DESCRIPTION

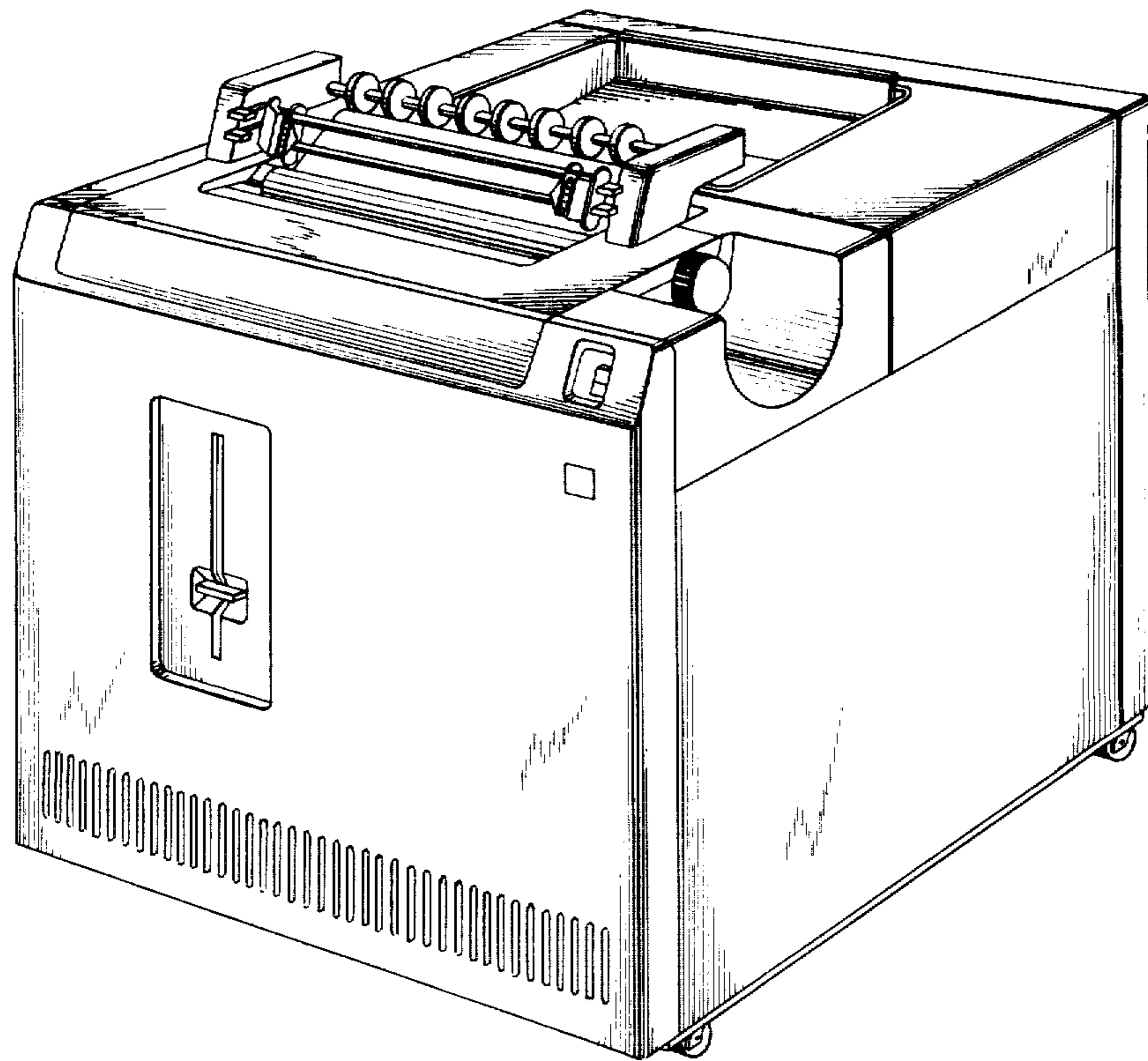
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a data processing console showing our new design.

FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale.



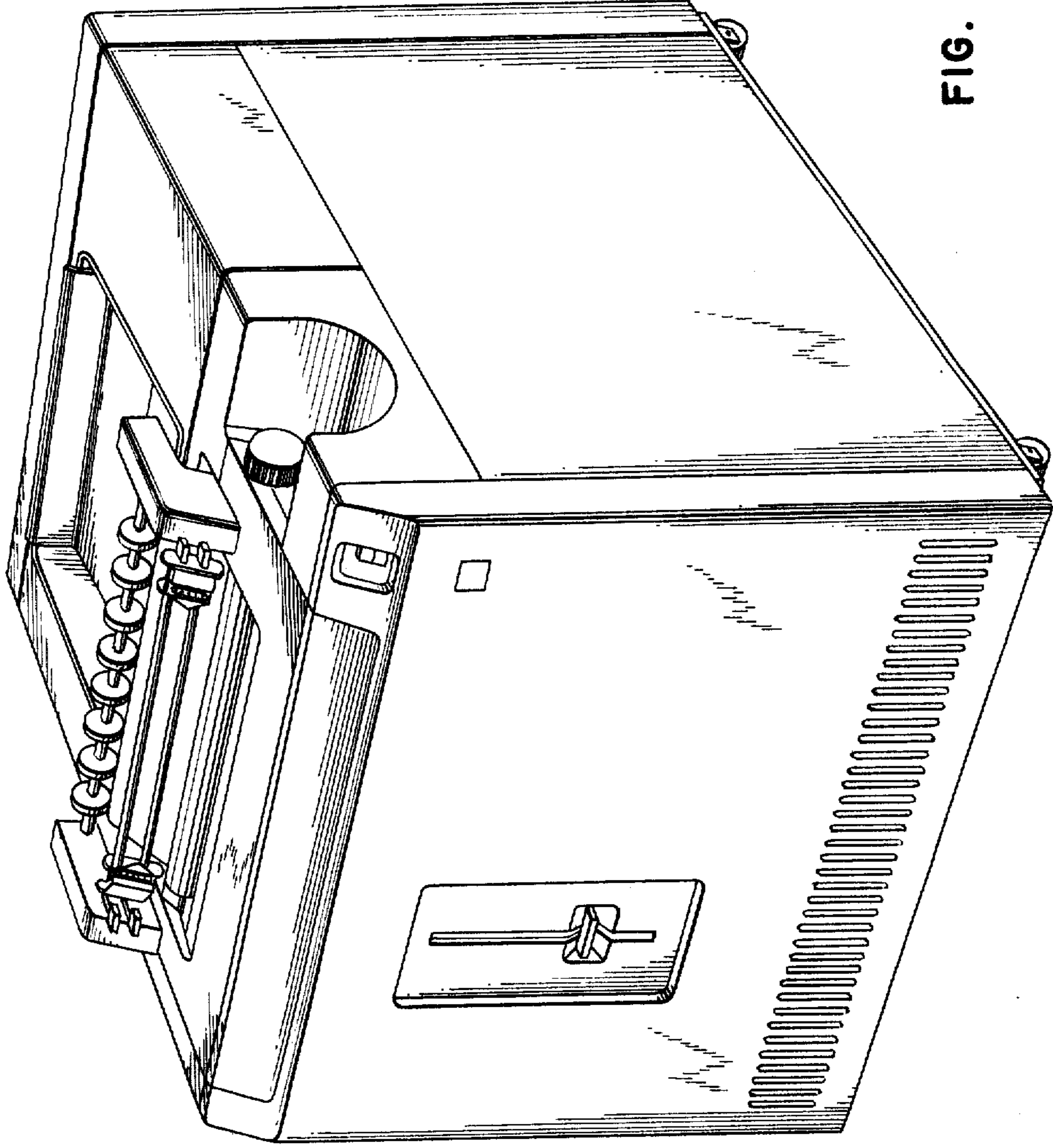

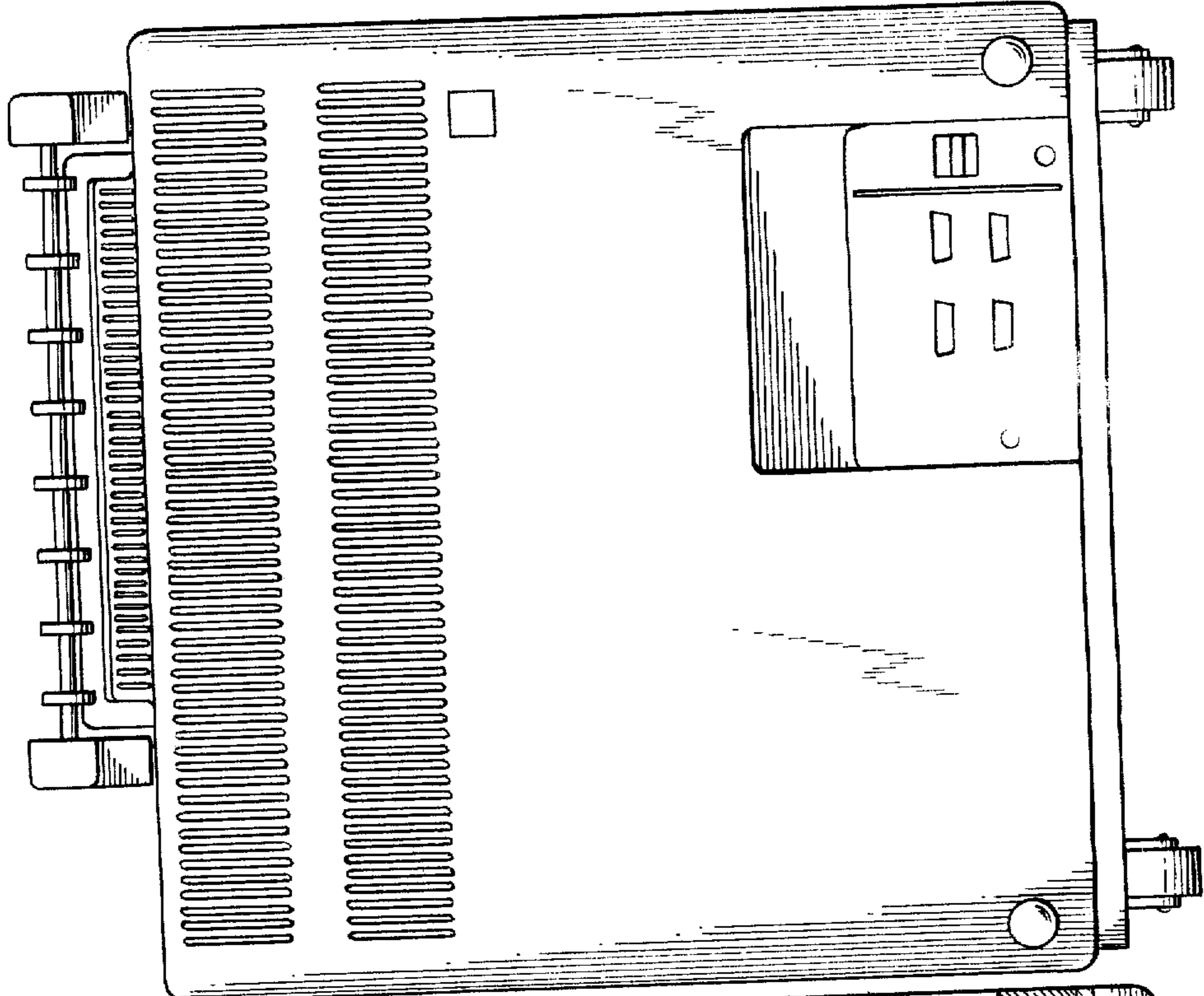

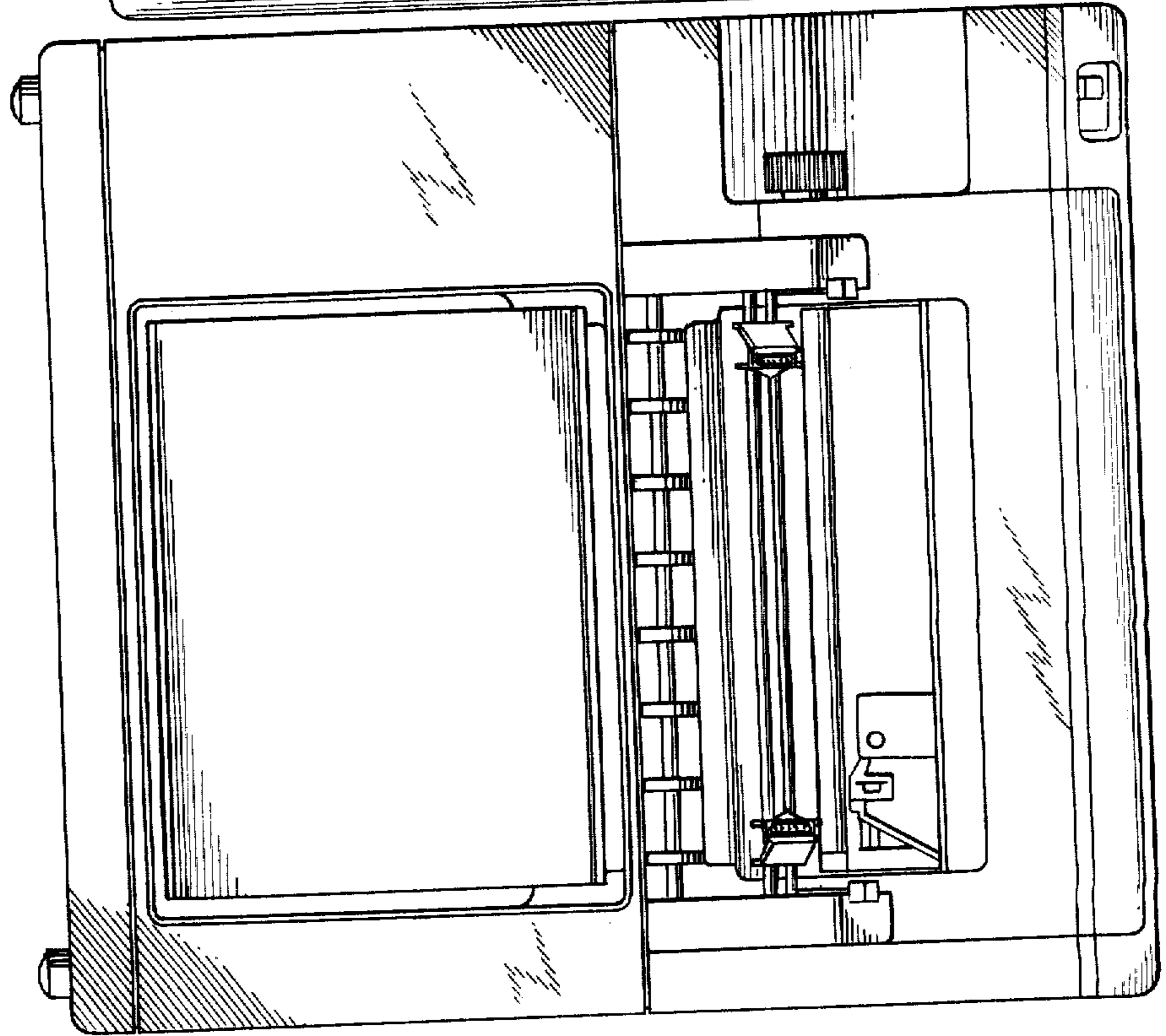

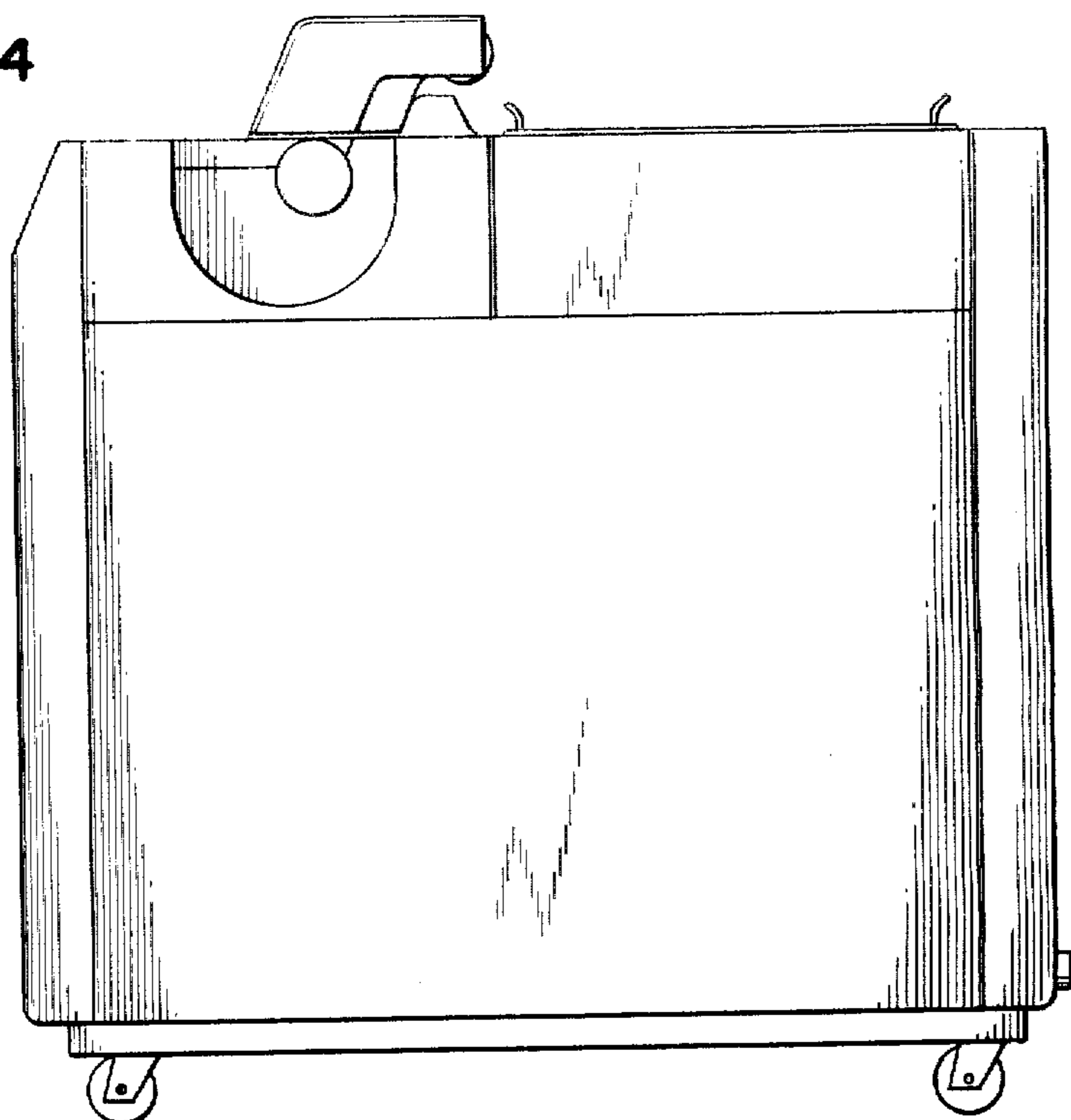
