DESCRIPTION

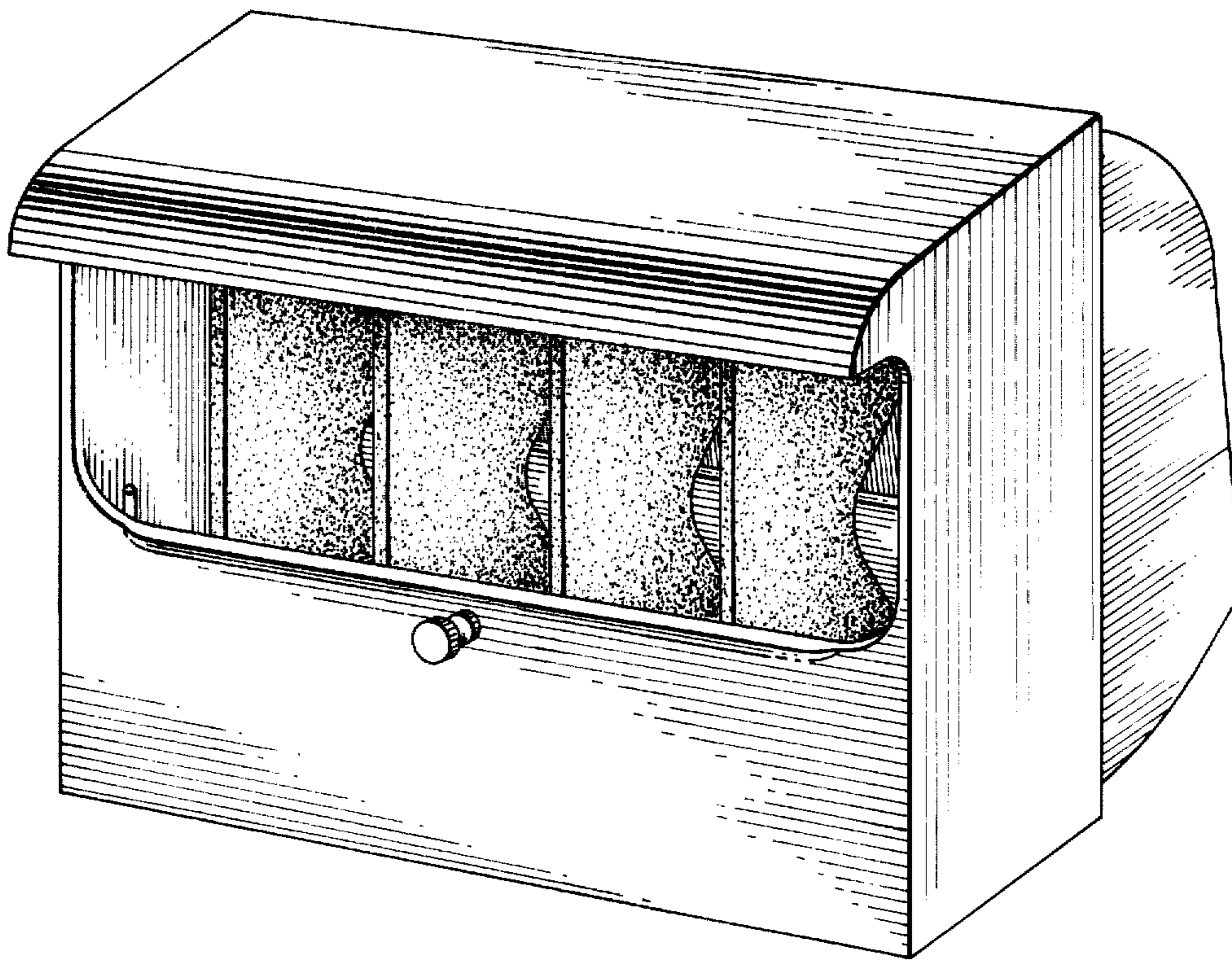
FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side of a room humidifier showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

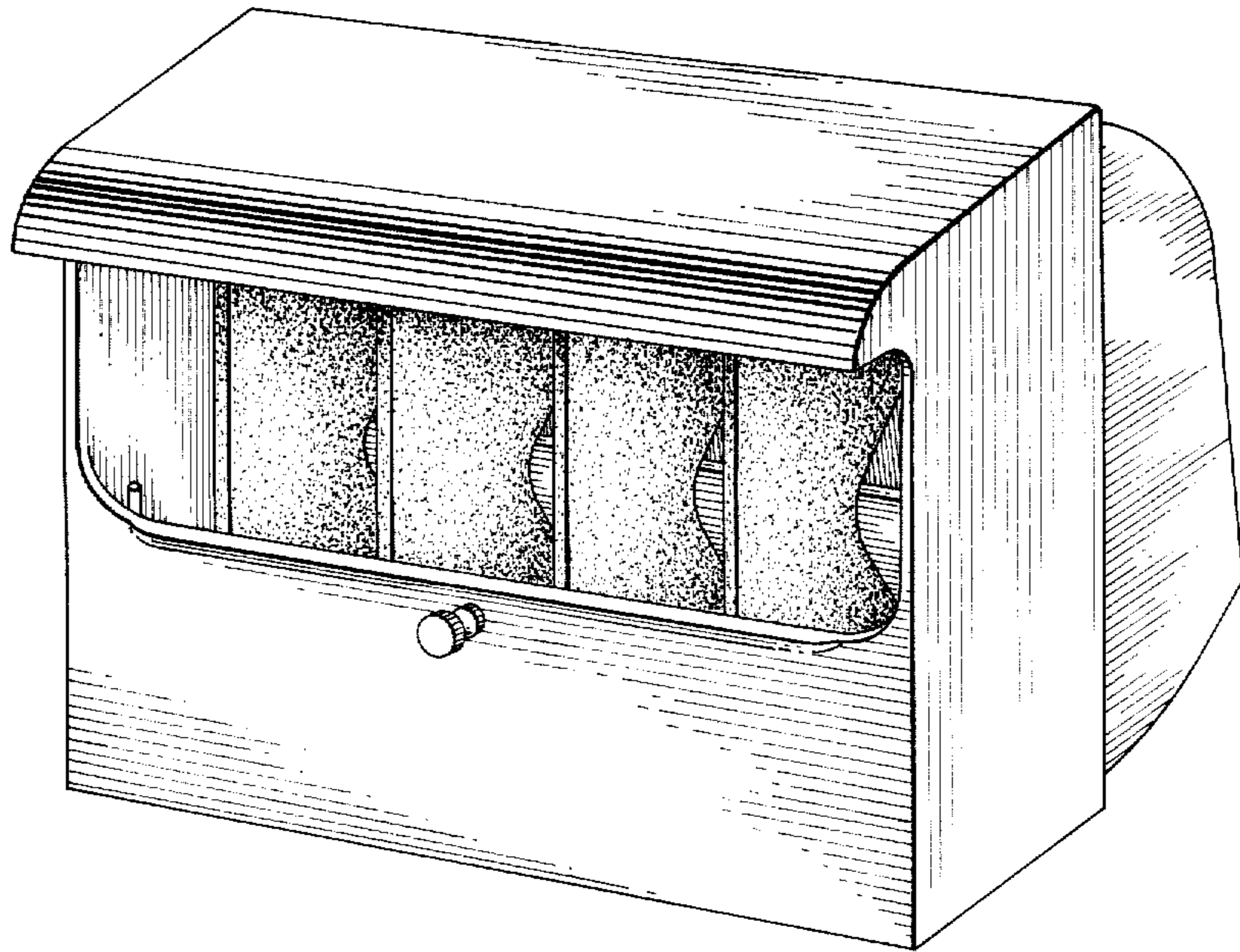
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

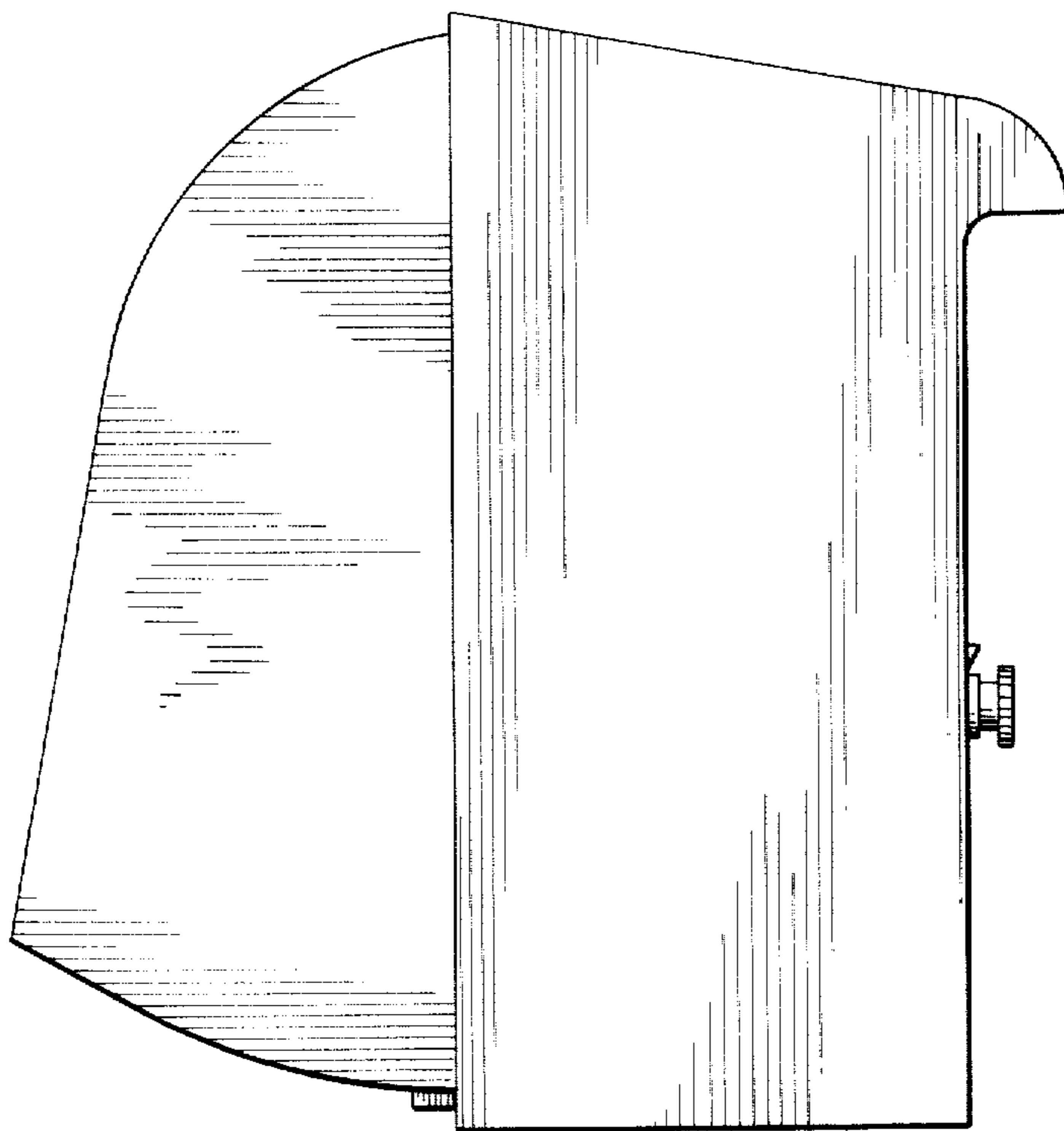
FIG. 5 is an exploded perspective view thereof.



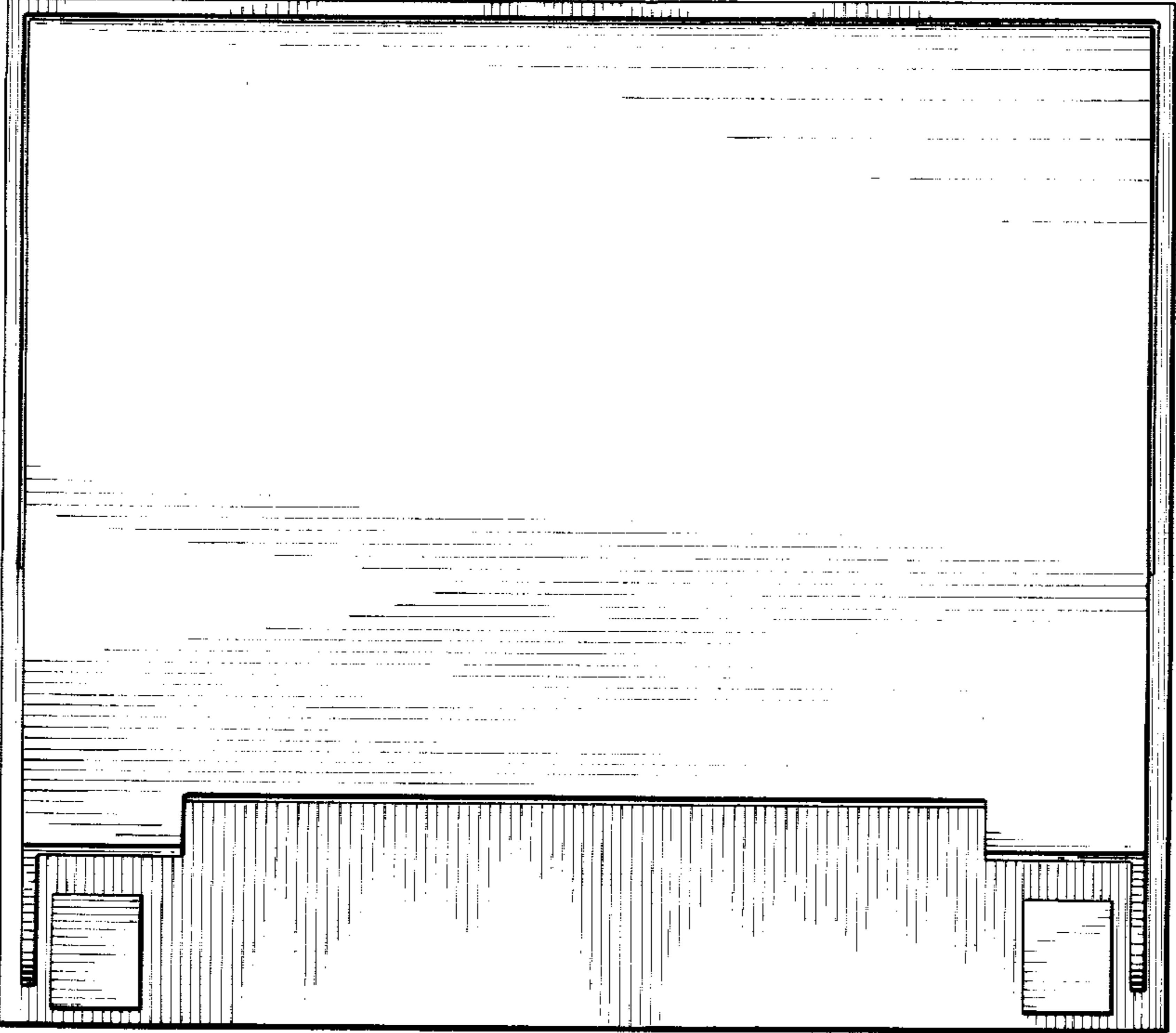

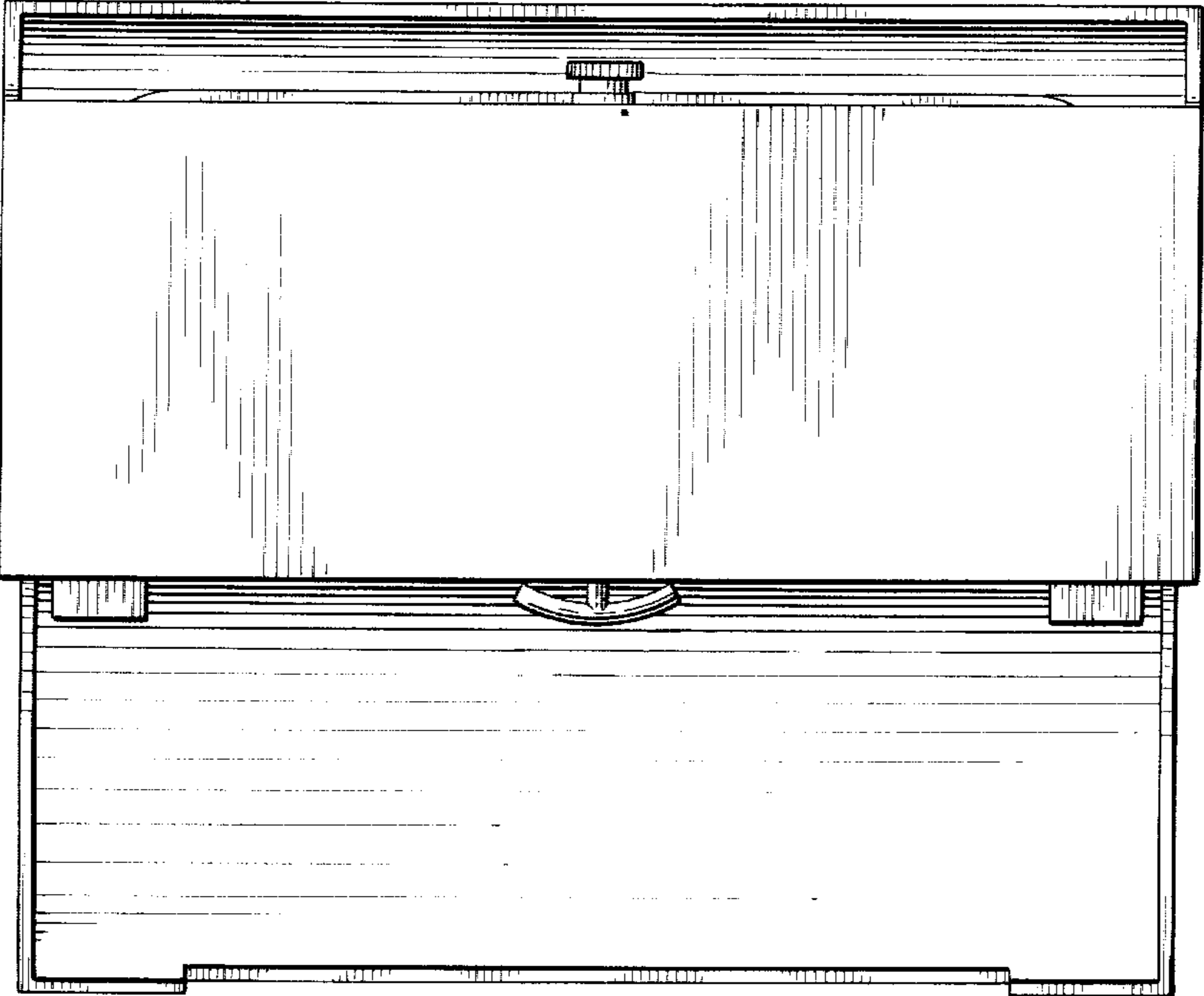
