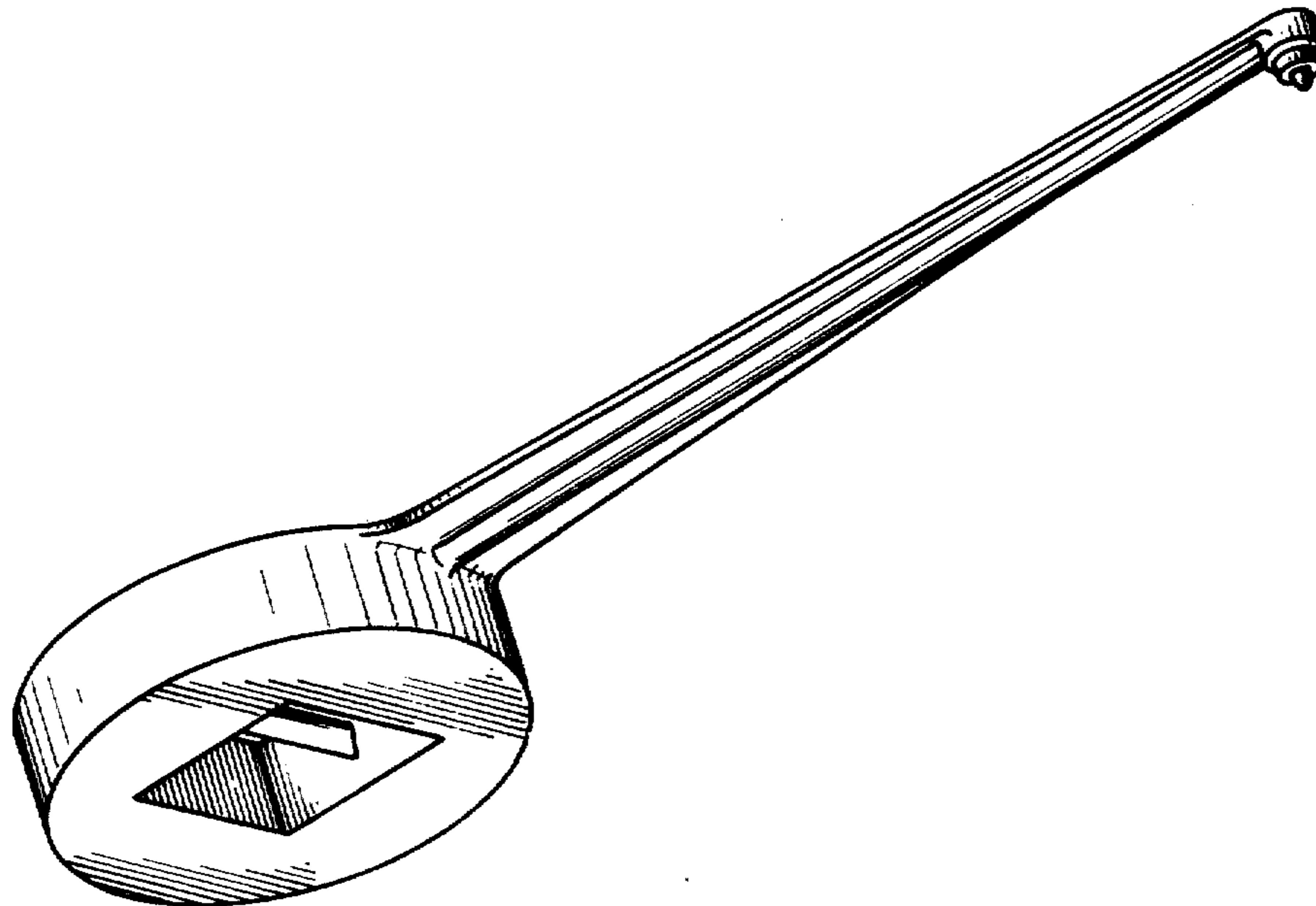

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a disposable recording pen with ink reservoir, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a disposable recording pen with ink reservoir showing my new design.
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof.
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof.
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.
The appearance of the right-hand side is a mirror image of that shown in FIG. 2.



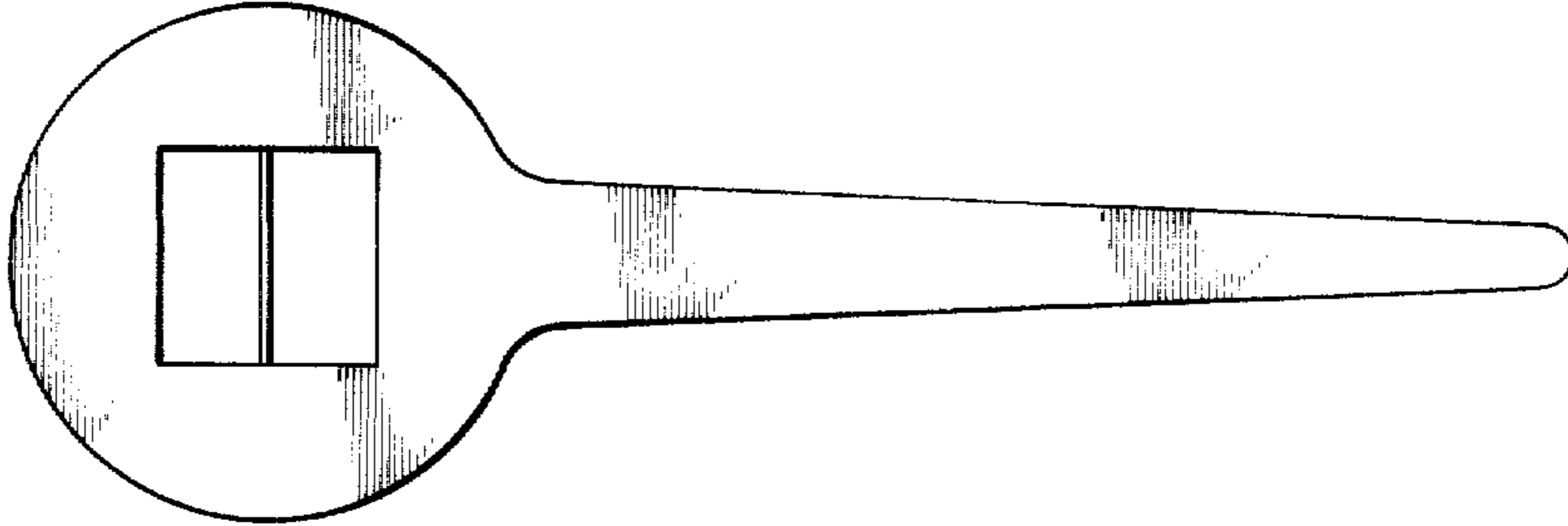

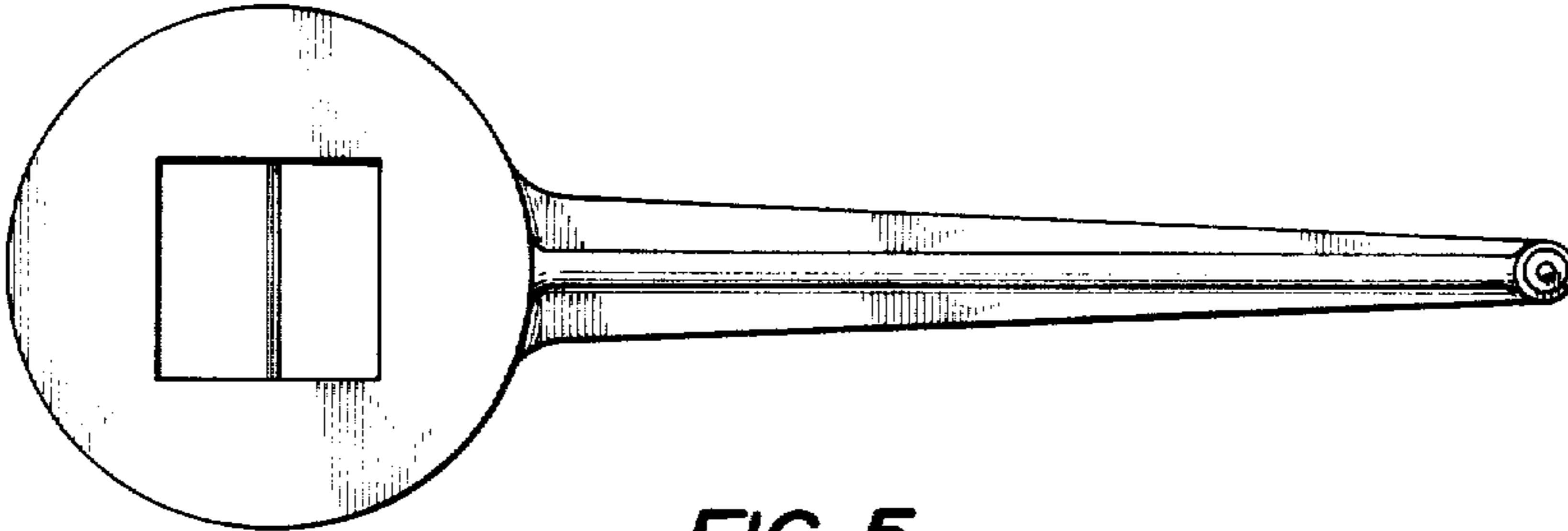

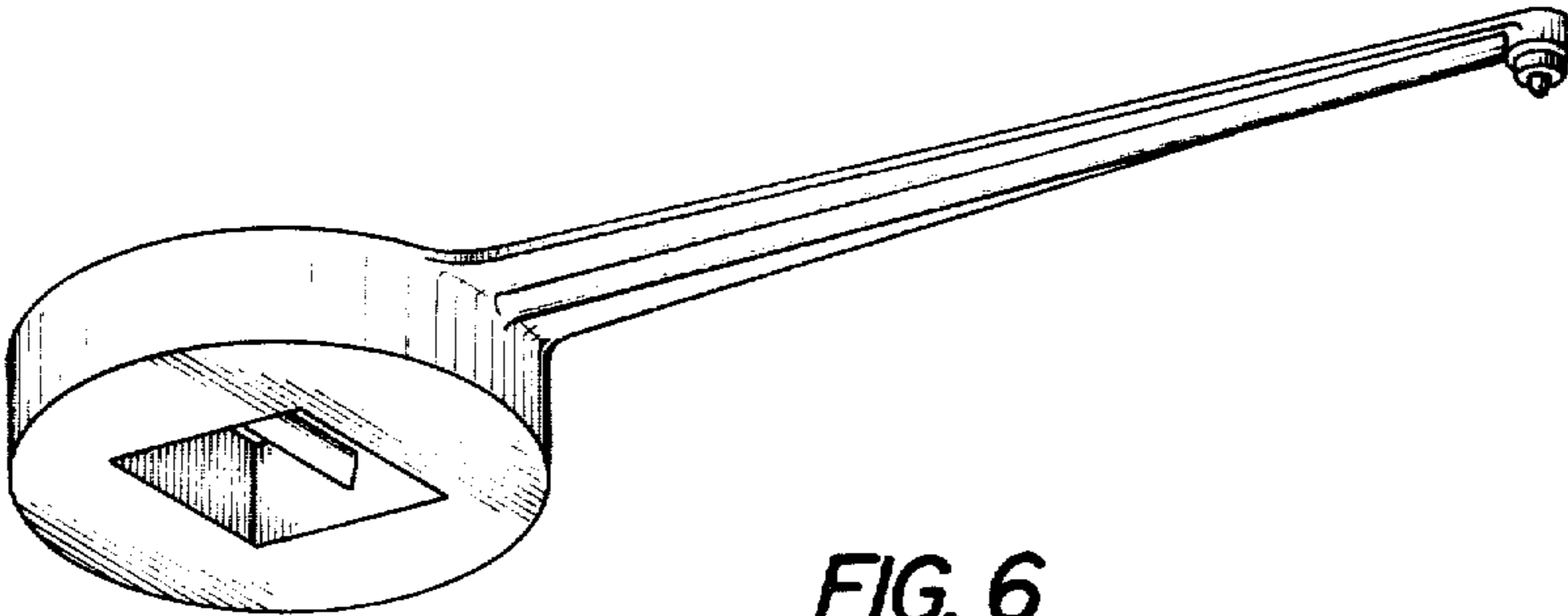
