a mirror image thereof;

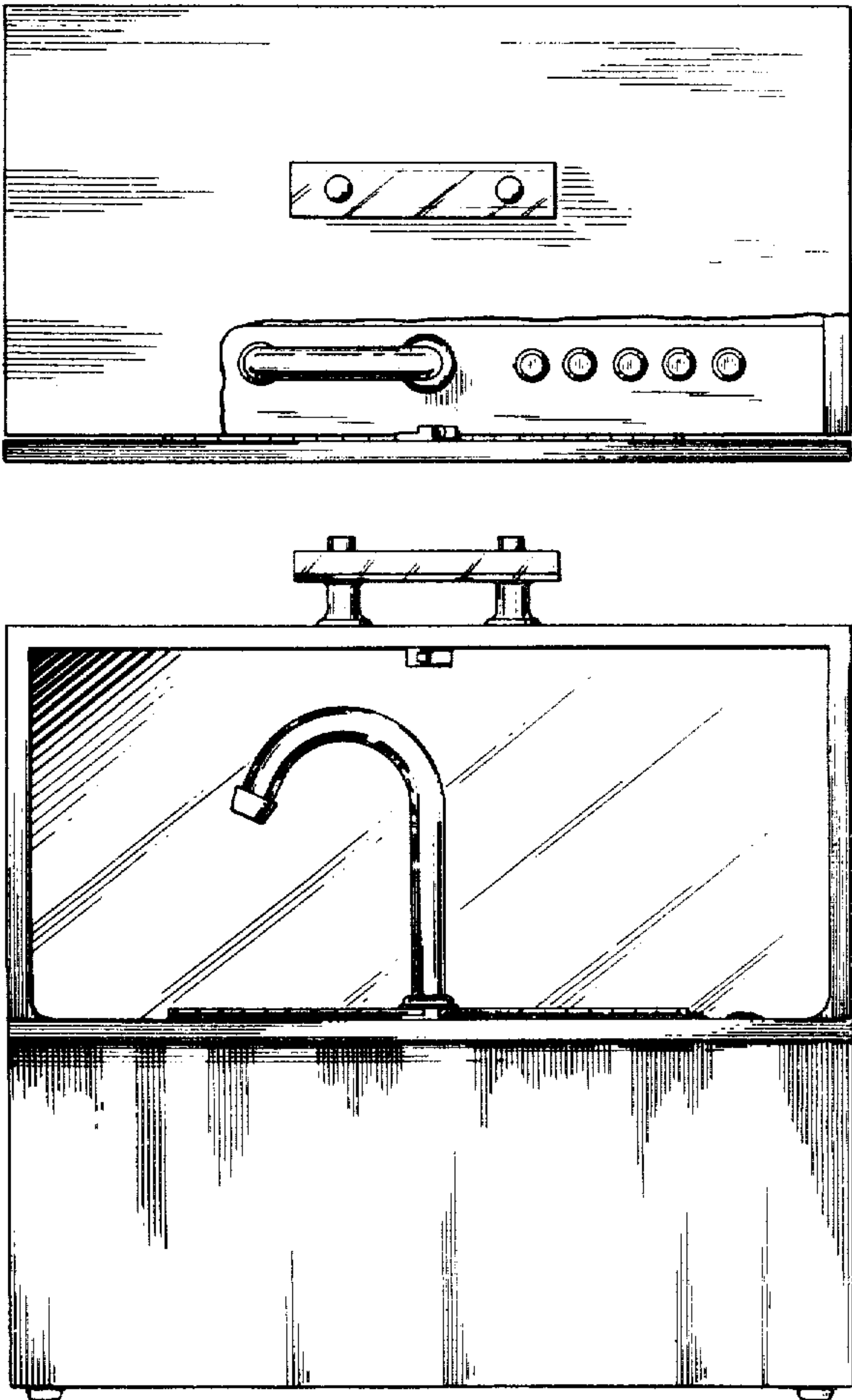
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

broken away for convenience of illustration.



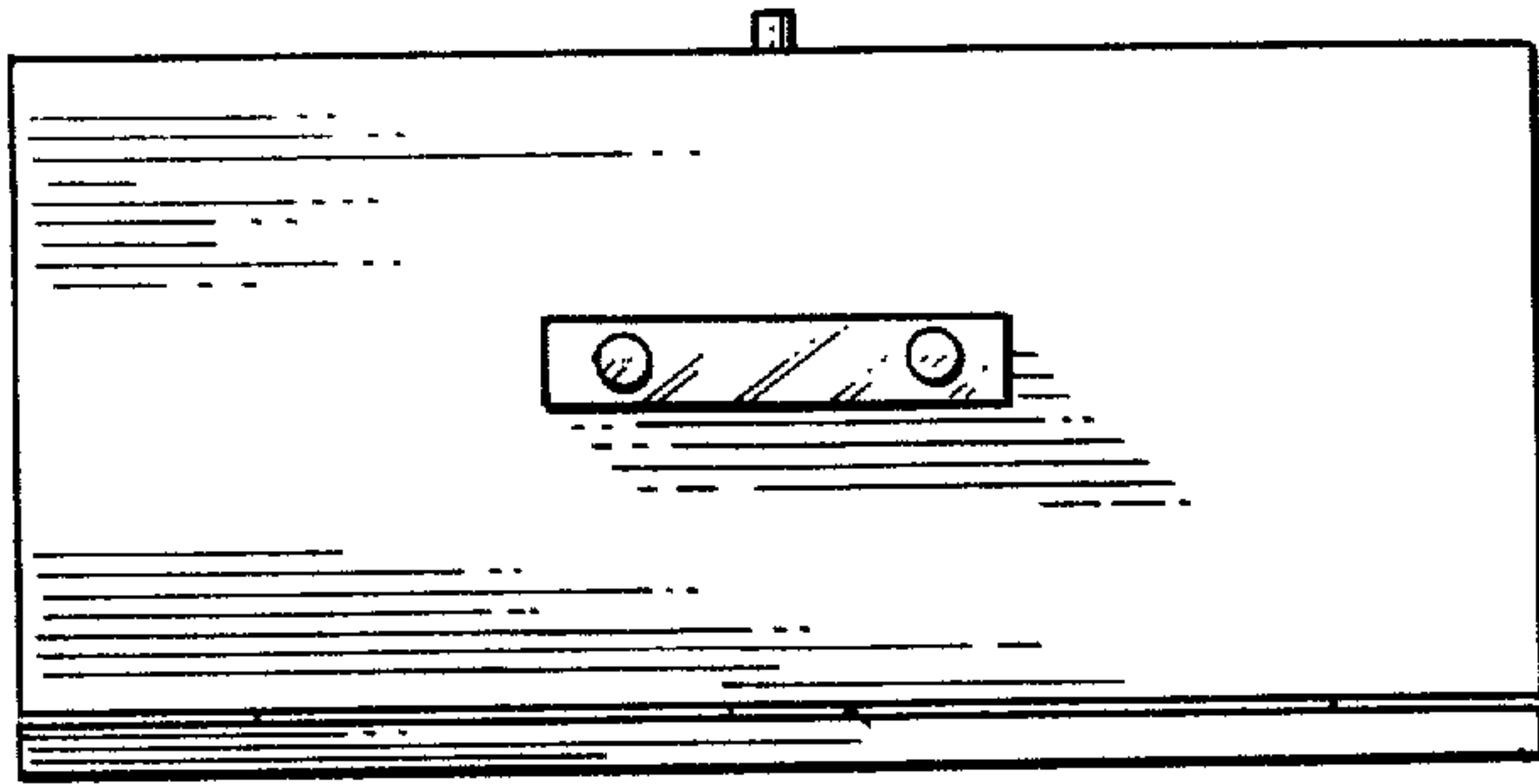

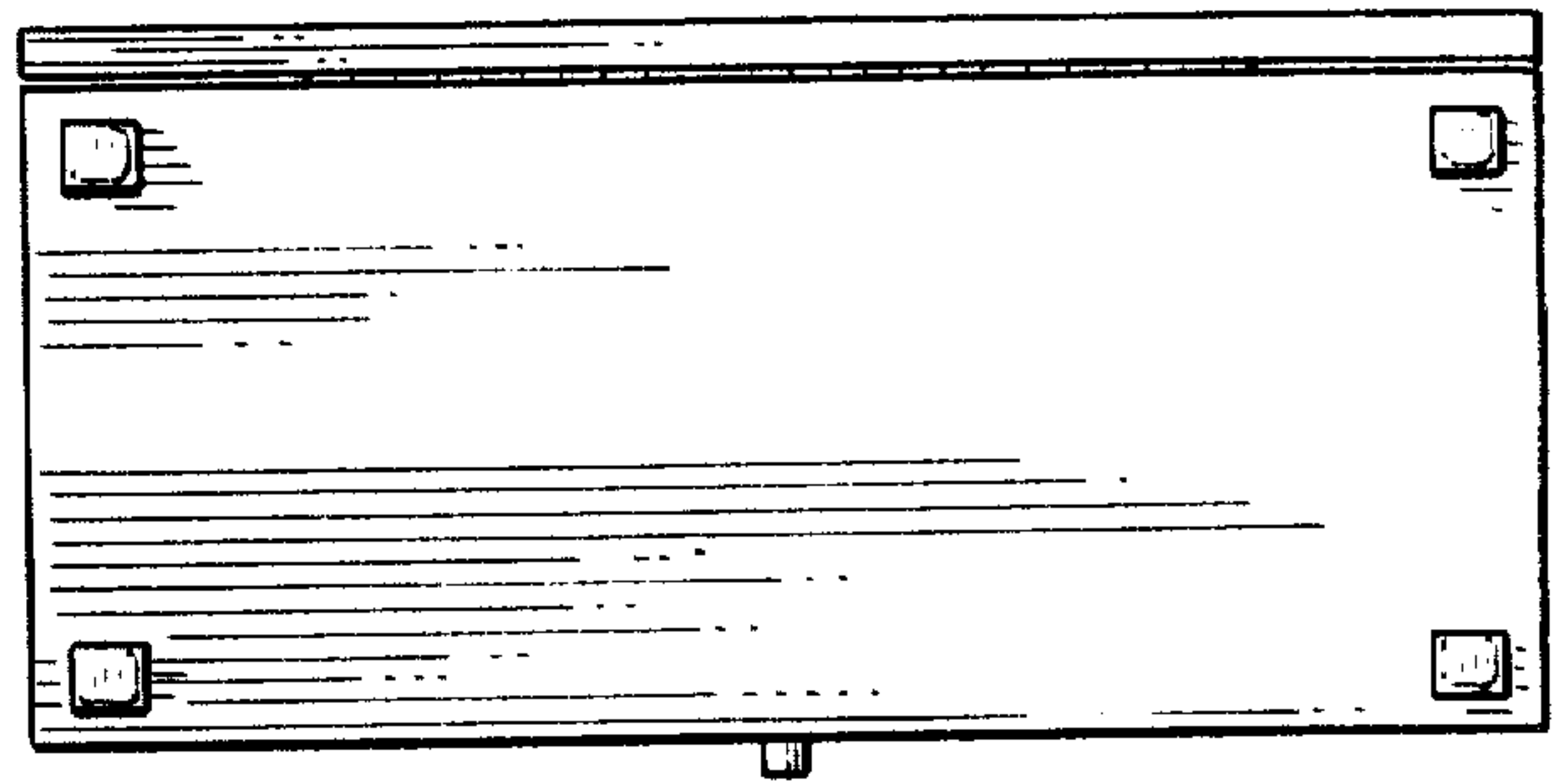

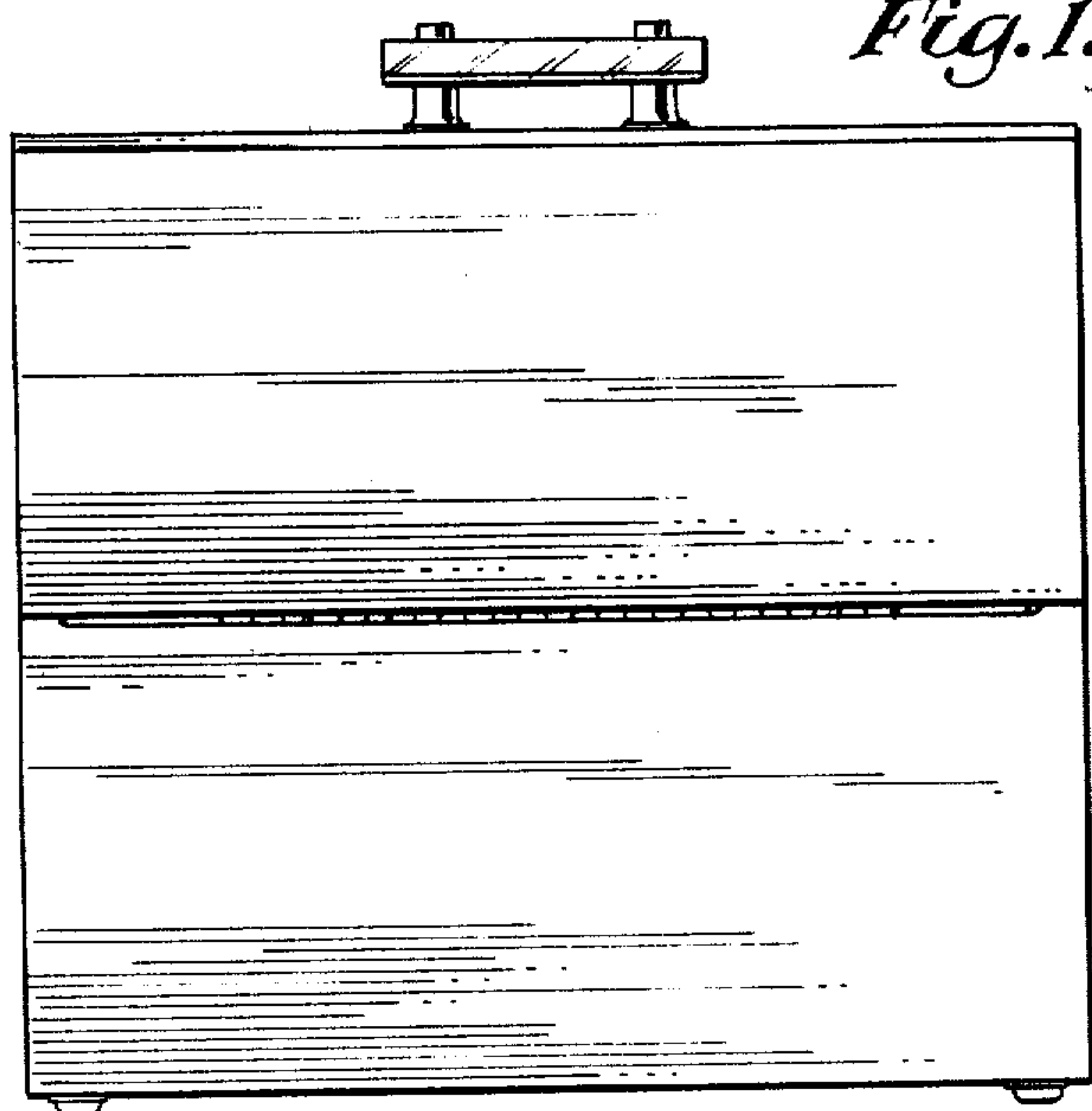

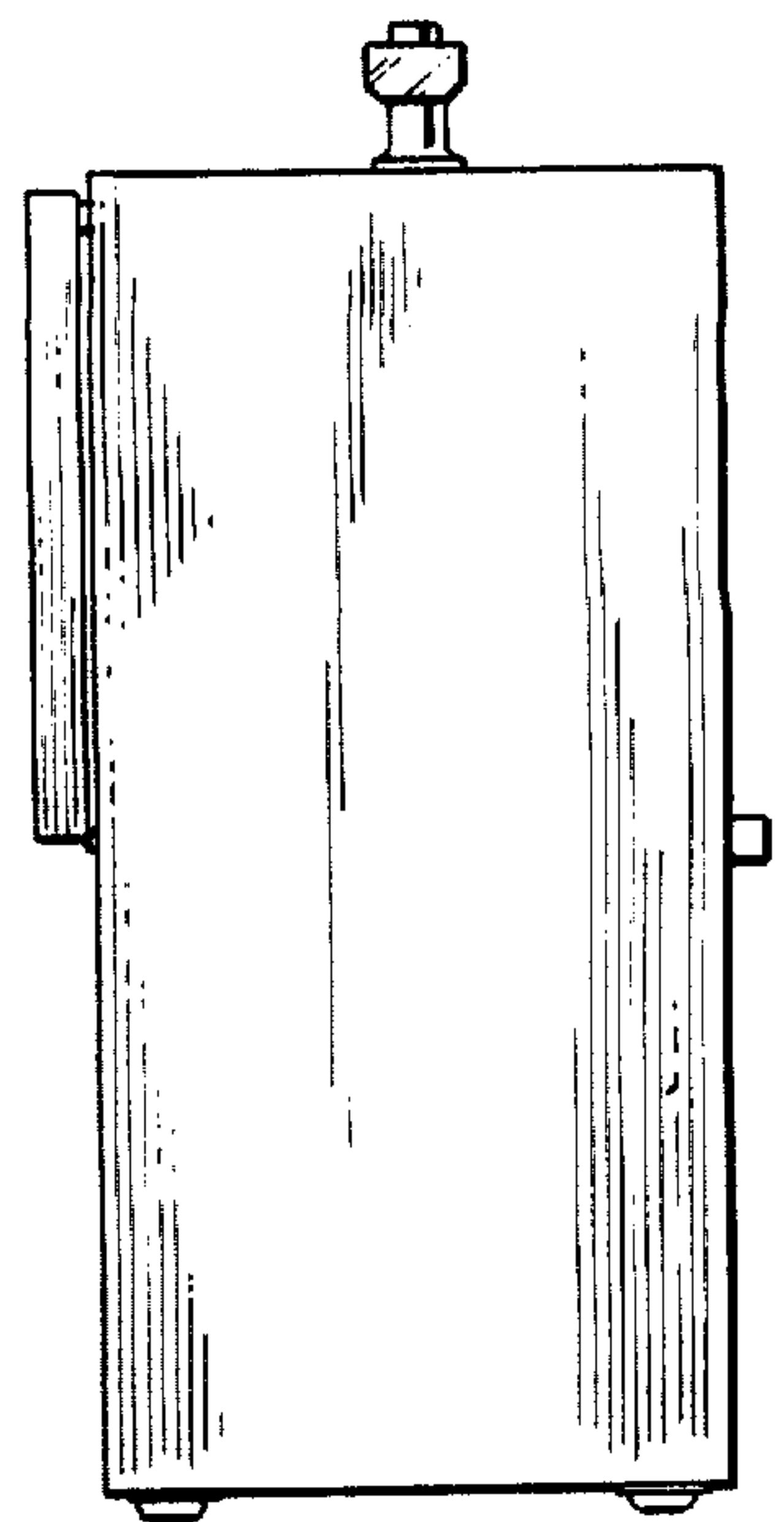

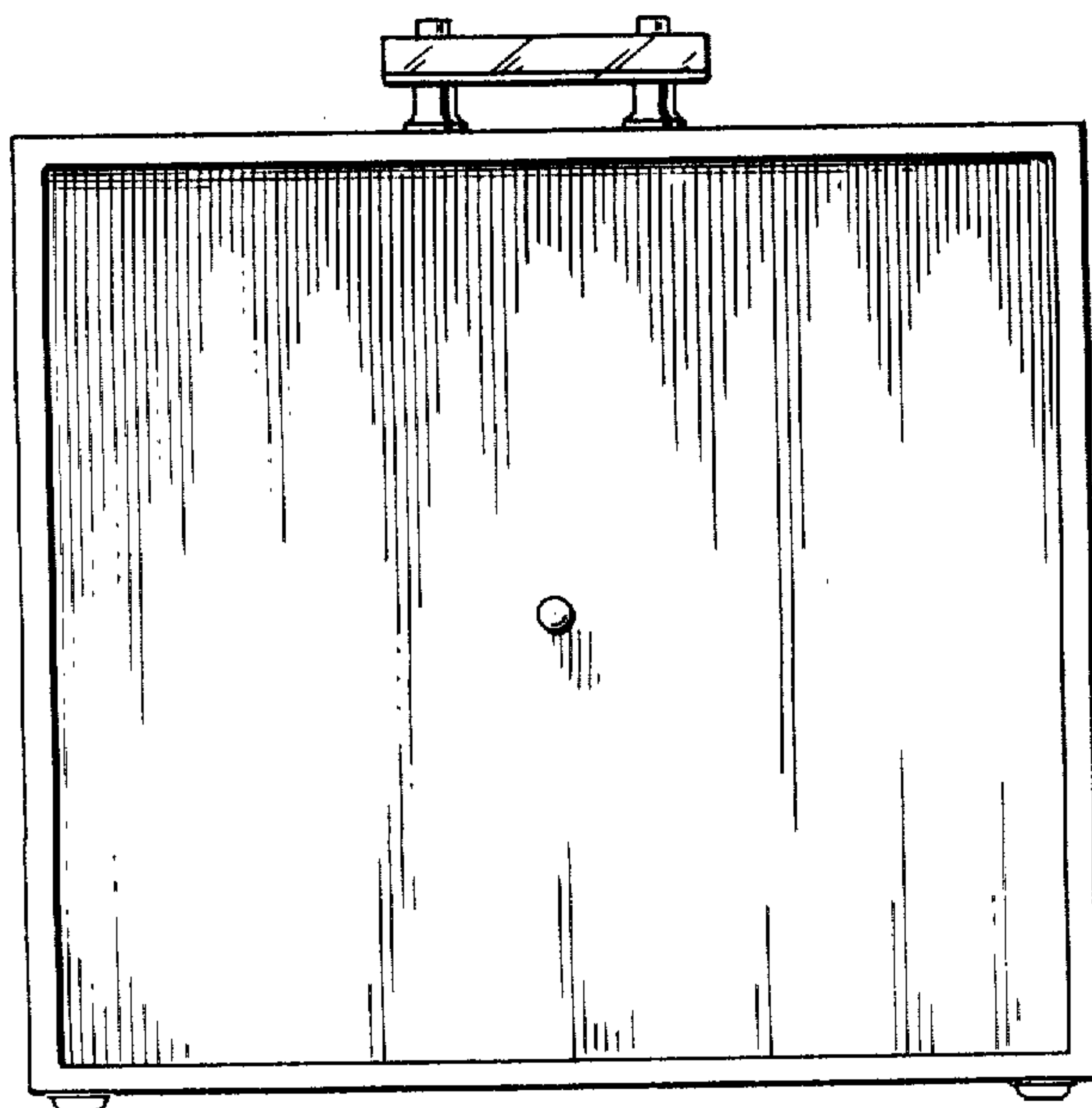

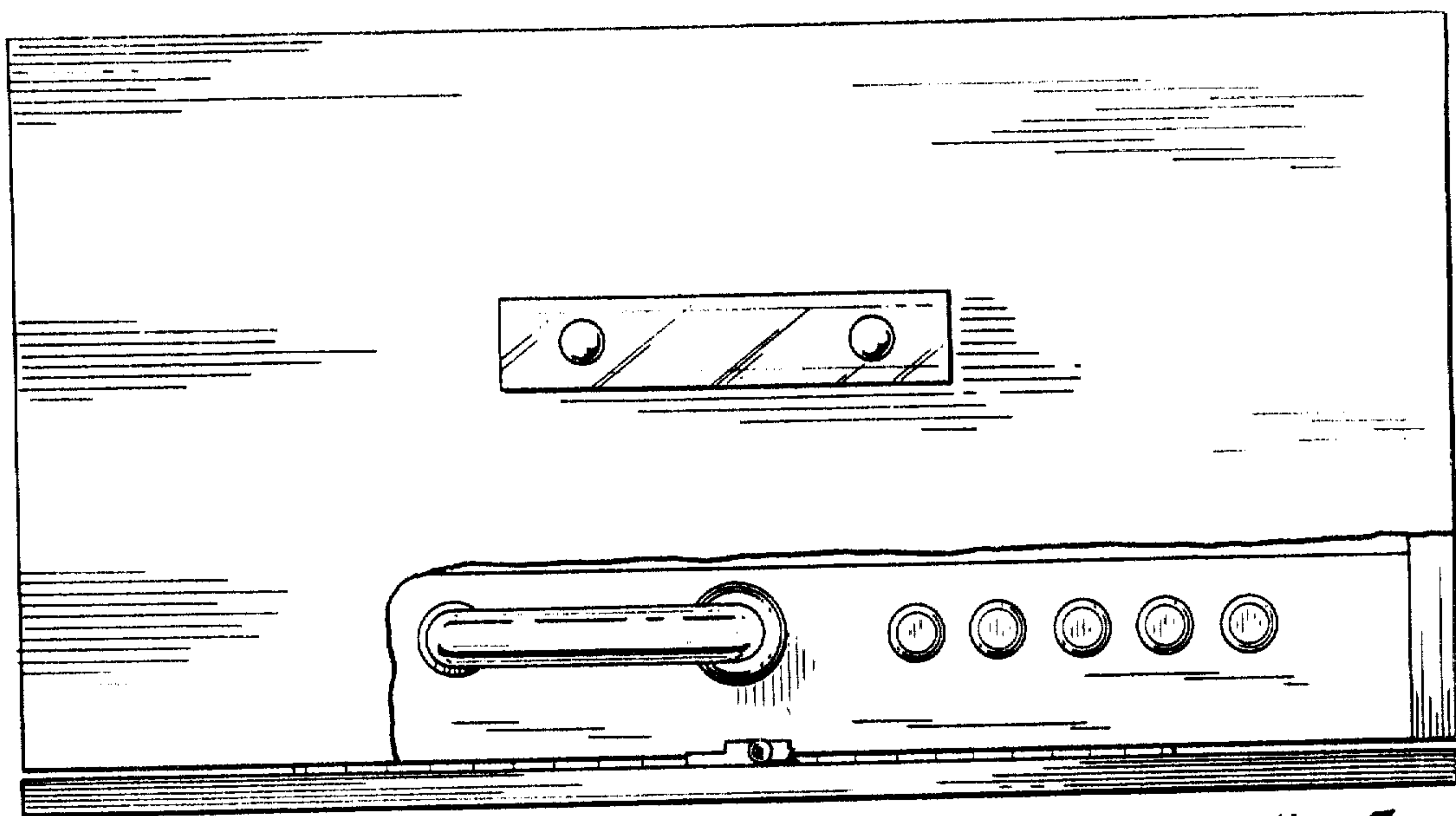
