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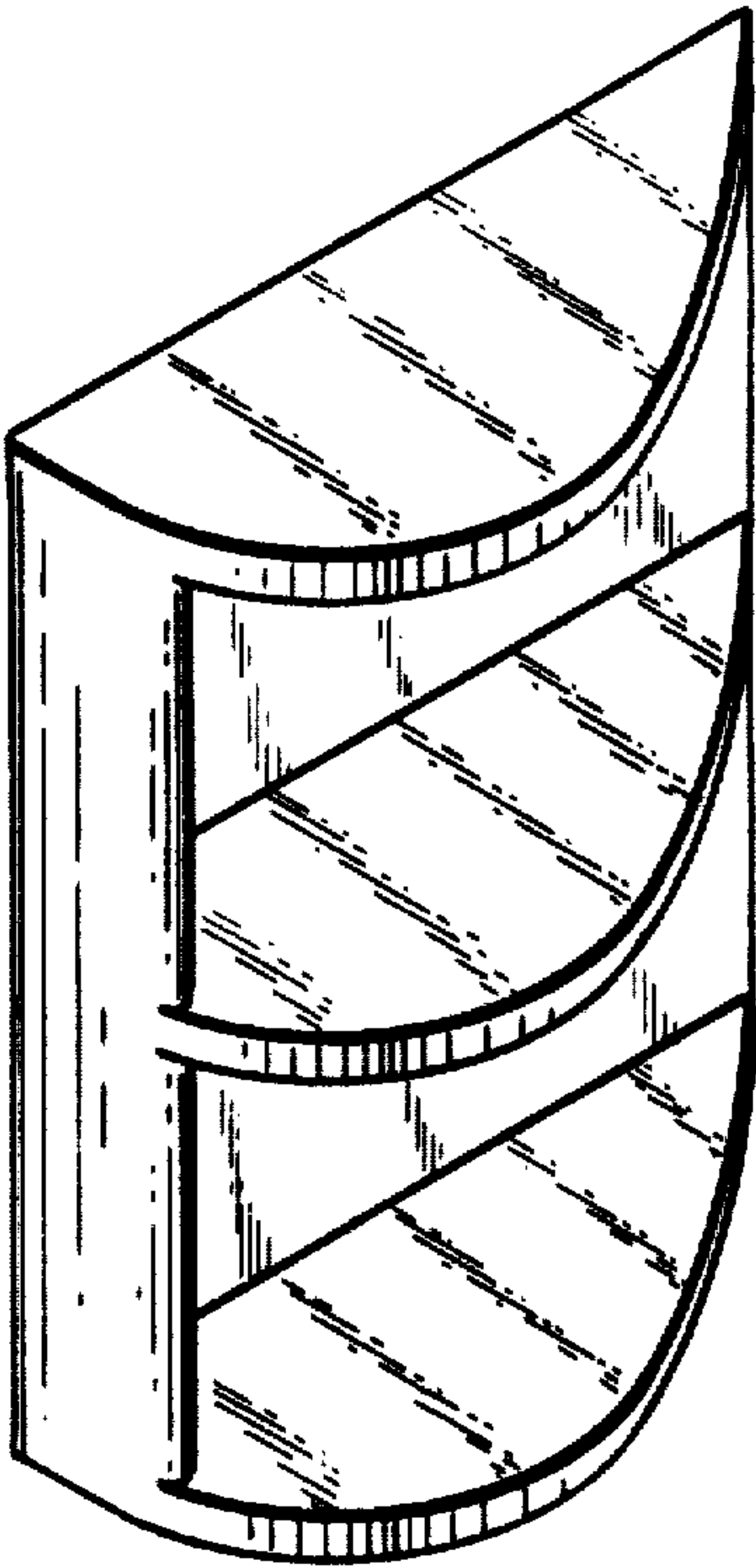

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shelving unit embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being flat and unornamented;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1.



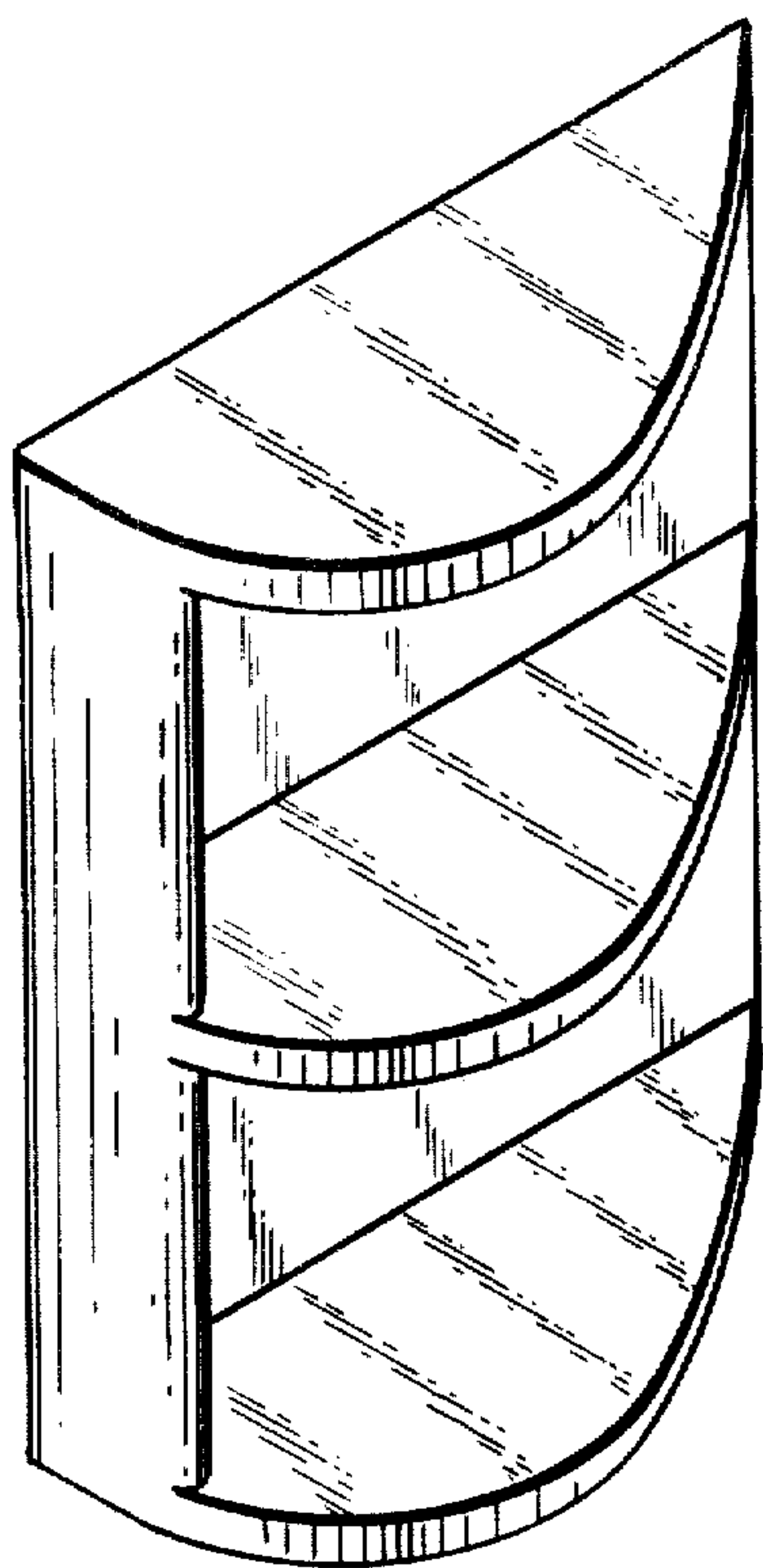

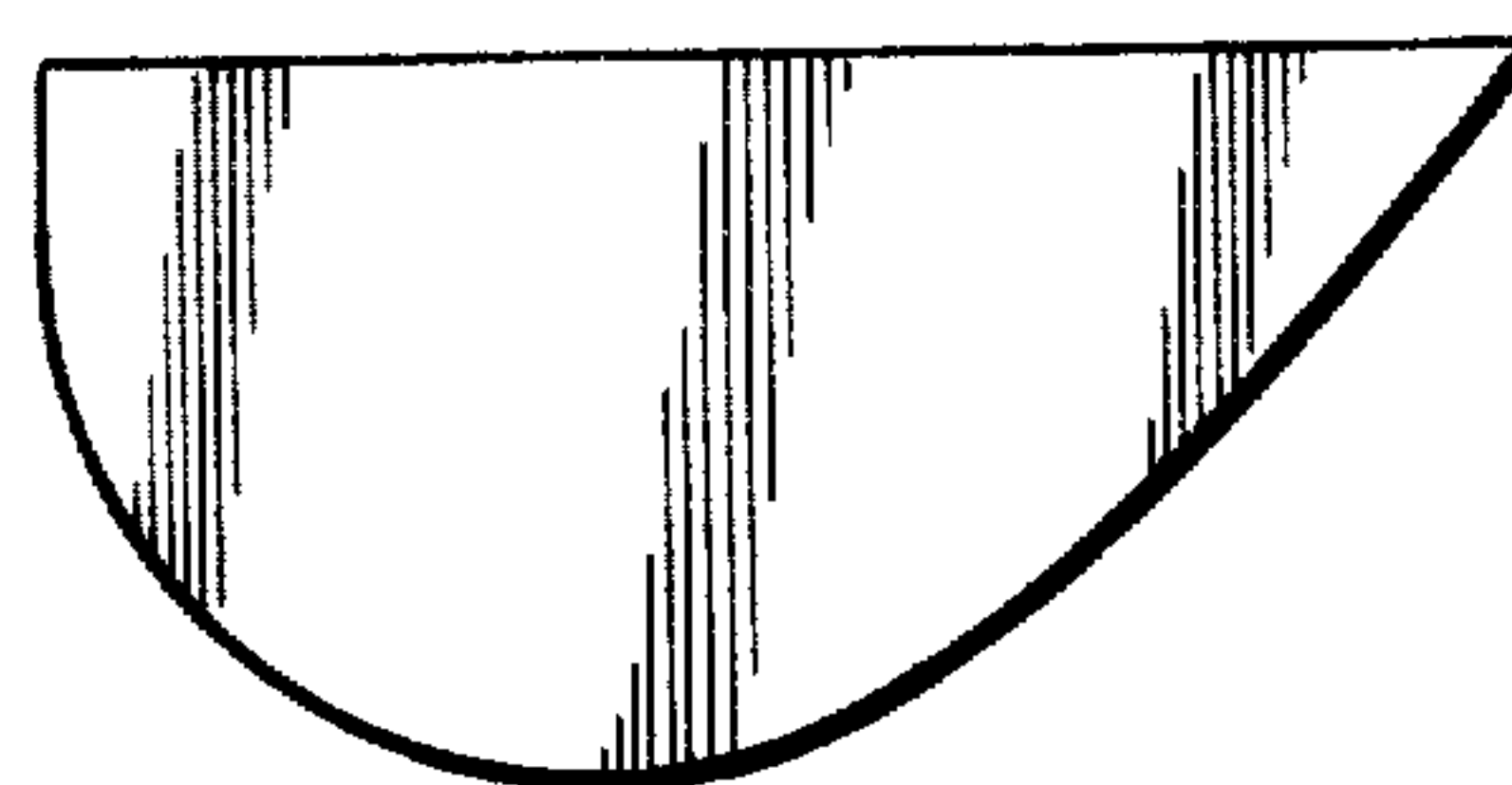

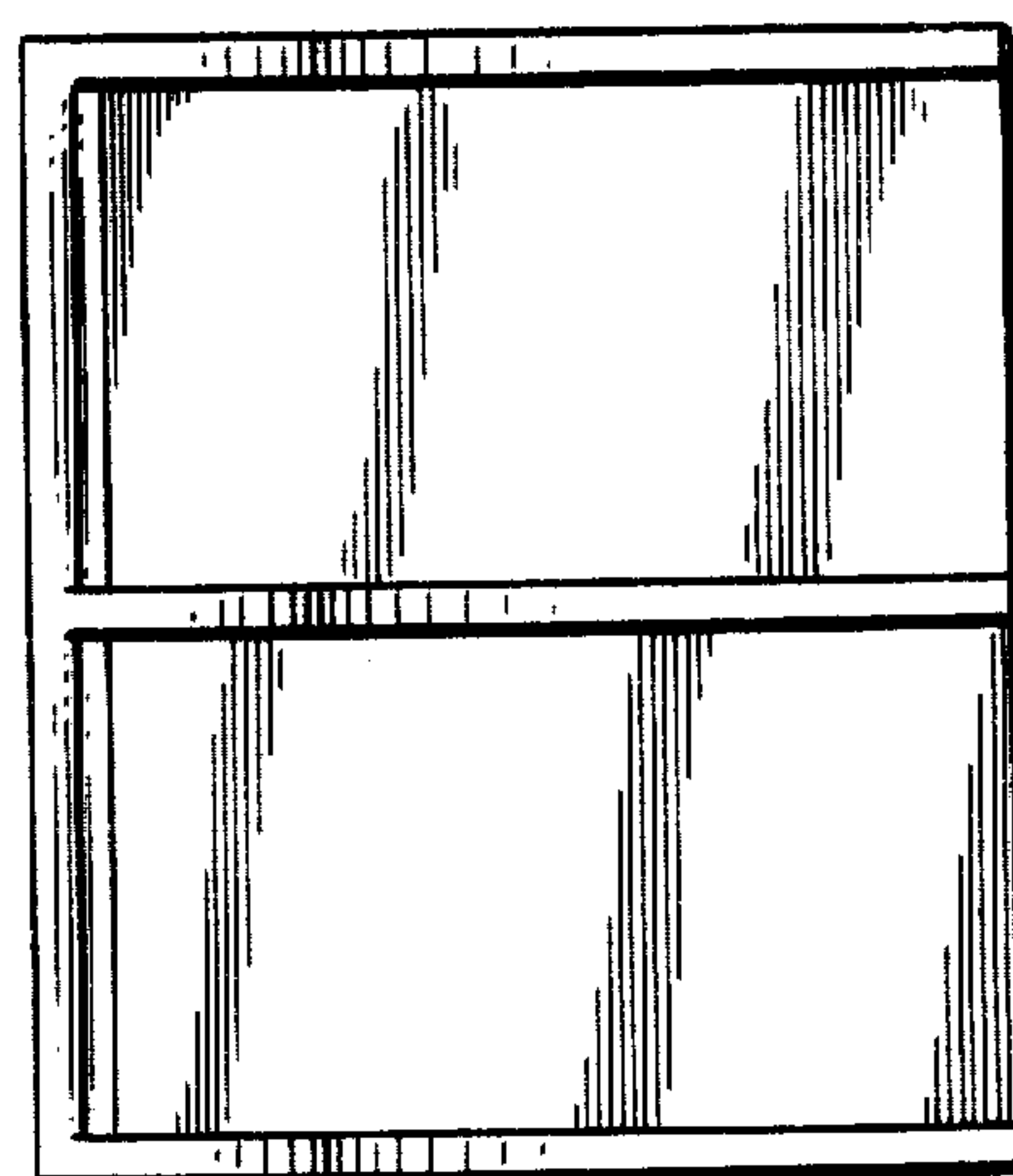

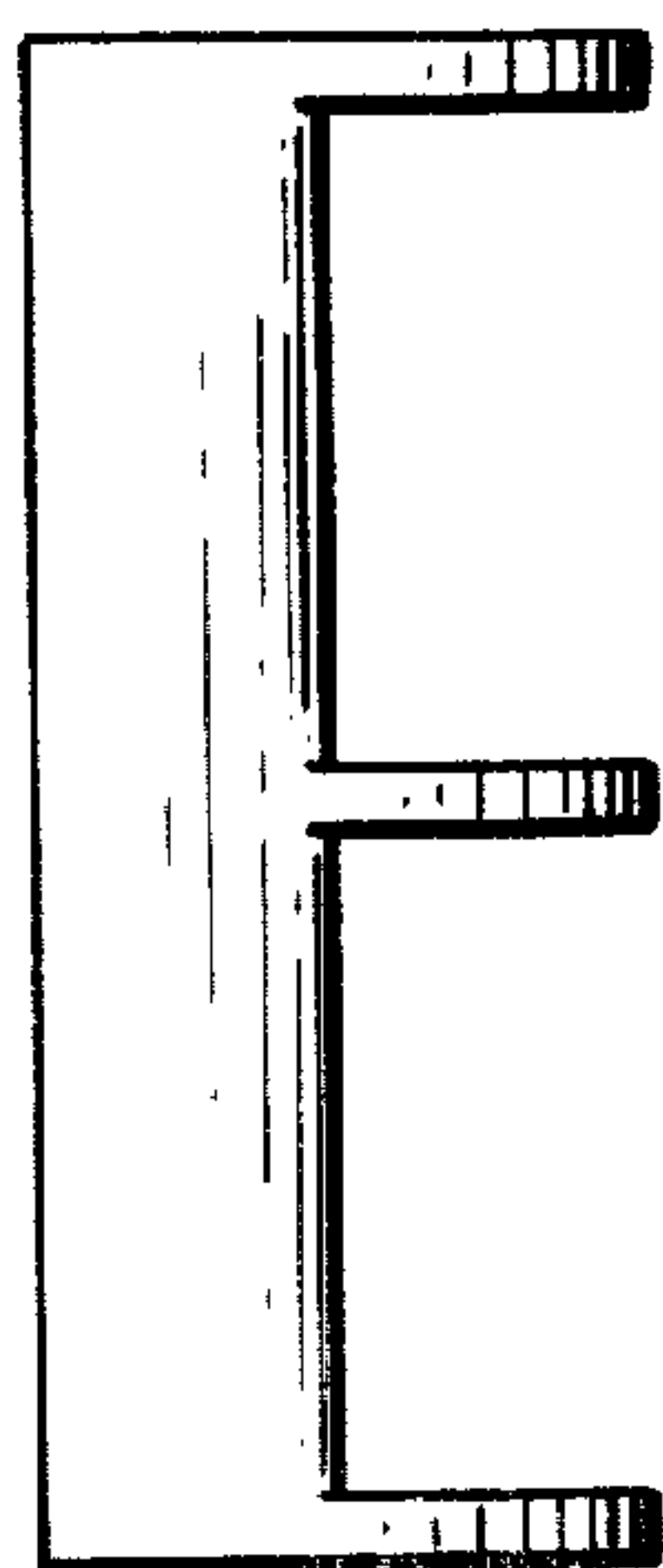

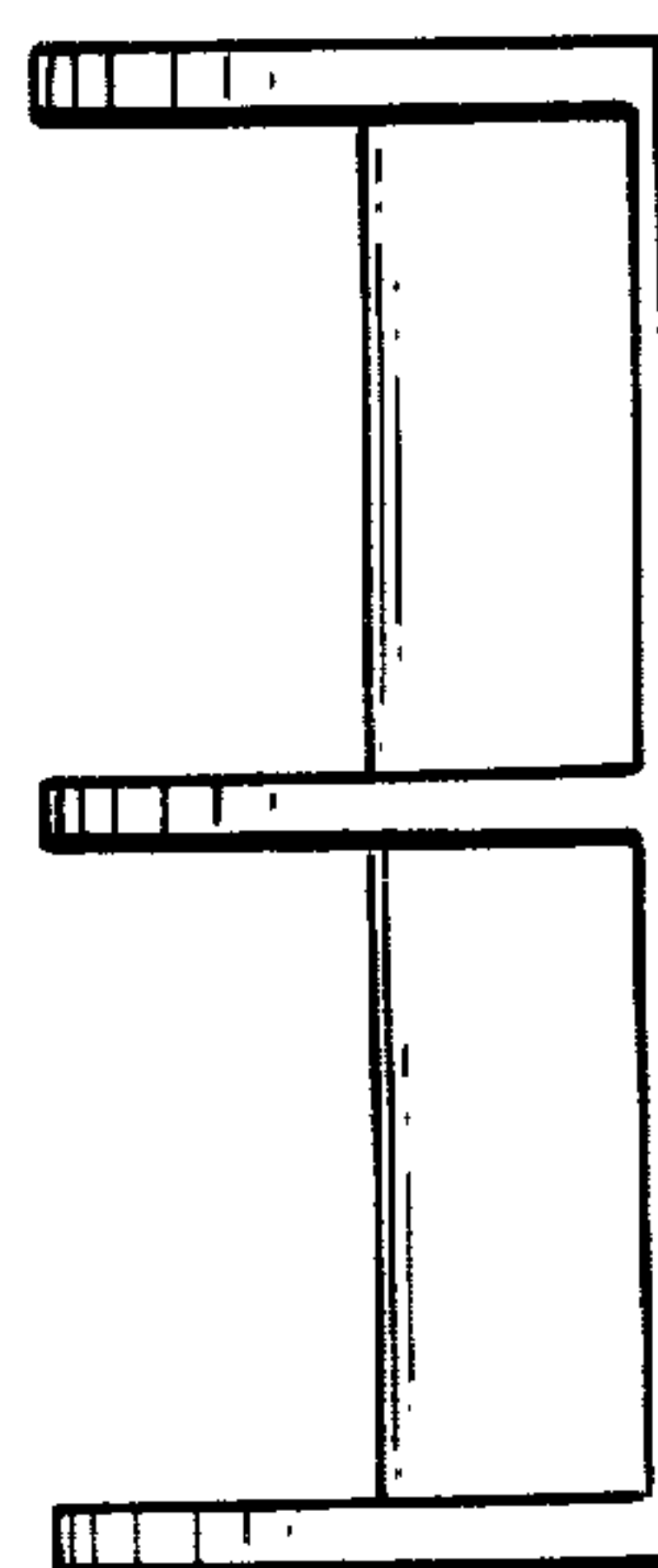
