FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a paper shredder or the like showing my new design;

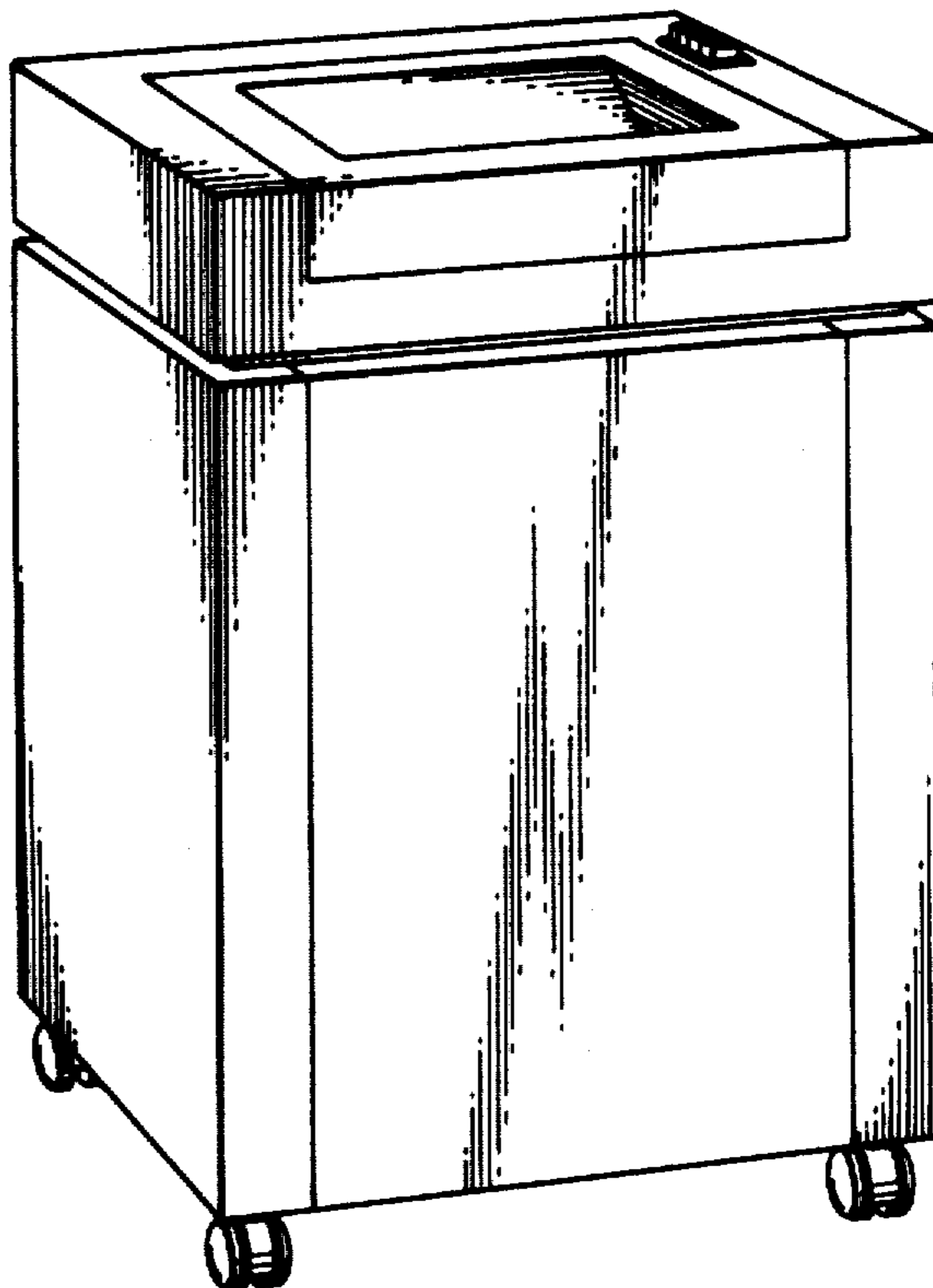
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1, the side opposite being a mirror image thereof;

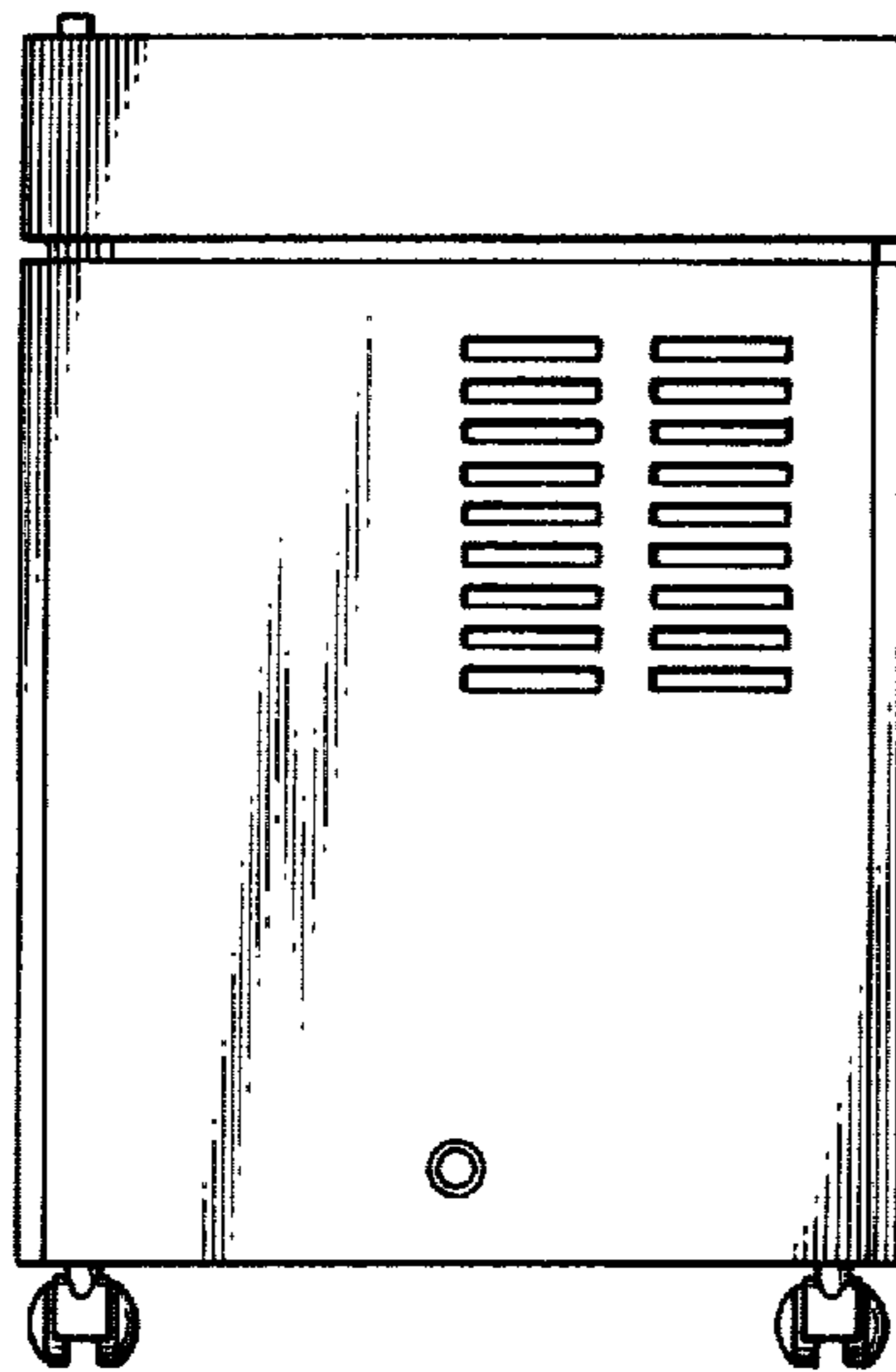
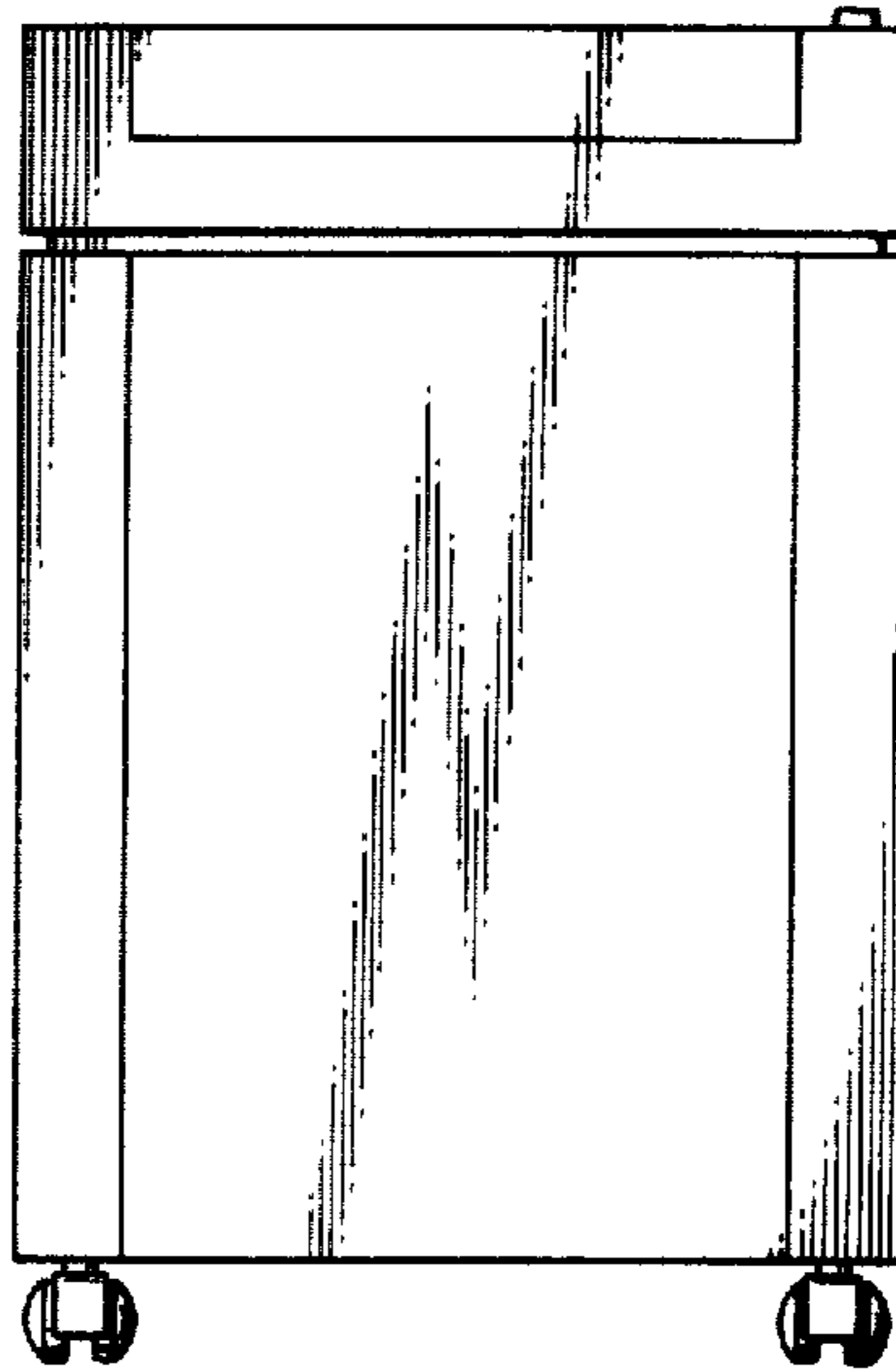
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

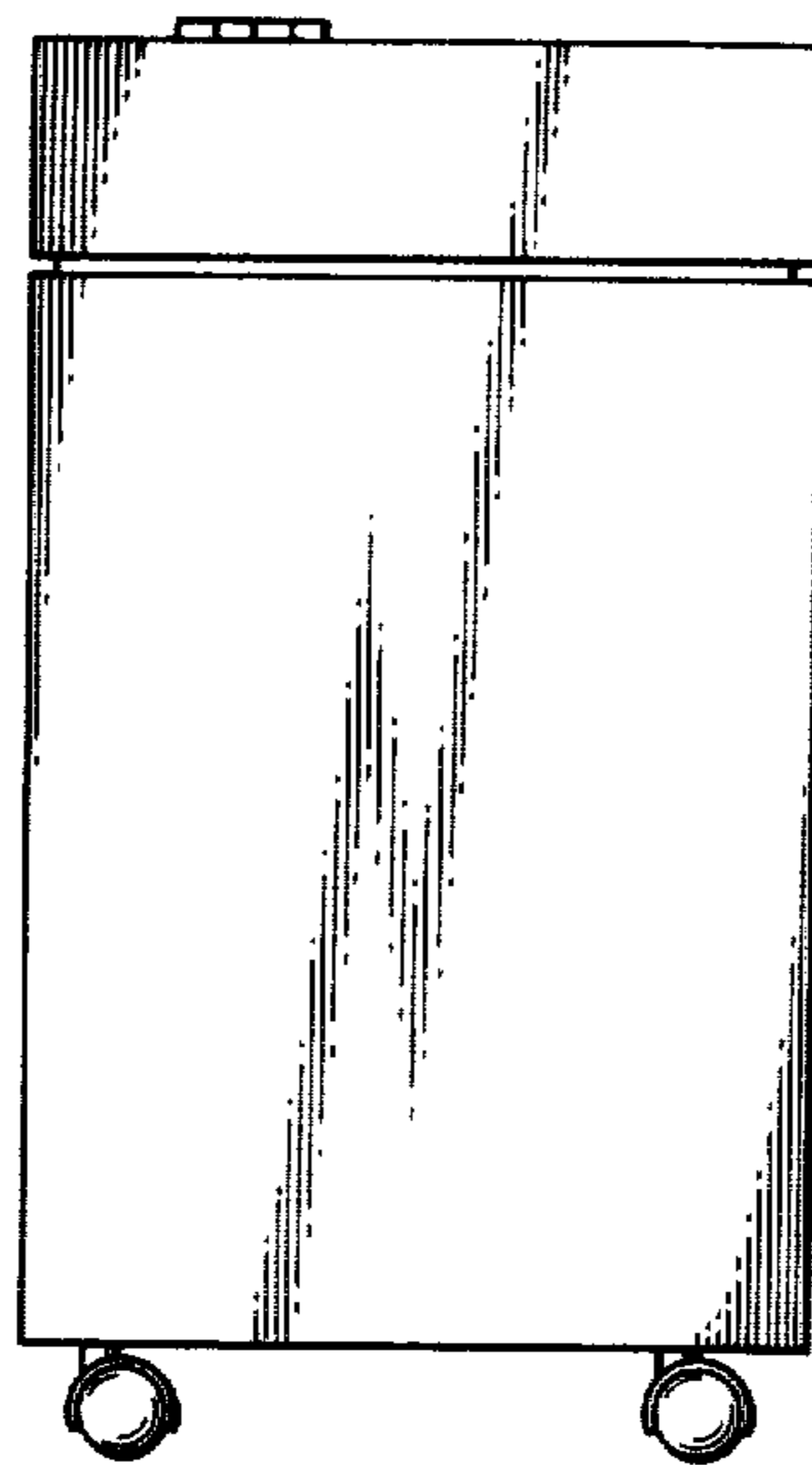

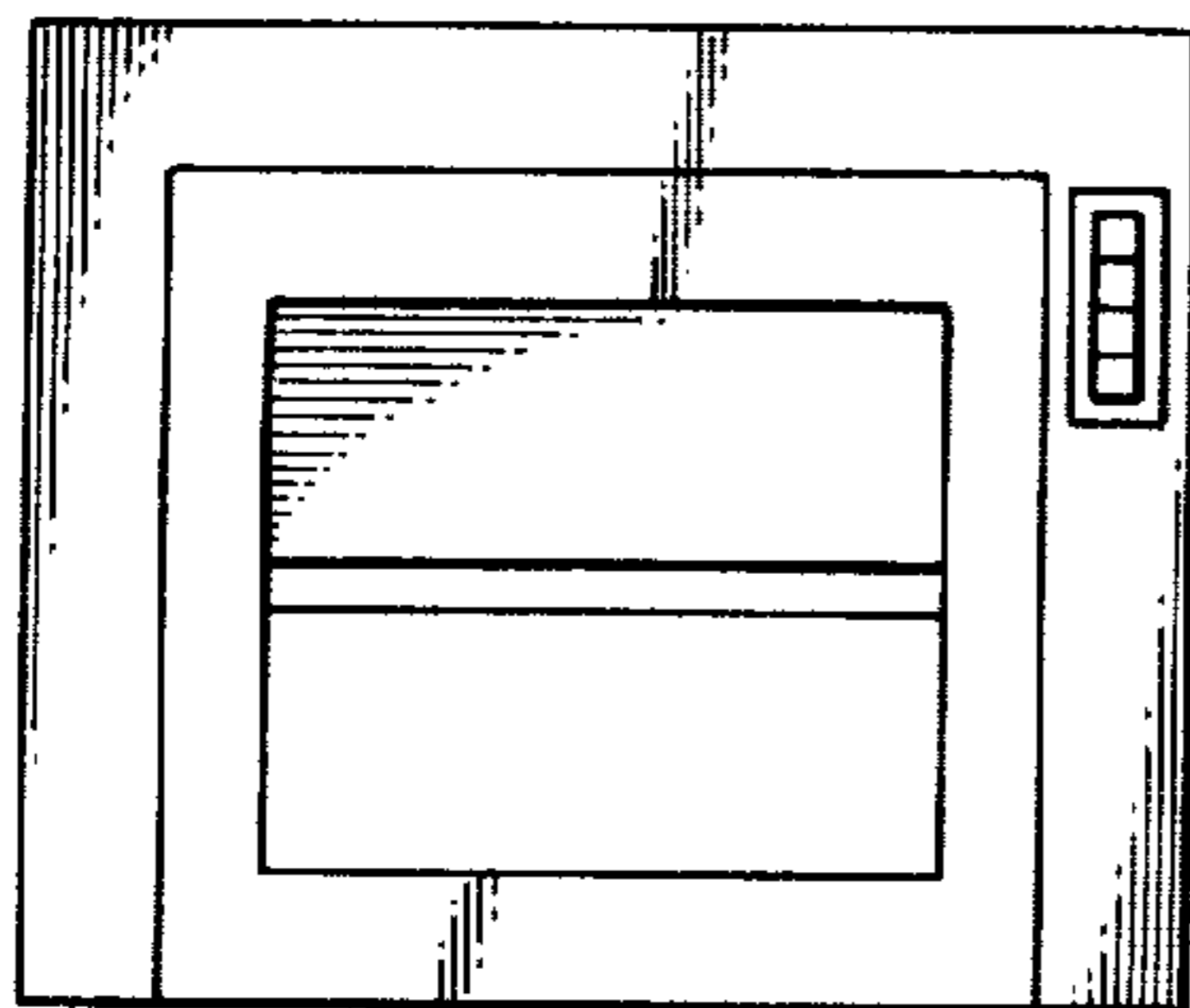

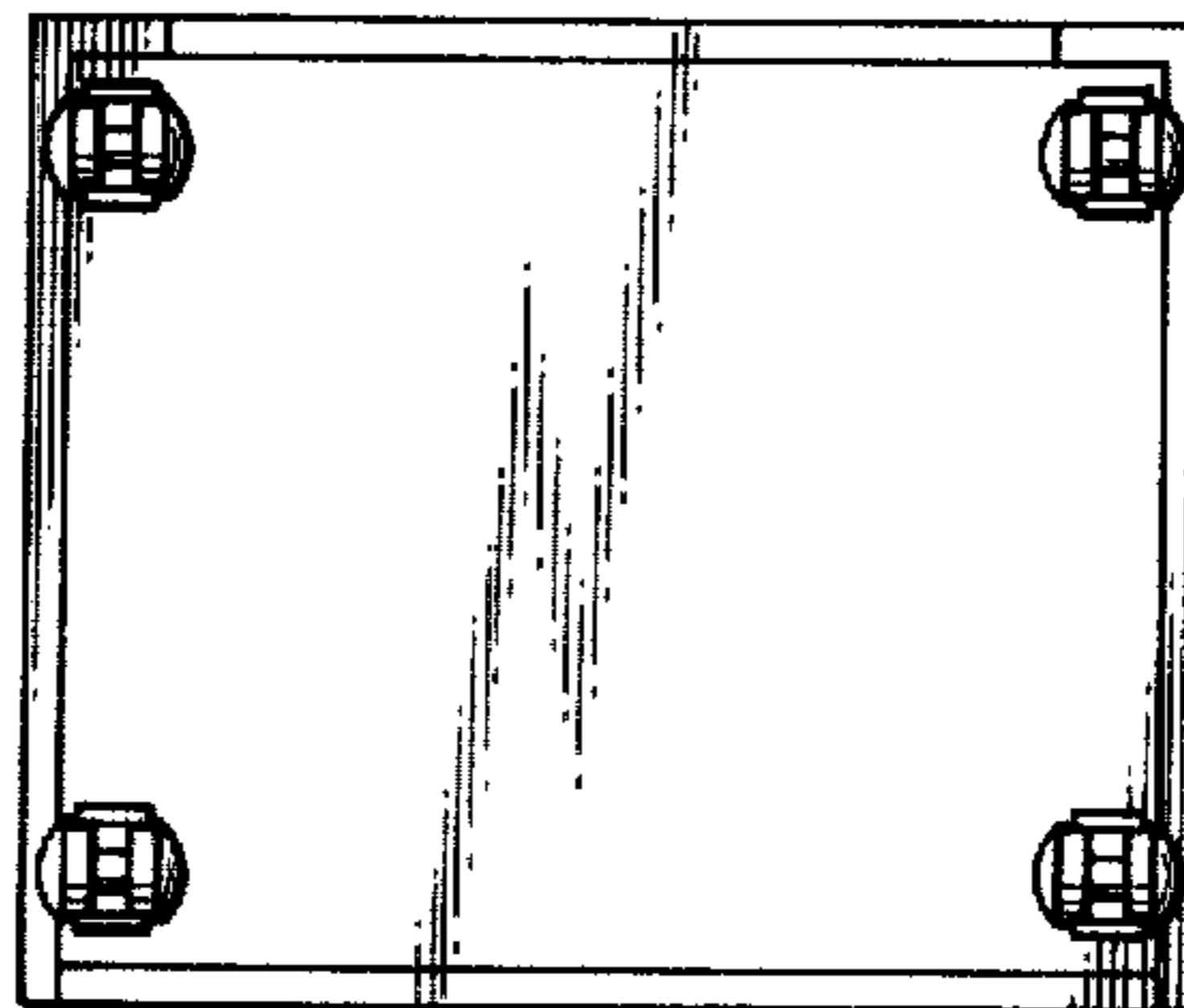
