[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bass guitar or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bass guitar or similar article showing my design;  
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the body of the guitar.

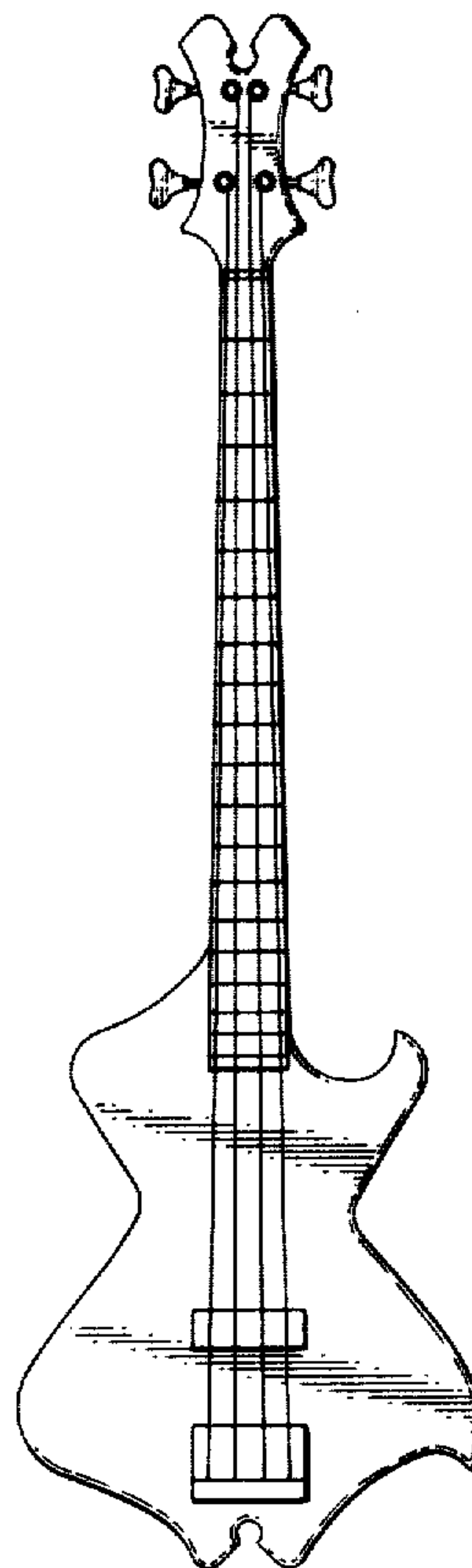

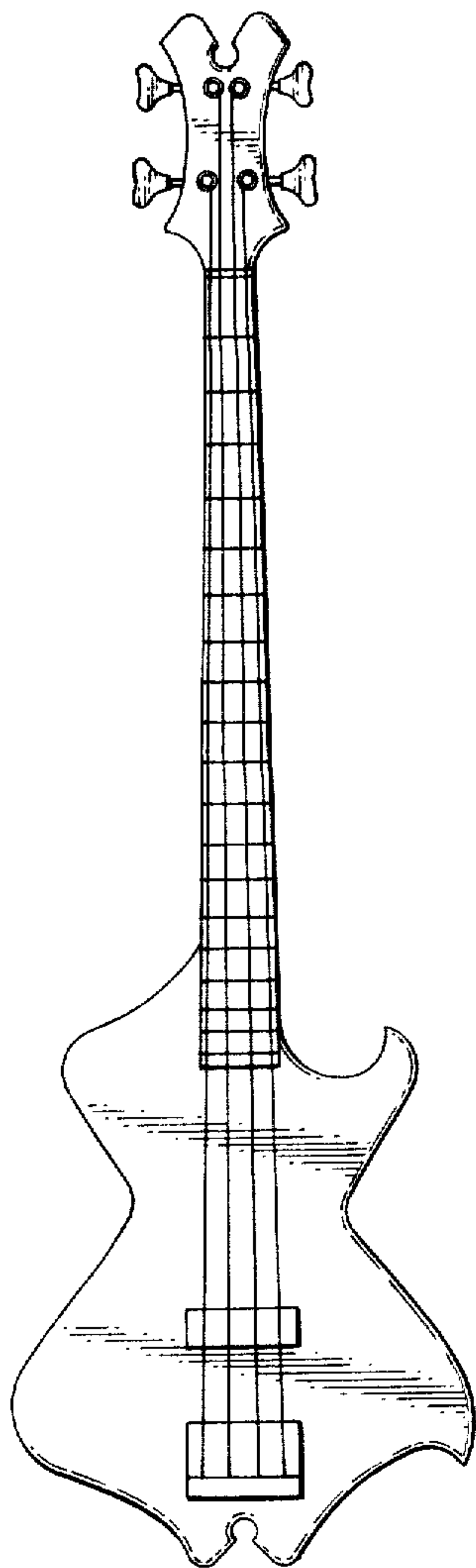

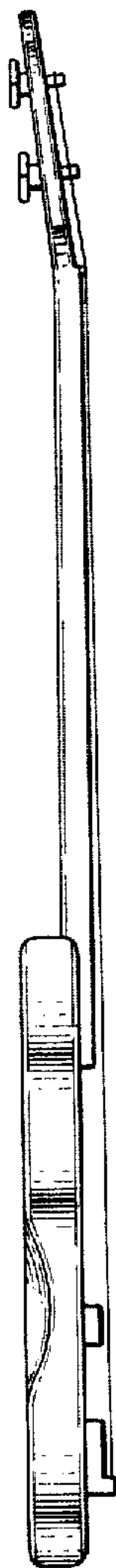

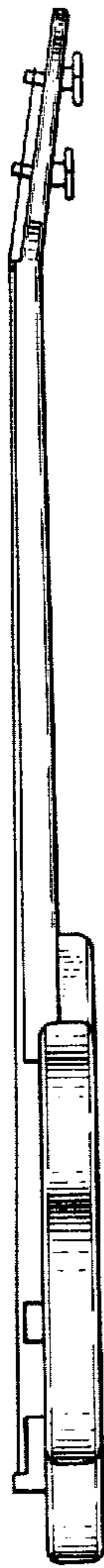
