DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wall mounted bathroom accessory fixture showing my new design;

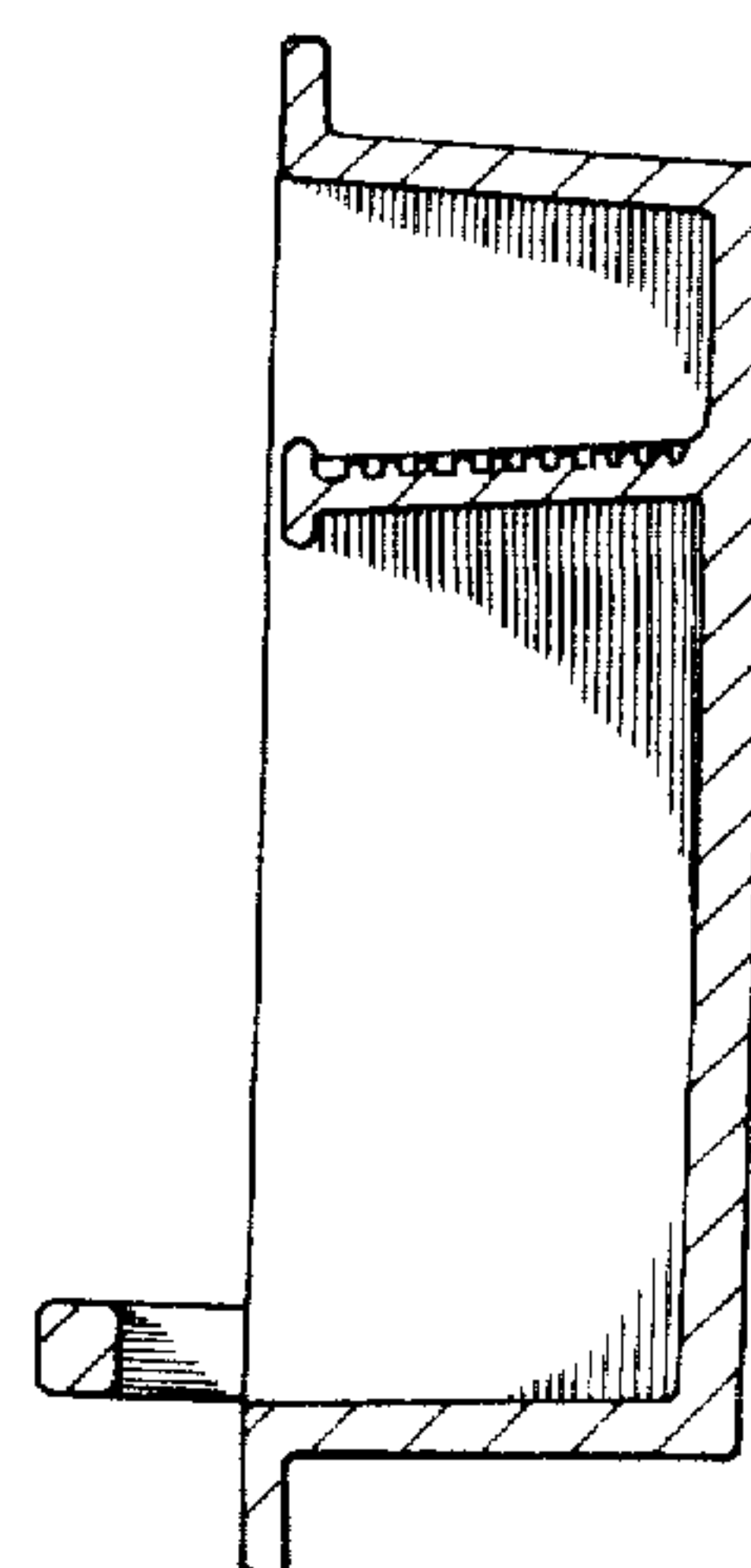
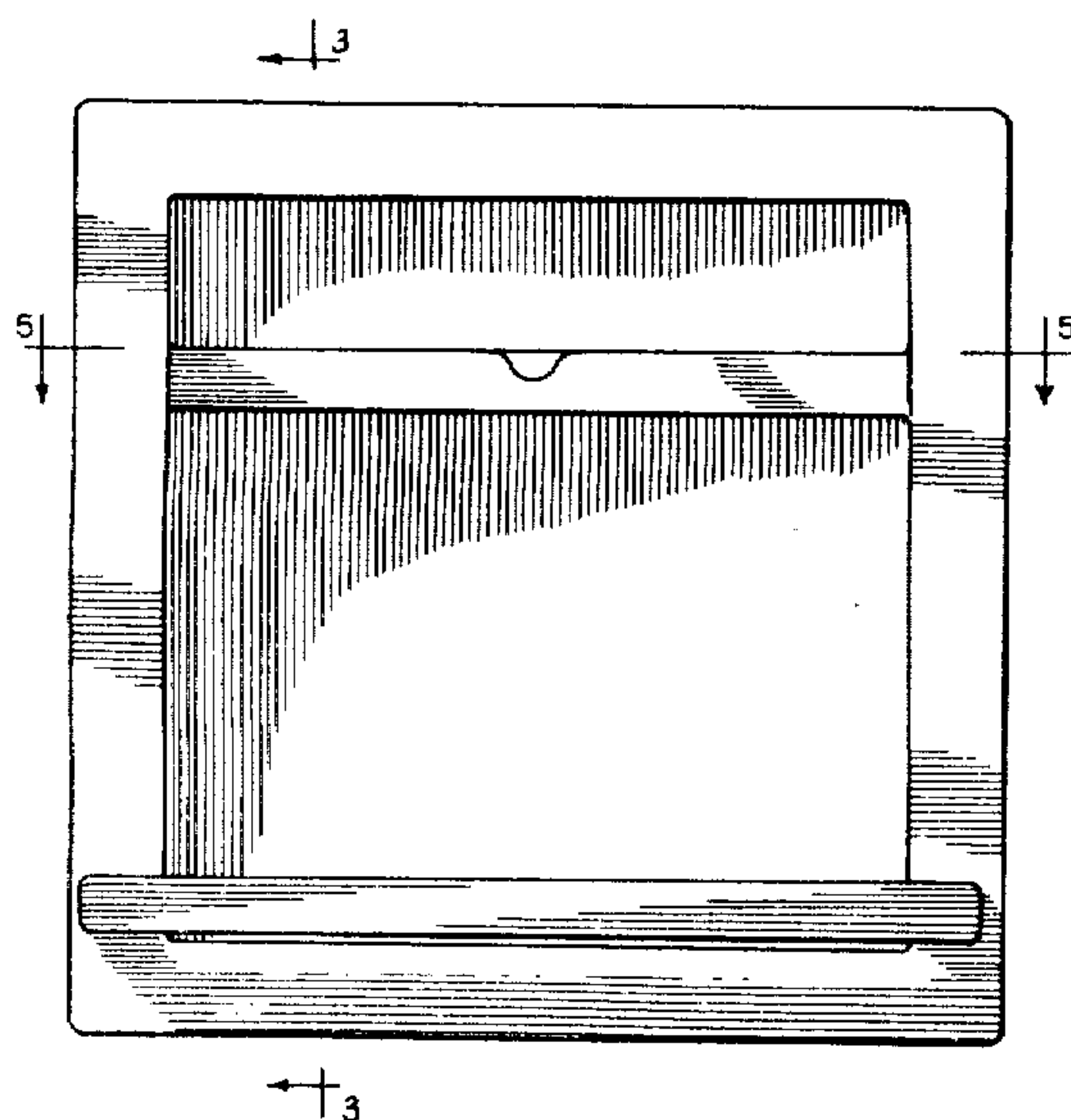
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

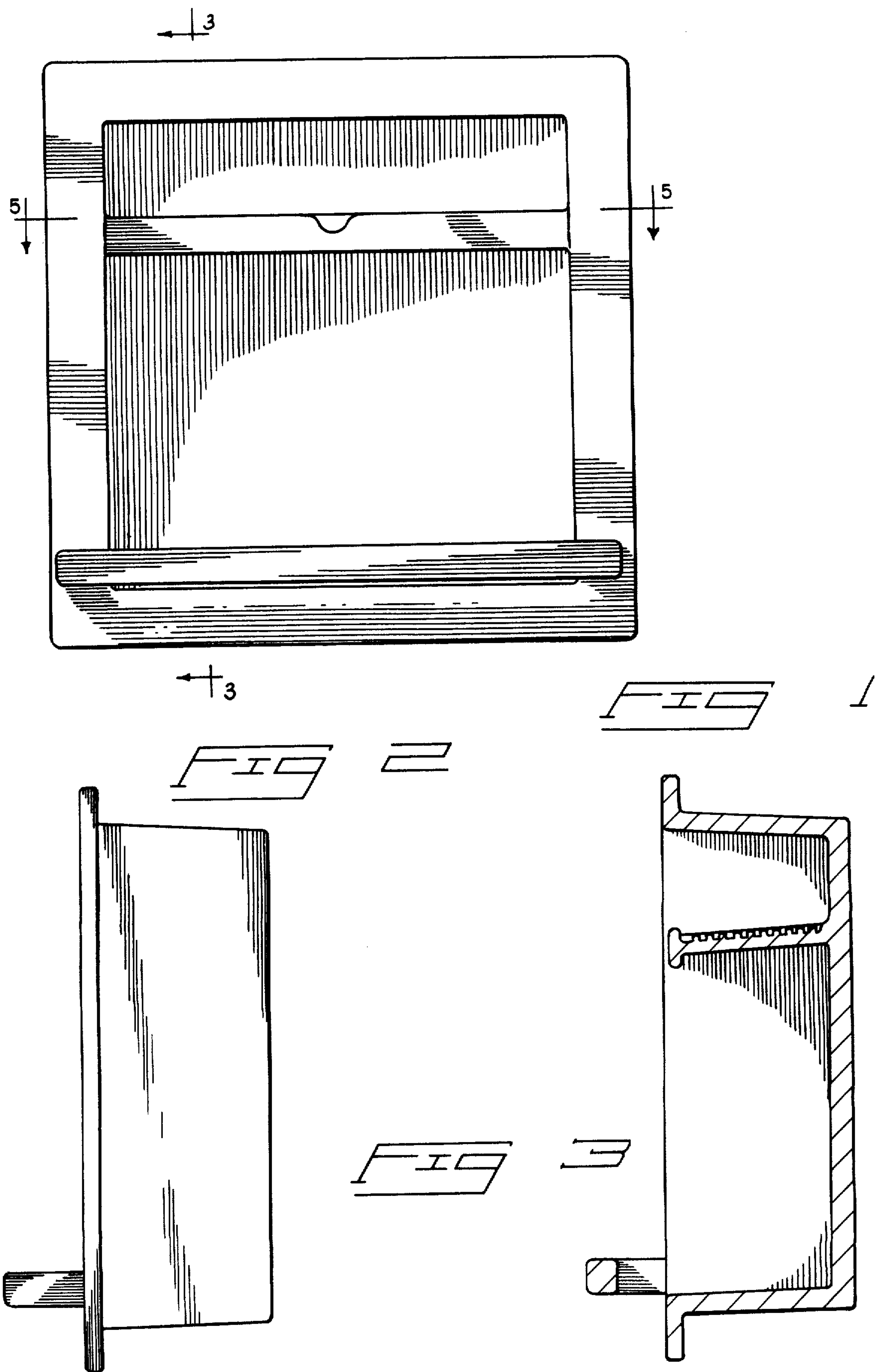
FIG. 3 is a sectional view thereof taken in the direction of the arrows on line 3—3 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a fragmentary sectional view thereof taken in the direction of the arrows on line 6—6 of FIG. 5.





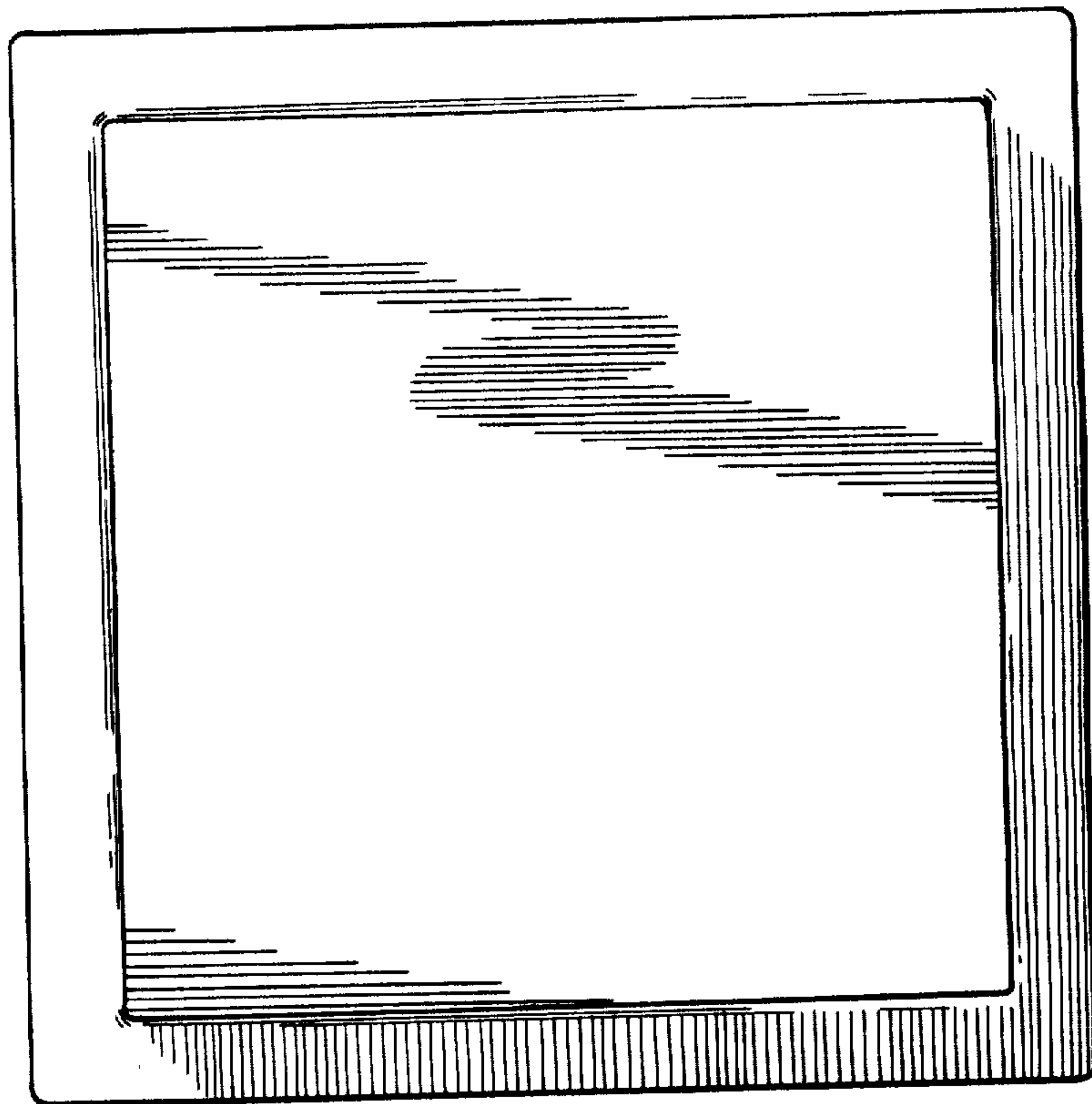

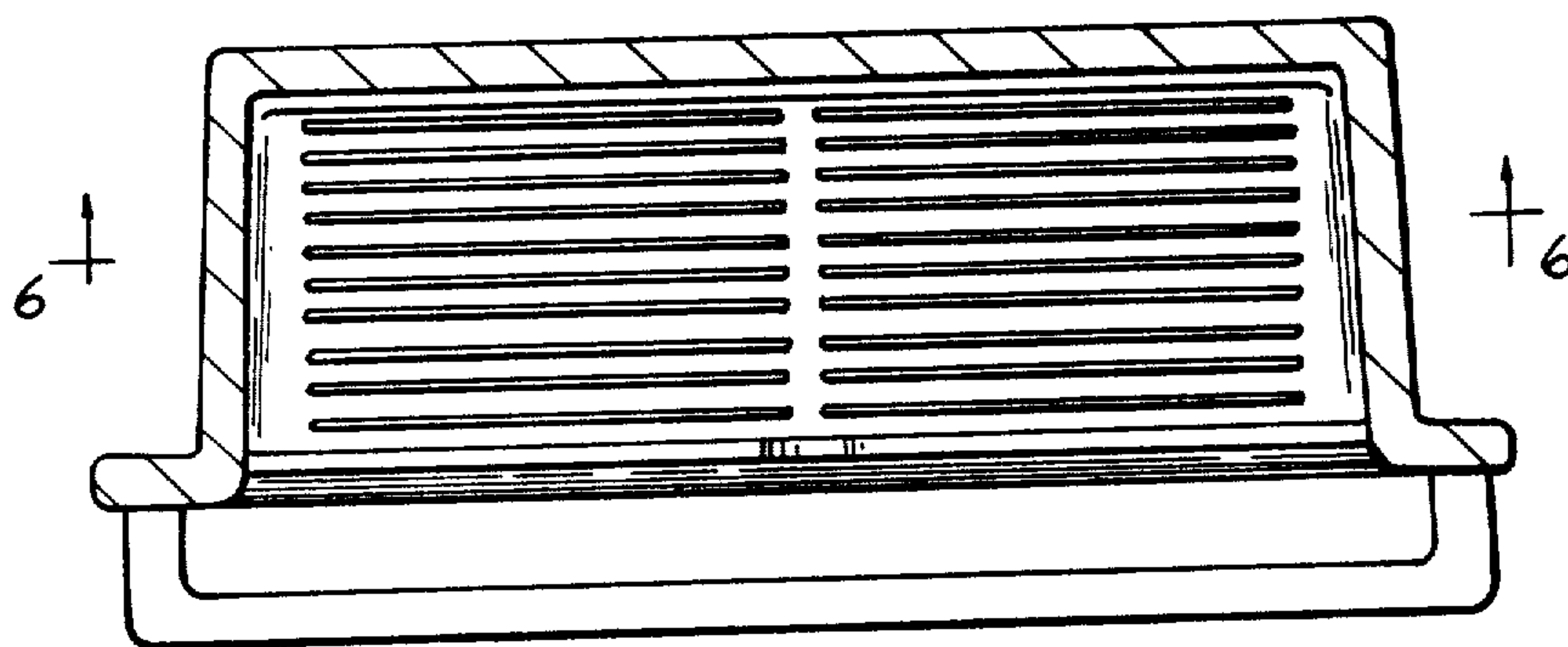

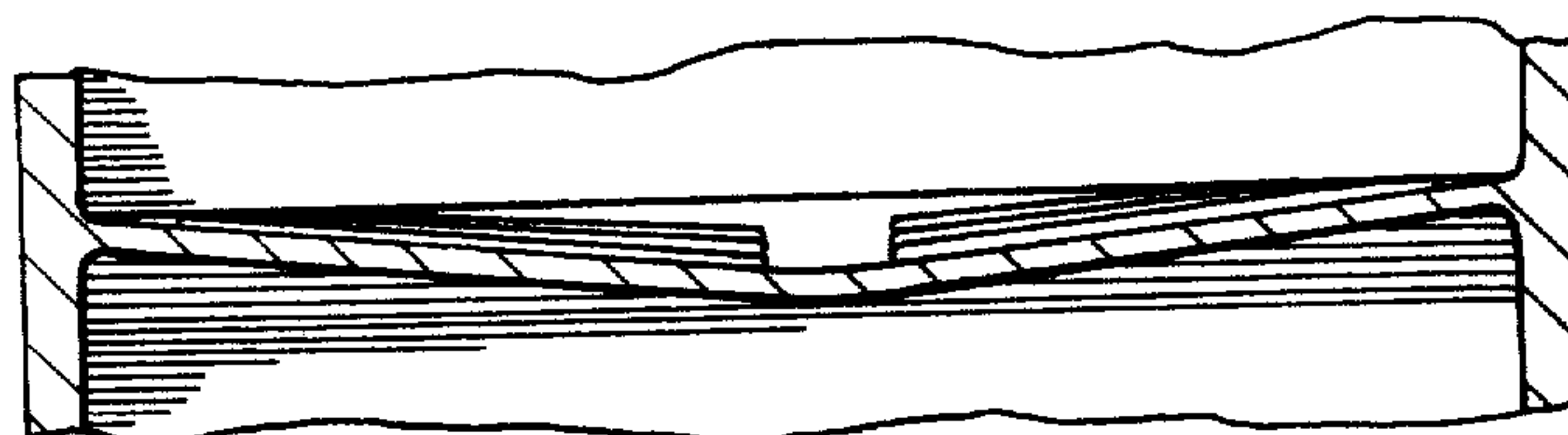
