[57] **CLAIM**

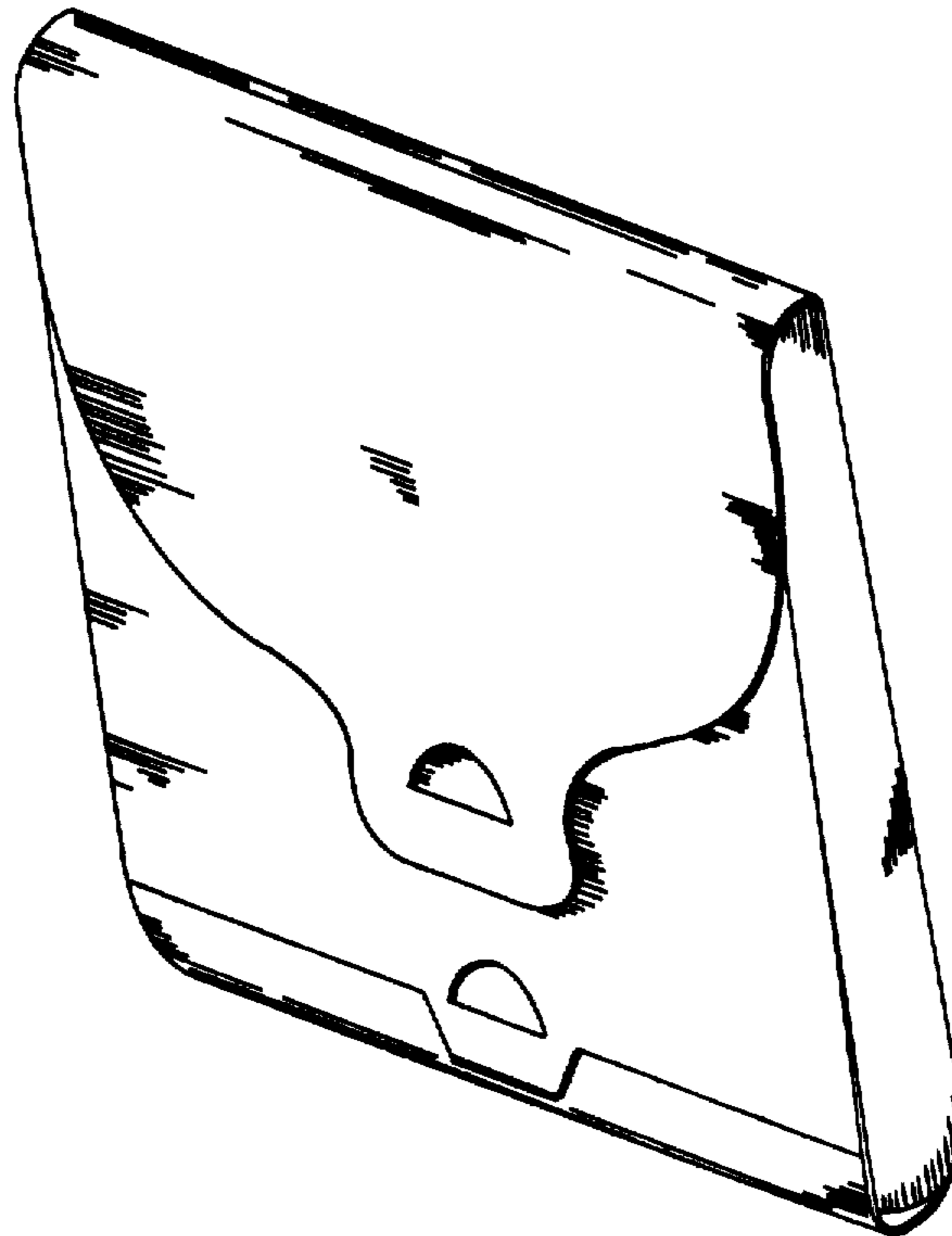
The ornamental design for a brassiere display package, substantially as shown.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a brassiere display package showing our new design;

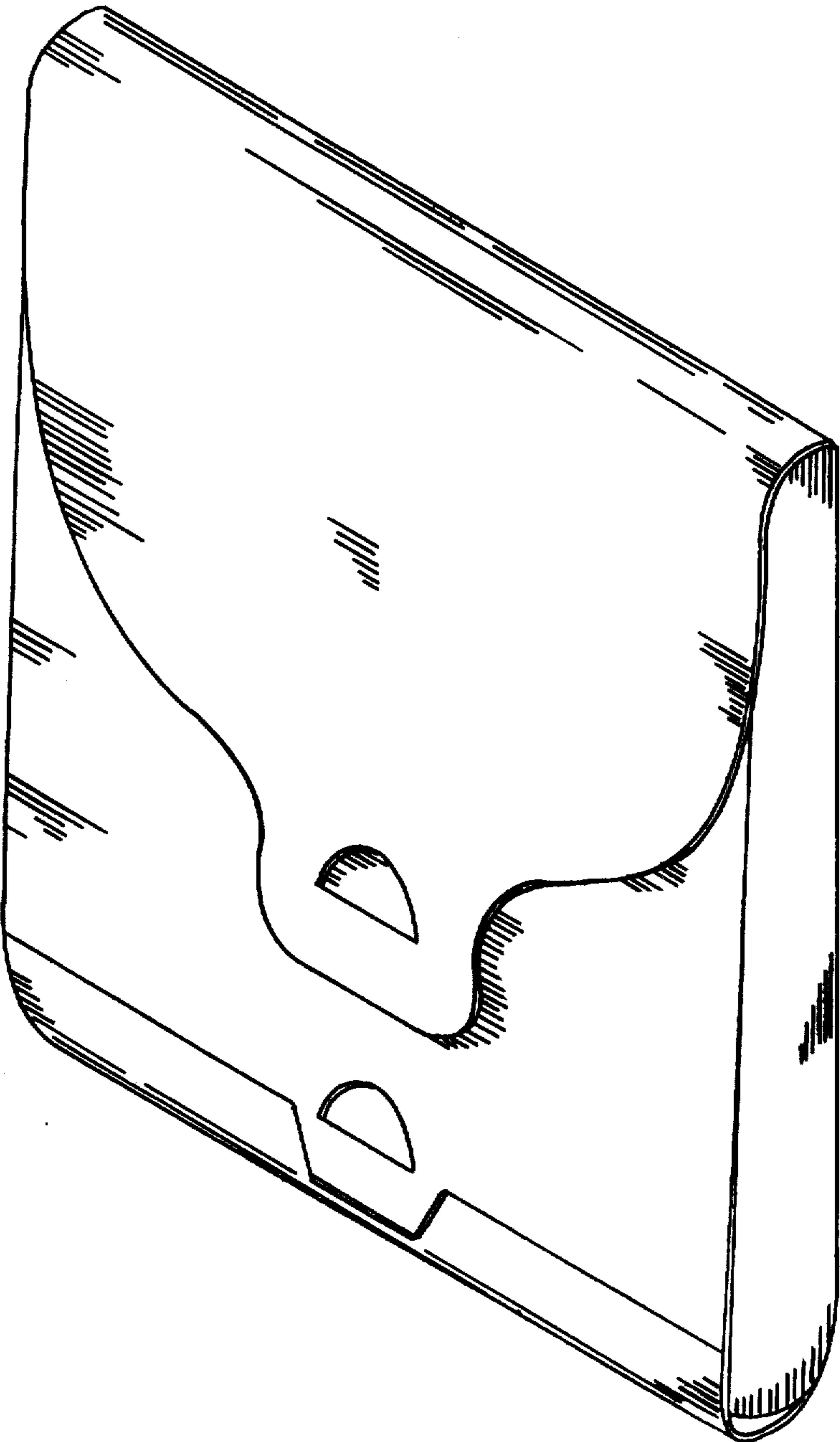

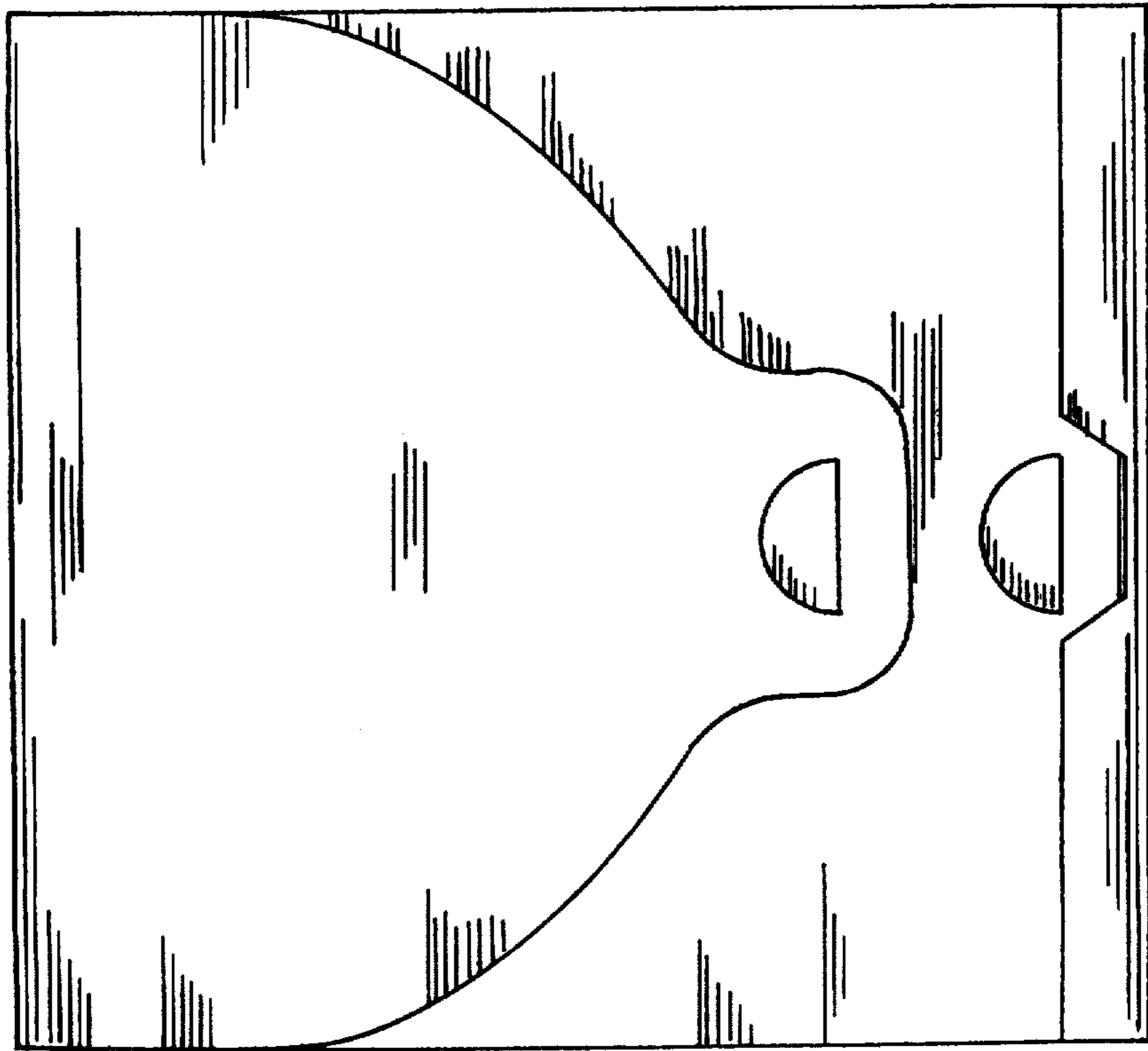
