[57] CLAIM


The ornamental design for a pearl necklace or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a fragmentary front elevational view of a pearl necklace or similar article, showing my new design portions of the chain being omitted for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a fragmentary top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a fragmentary bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof the chain being omitted for convenience of illustration and, the opposite side being the same.
