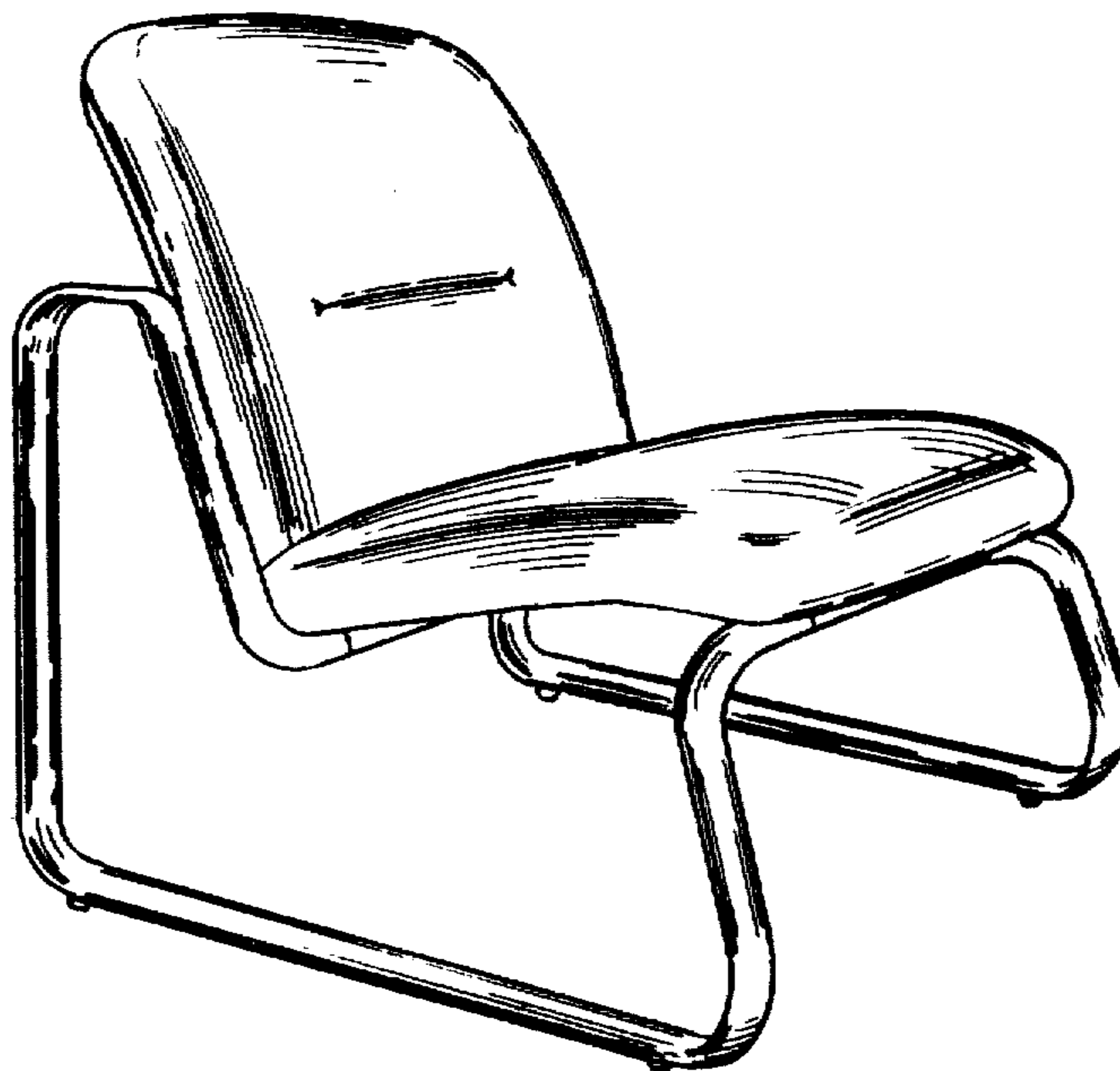

The ornamental design of a seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing our design in the form of a chair;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of our seat design; and
FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view thereof.
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of our seat design; and
FIG. 10 is a rear perspective view thereof.
FIG. 11 is a front perspective view of a fourth embodiment of our seat design; and
FIG. 12 is a rear perspective view thereof.



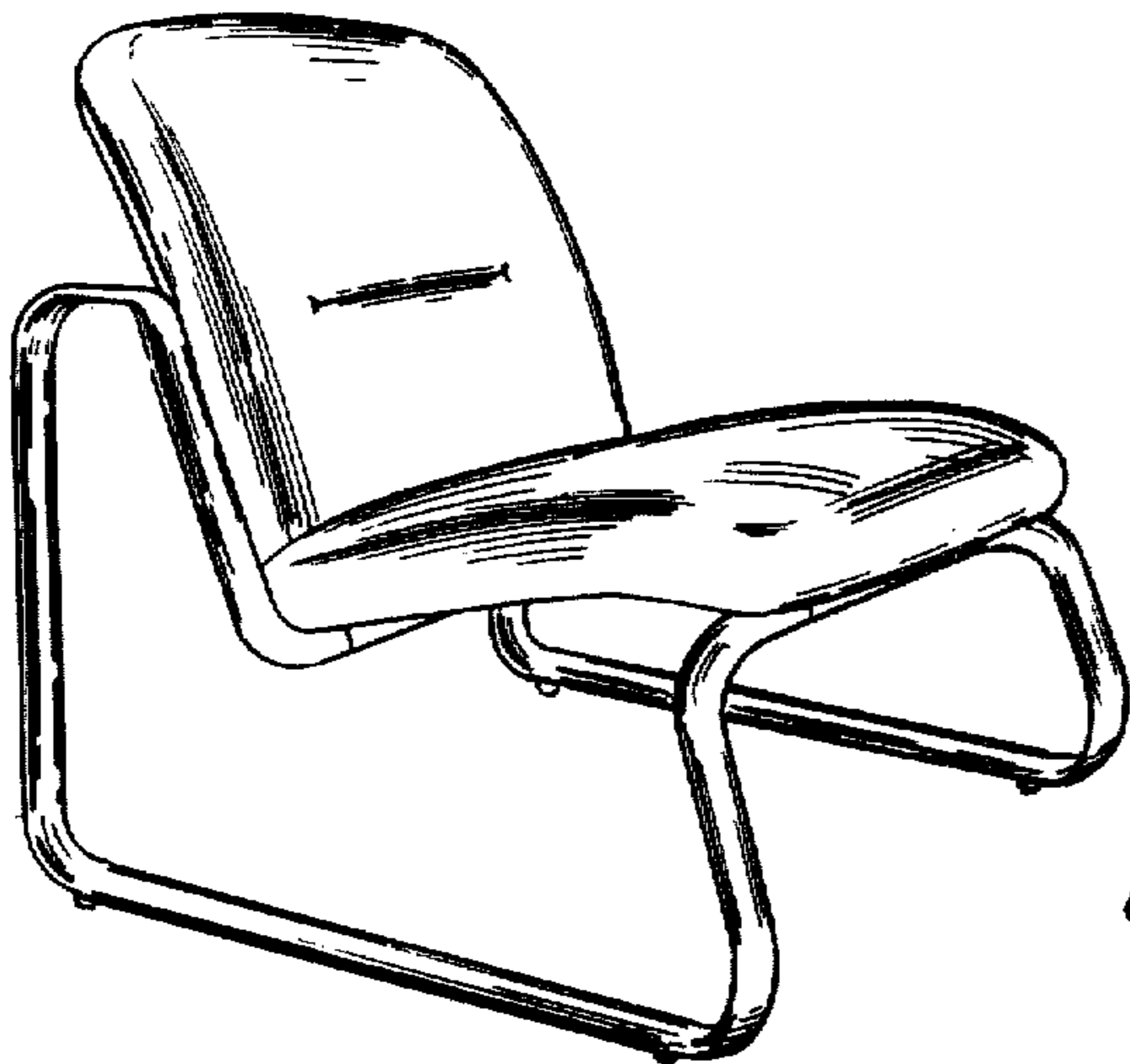

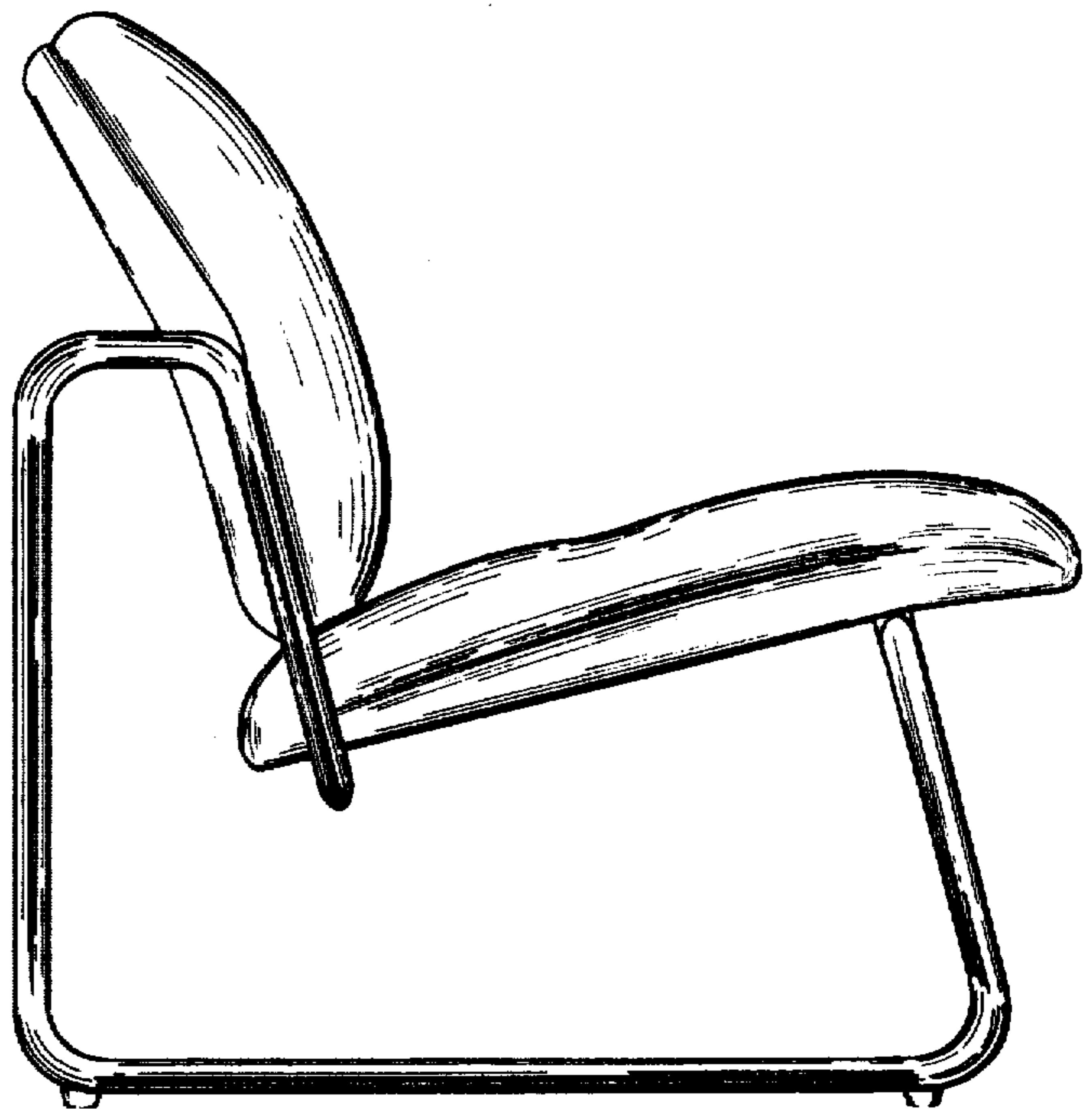

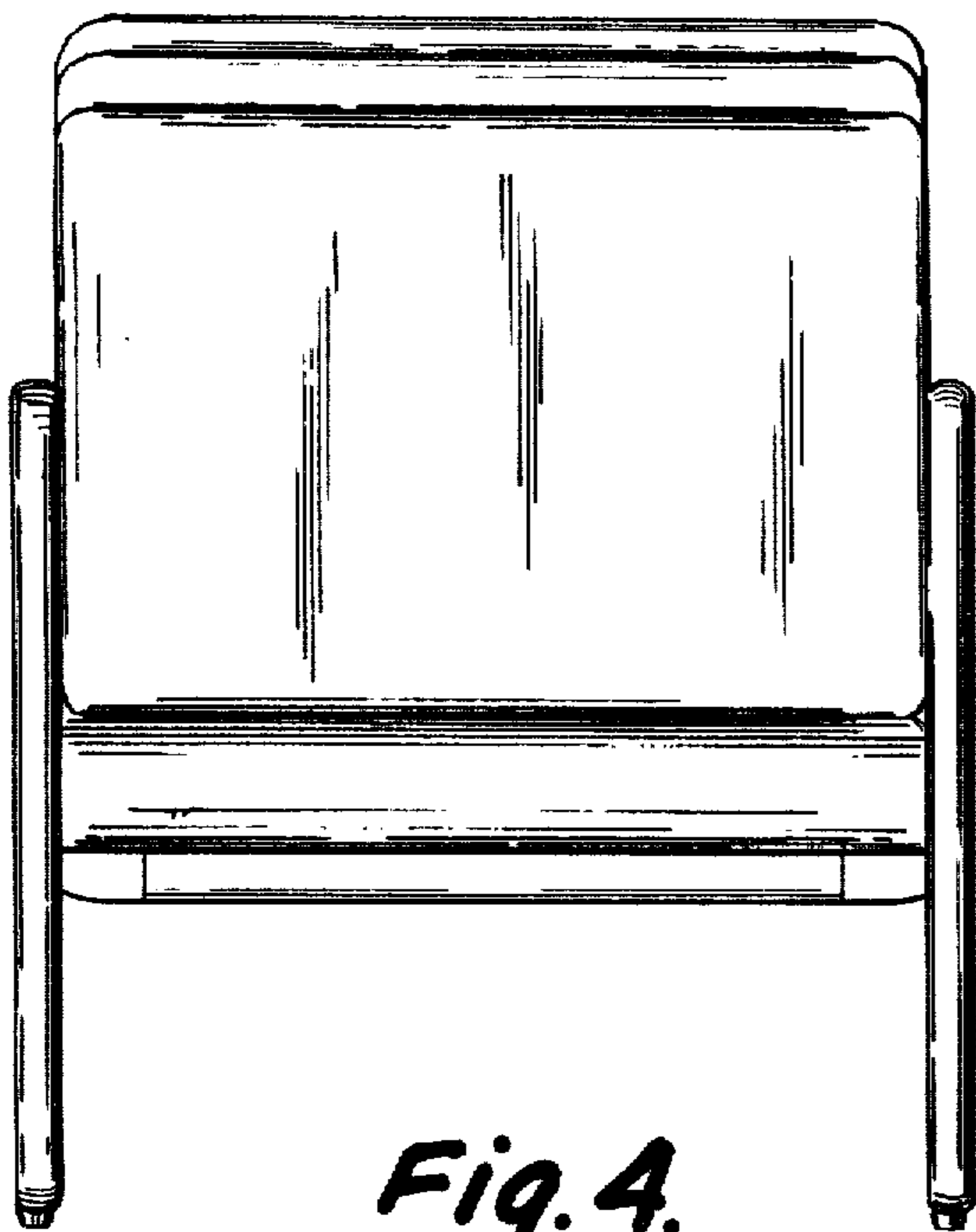

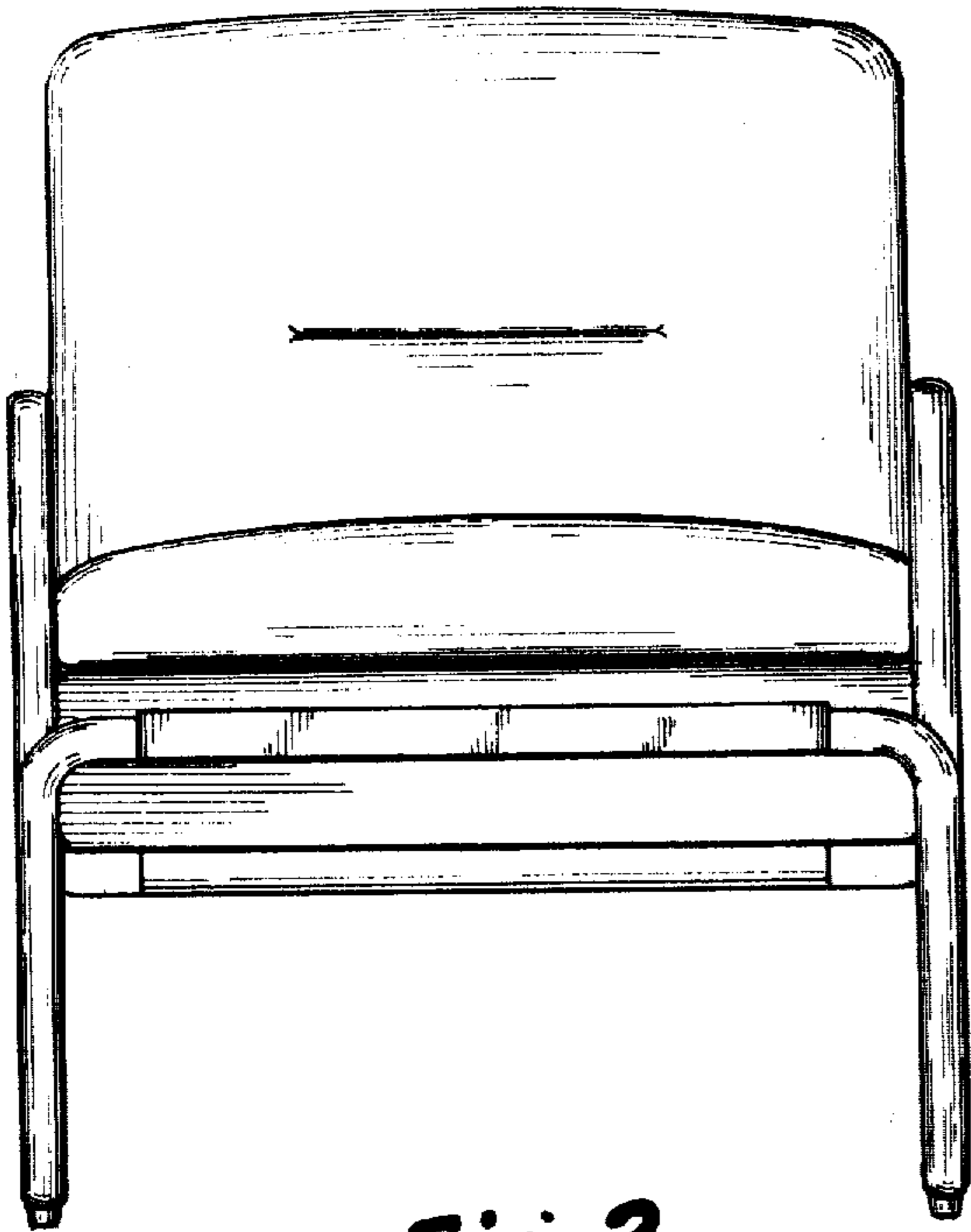

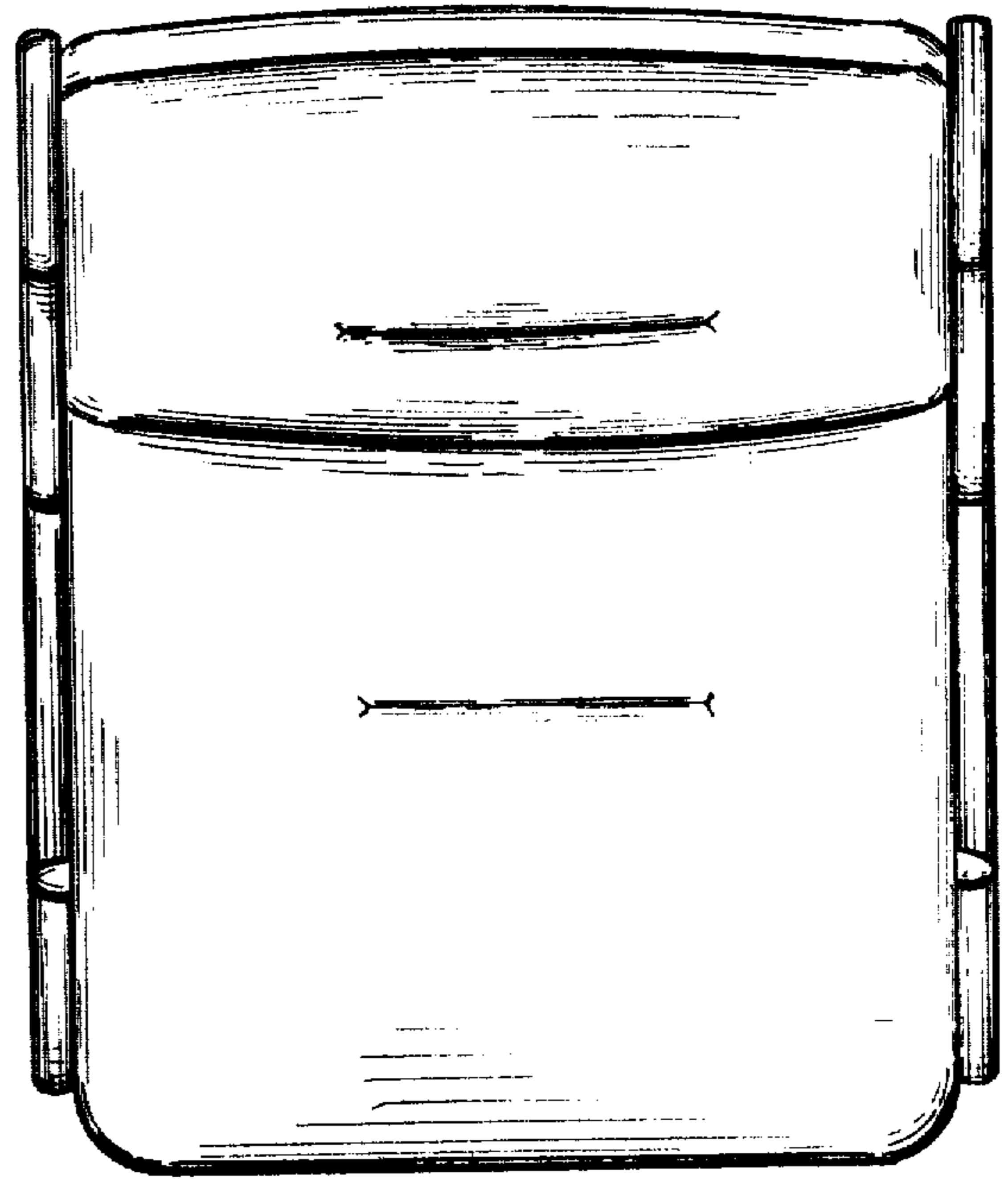

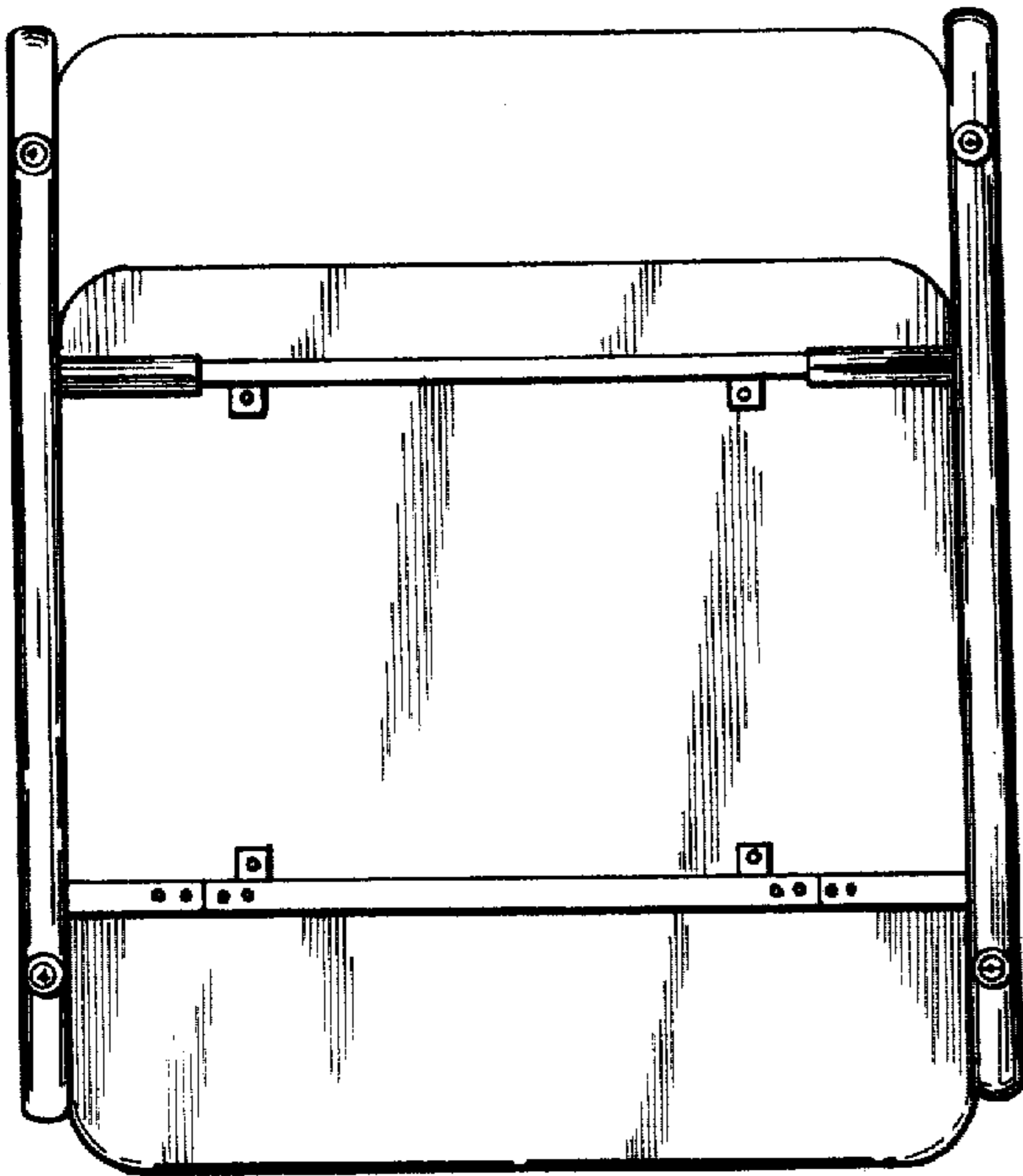

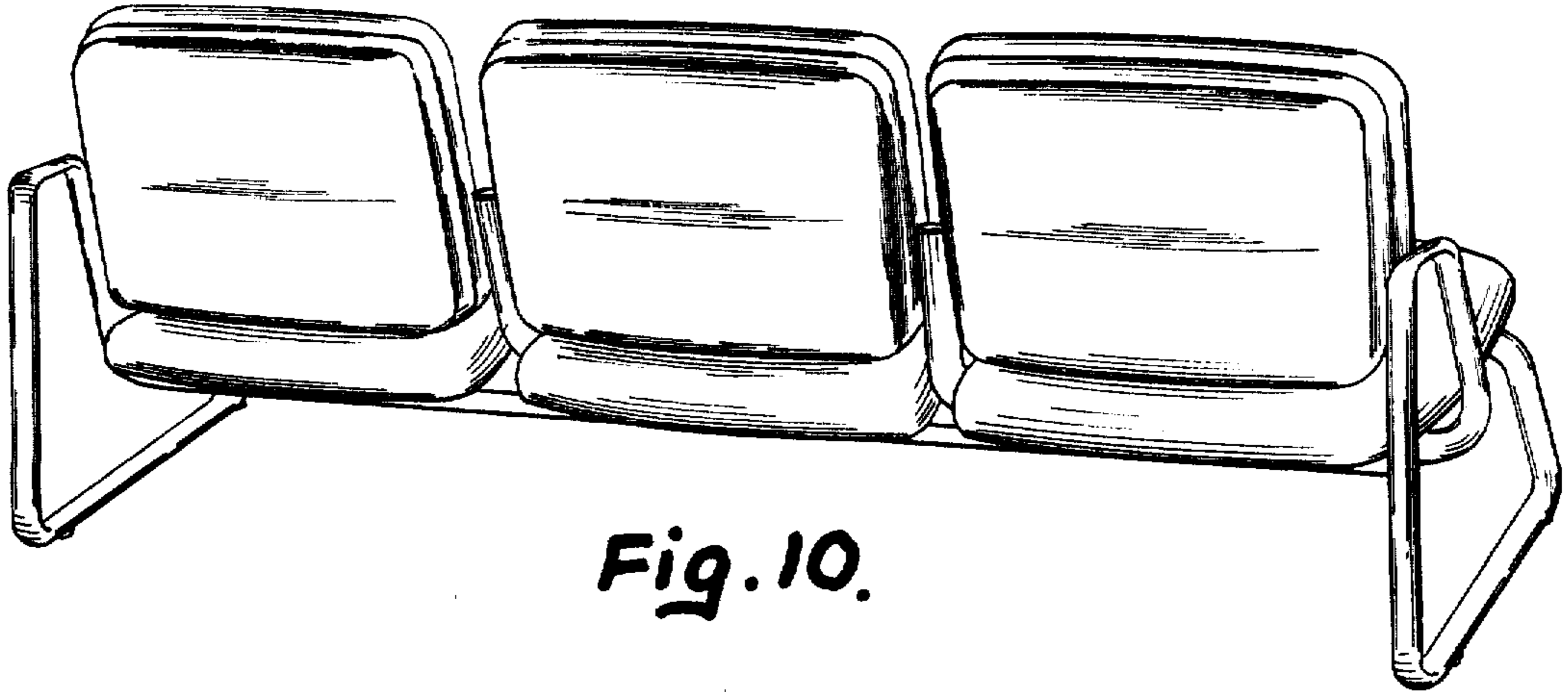

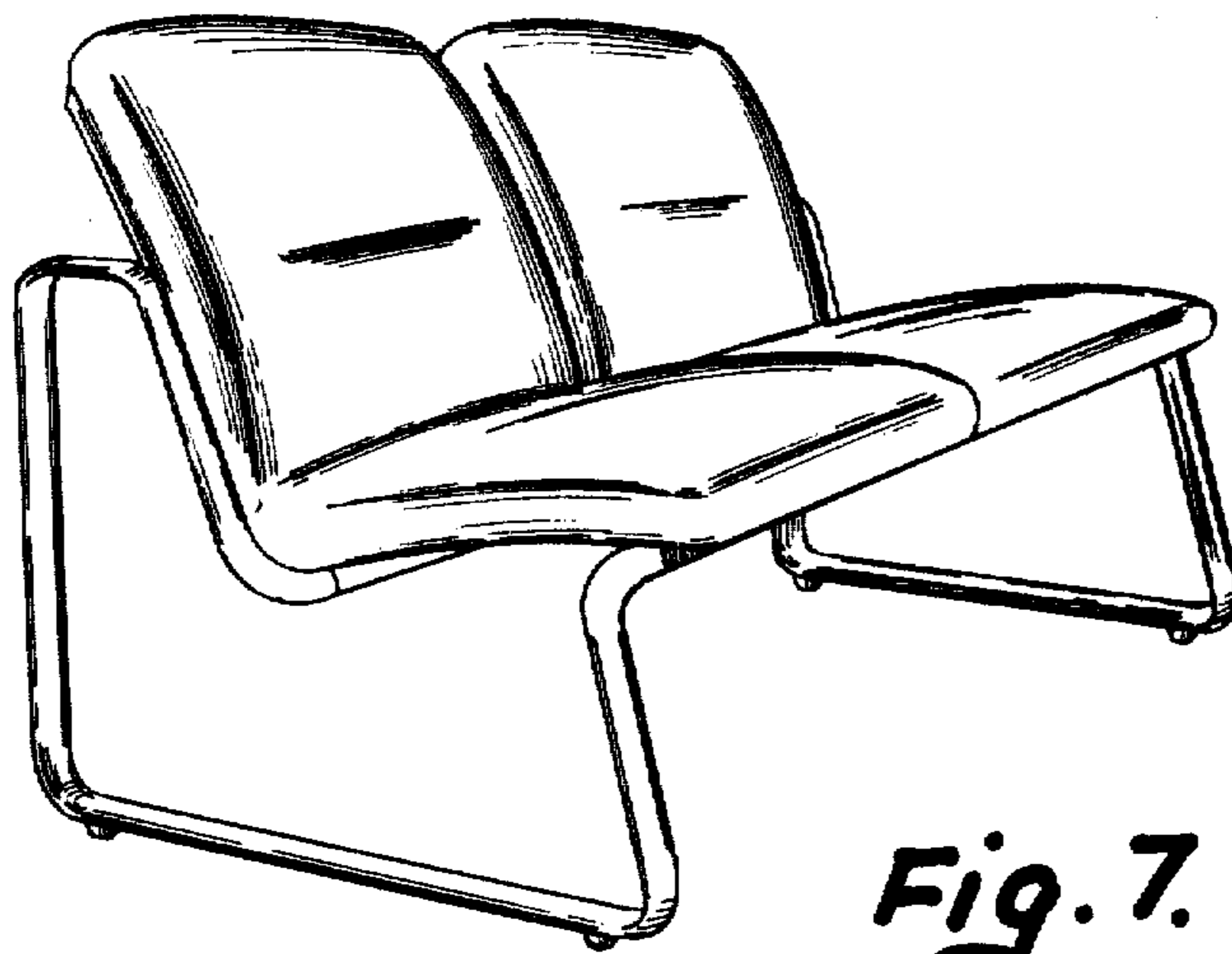

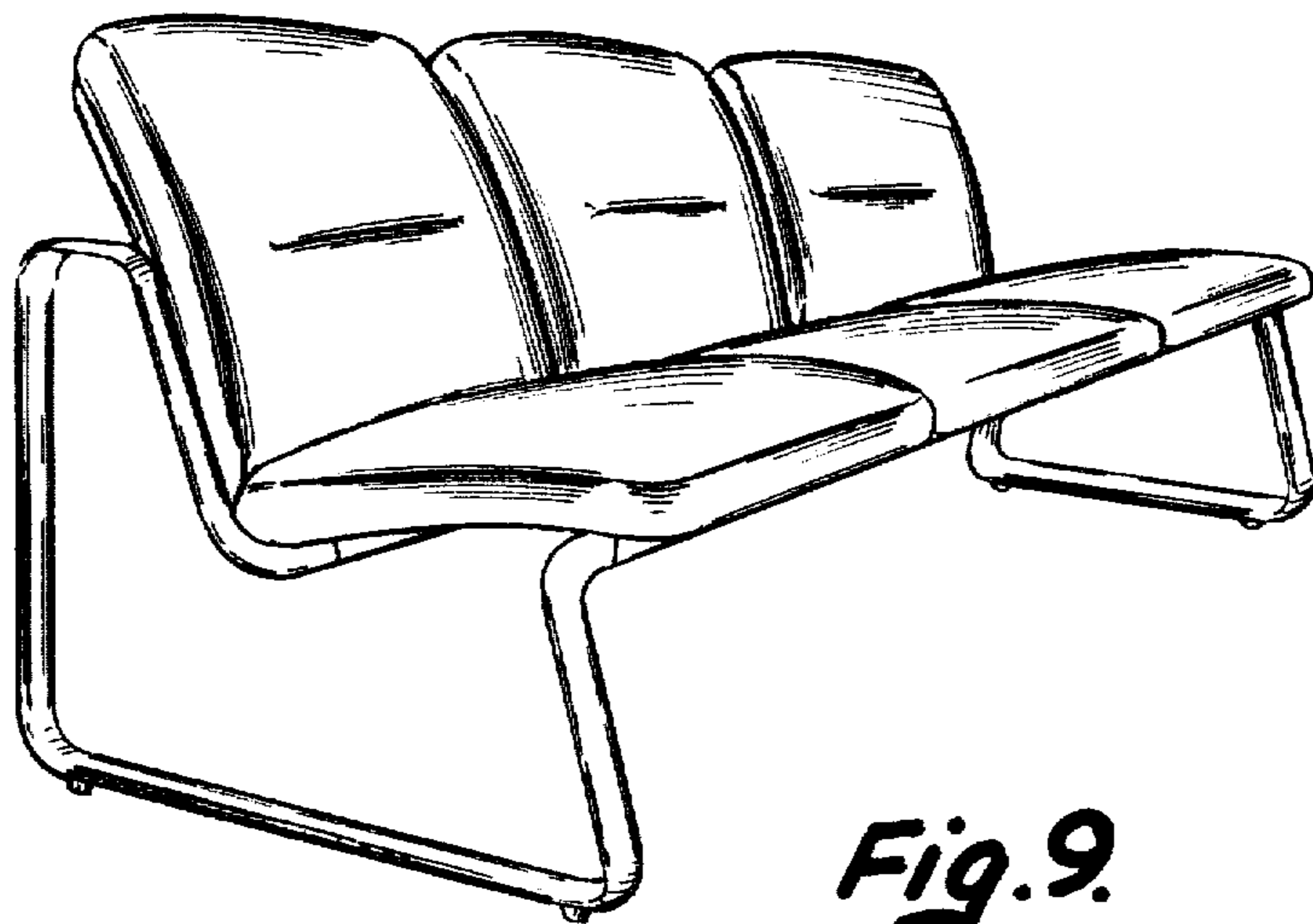

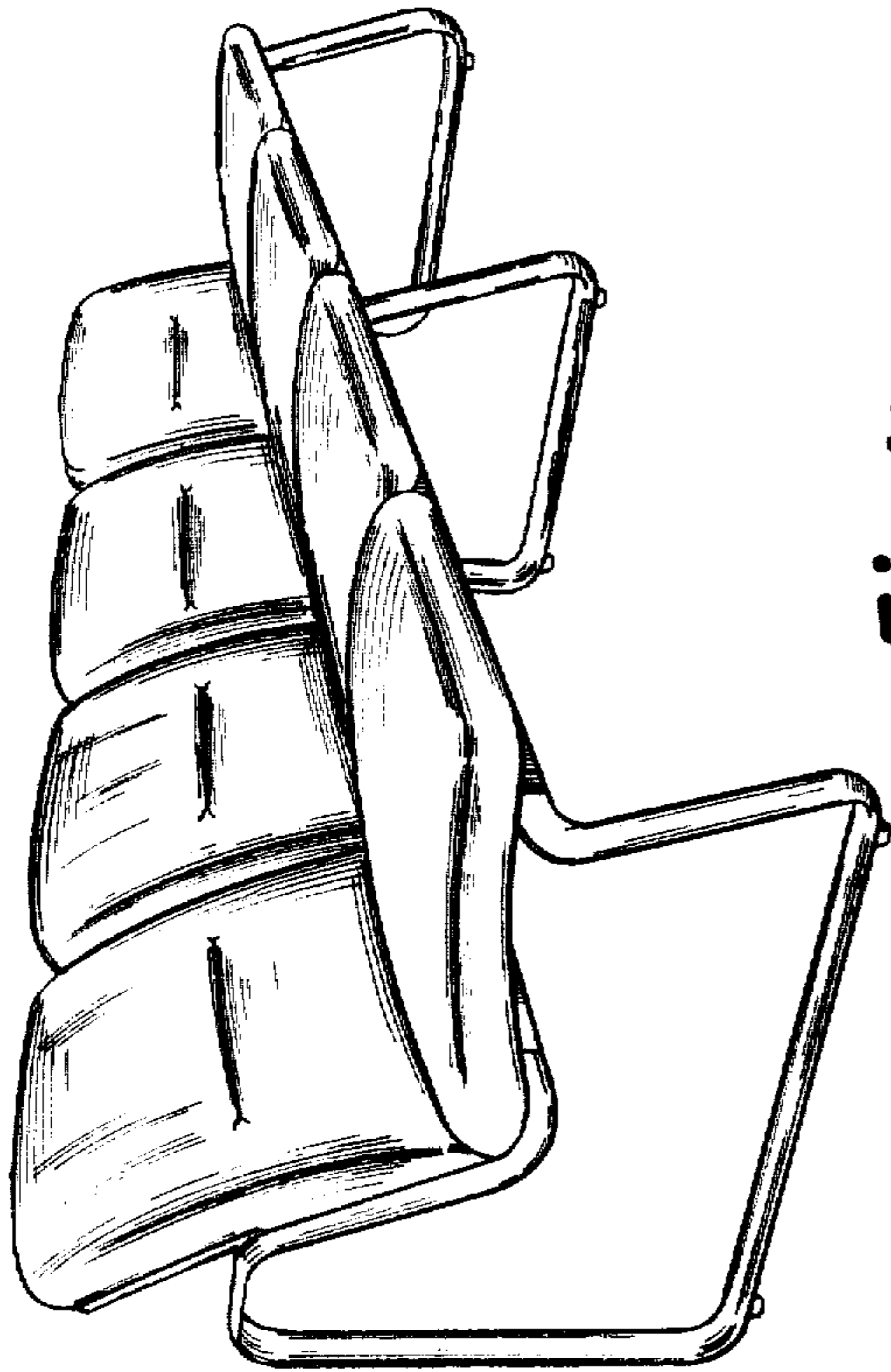

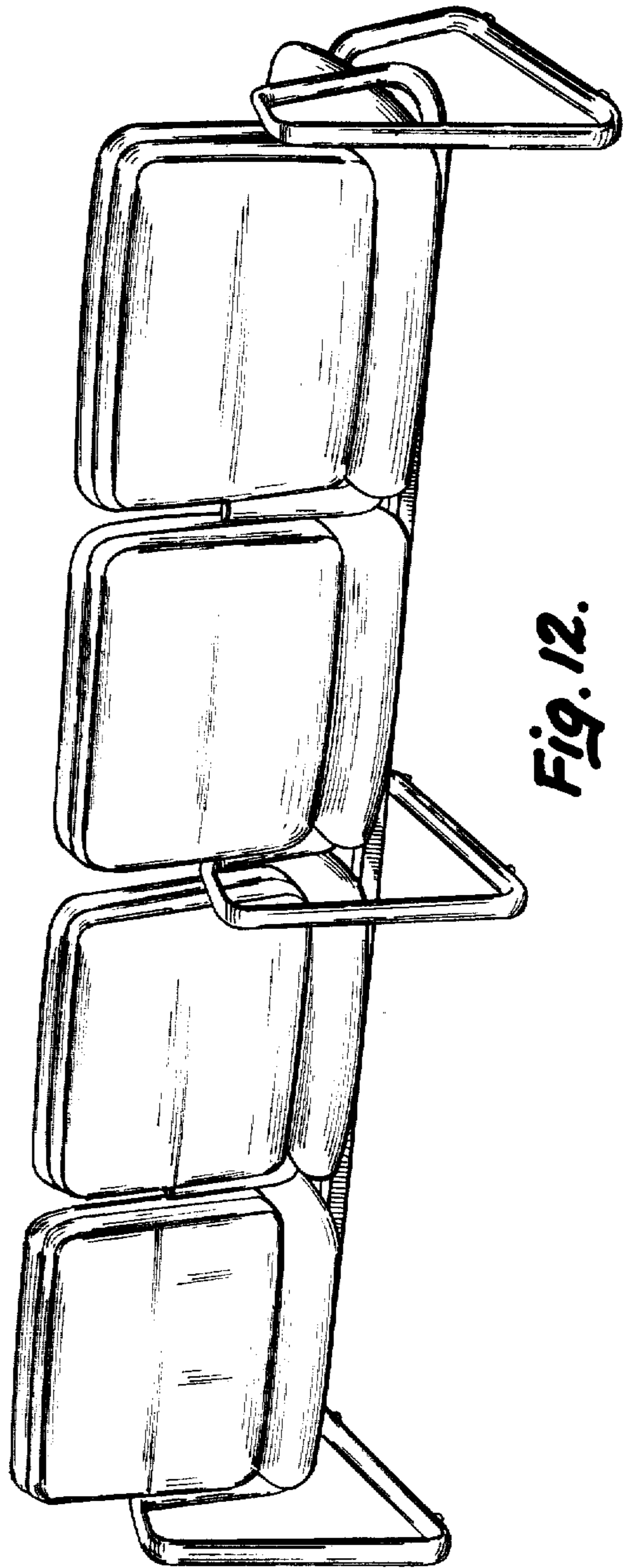

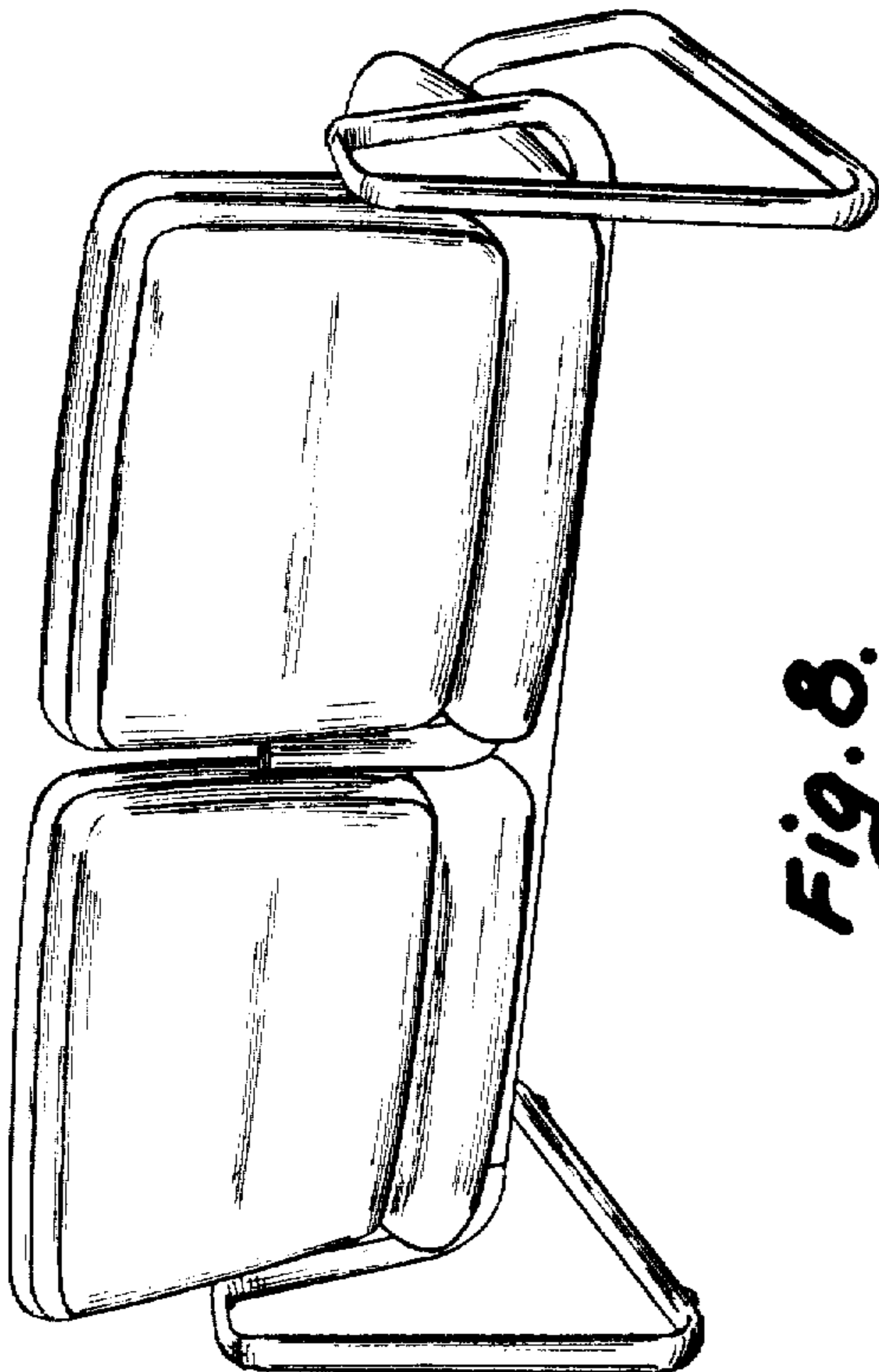
