

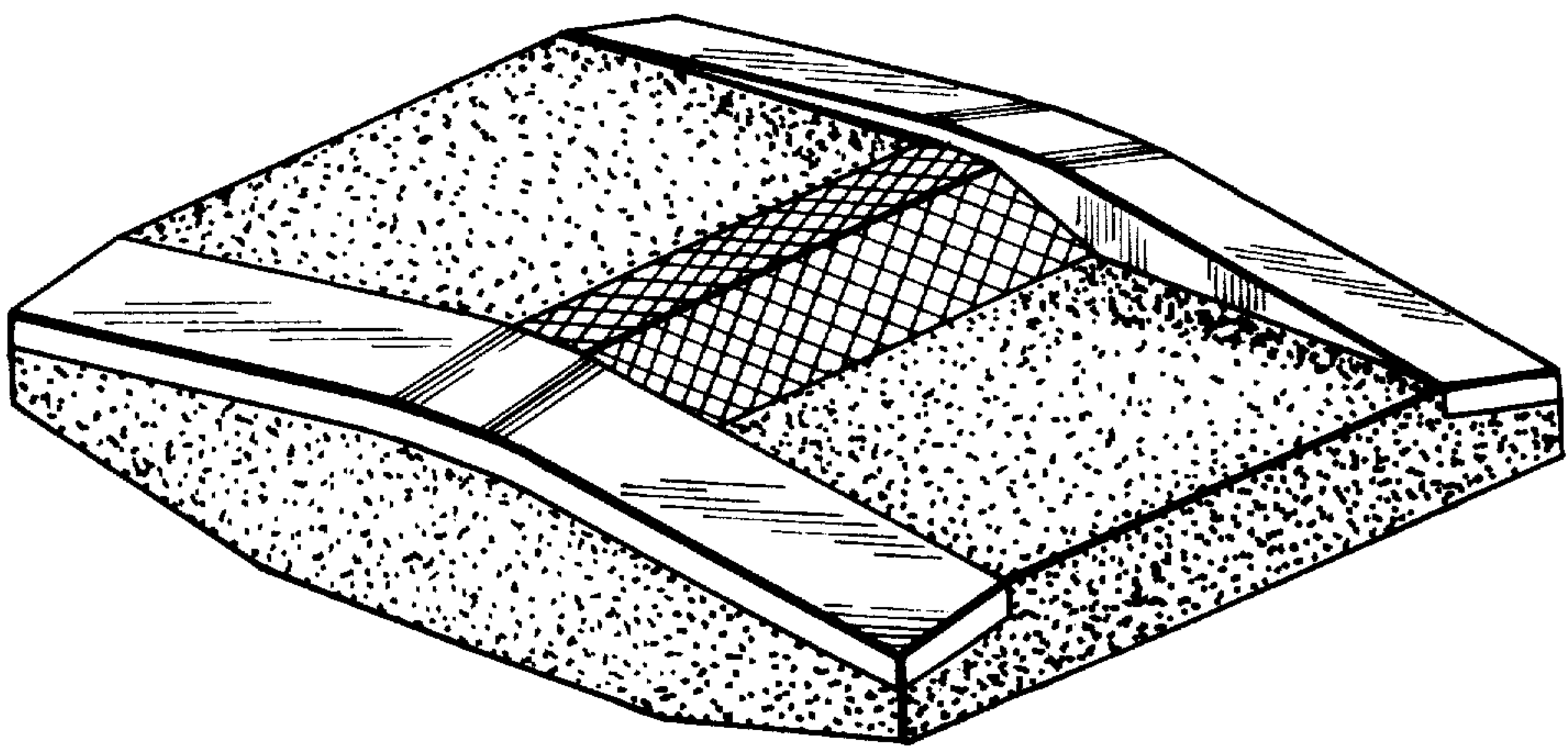

[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for a reflective pavement marker for roads, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a uni-directional reflective pavement marker showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front end view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear end view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof, both sides being identical;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a bi-directional reflective pavement marker showing my new design;
FIG. 8 is an end view thereof, both ends being identical;
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 11 is a side elevational view thereof, both sides being identical;
FIG. 12 is an enlarged fragmentary, cross-sectional view taken on line 12—12 of FIG. 3.



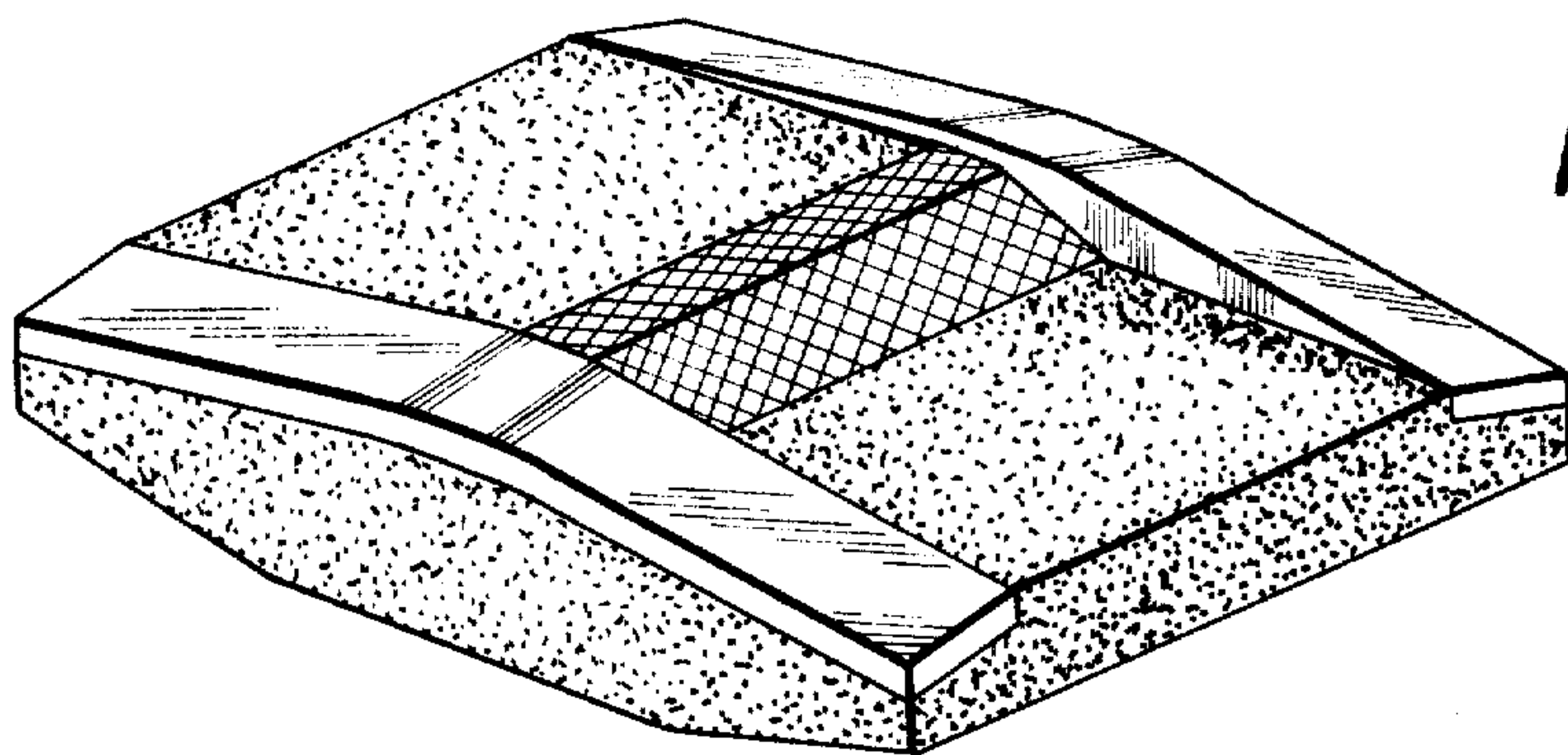

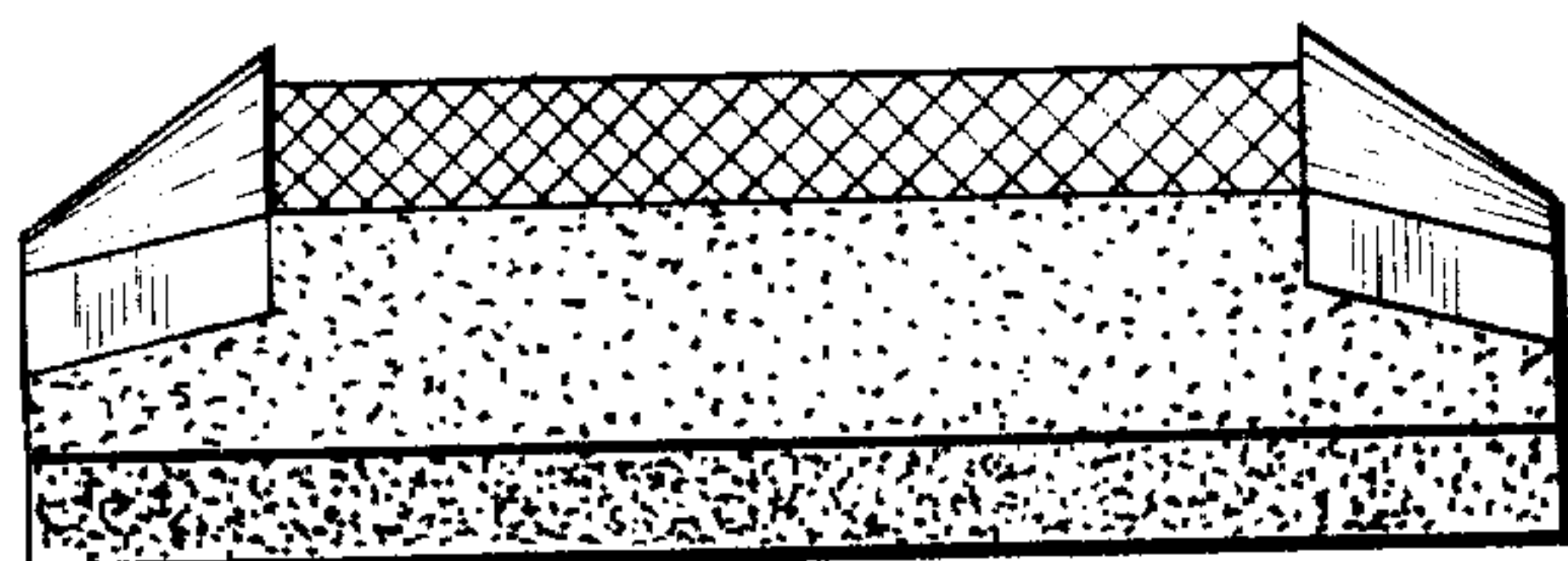

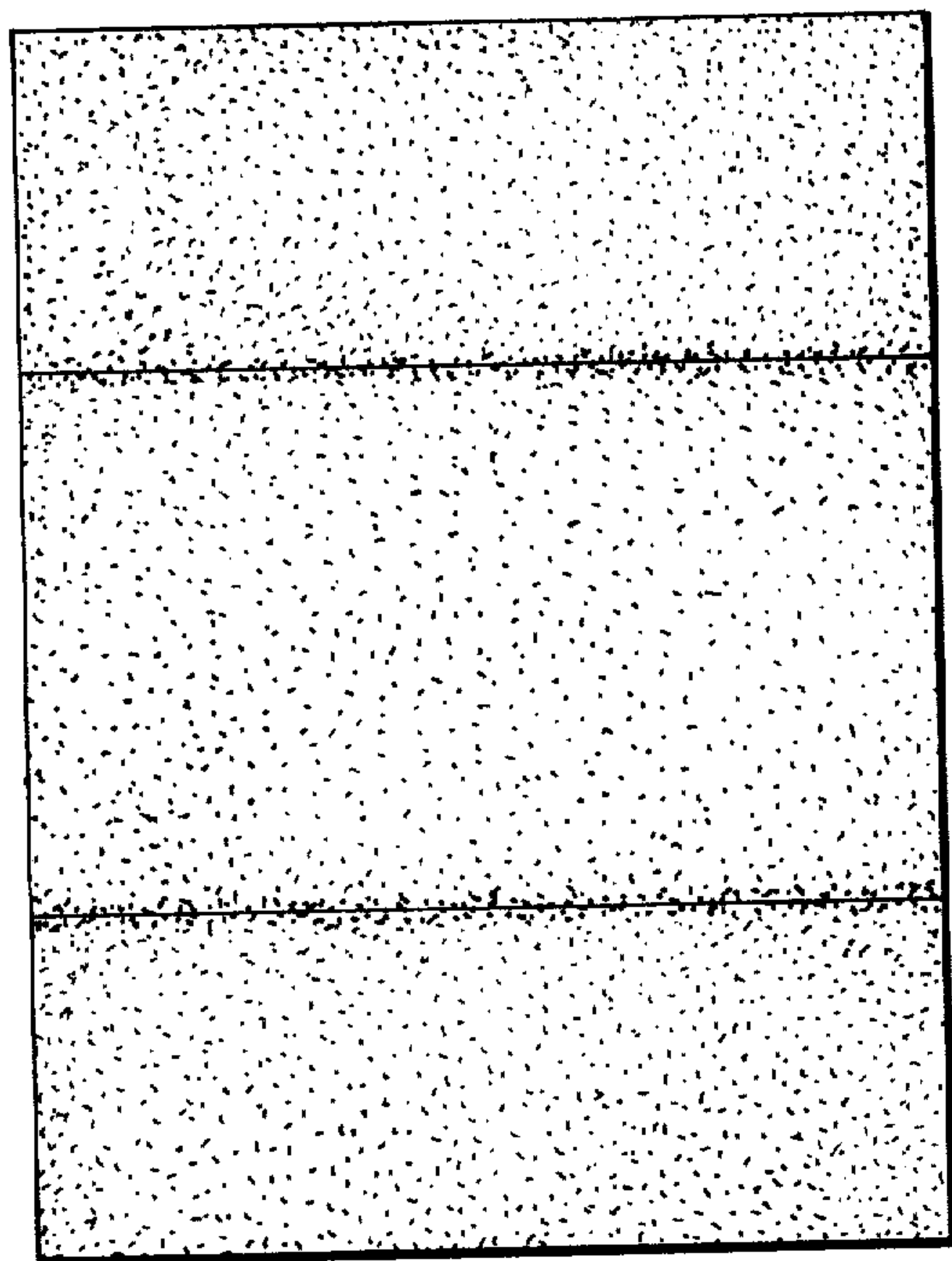

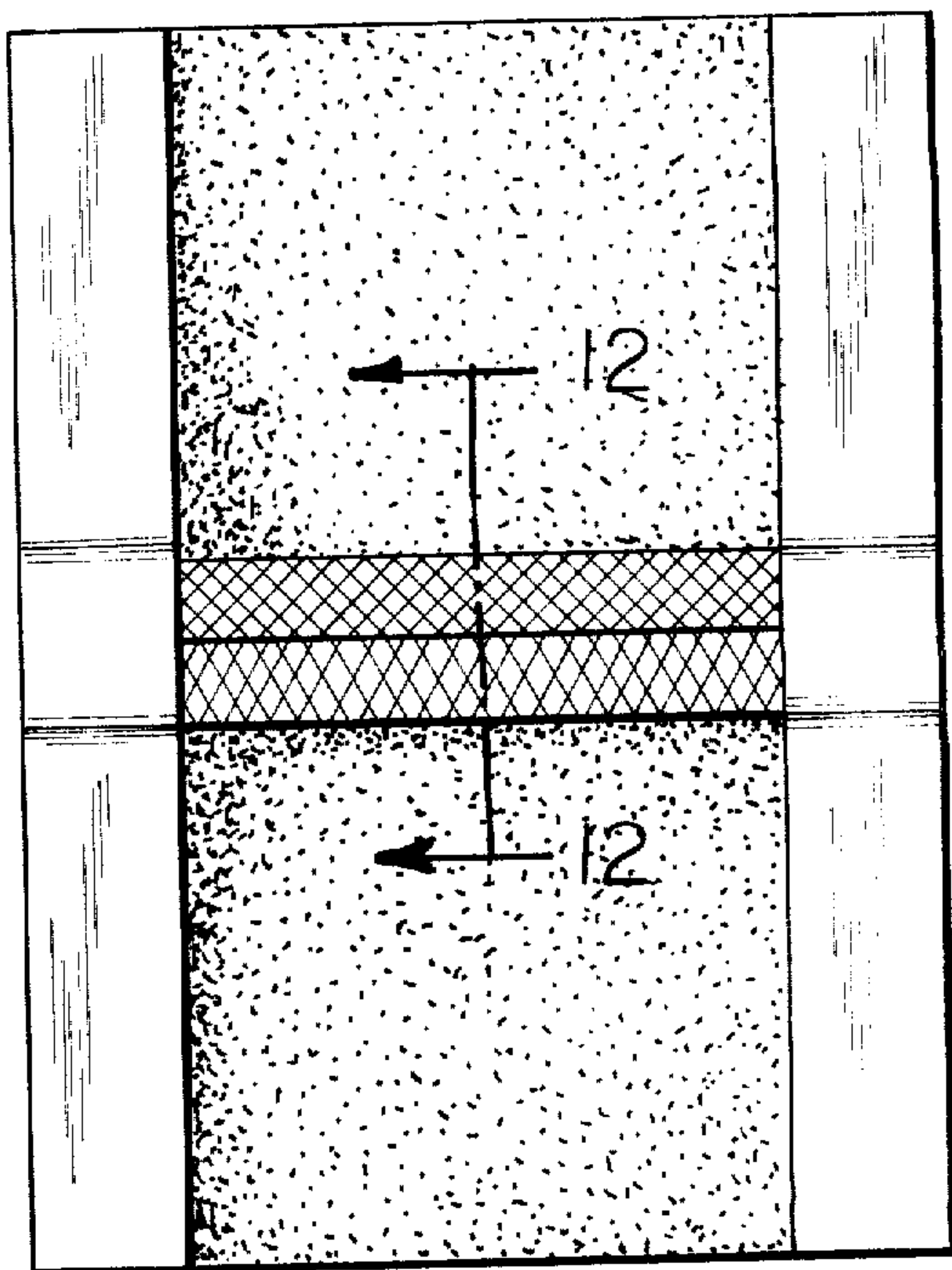

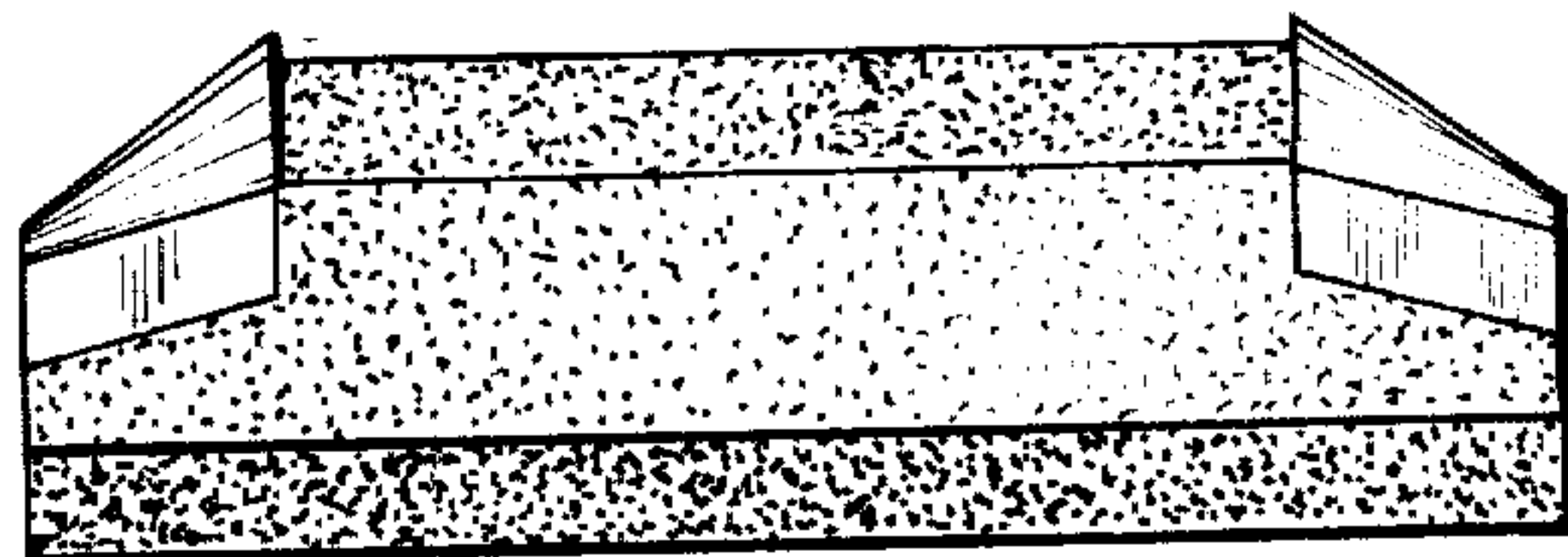
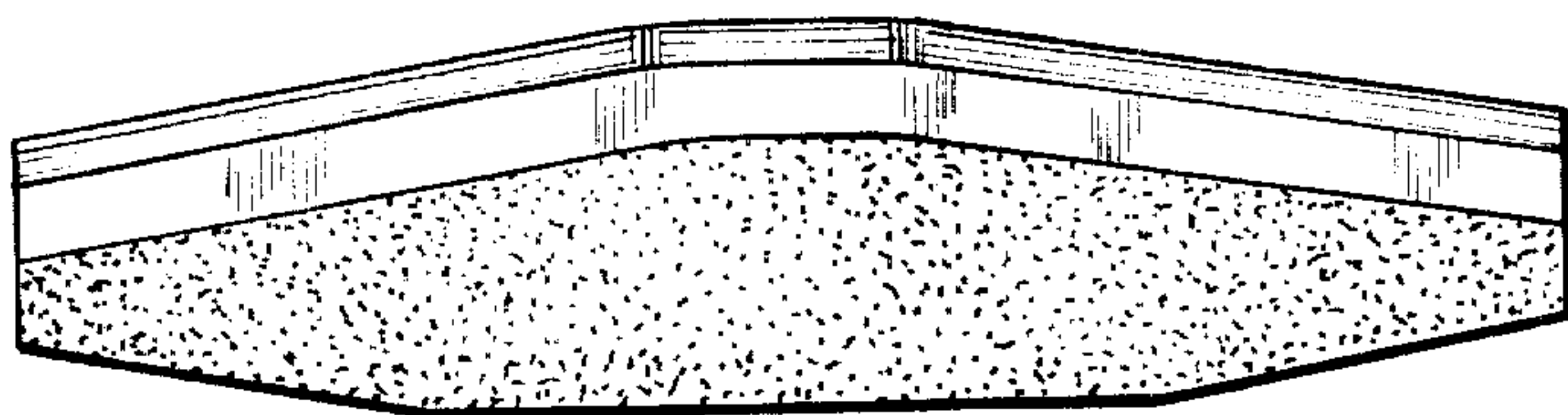

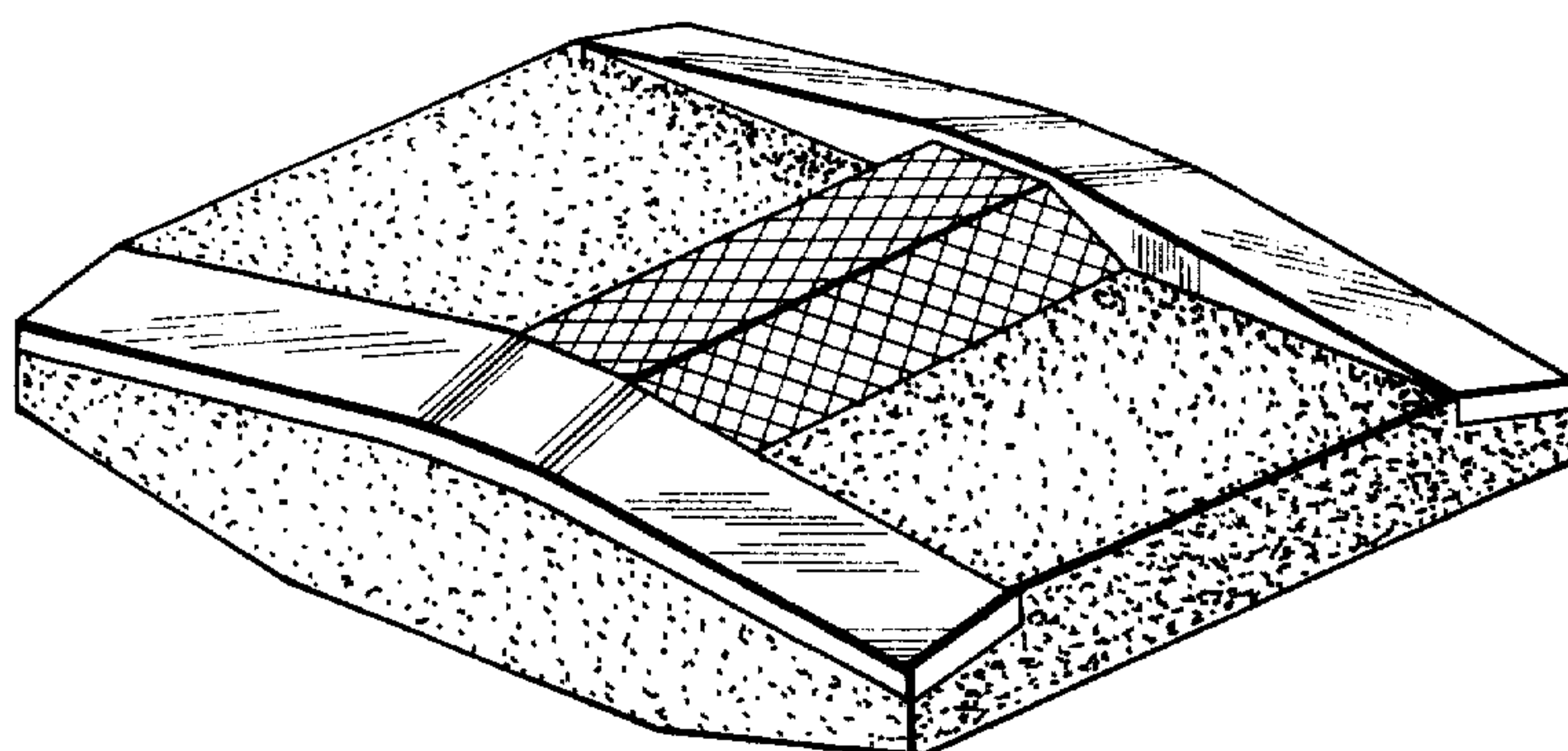

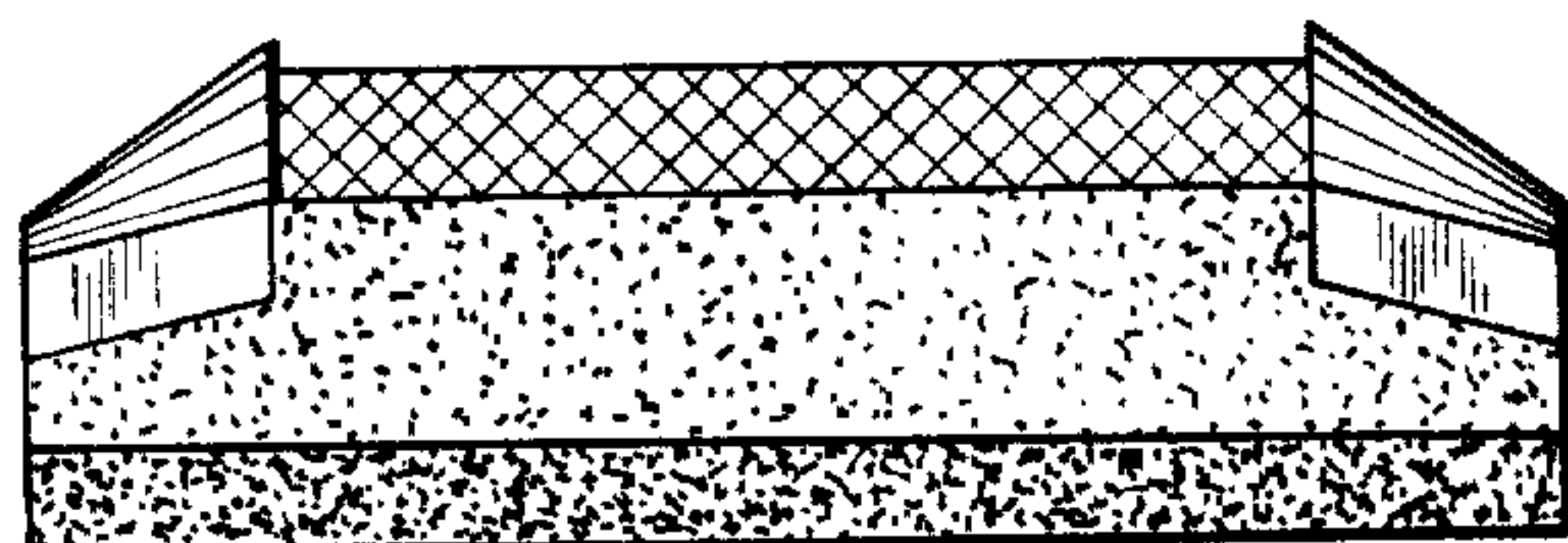

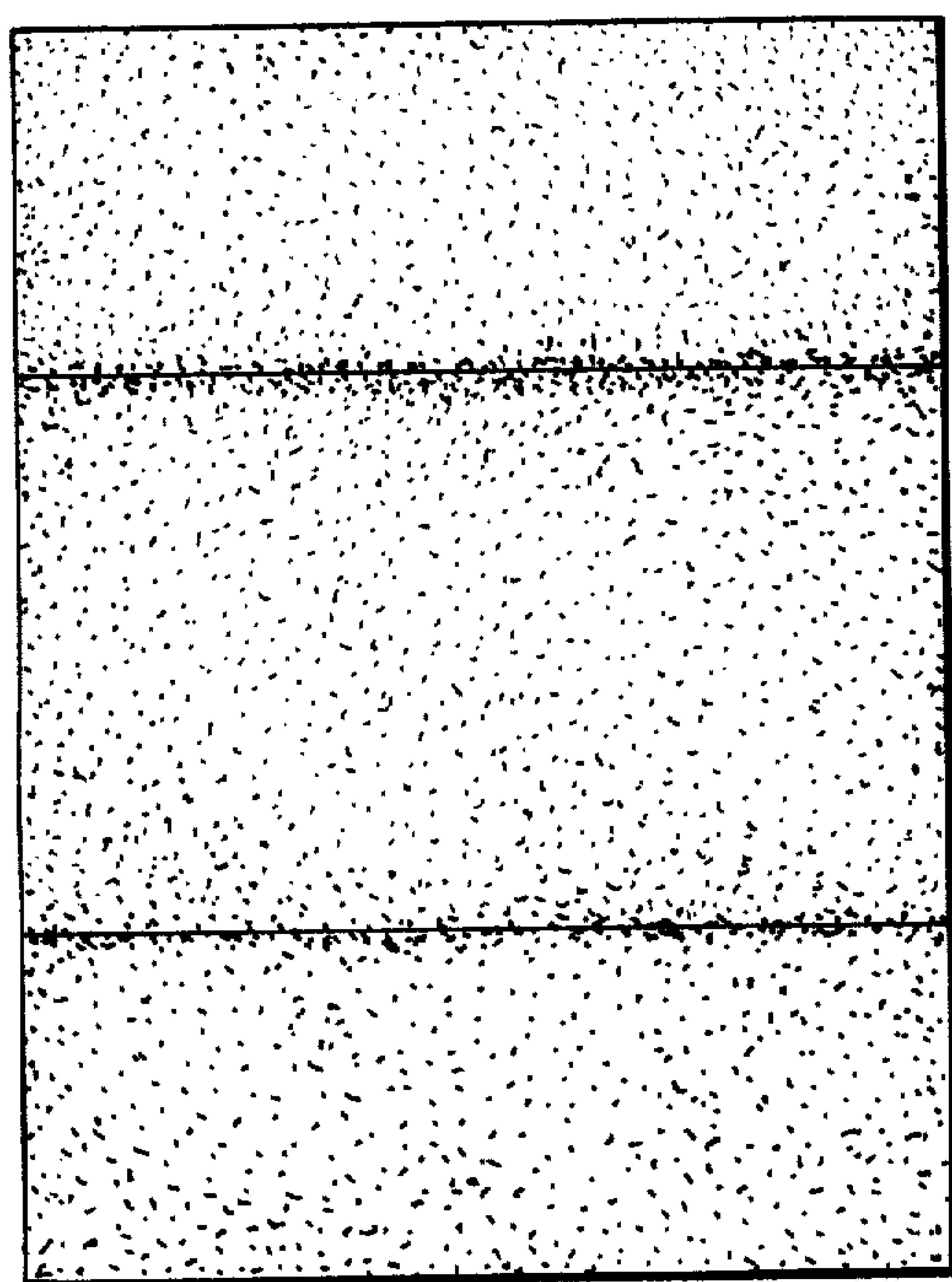

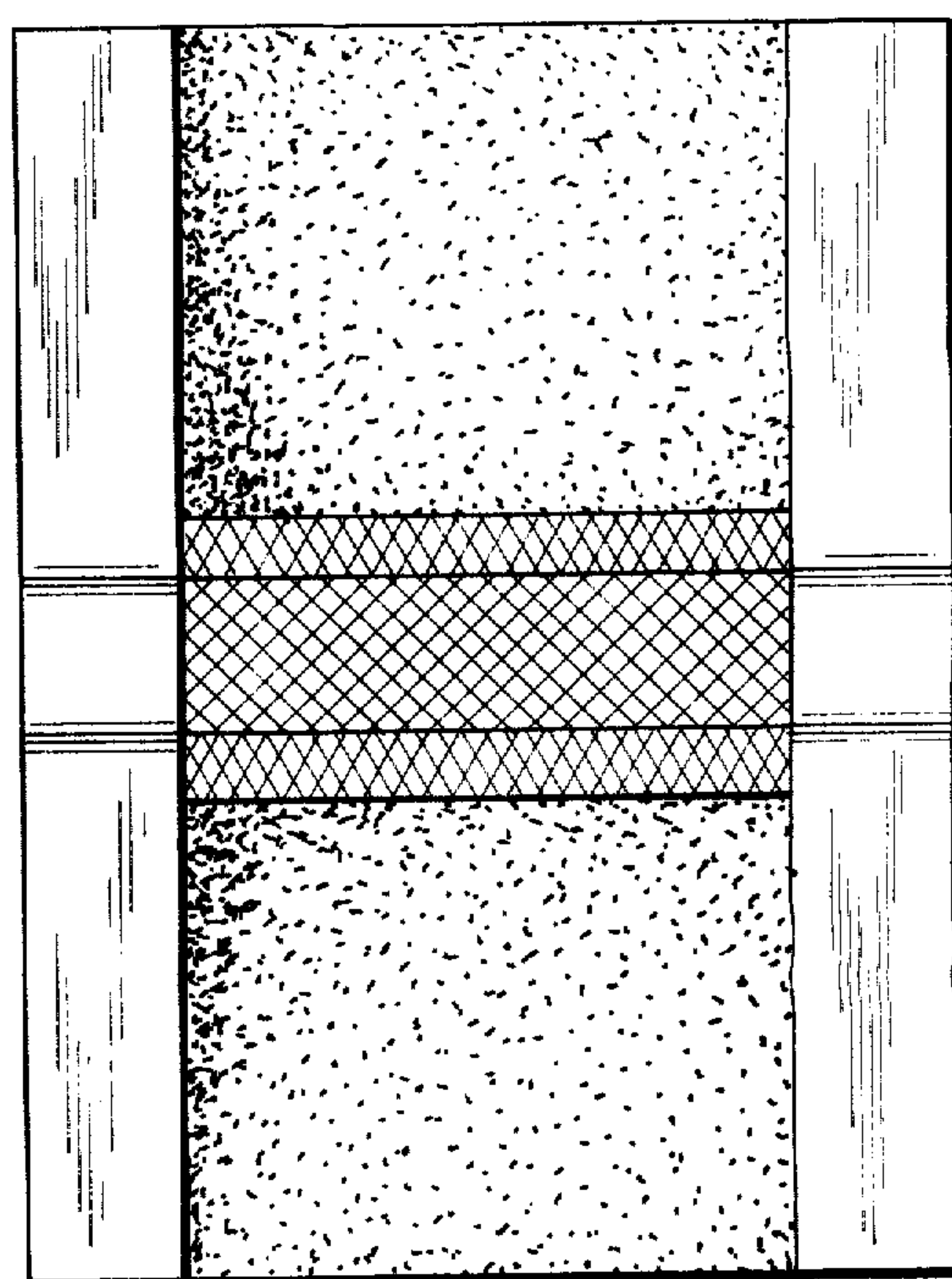

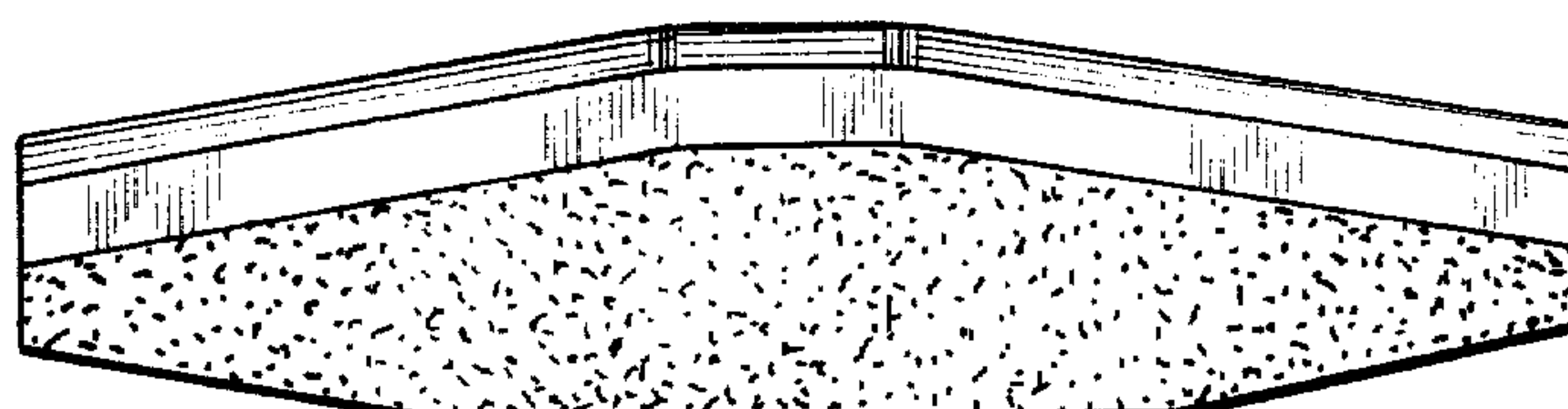

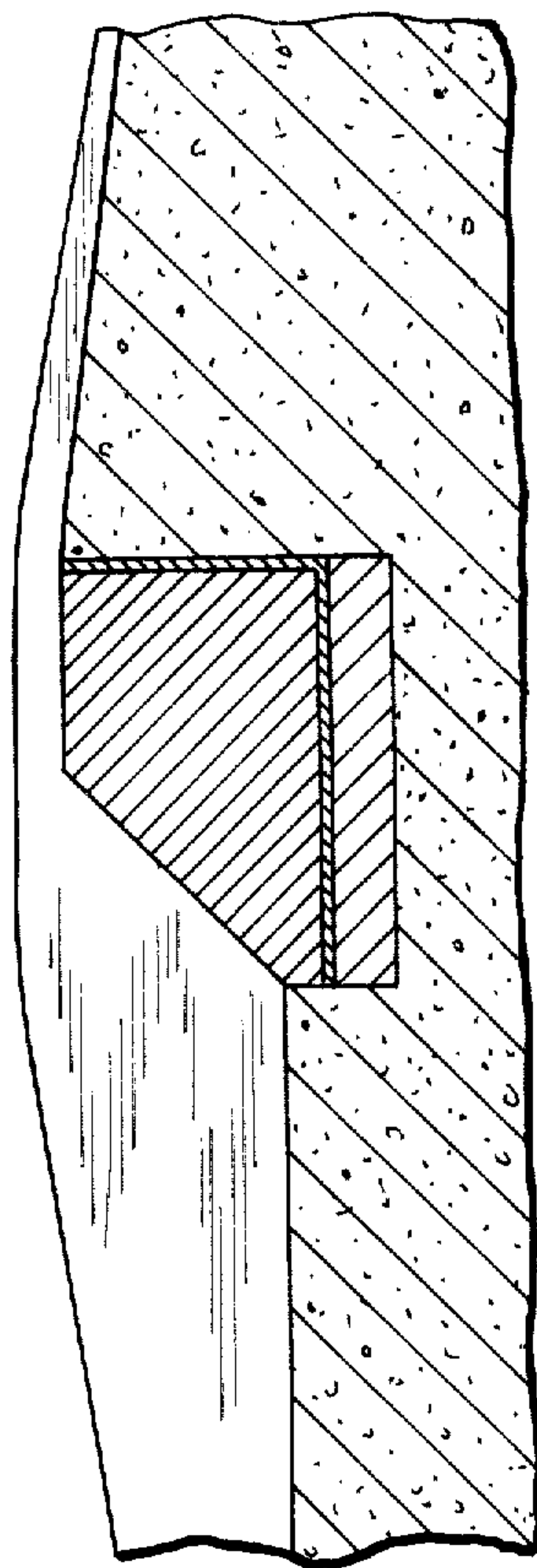
