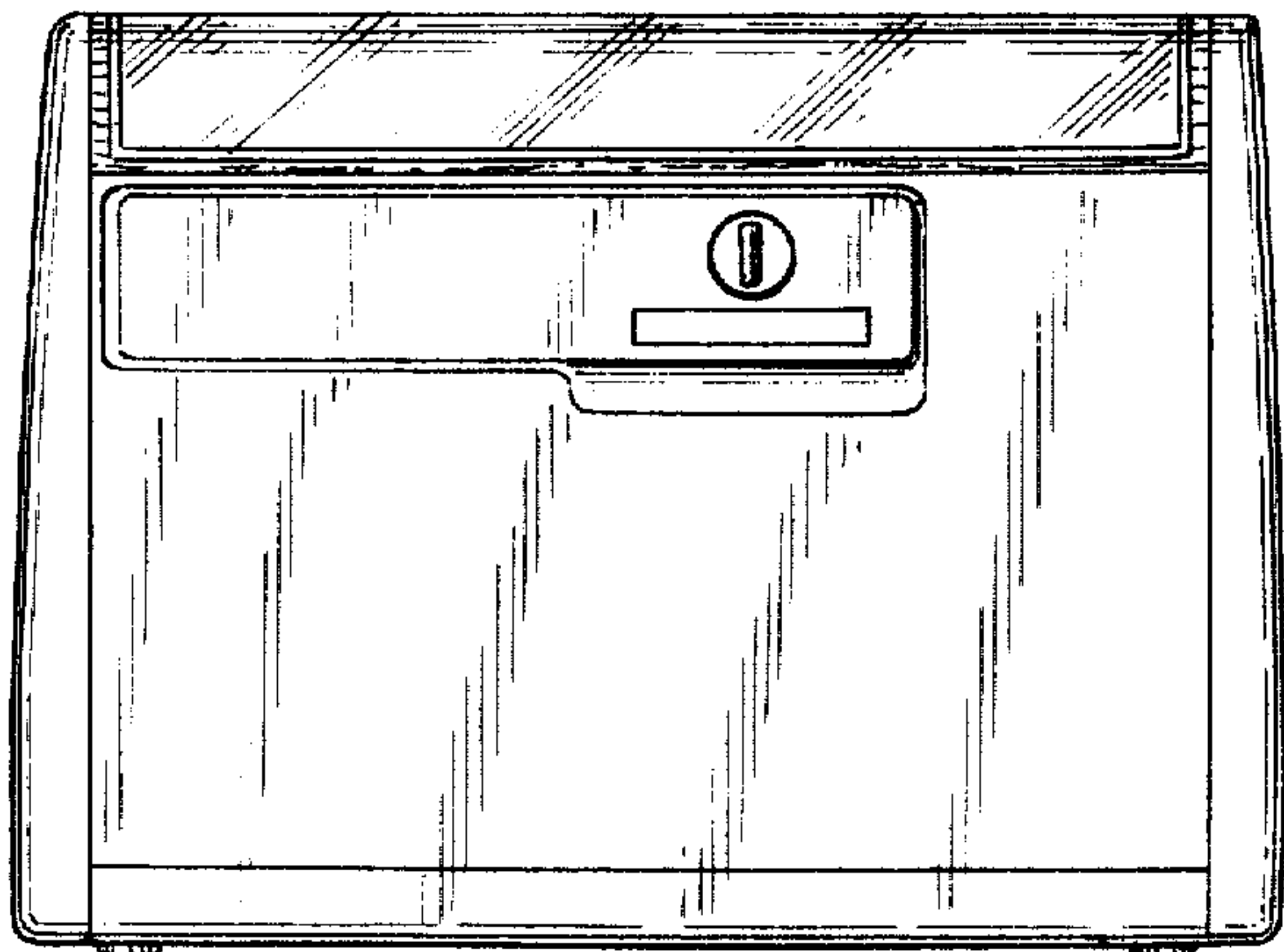
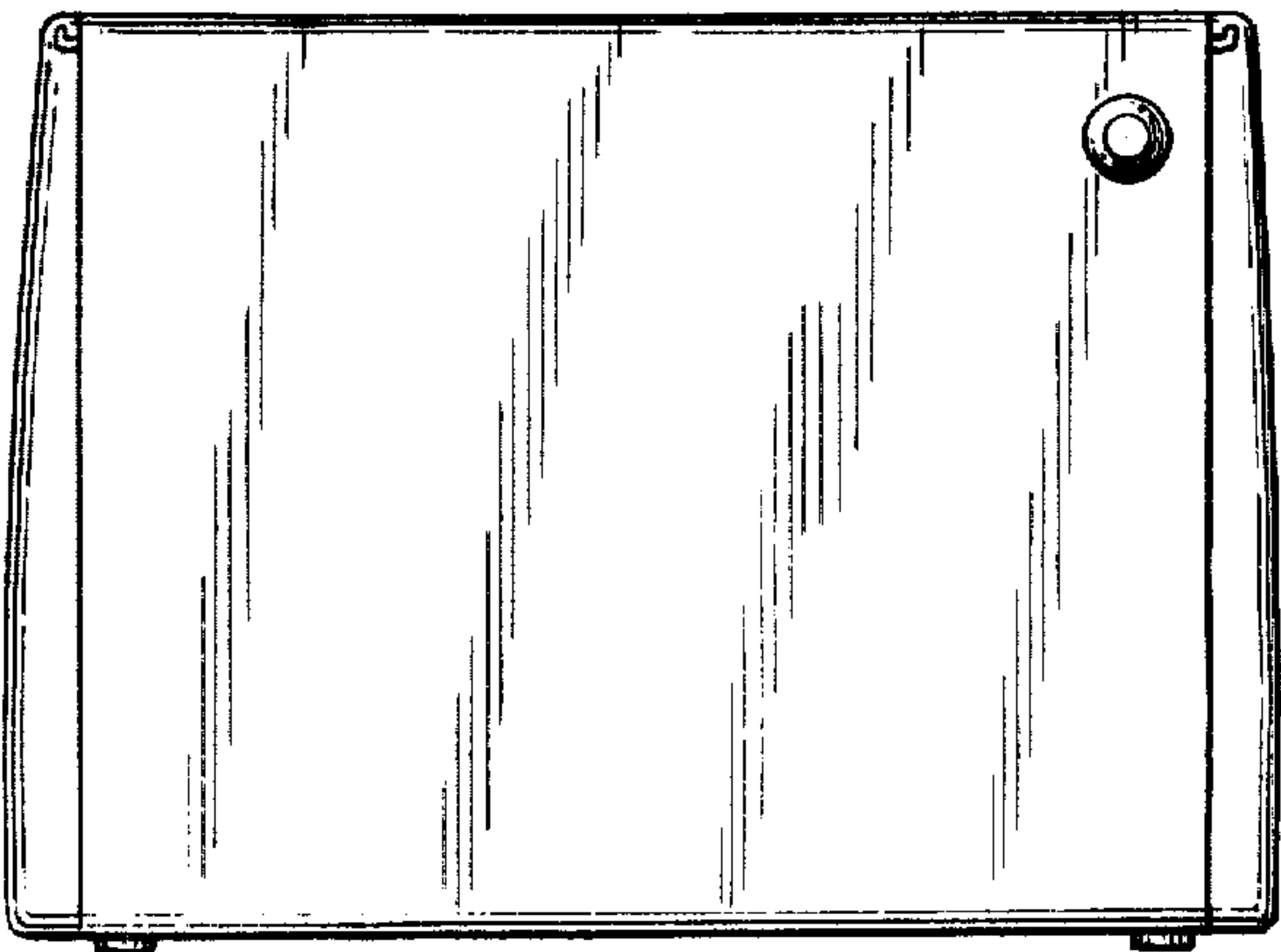
