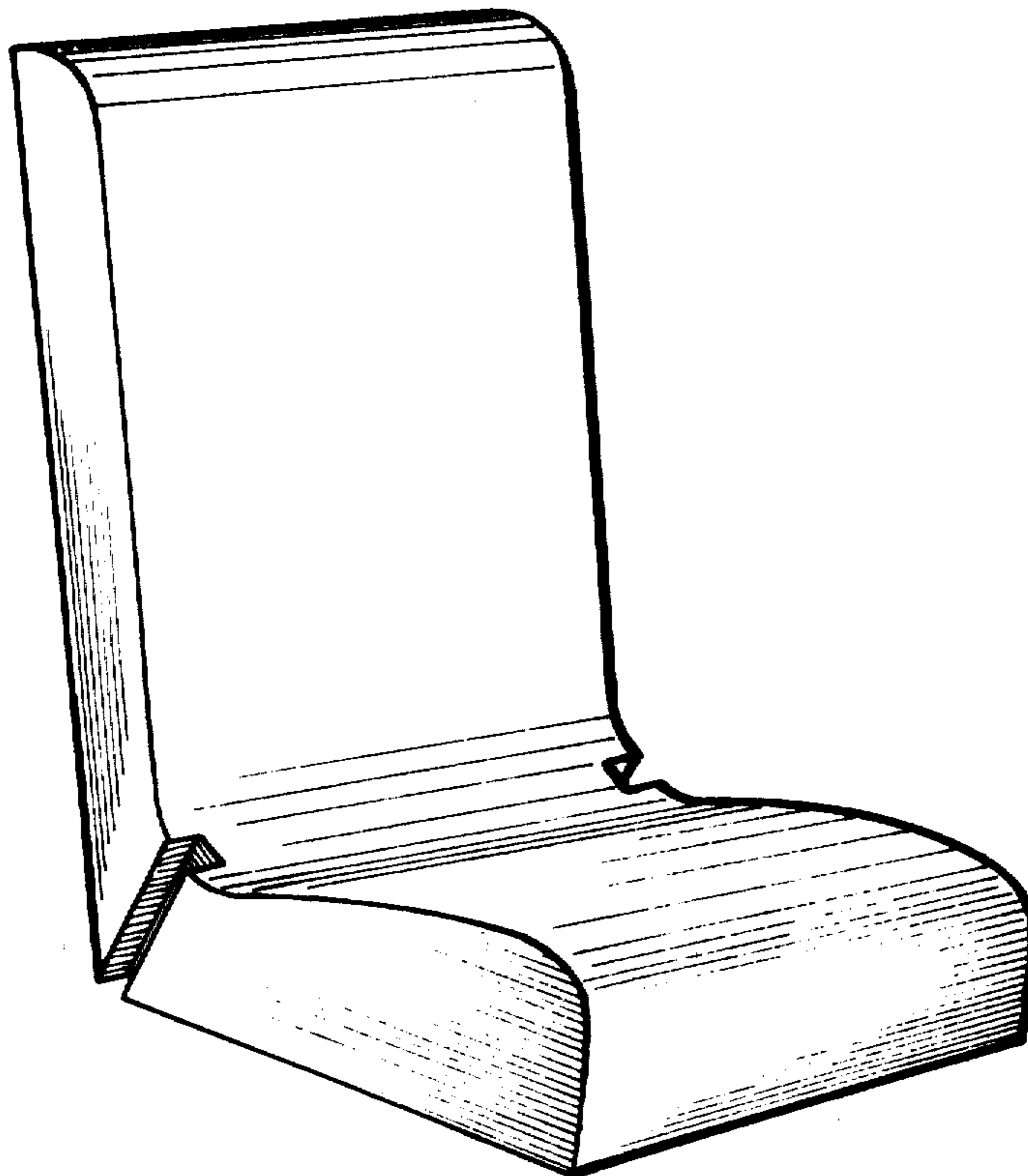

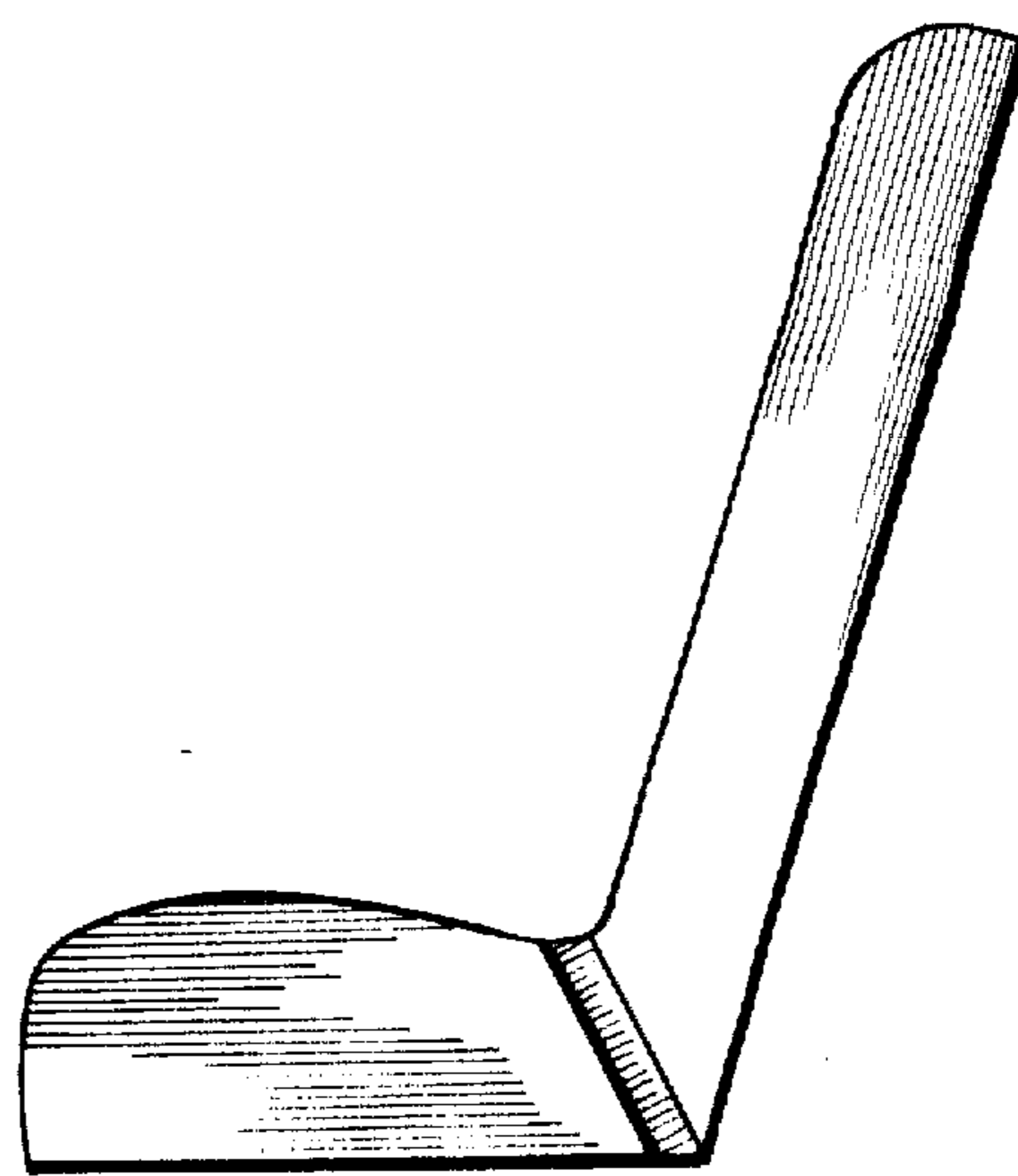
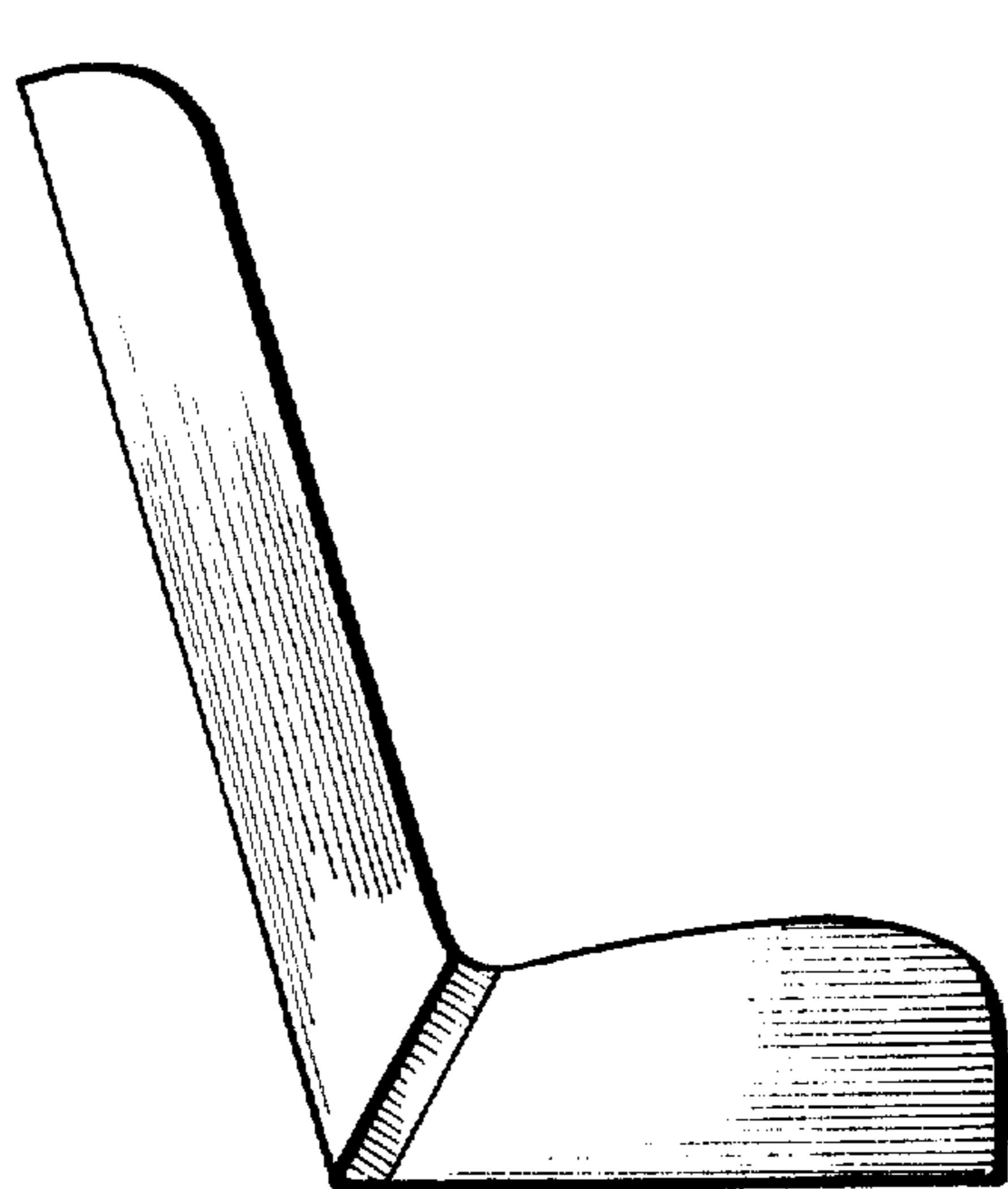
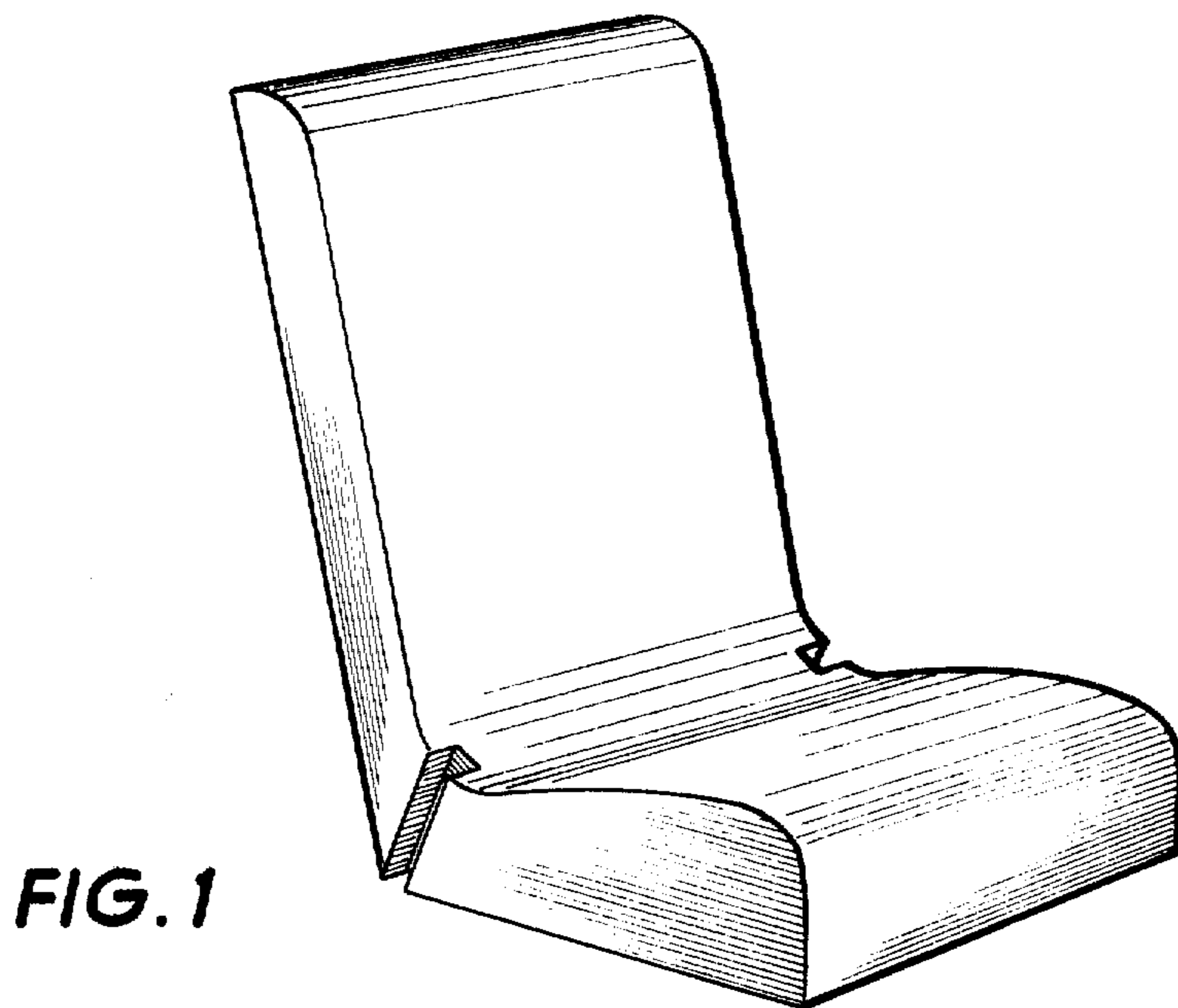
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the auxiliary seat for a child;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation of the right side of the seat;
FIG. 3 is a side elevation of the left side of the seat;
FIG. 4 is a frontal elevation;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation;

FIG. 7 is an underside view.





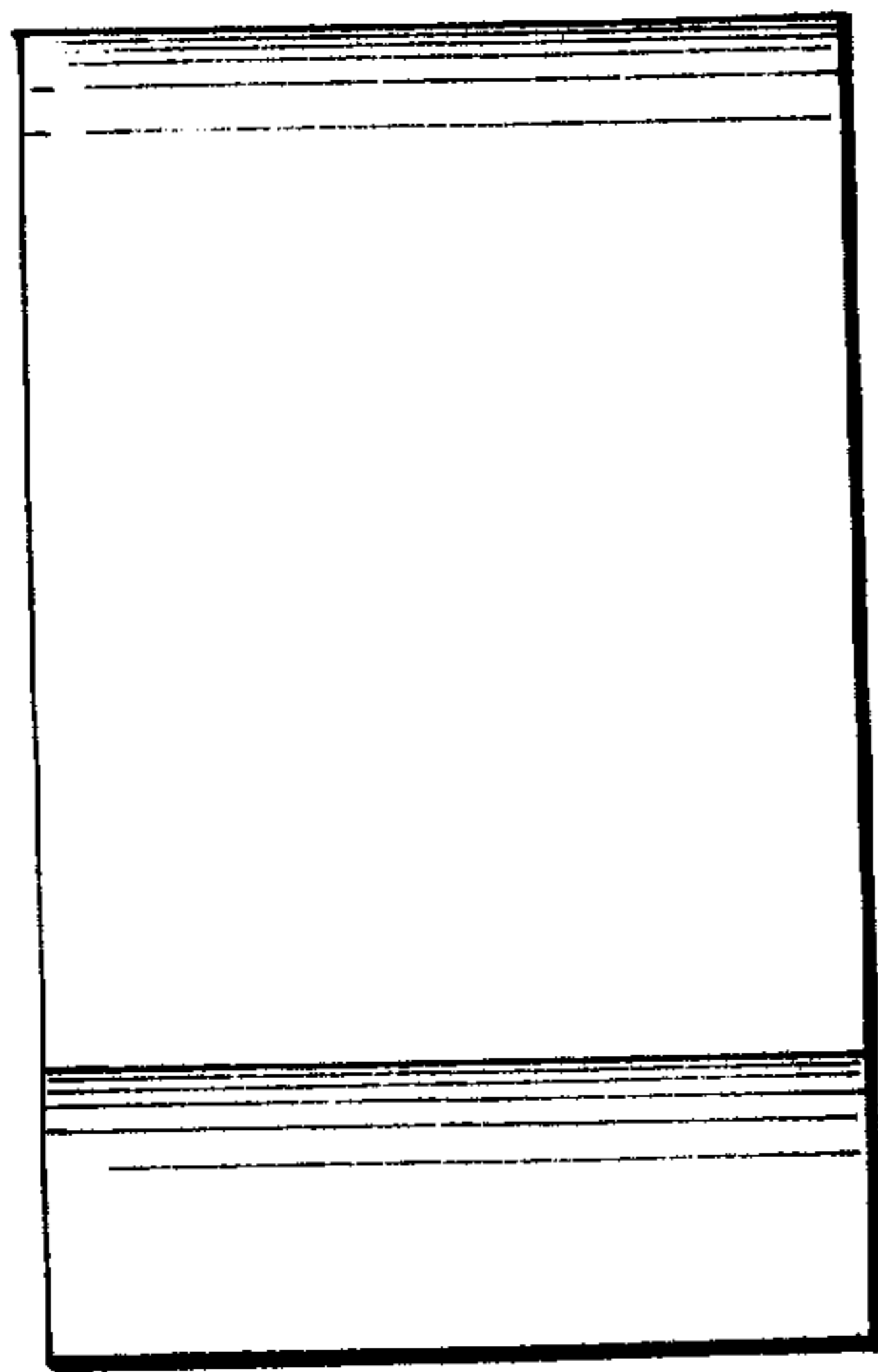

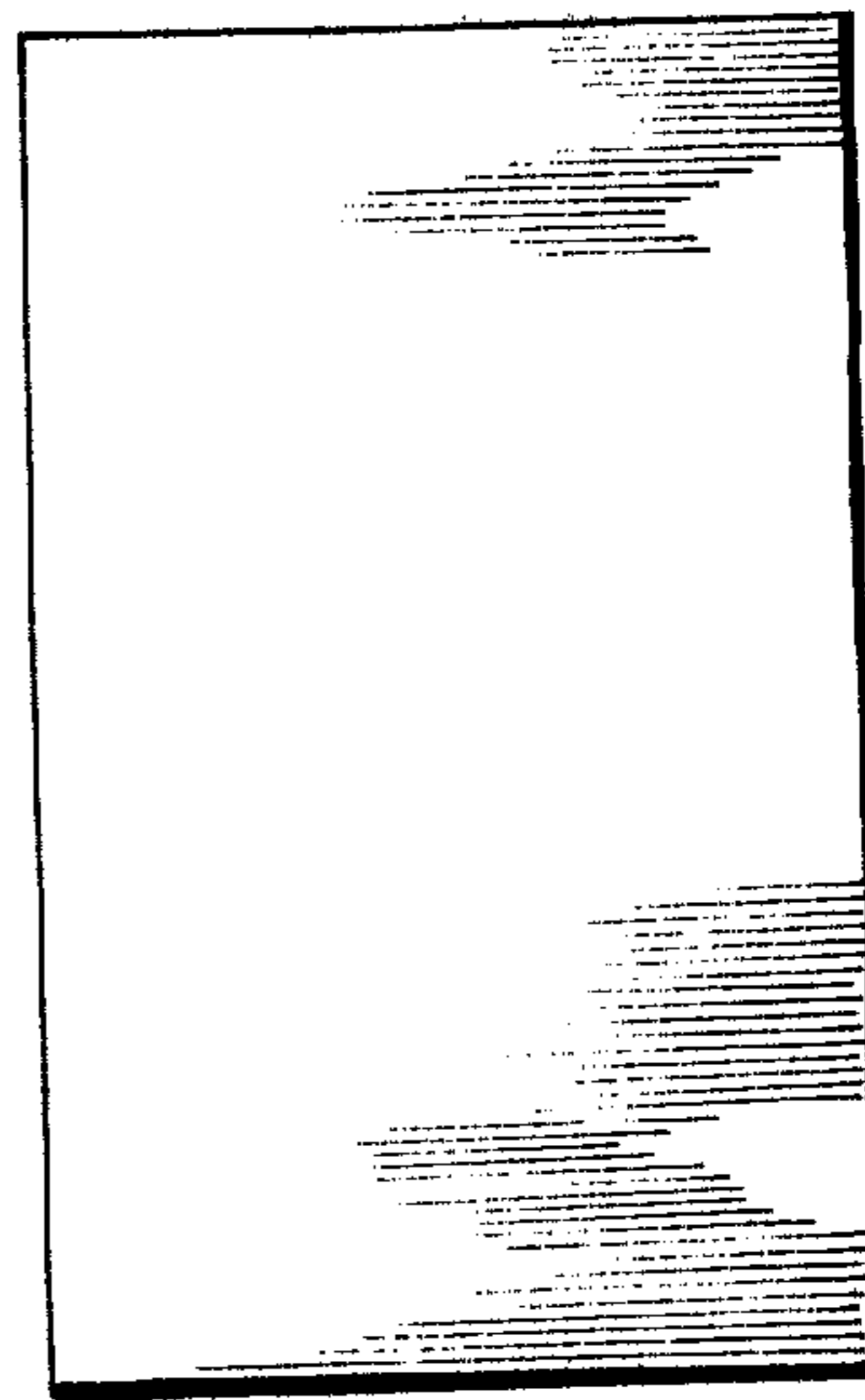

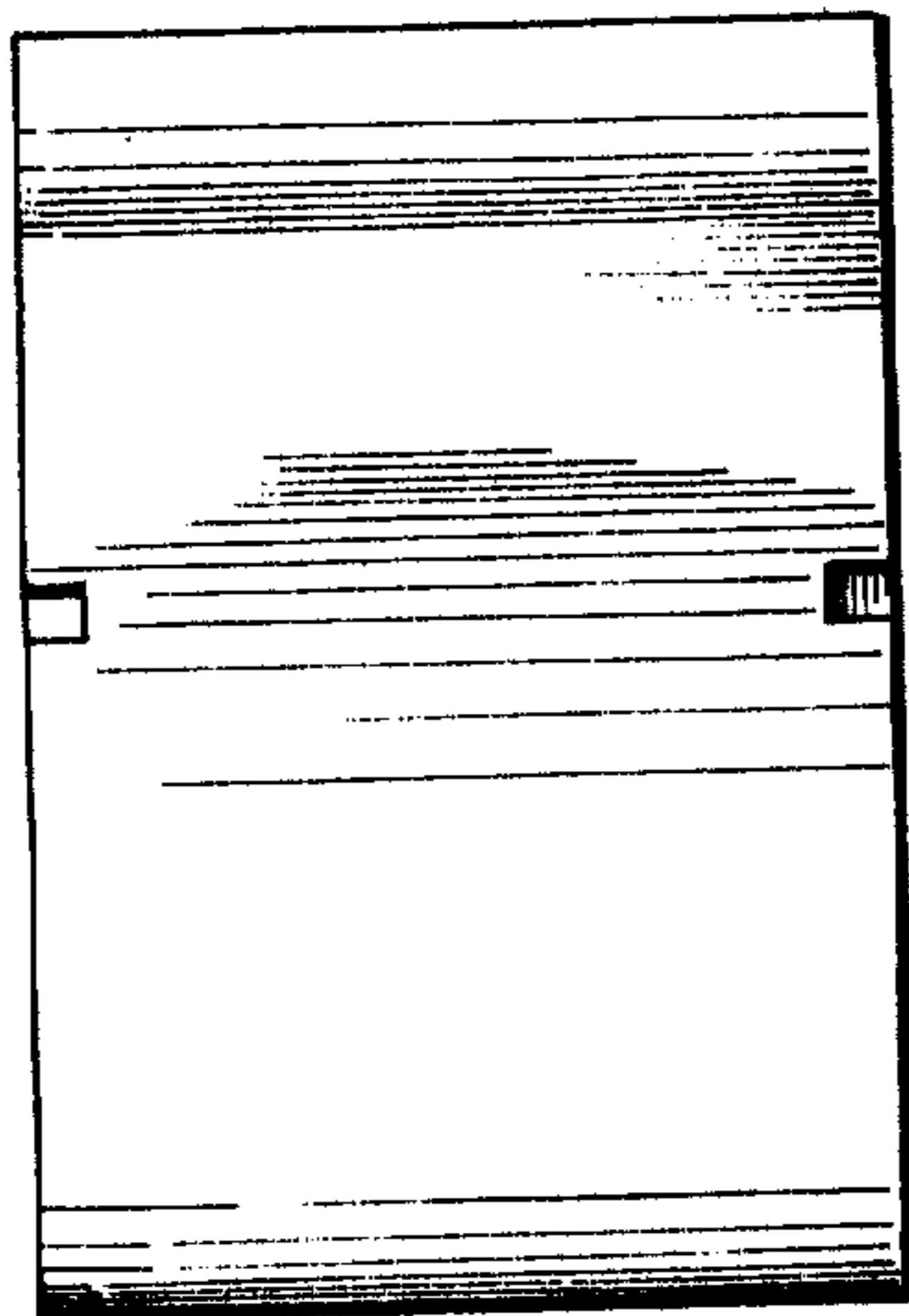

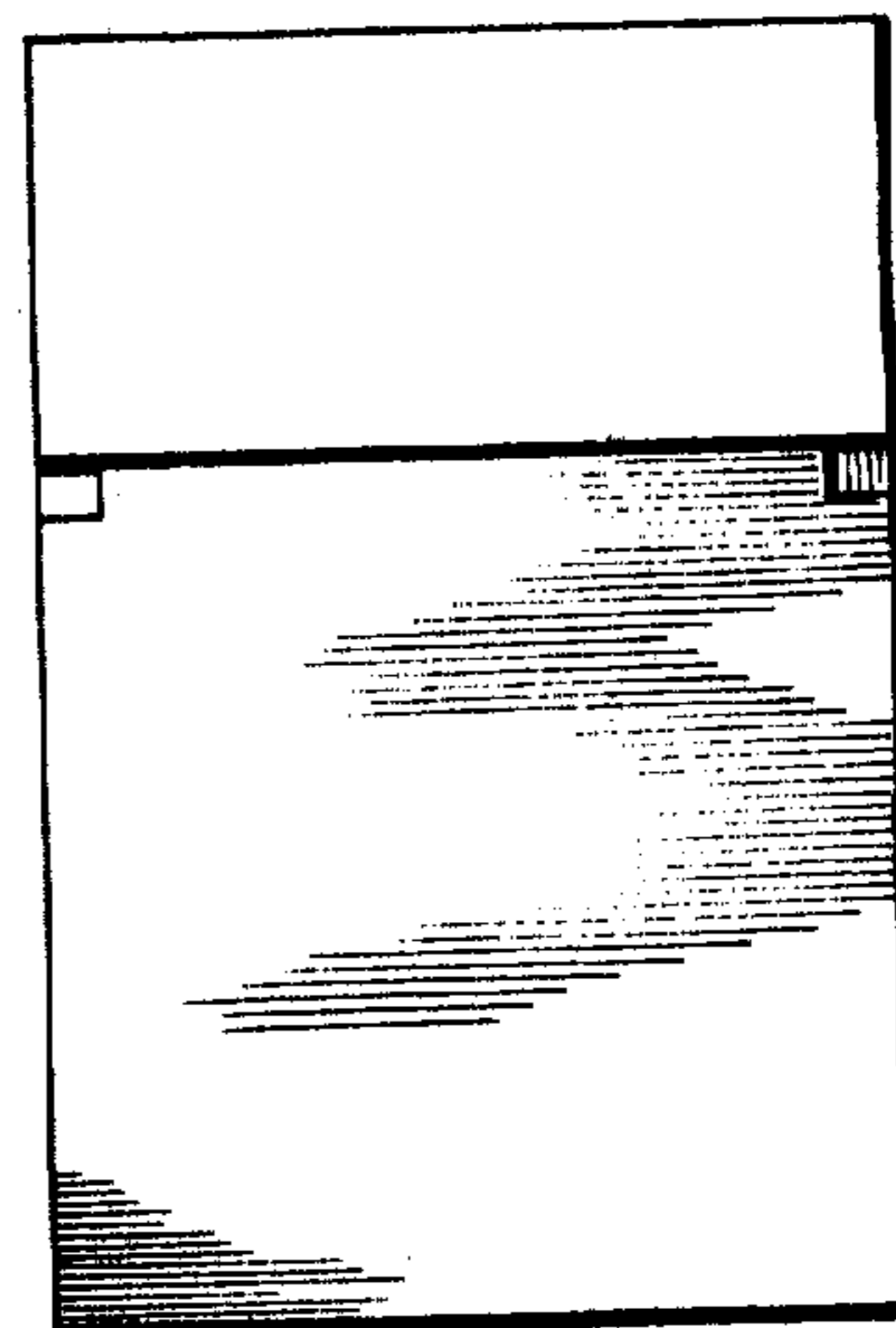
