DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a combined radio receiver and tape recorder showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear, bottom and left side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof.

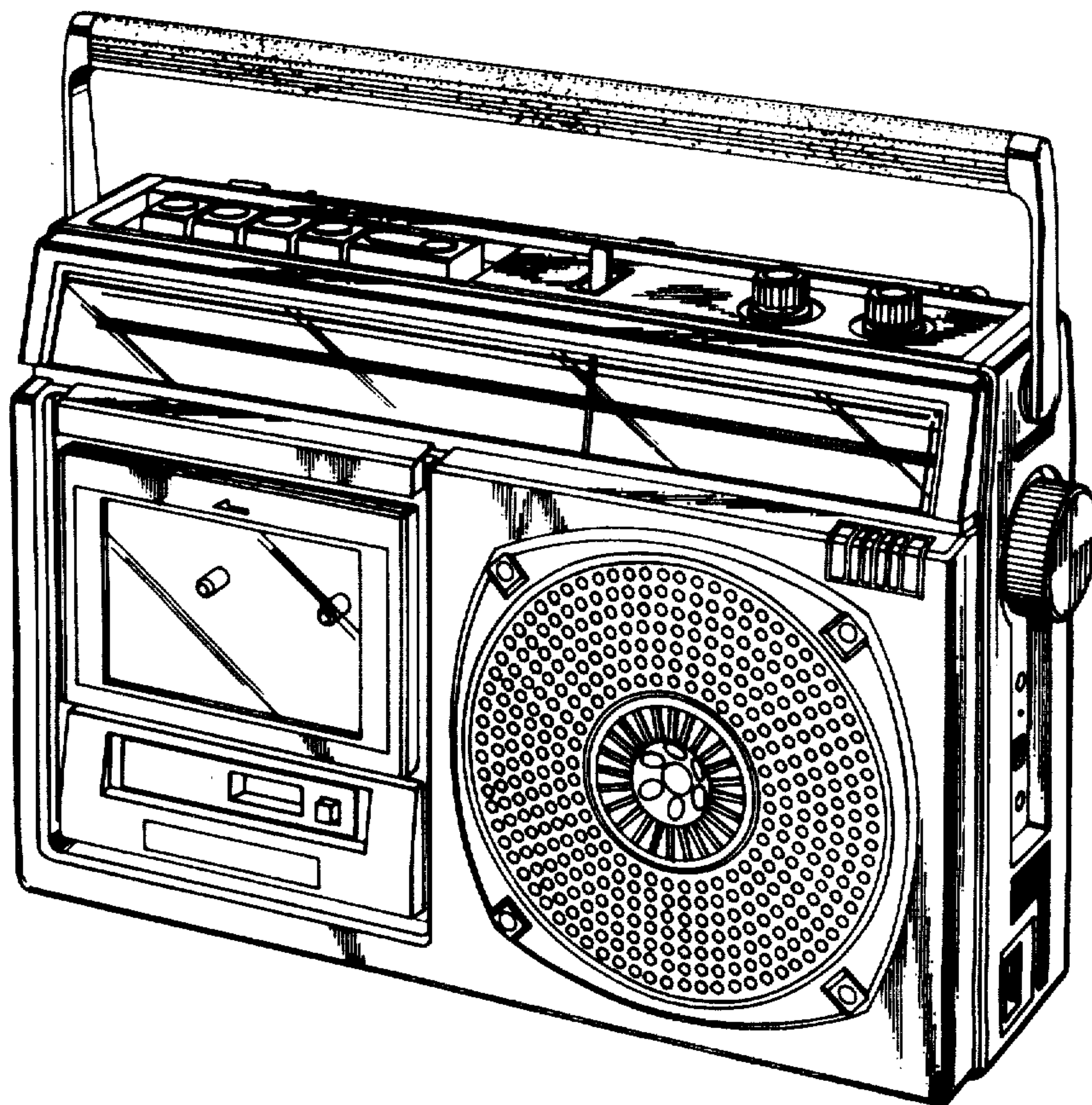

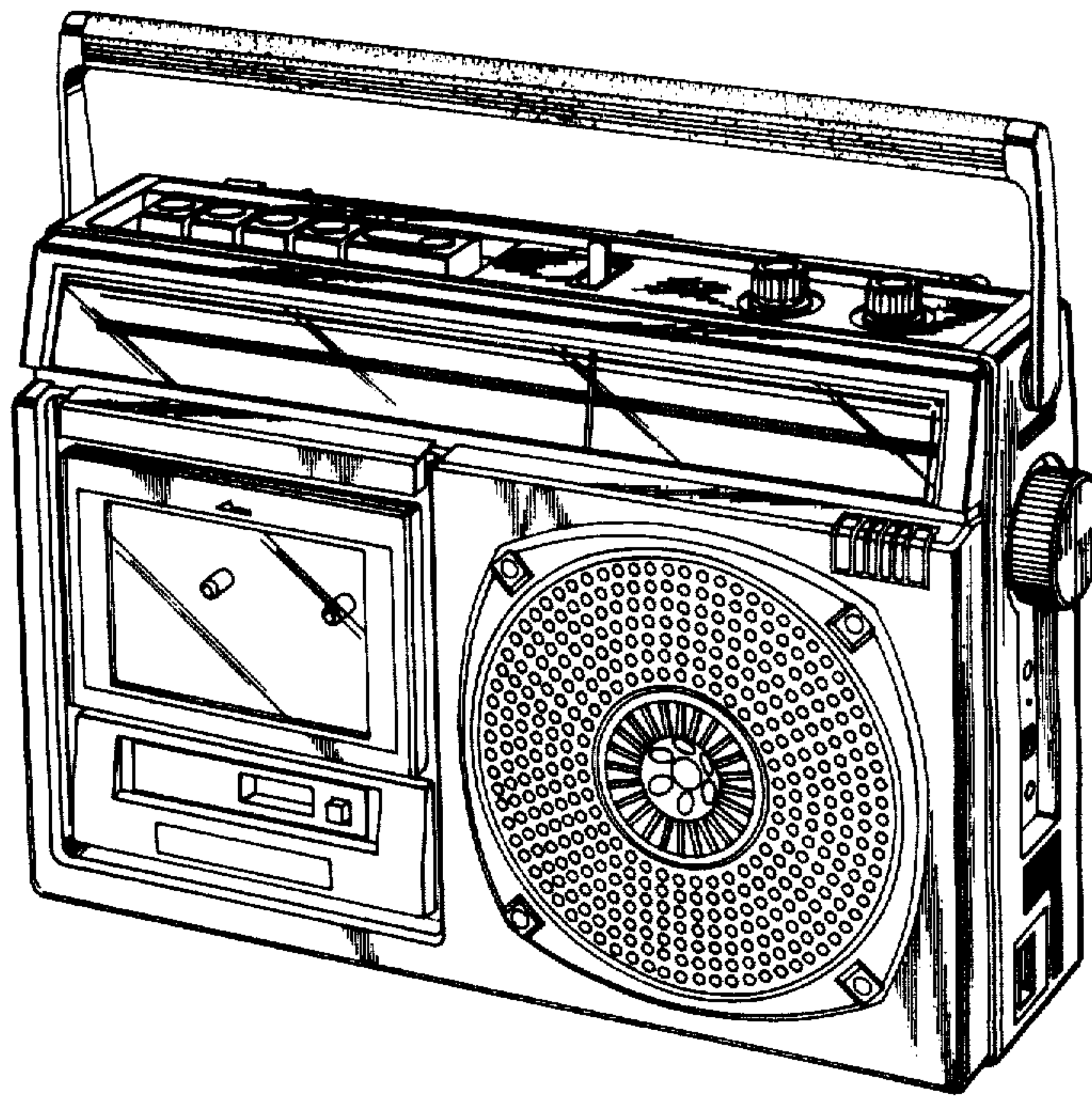

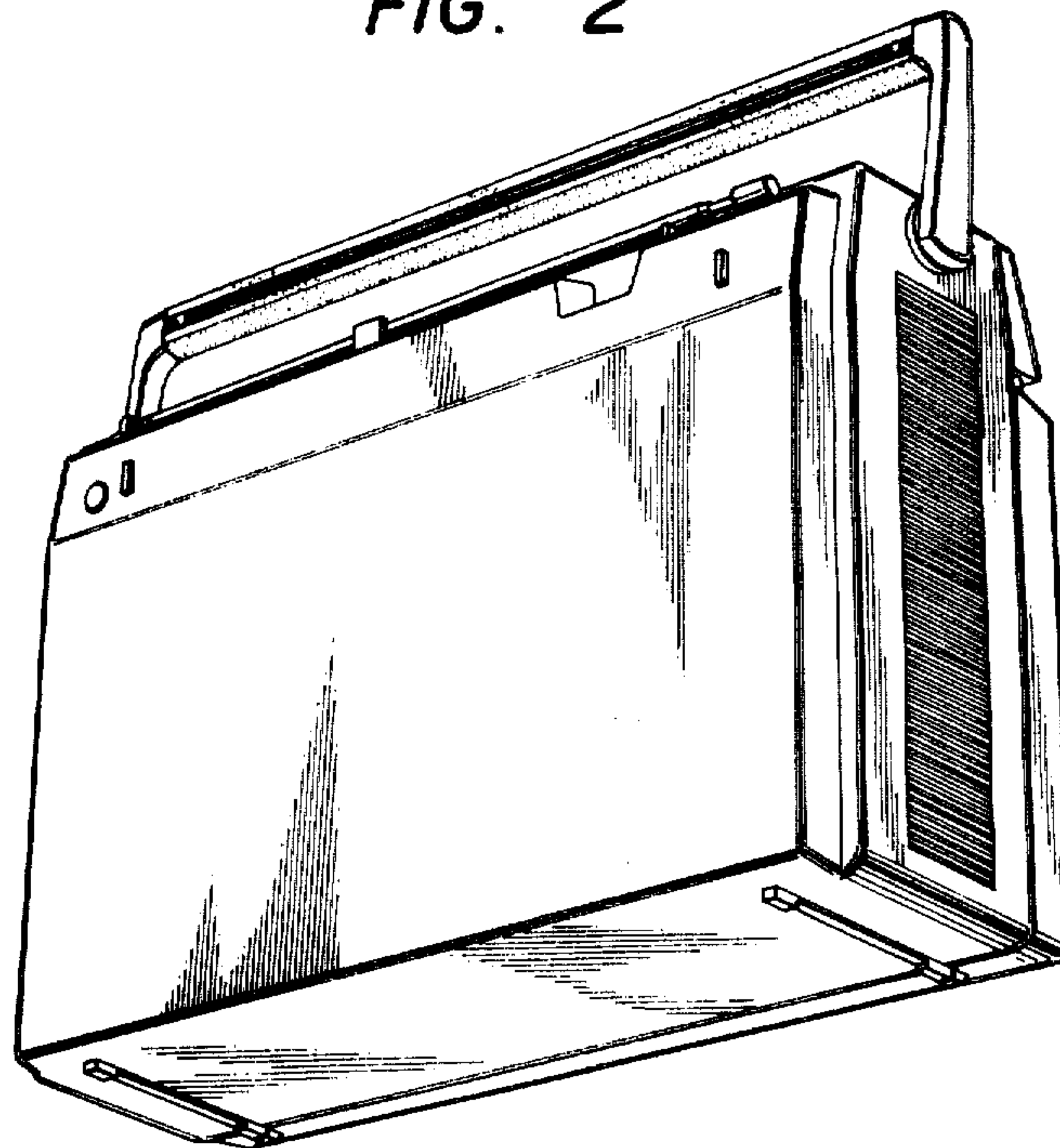

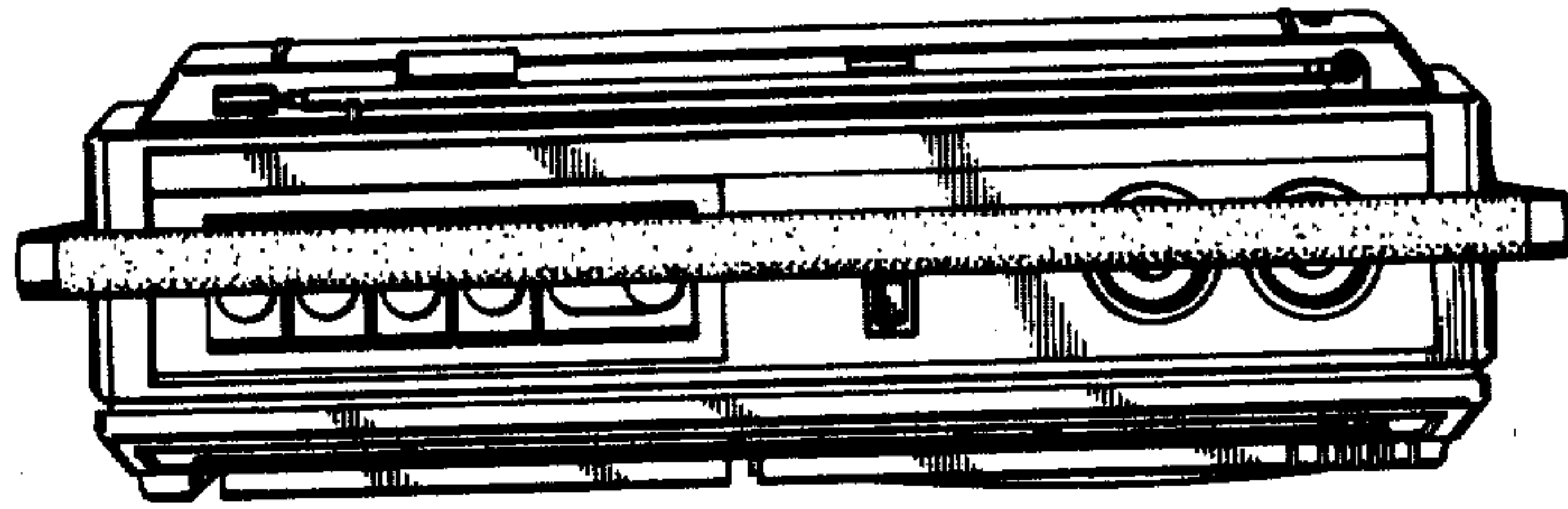
