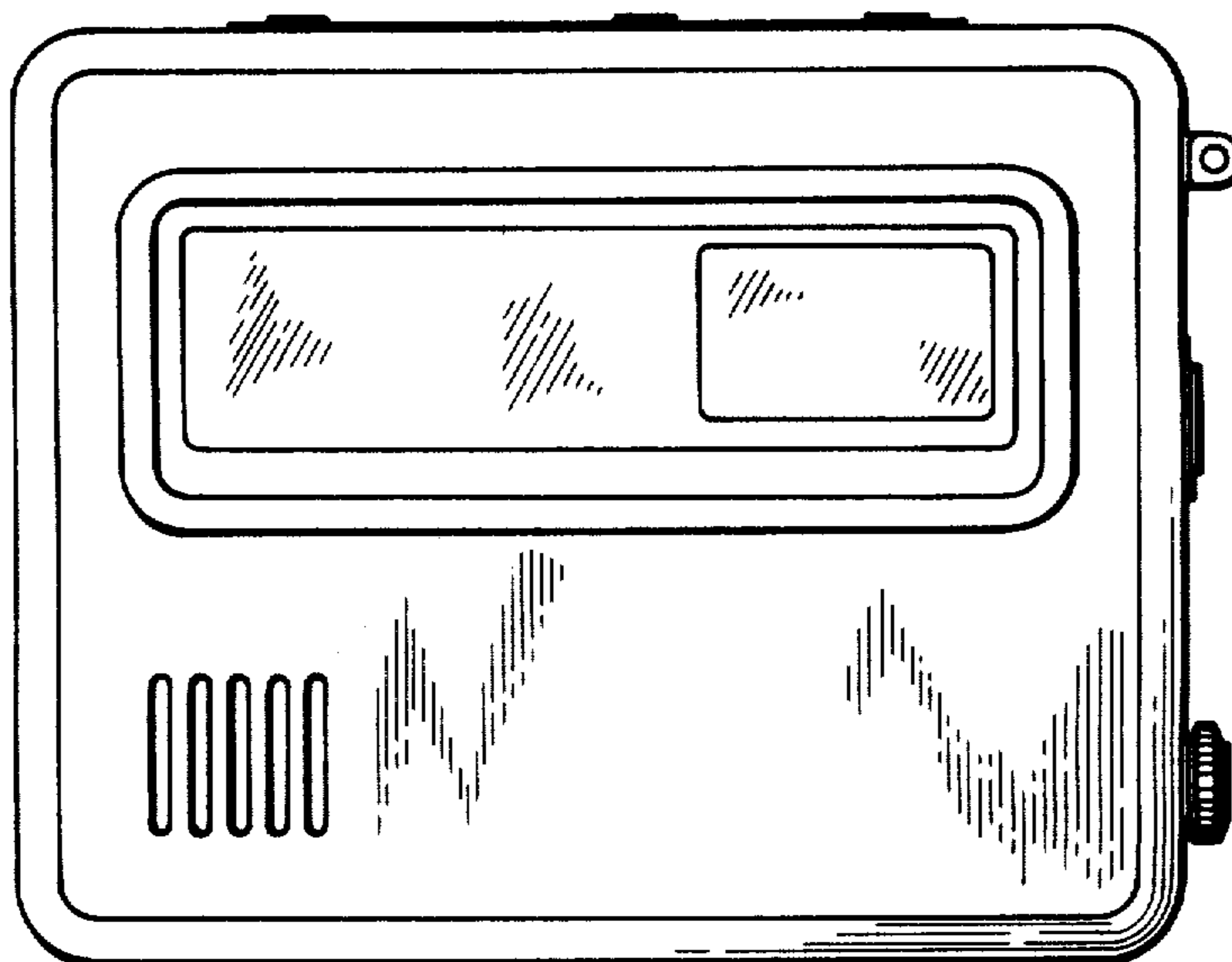

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a pocket clock showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.



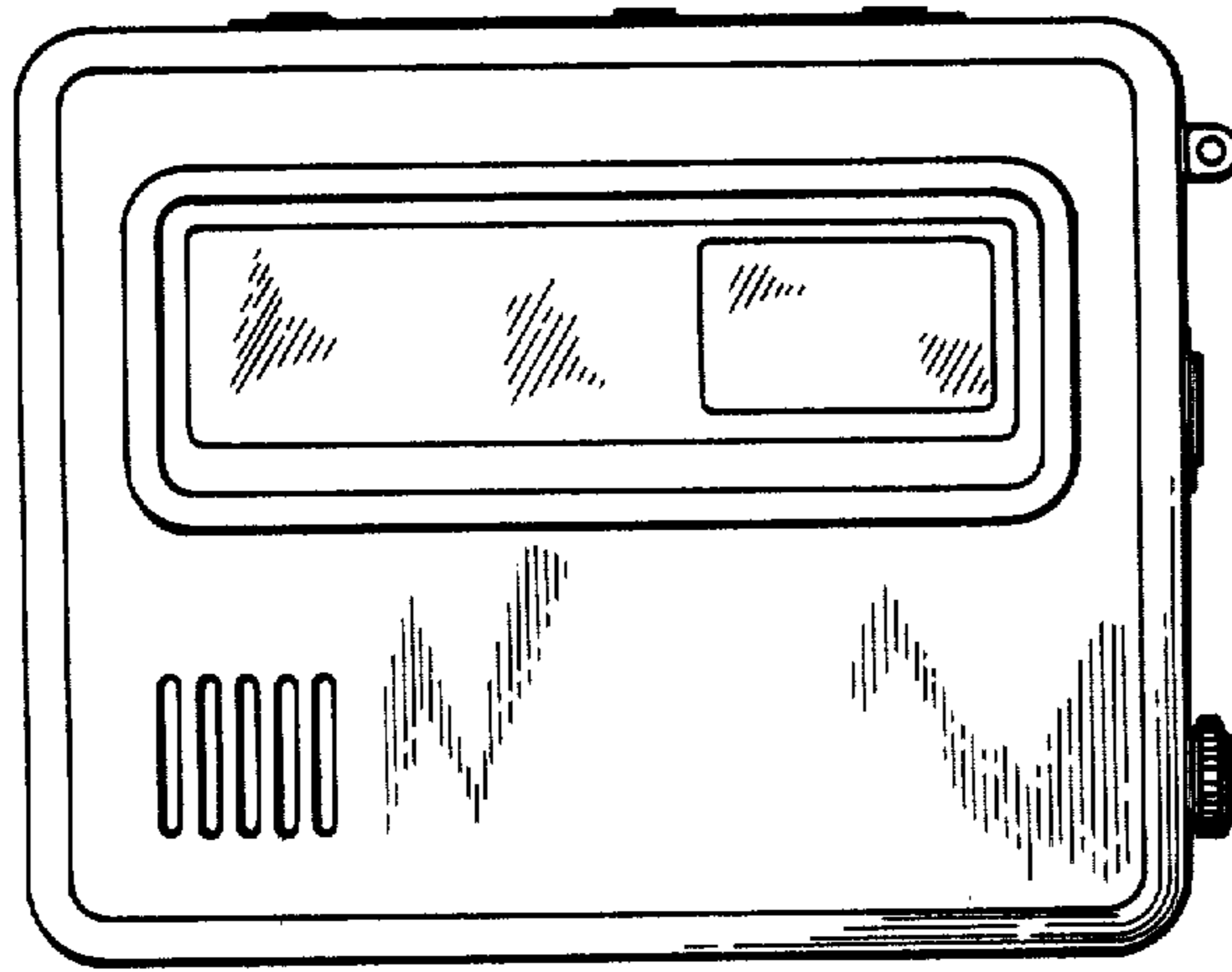

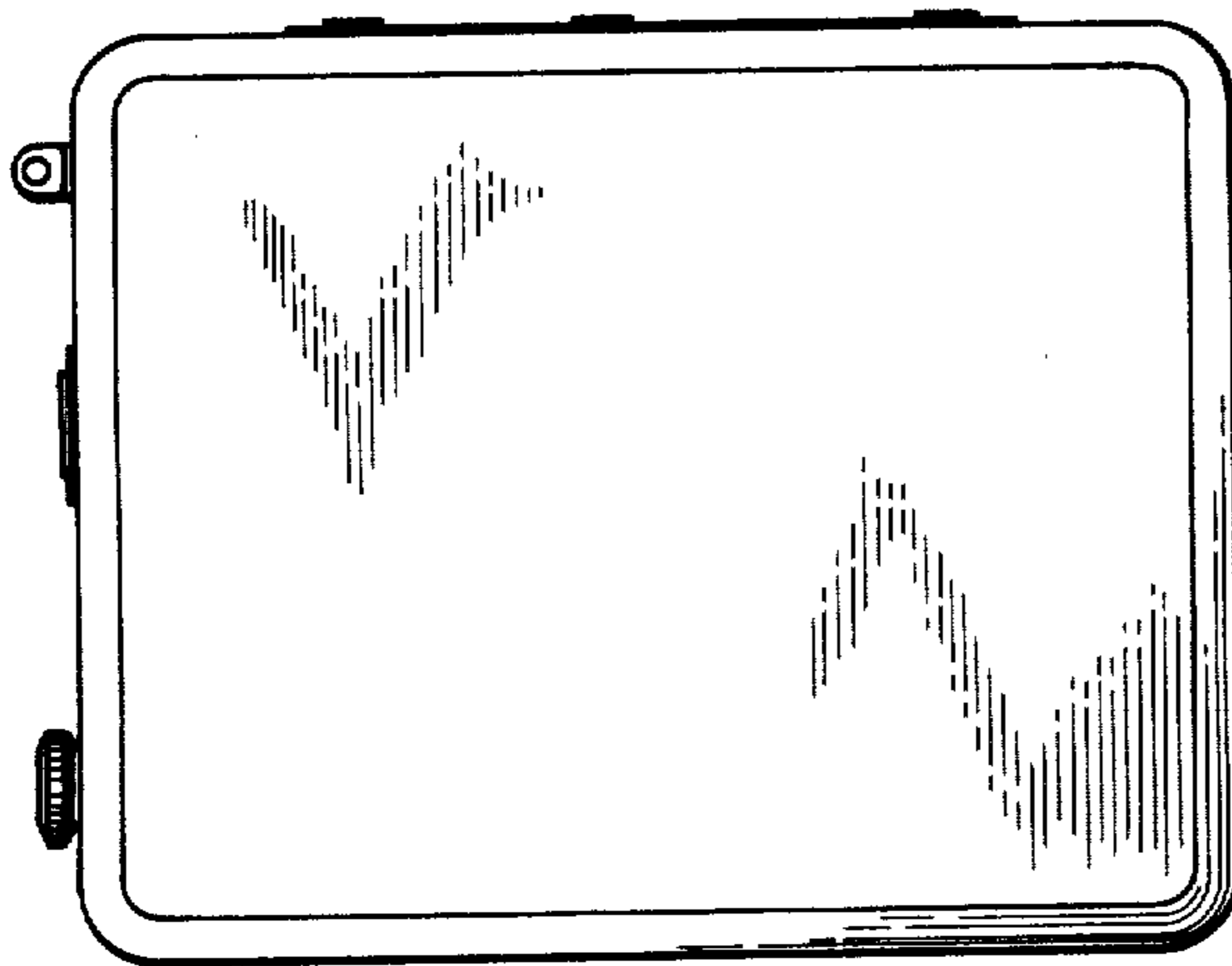

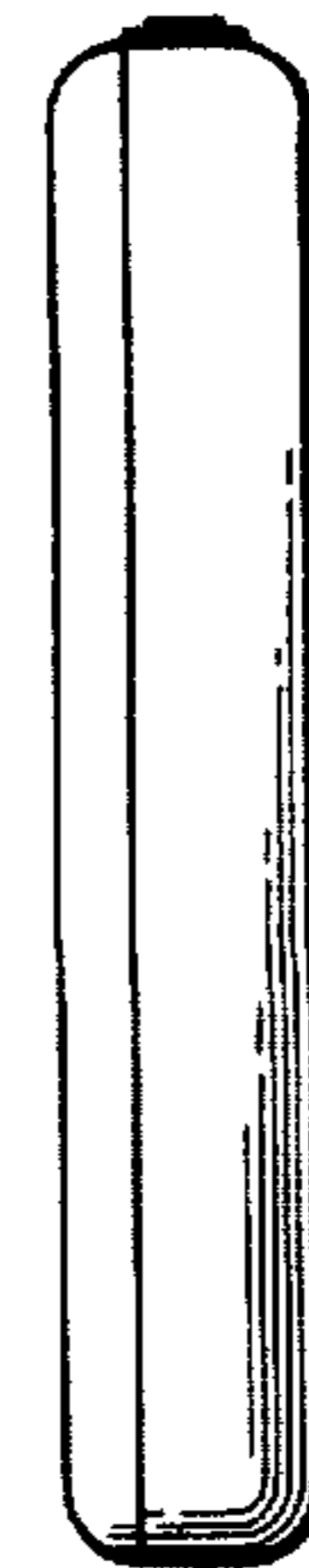

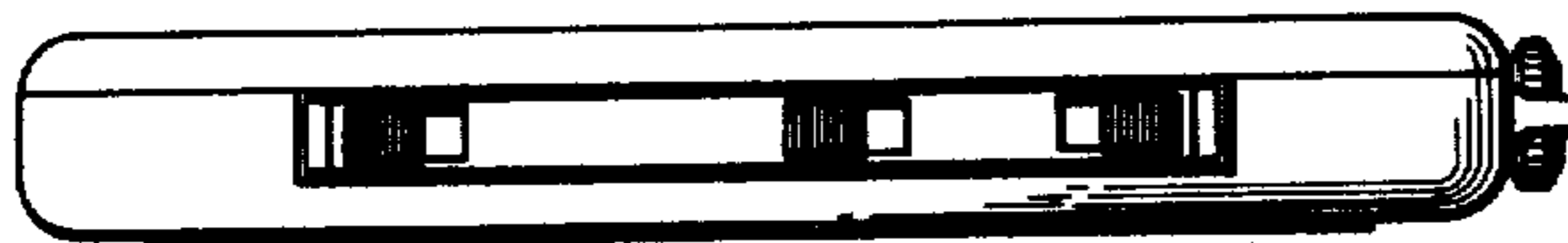

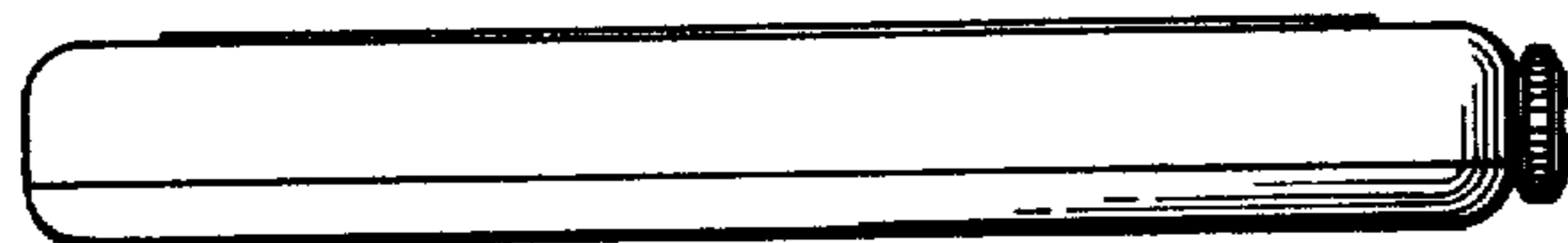
