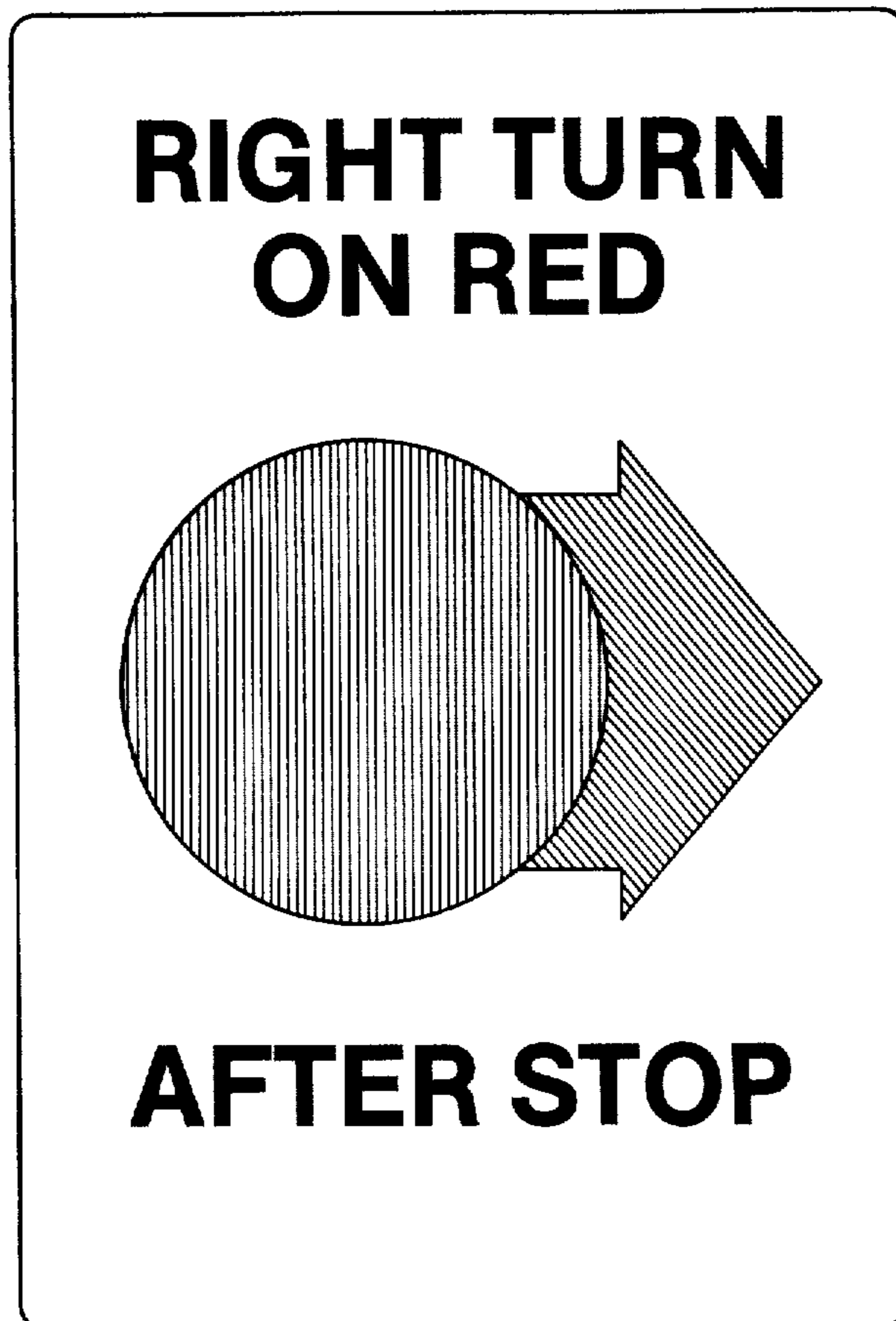
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a traffic sign, as shown and described.

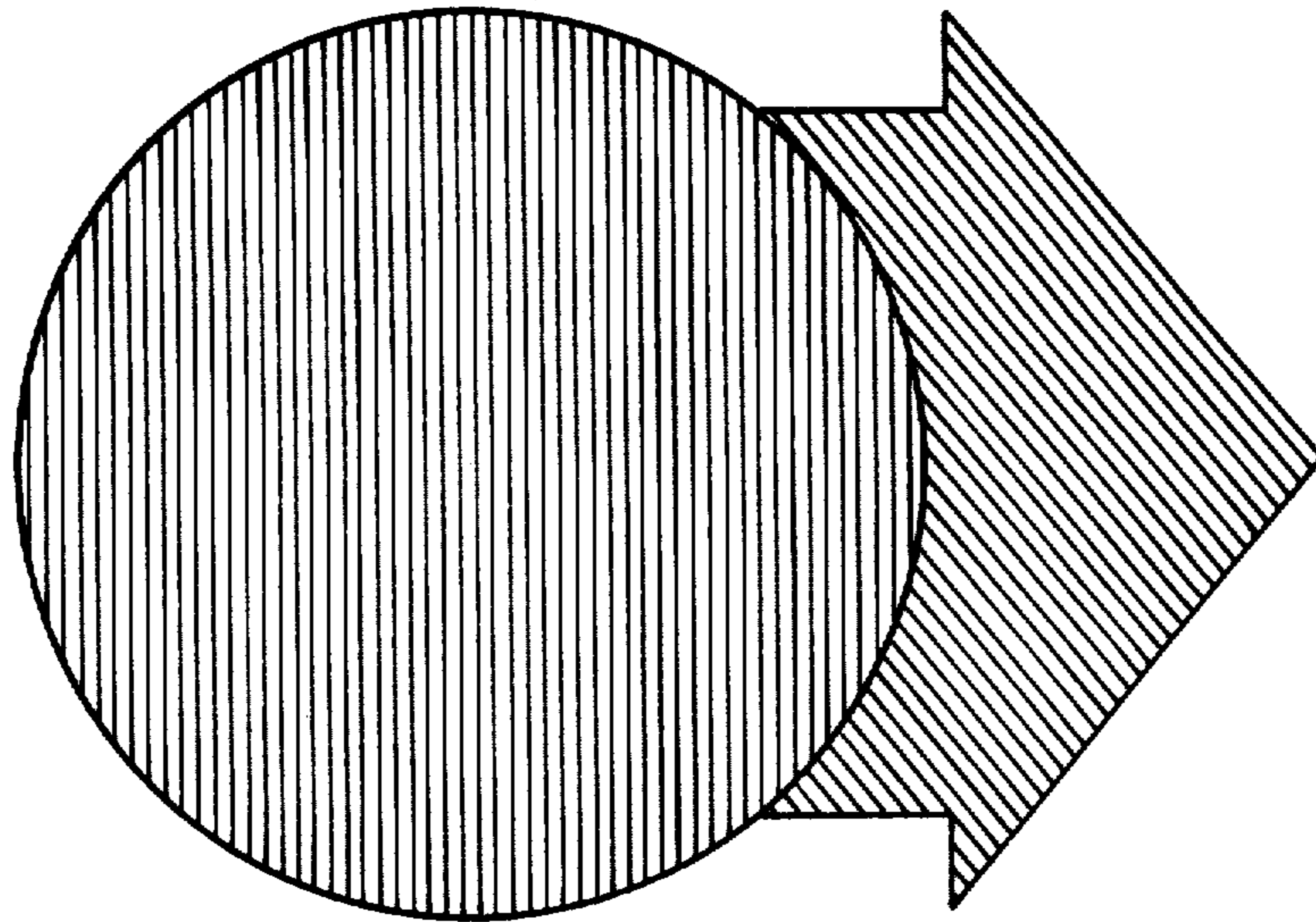
DESCRIPTION
