[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a chair showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof, the undisclosed side being substantially identical with the side shown;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a cross section taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 2;
FIG. 6 is a second embodiment of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a side elevation view of FIG. 6;
FIG. 8 is a third embodiment of FIG. 1;
FIG. 9 is a second embodiment of FIG. 2, the sole difference being the chair is covered with a padded unit;
FIG. 10 is a third embodiment of FIG. 2, the sole difference being the back is curved; and
FIG. 11 is a top view of FIG. 8.
The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side shown.
