described.

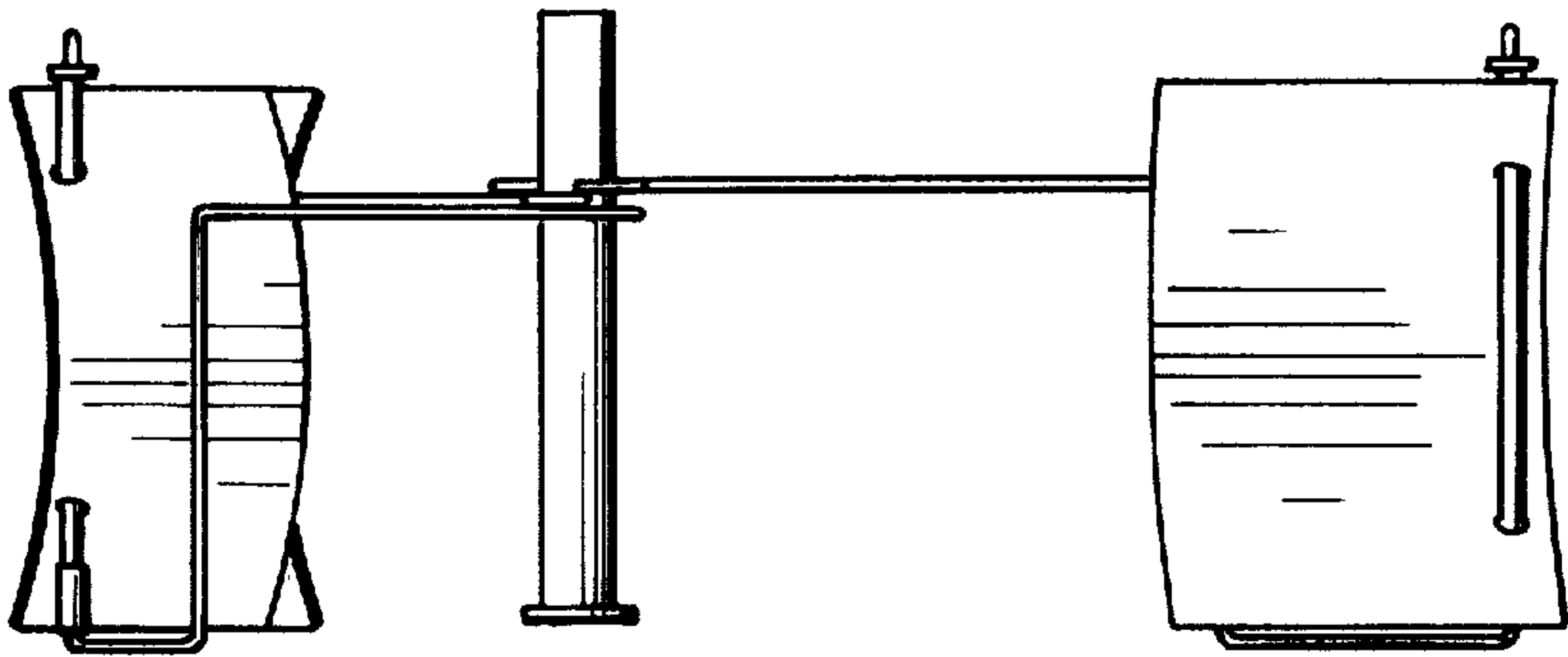
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



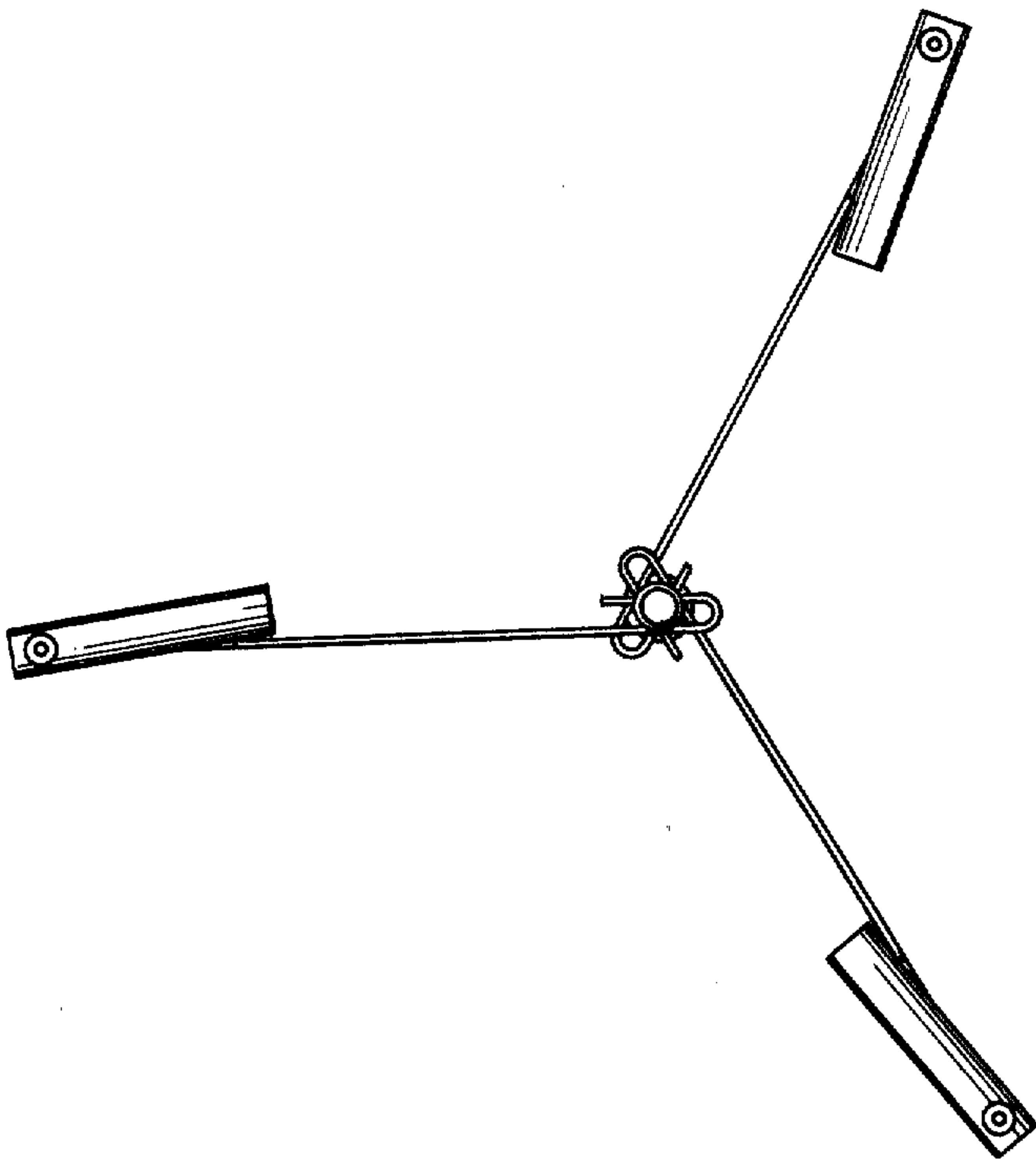

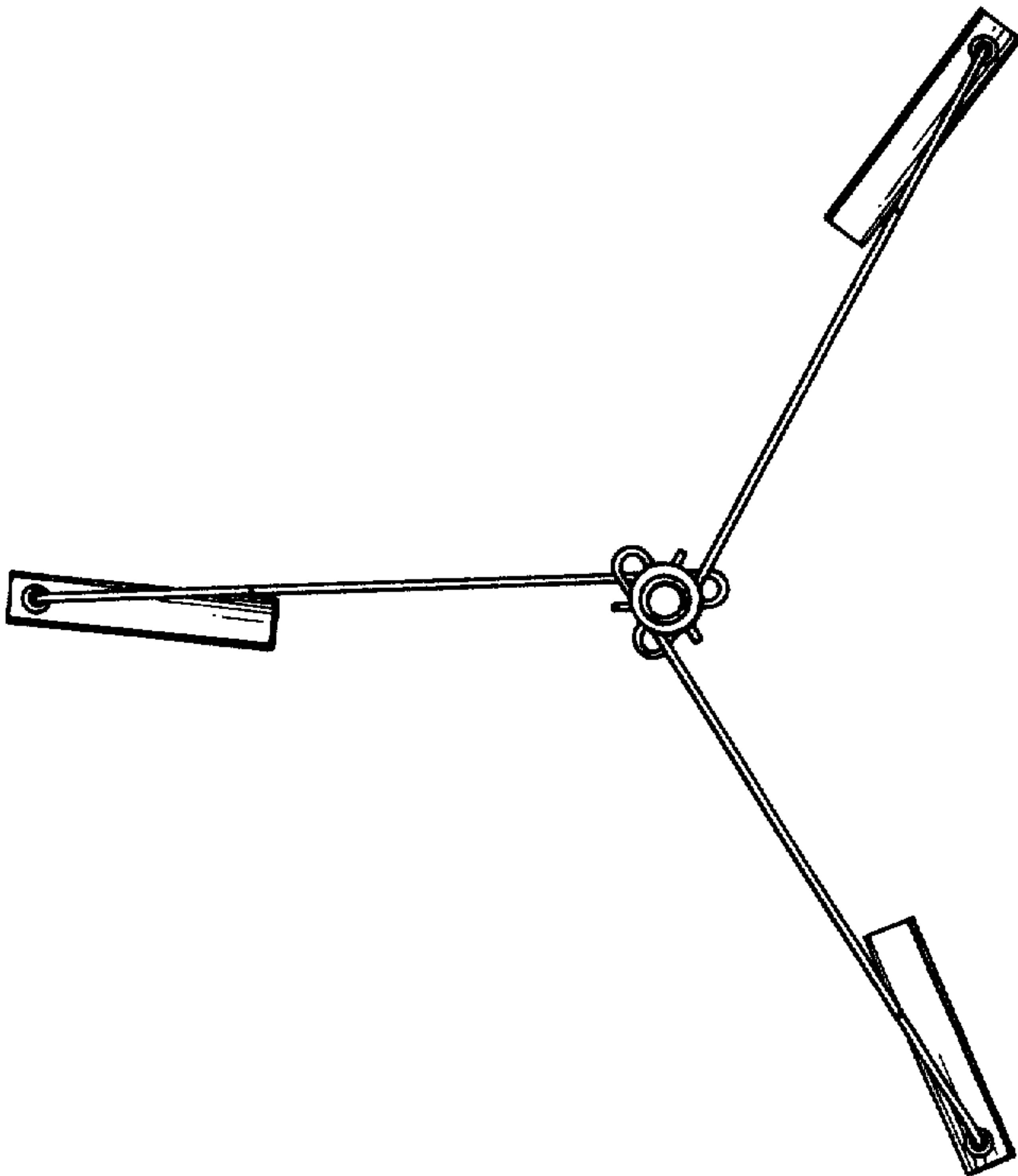

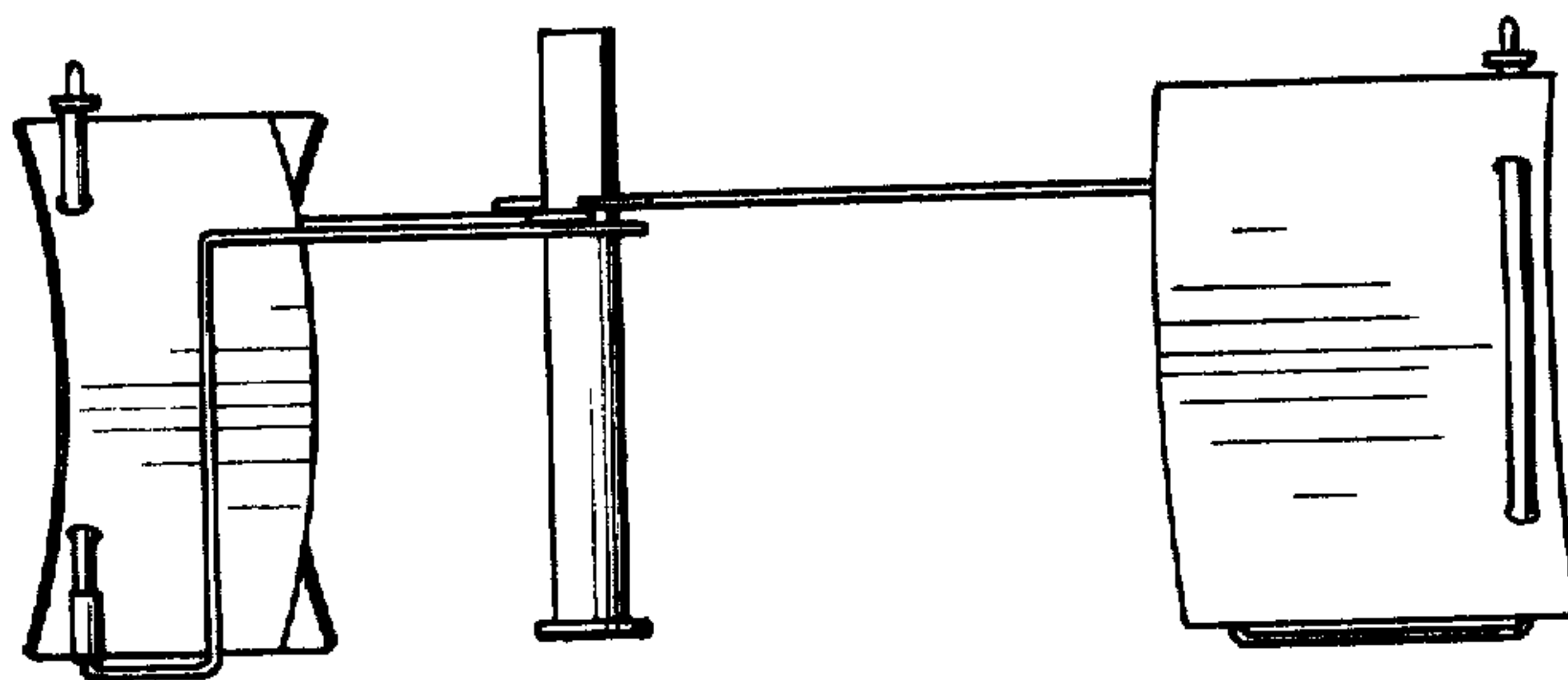

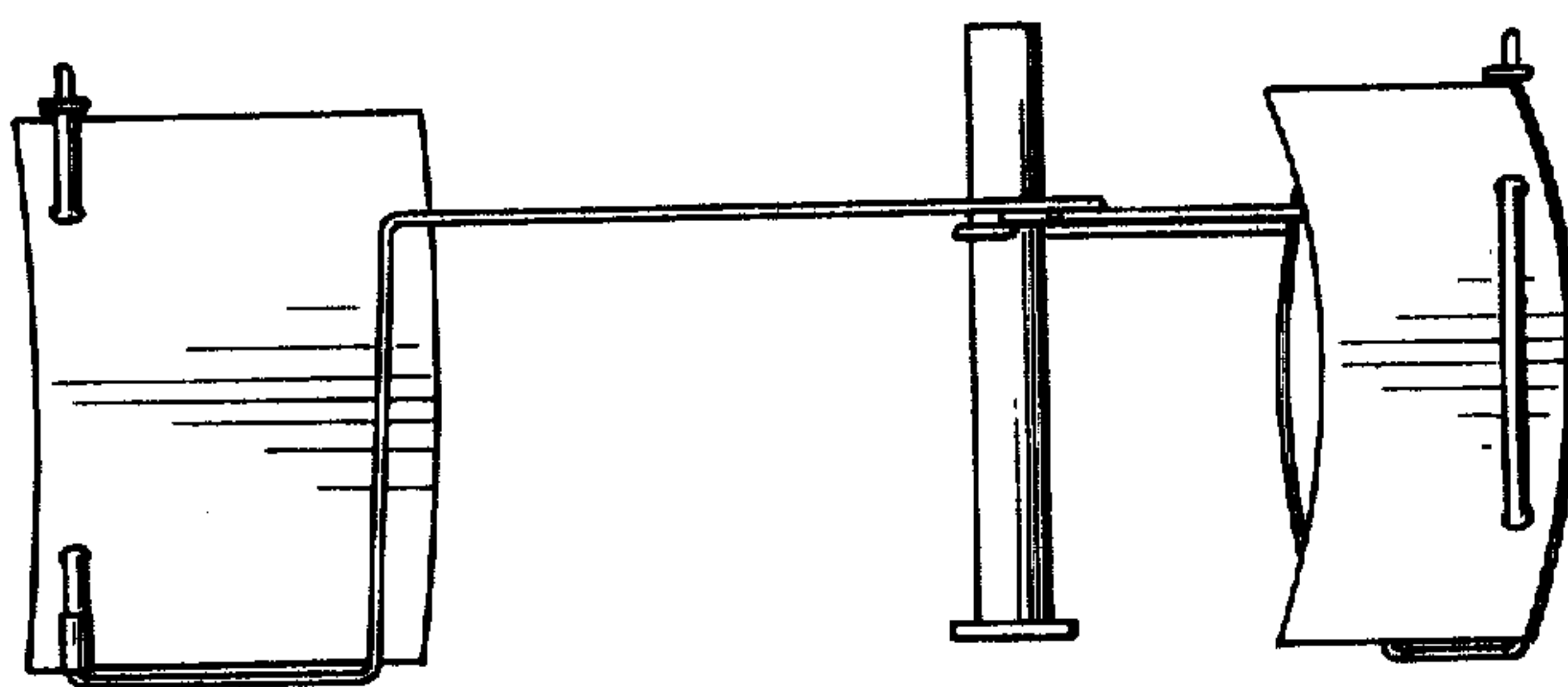
