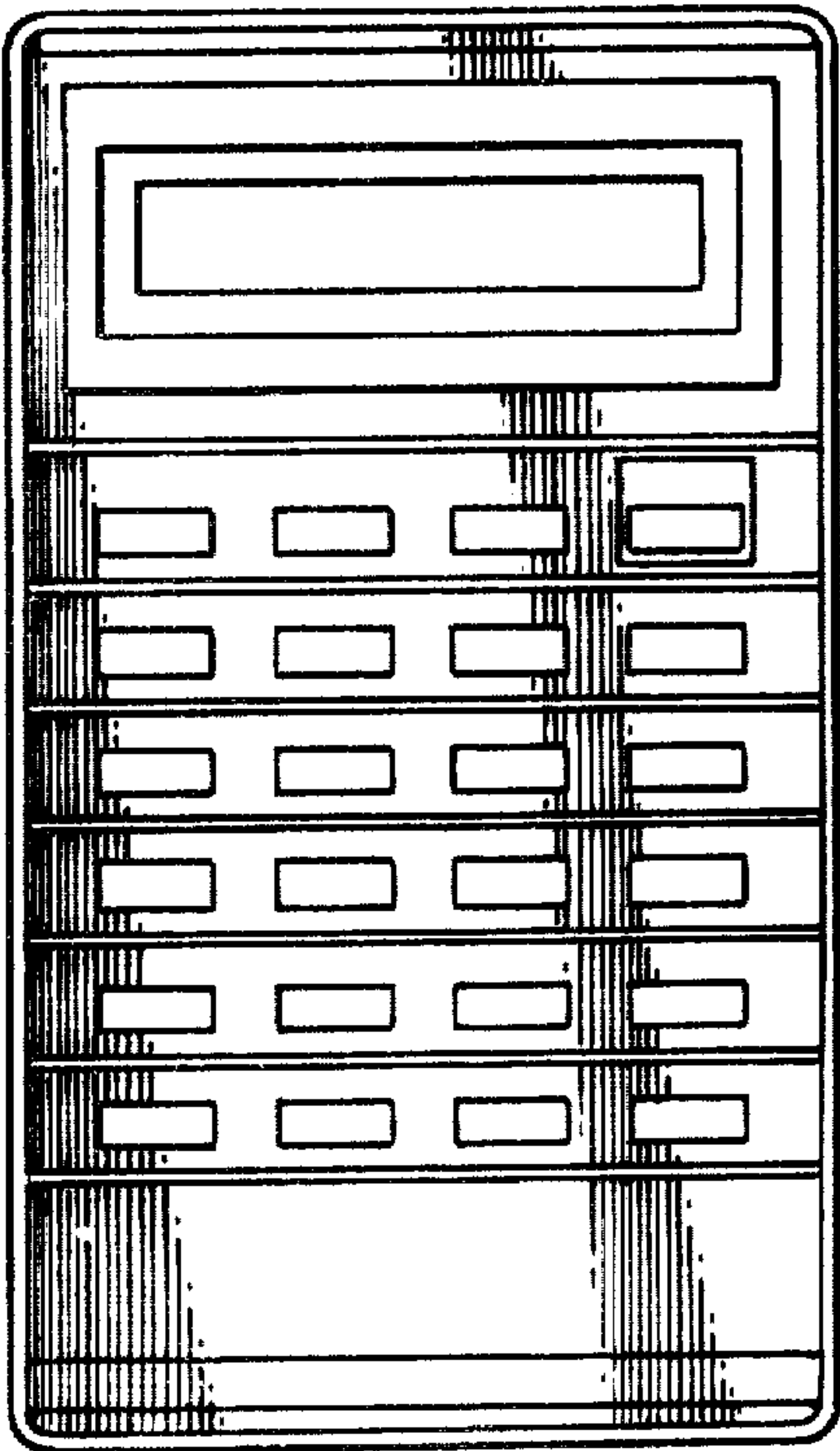

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of an electronic calculating machine showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a top perspective view thereof.



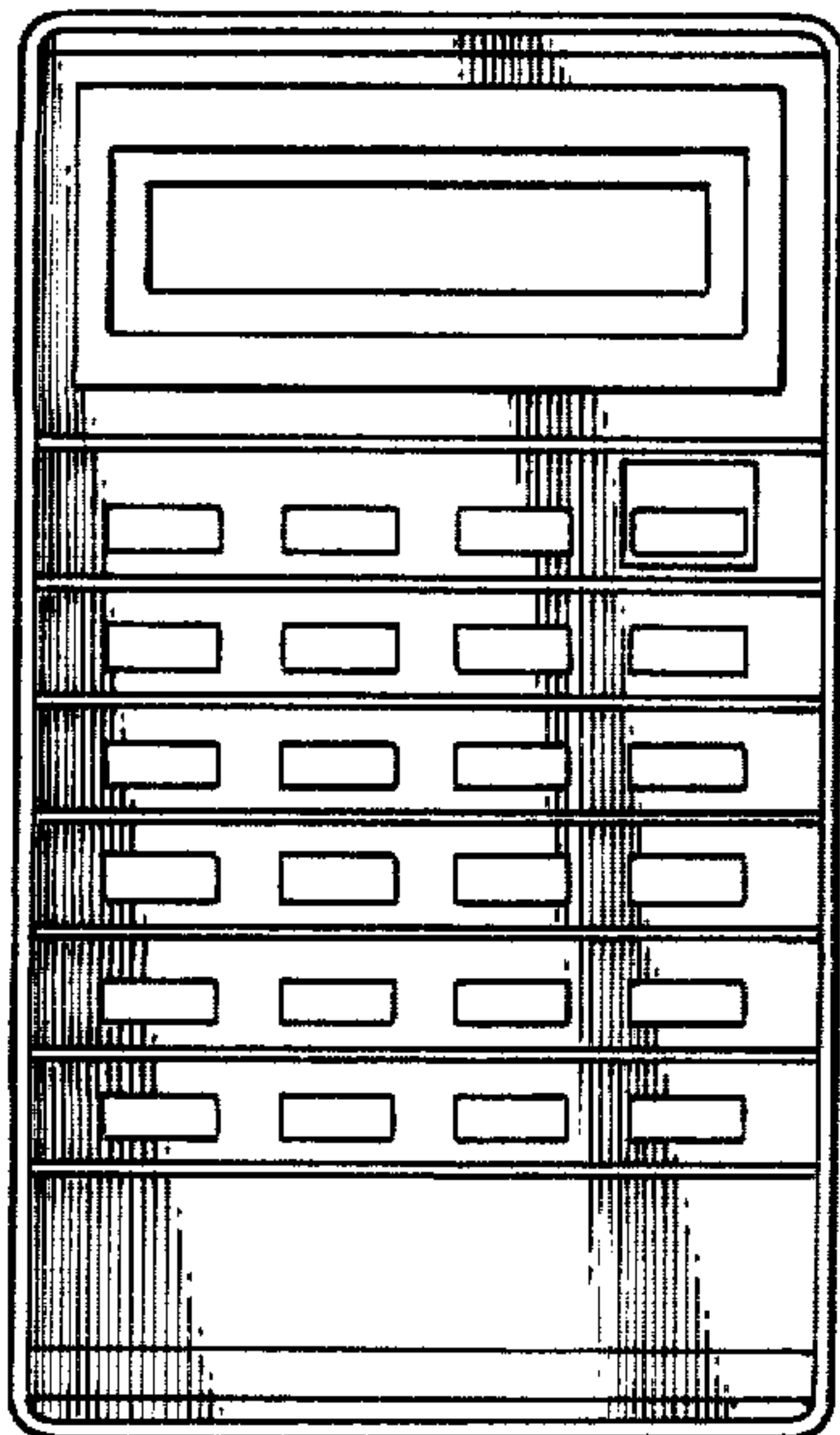

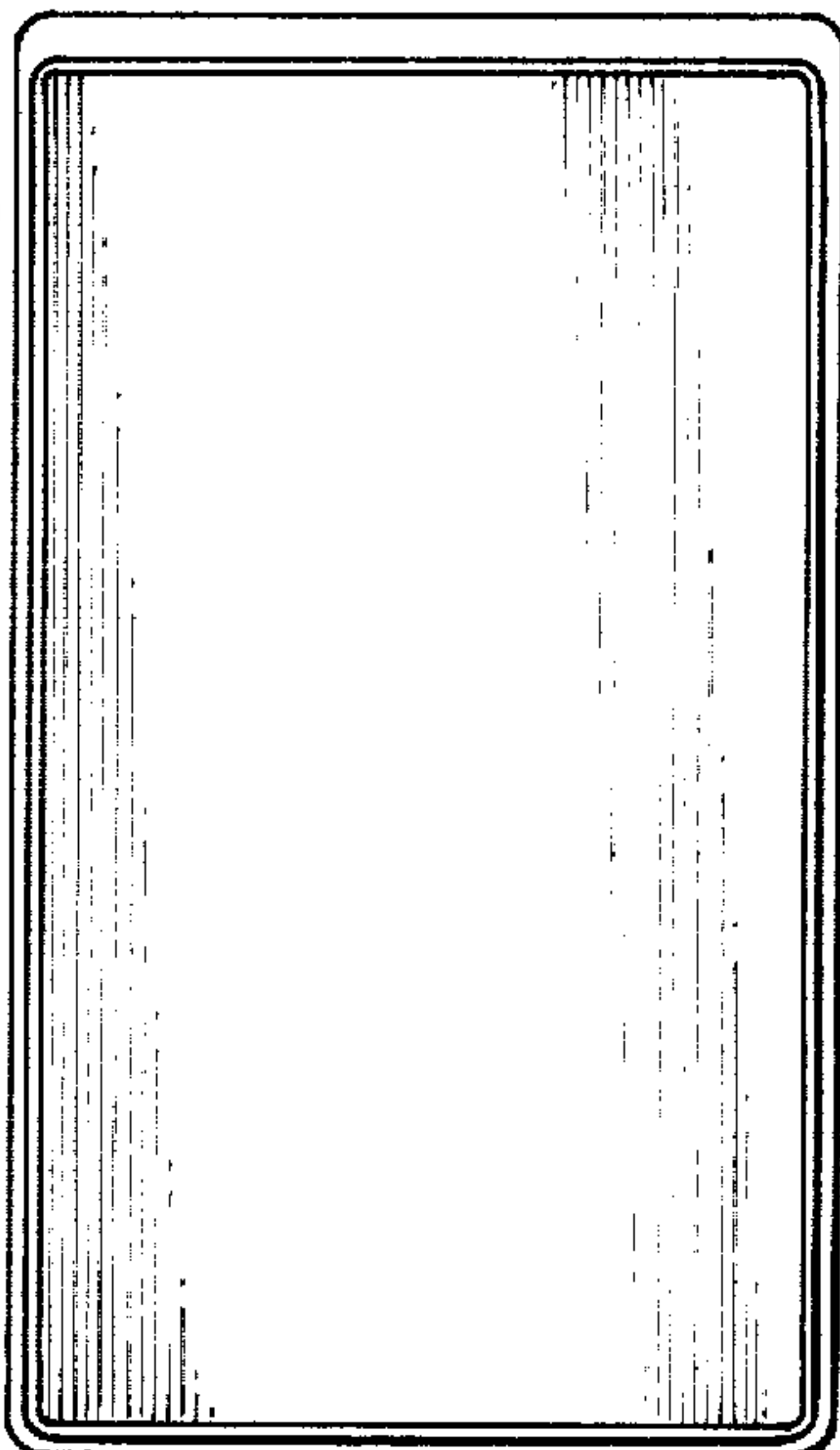

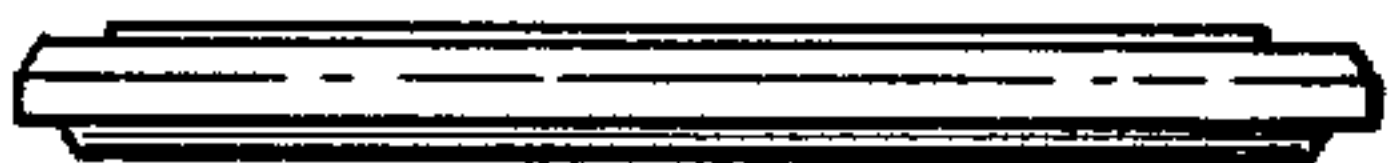

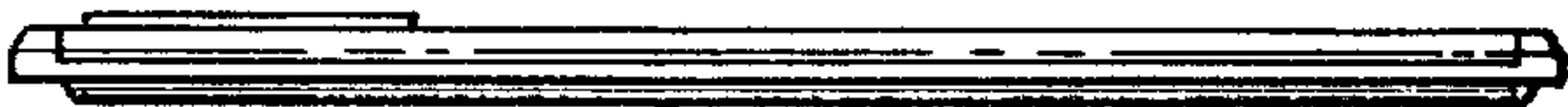

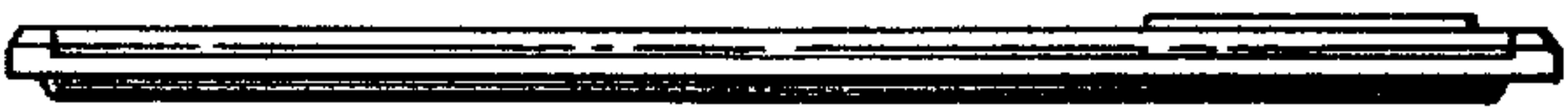
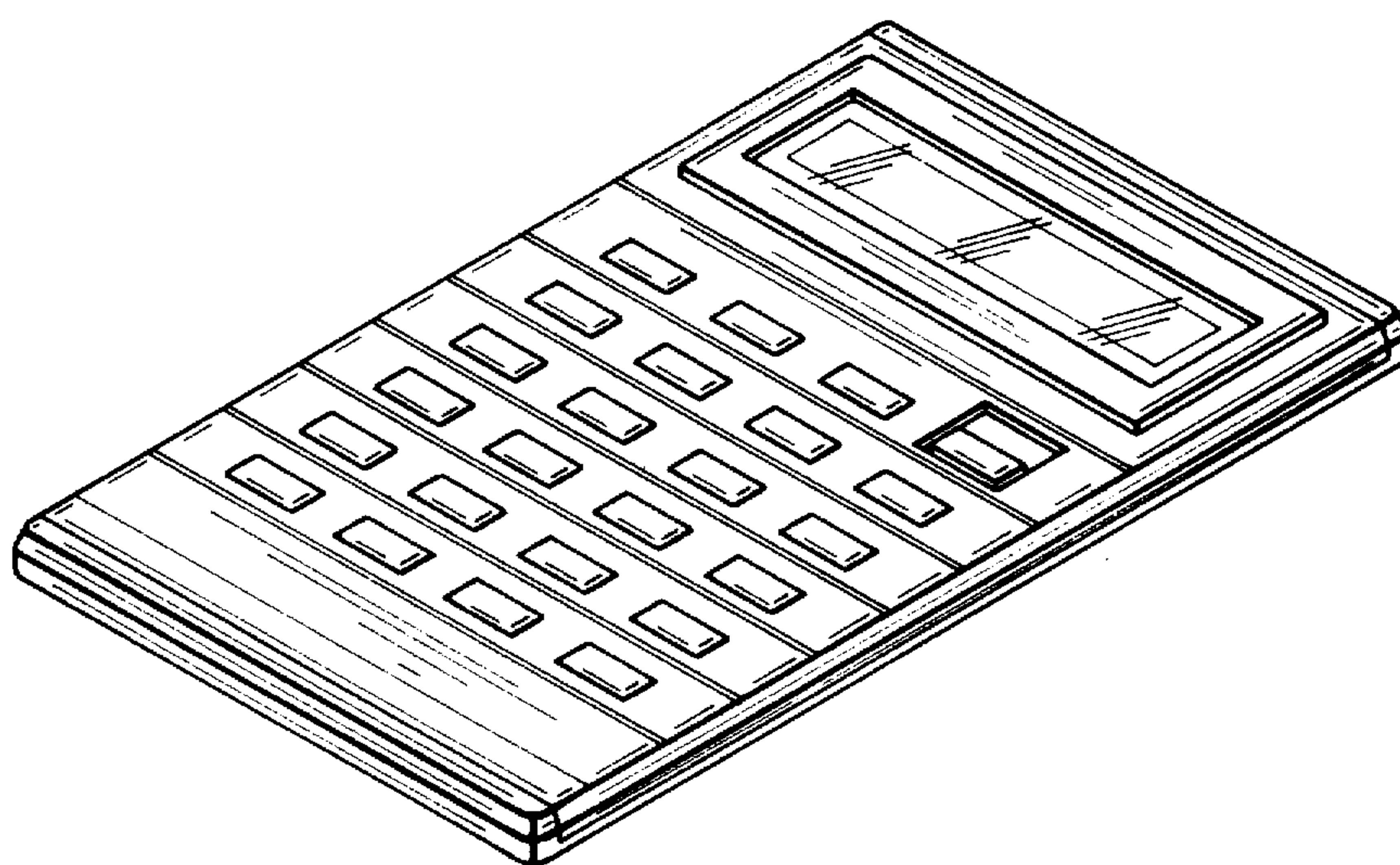
