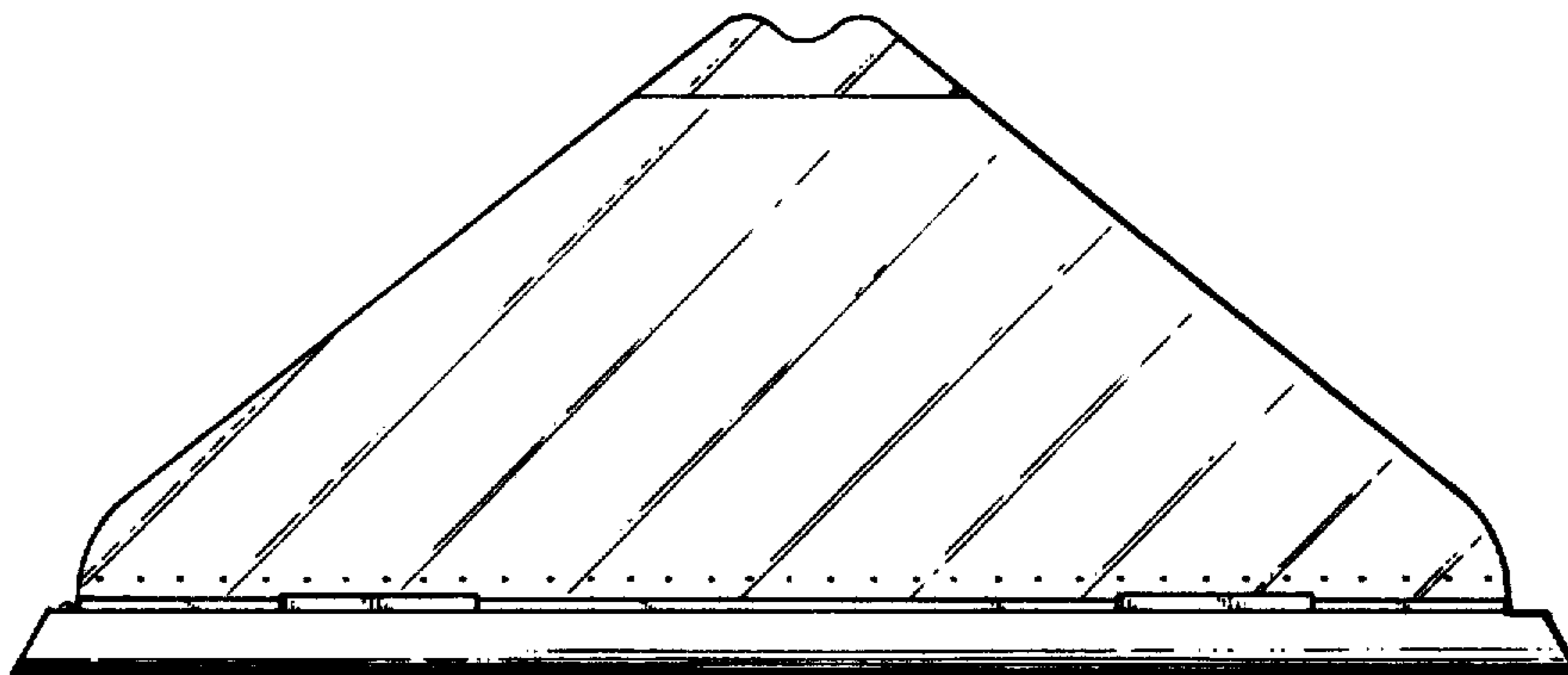
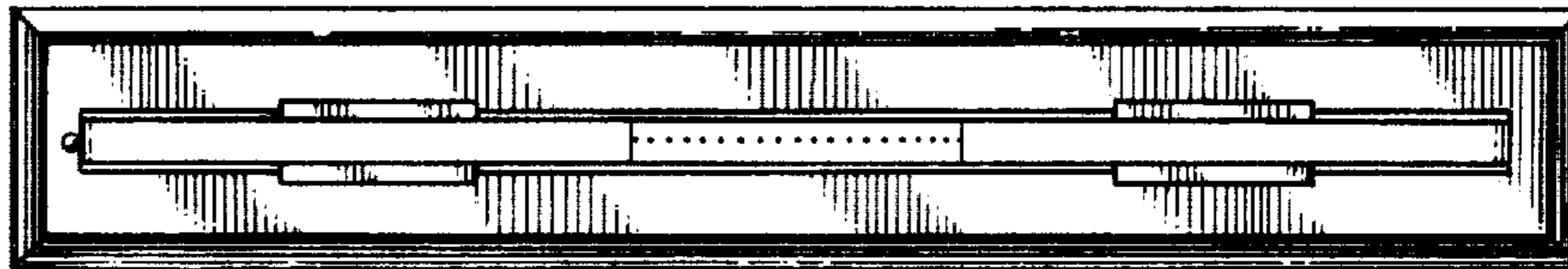

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an antfarm showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being the same as the front shown;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 4 is an elevational view taken from one side thereof, the opposite side being the same as the side shown.



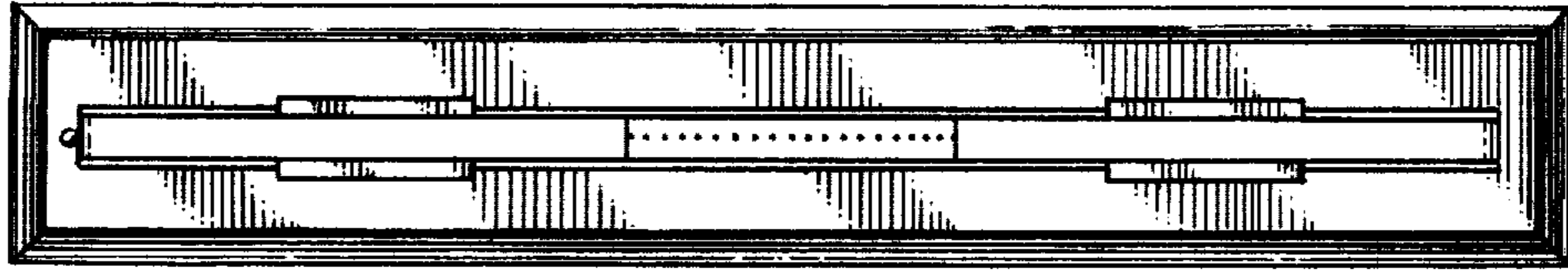

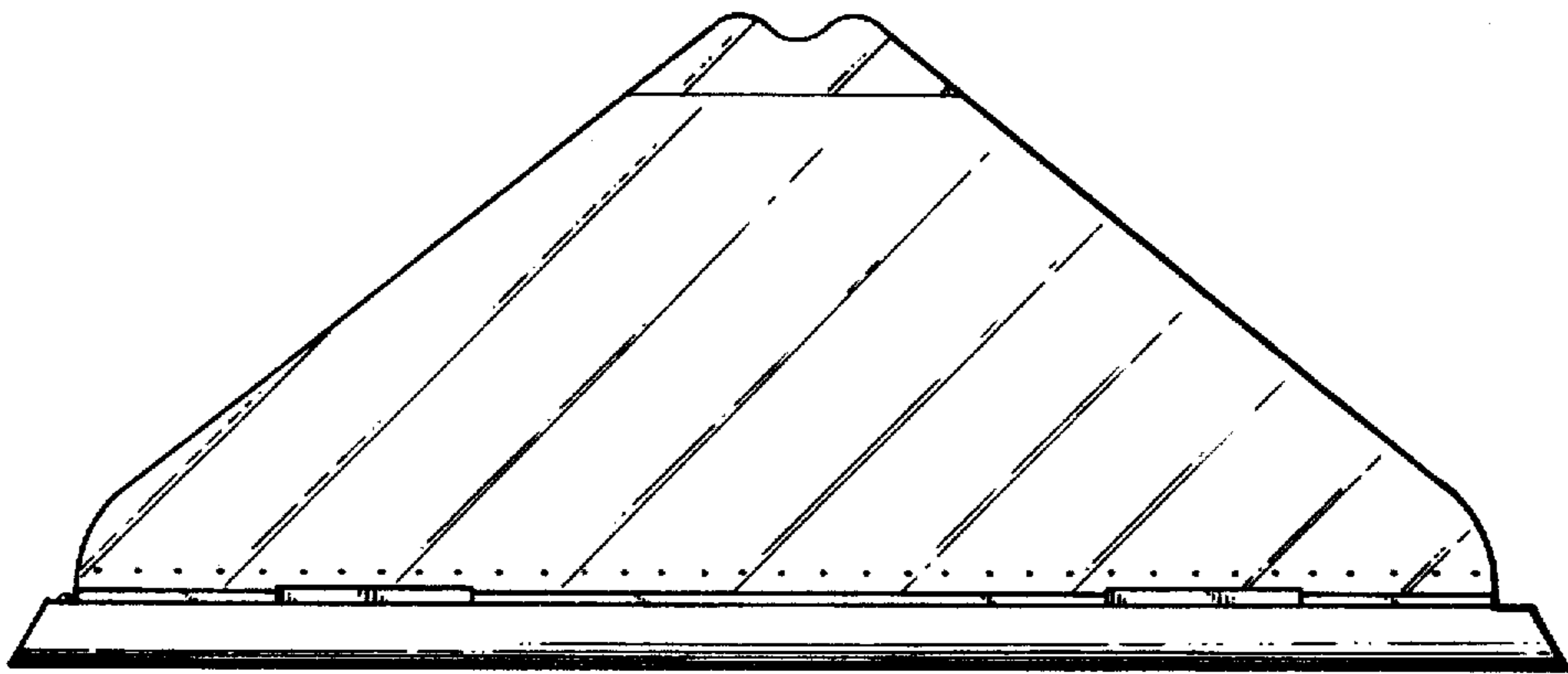

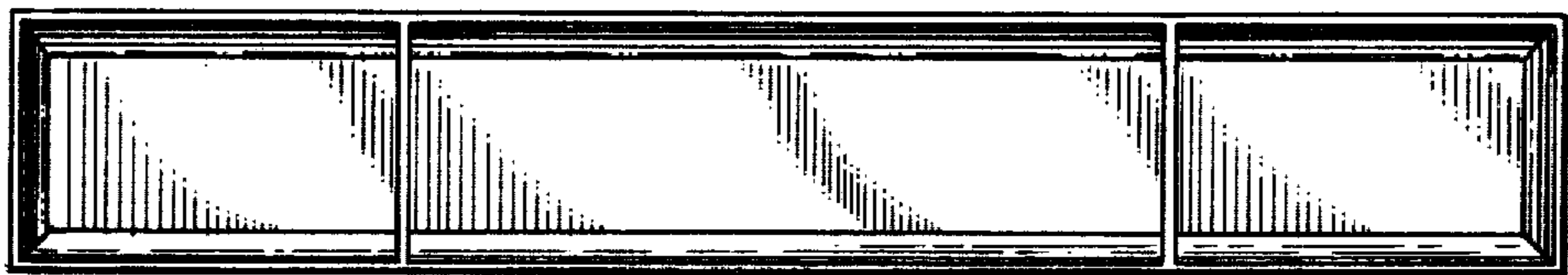
