DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a pendant embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the pendant of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the pendant of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a side elevation of the pendant of FIG. 1 taken from the left-hand side as shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a side elevation of the pendant opposite the side shown in FIG. 4; and
FIG. 6 is a rear view of the pendant of FIG. 1.
The broken line structure is shown for illustrative purposes only.

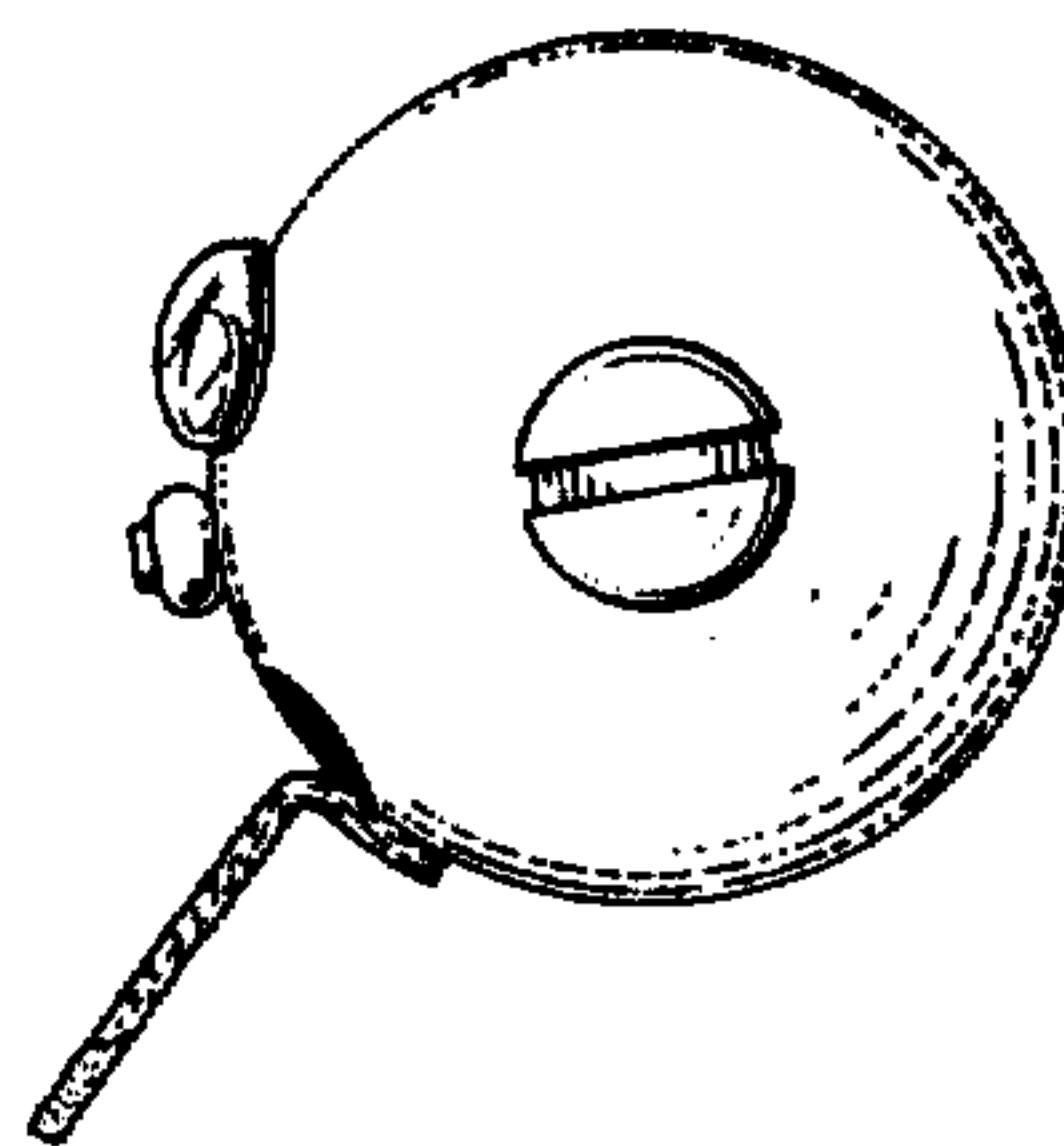
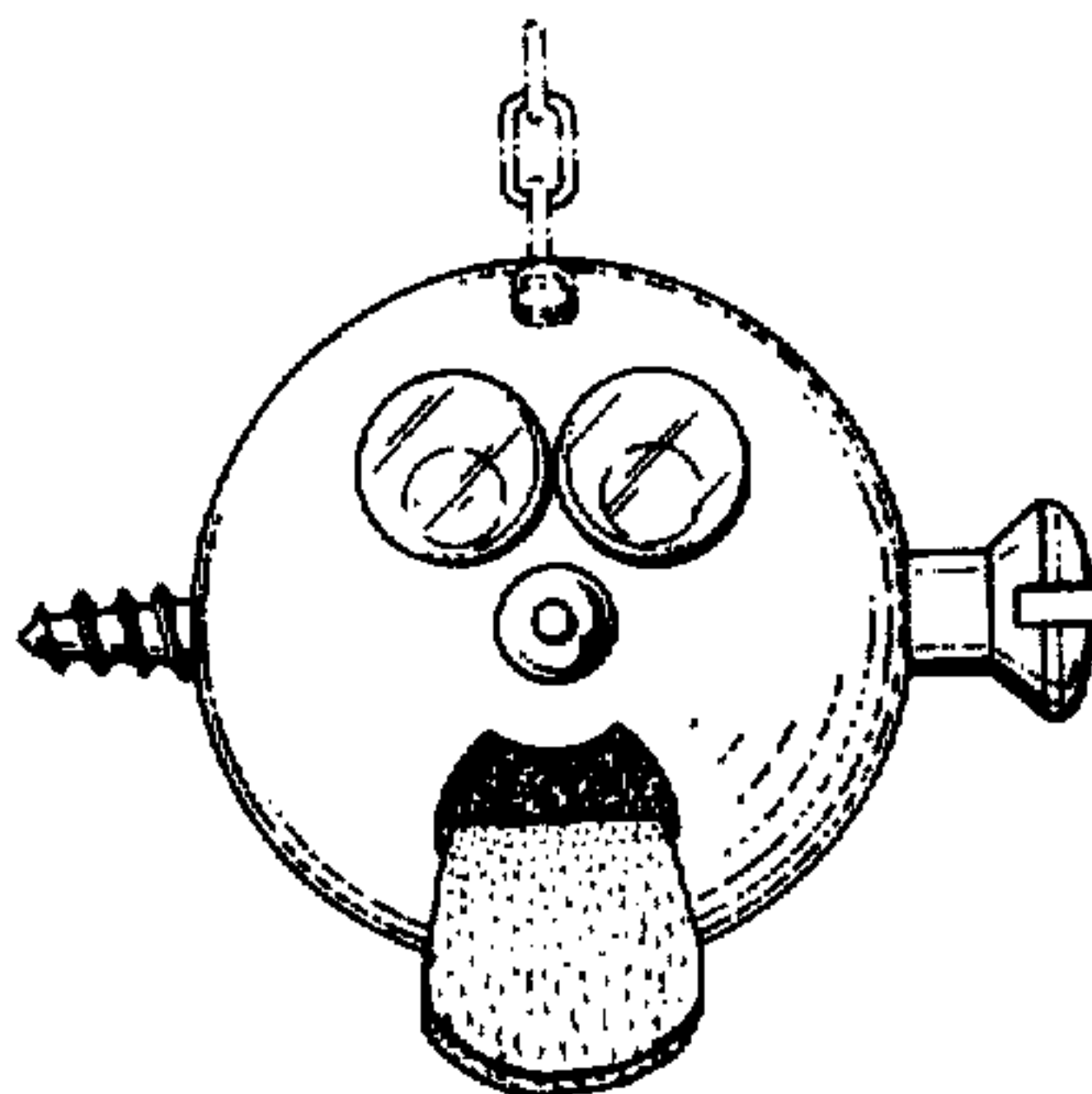

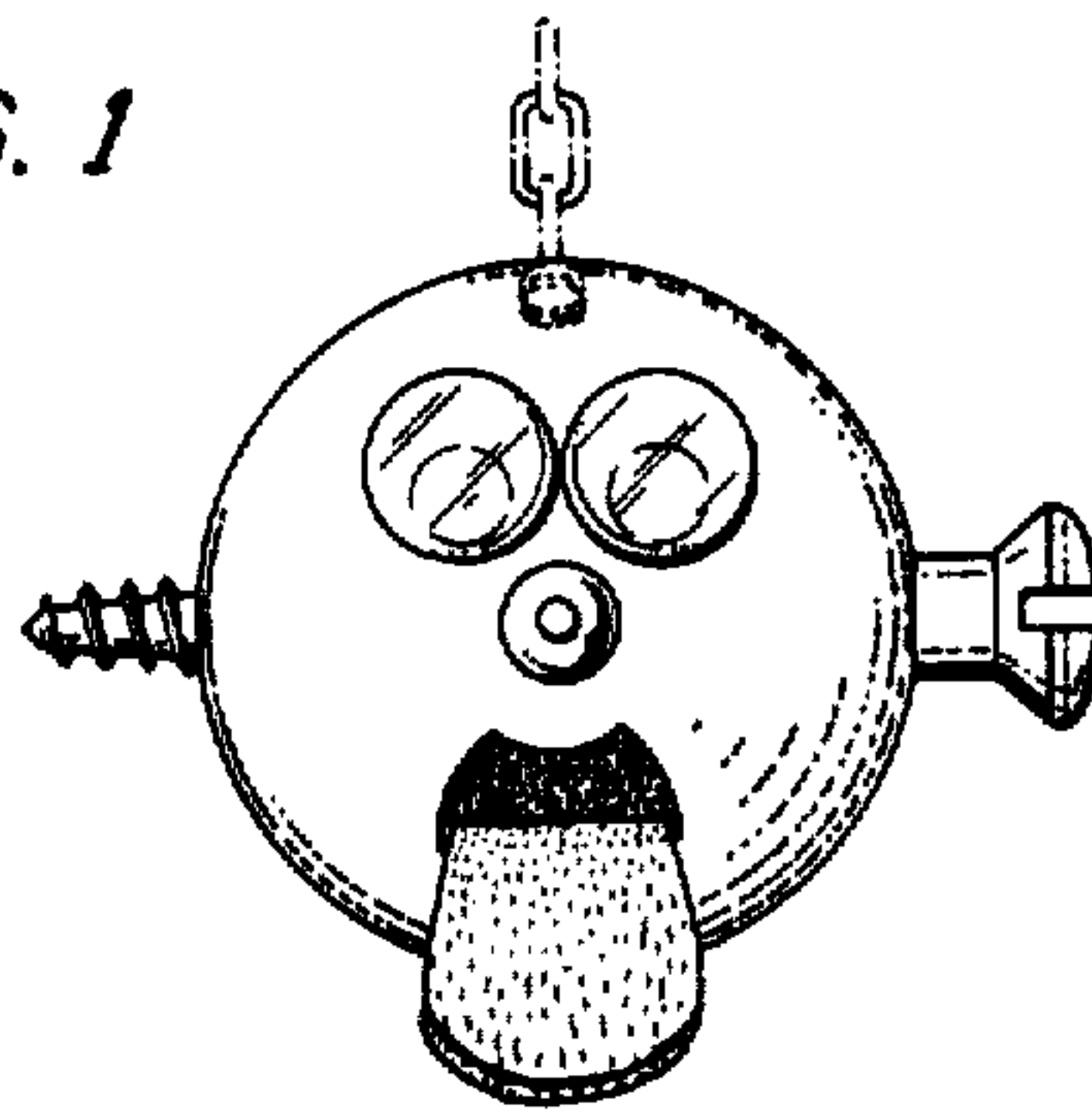

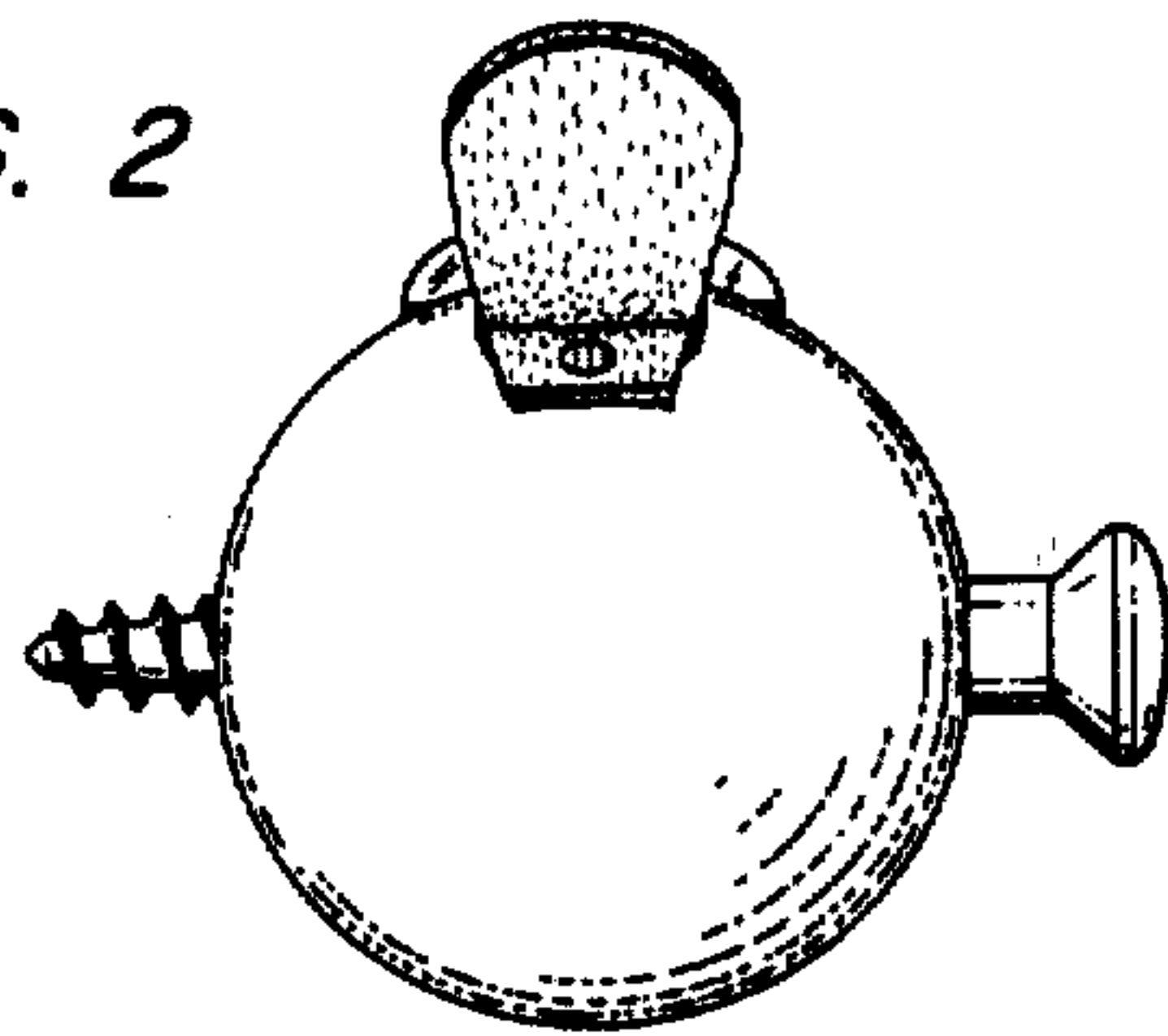

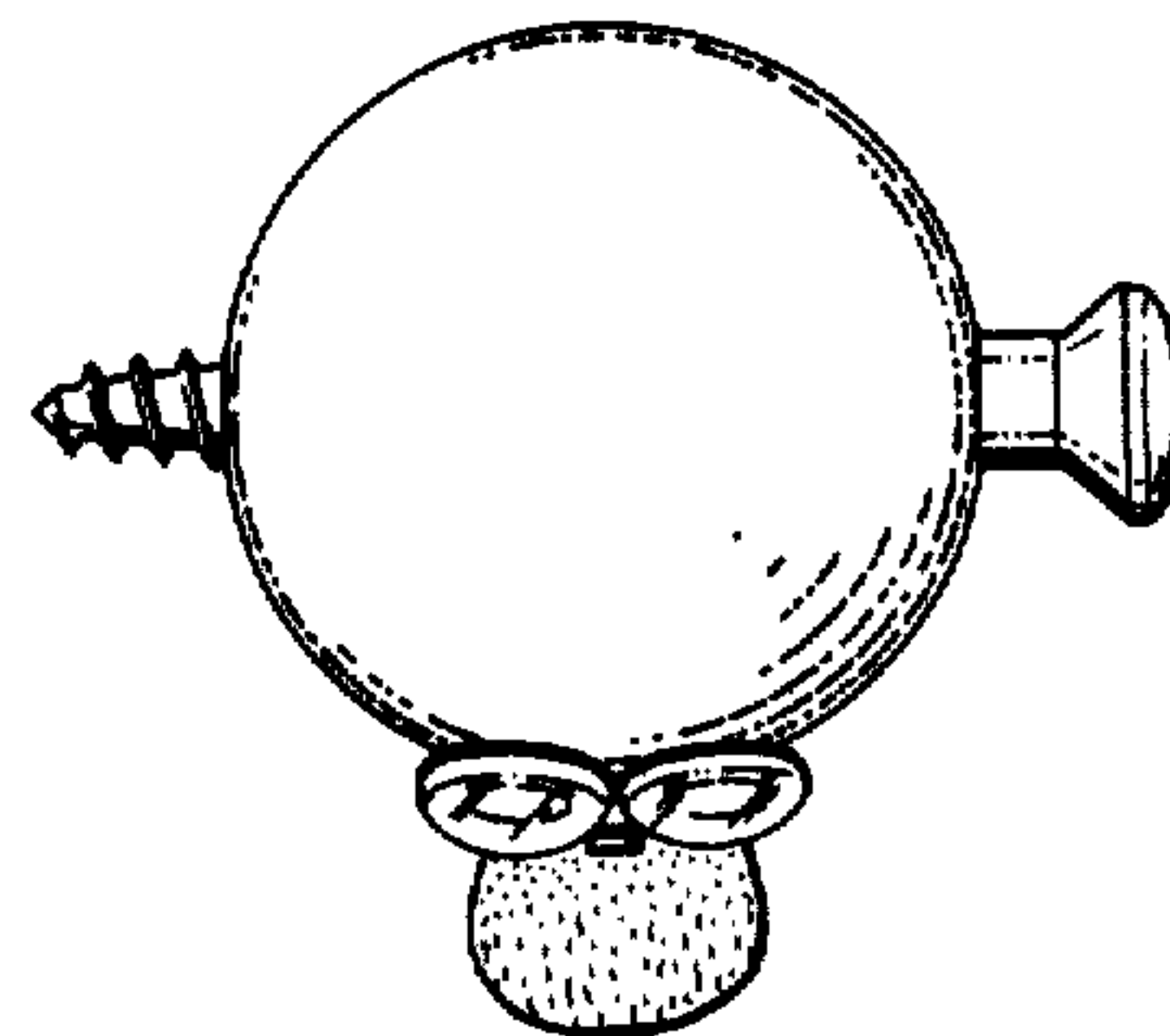

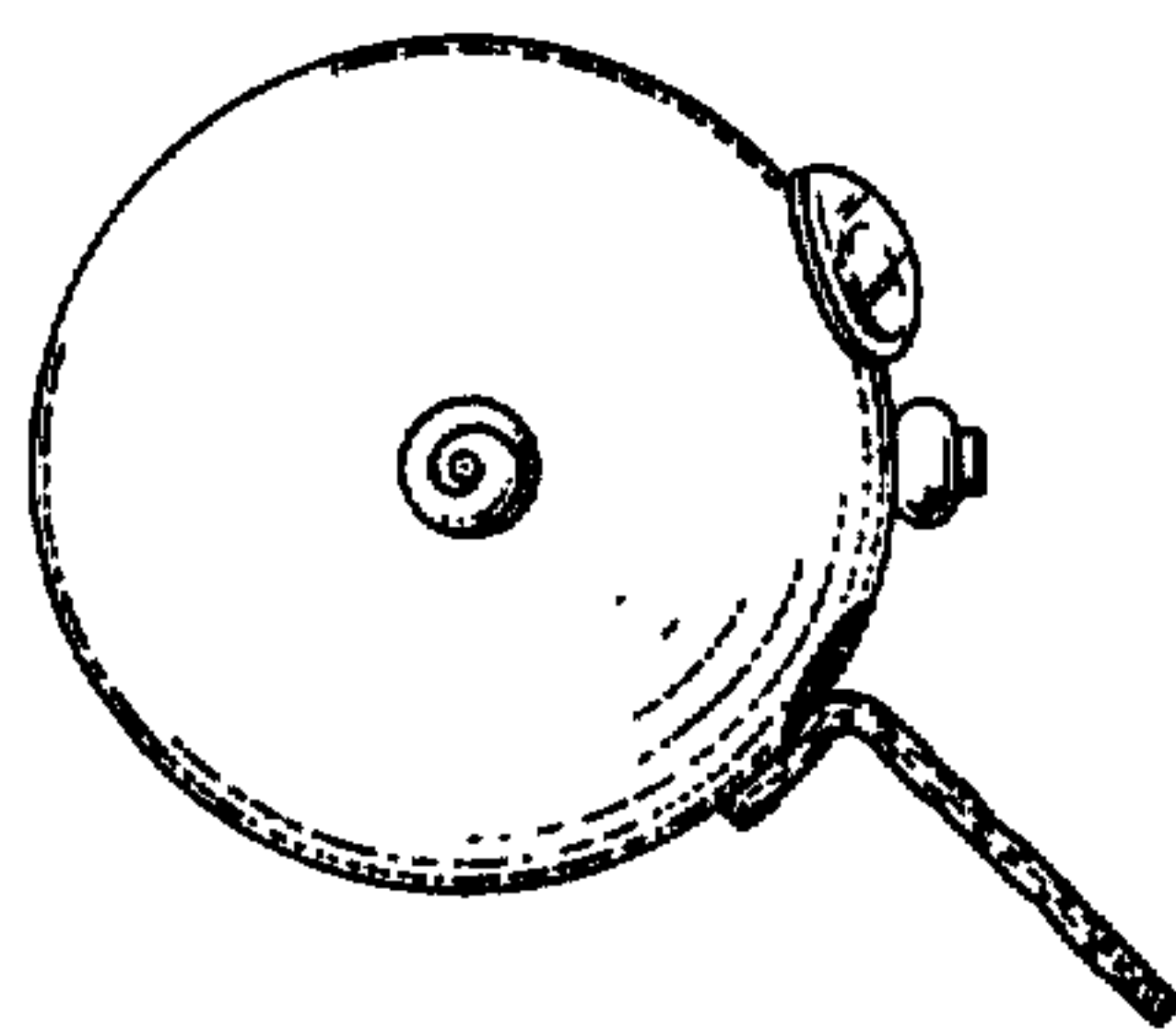

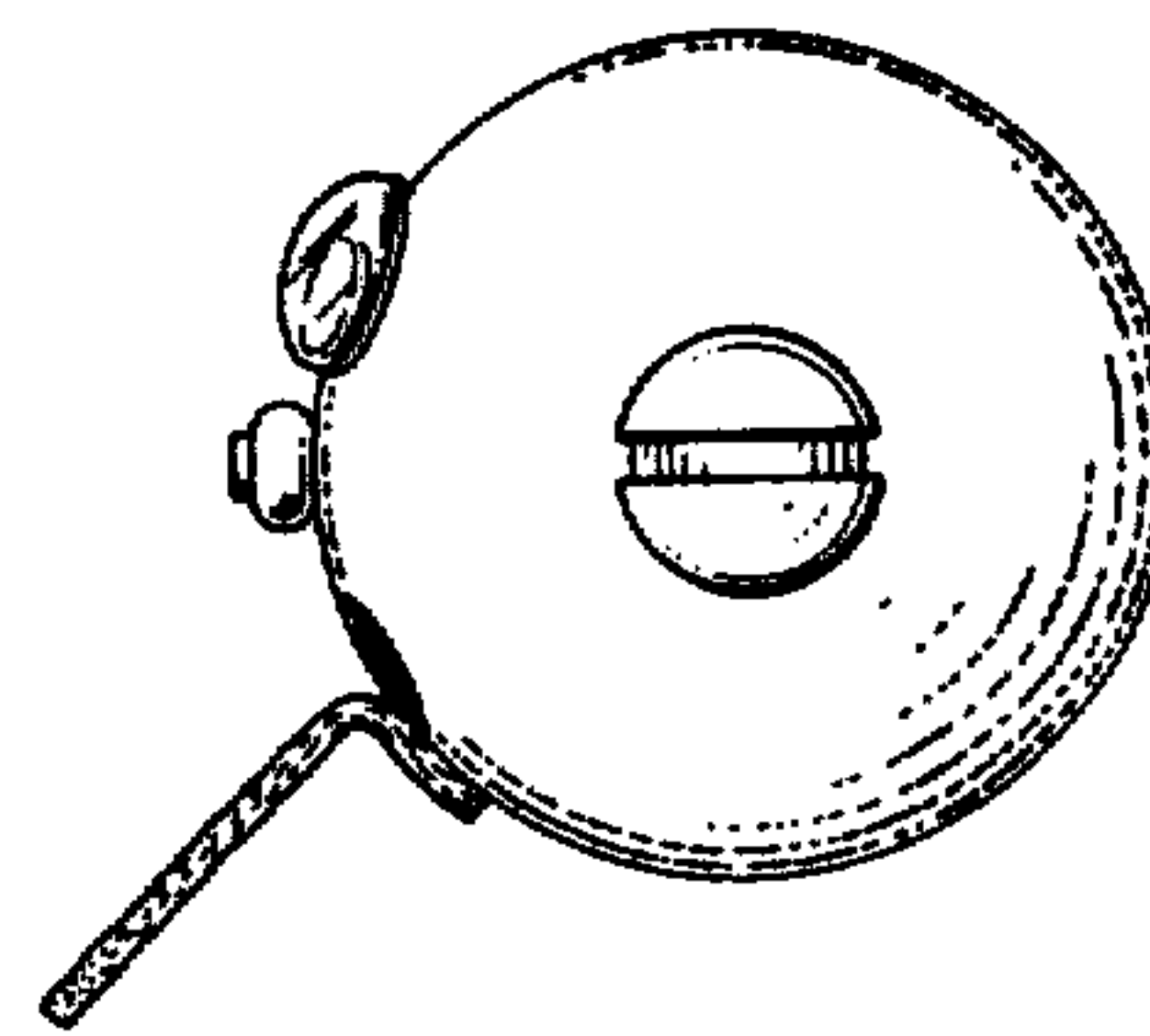
