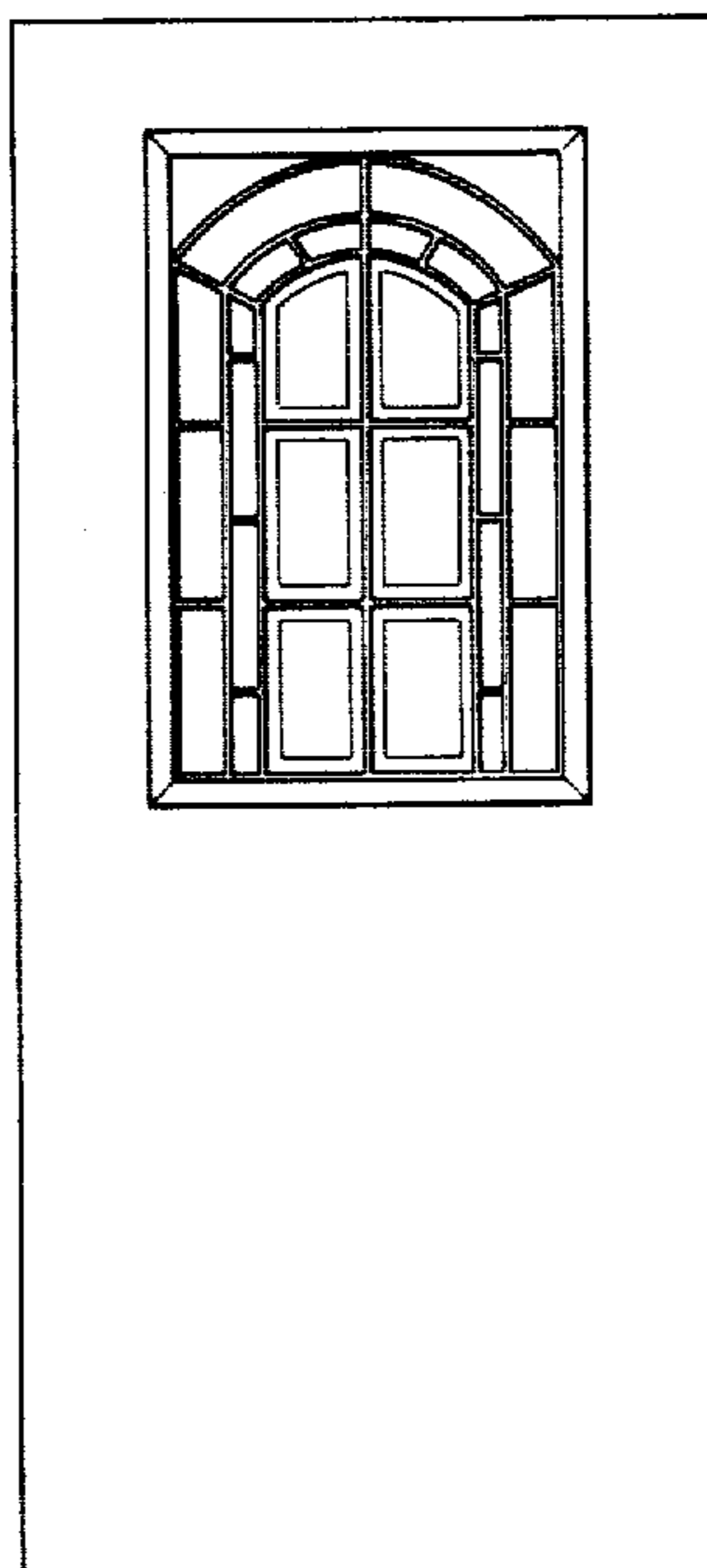
**CLAIM**
