The ornamental design for a belt mounted accessory bag or the like, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a belt mounted accessory bag or the like showing my new design;

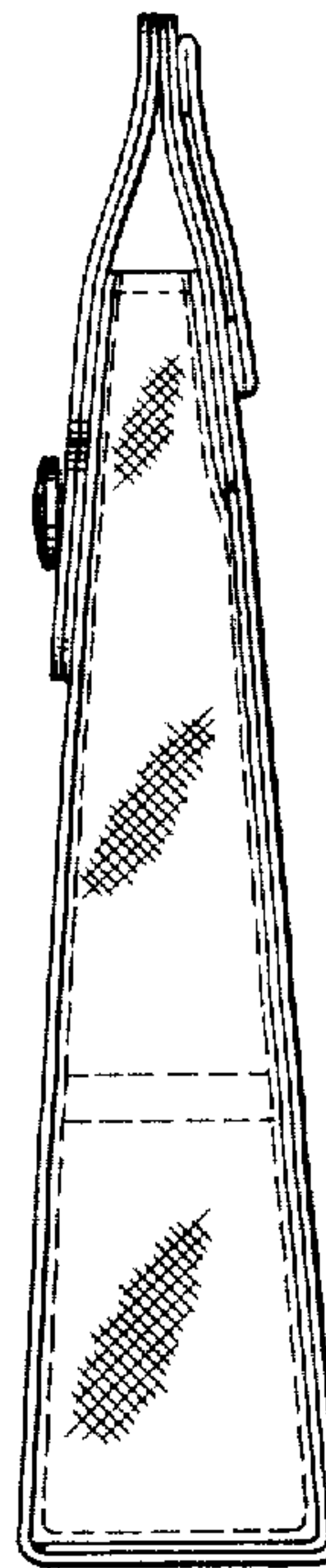
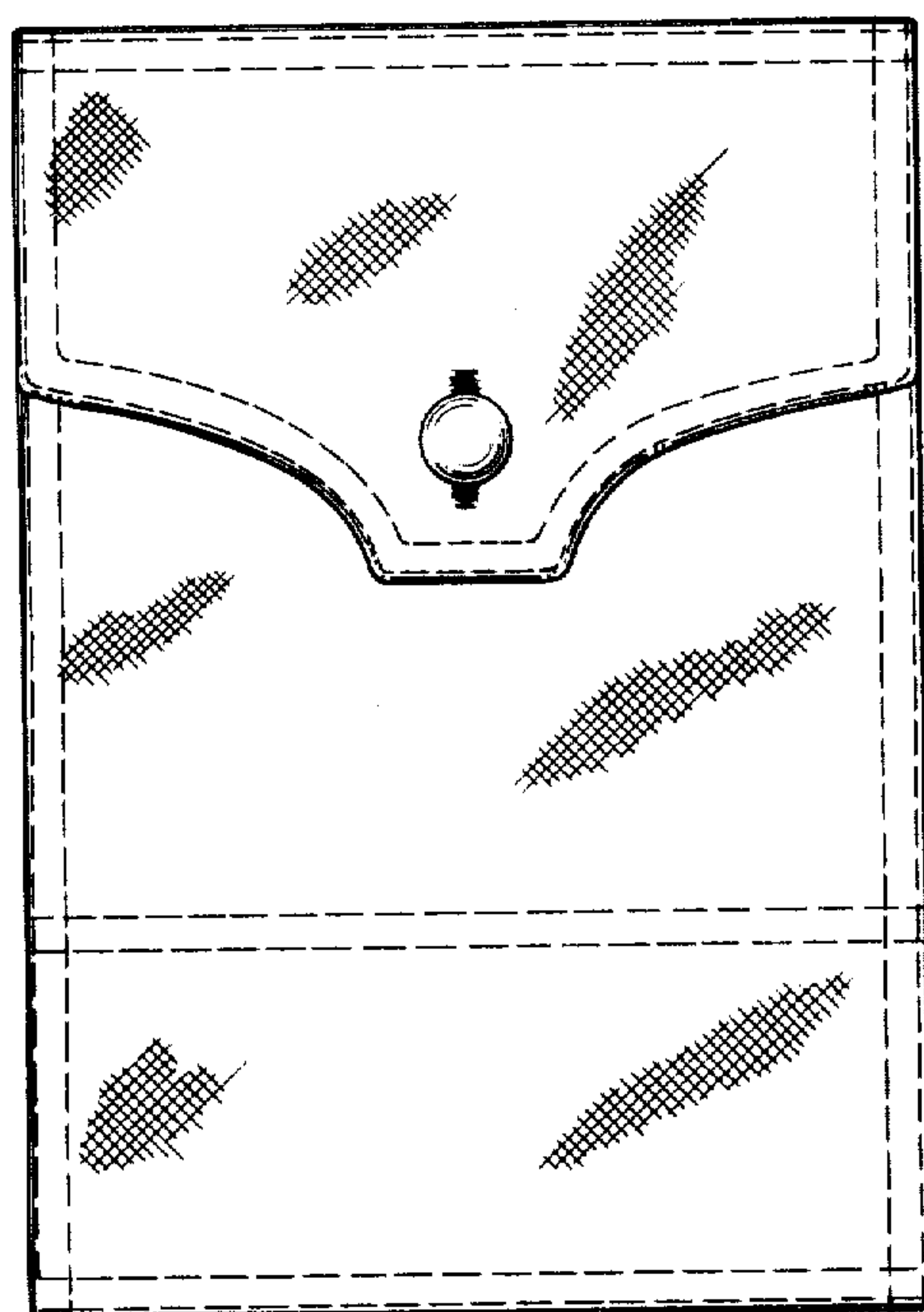
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

The broken lines on the bag indicate stitching.



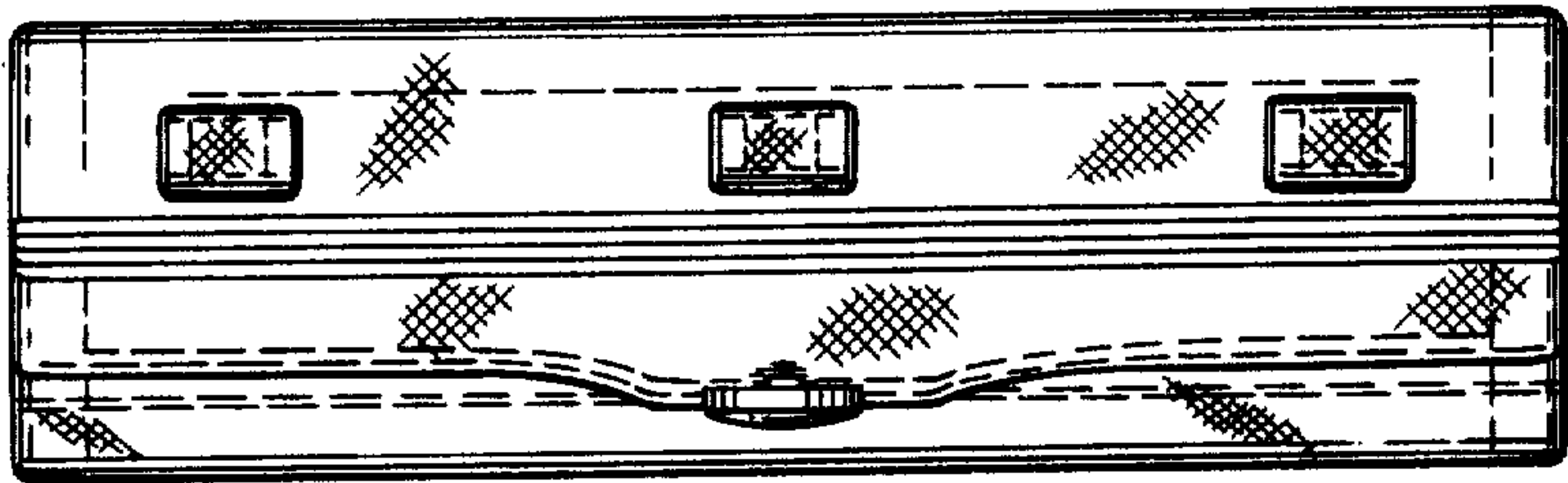

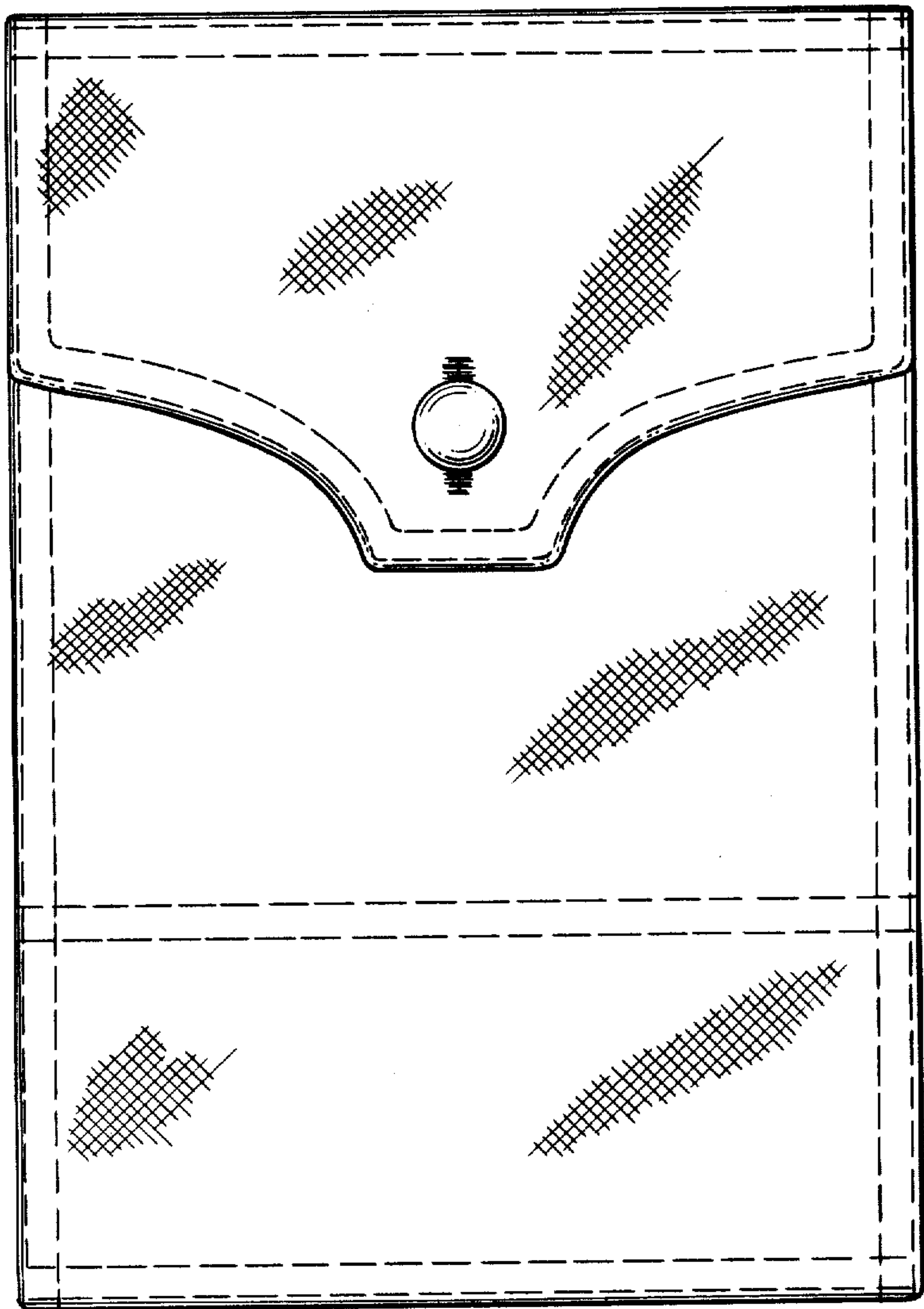

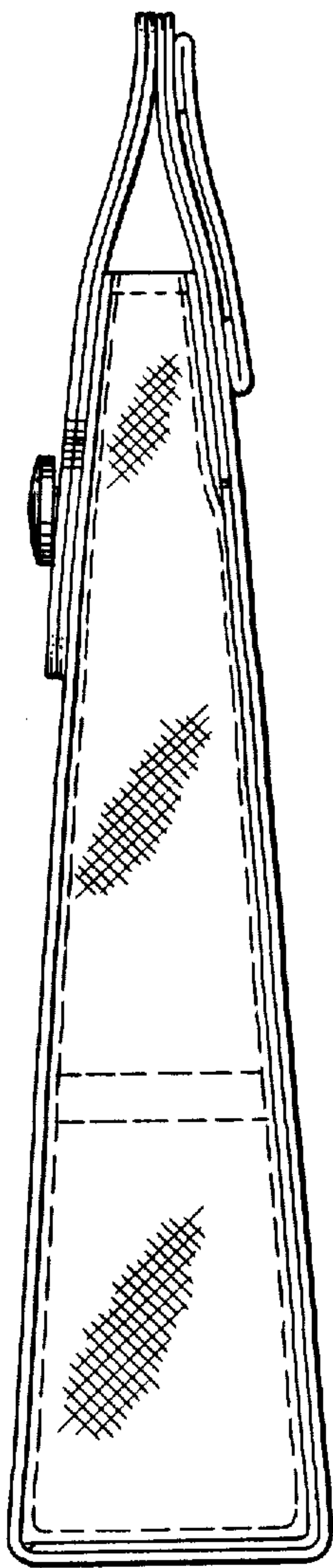

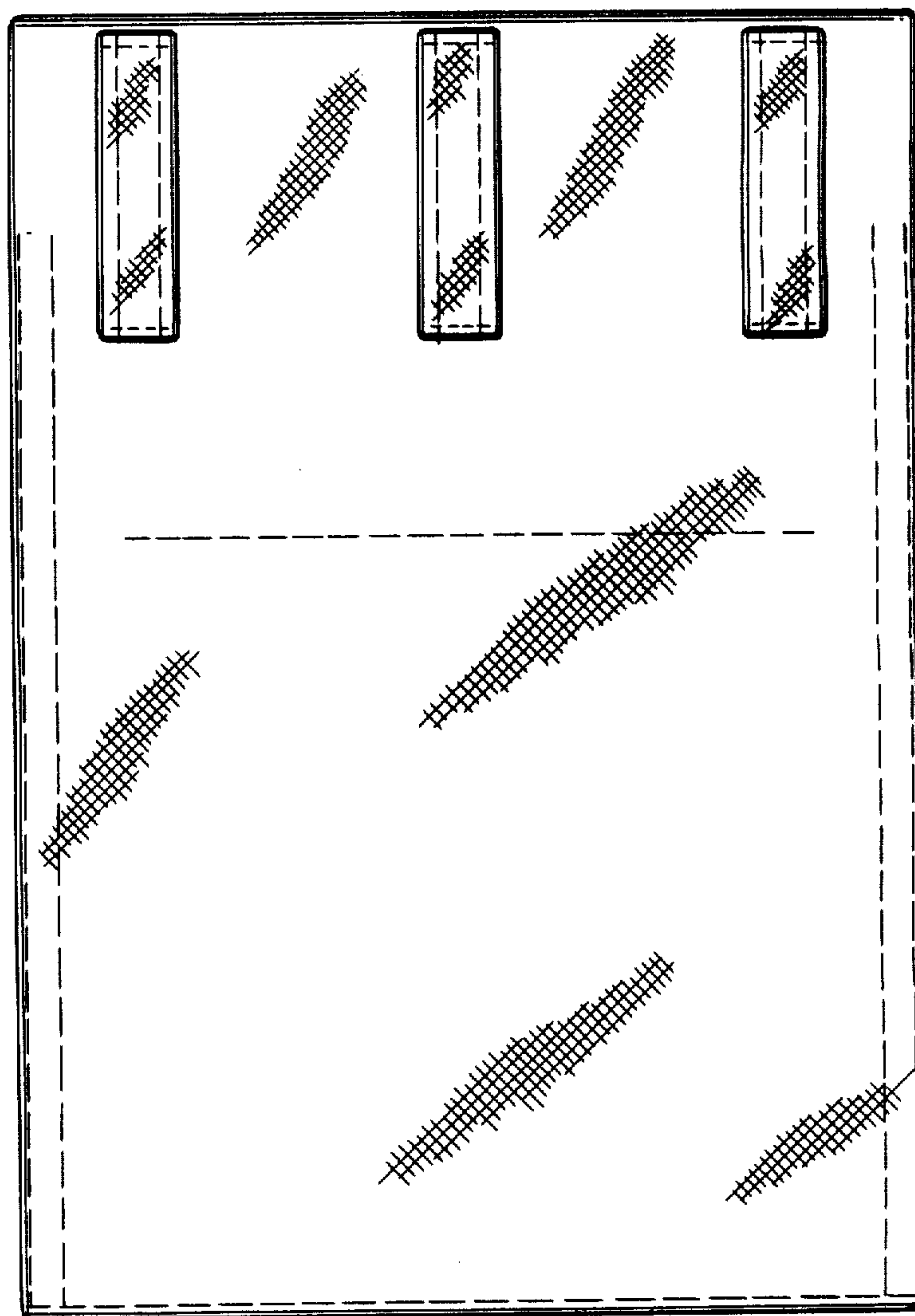
