DESCRIPTION

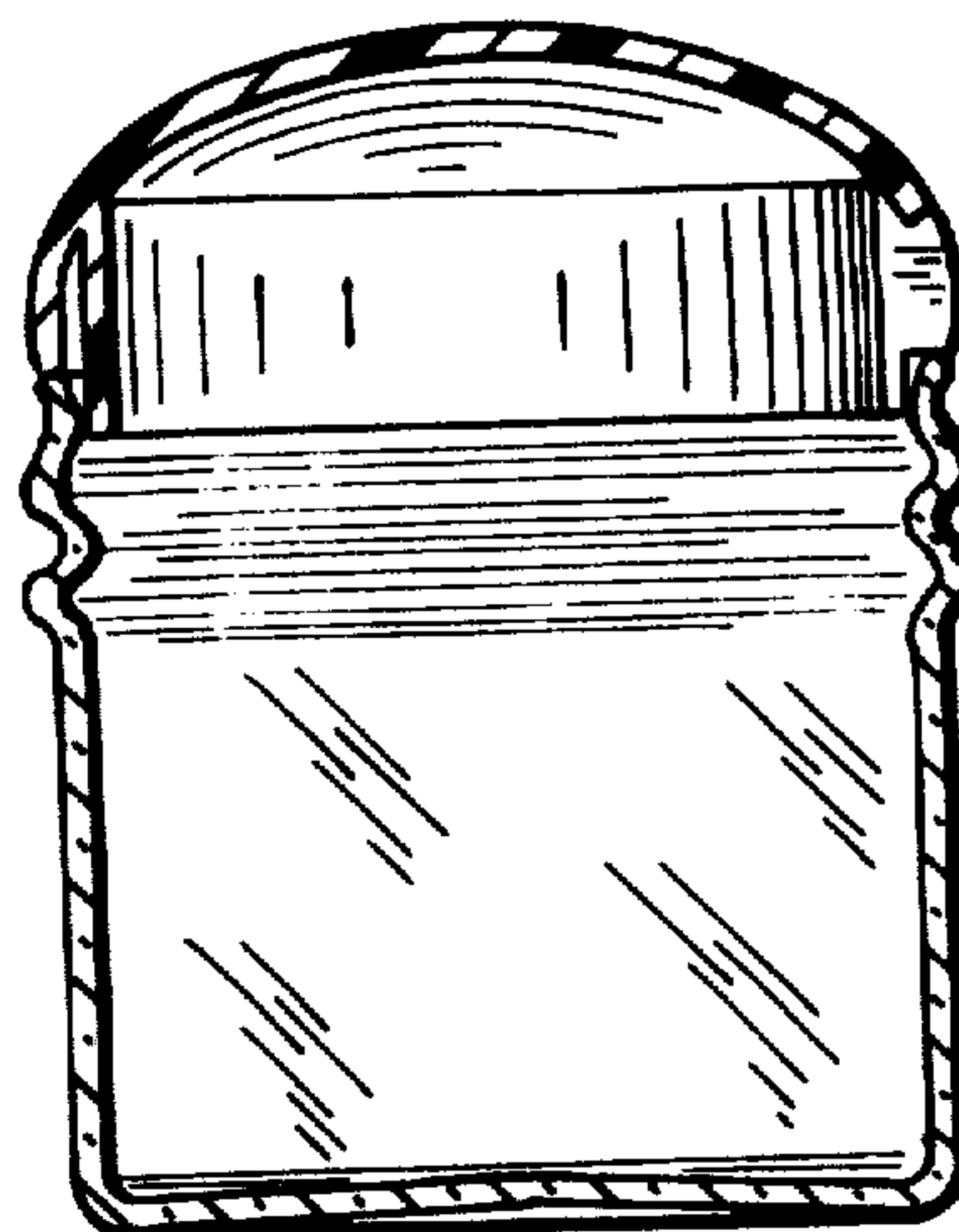
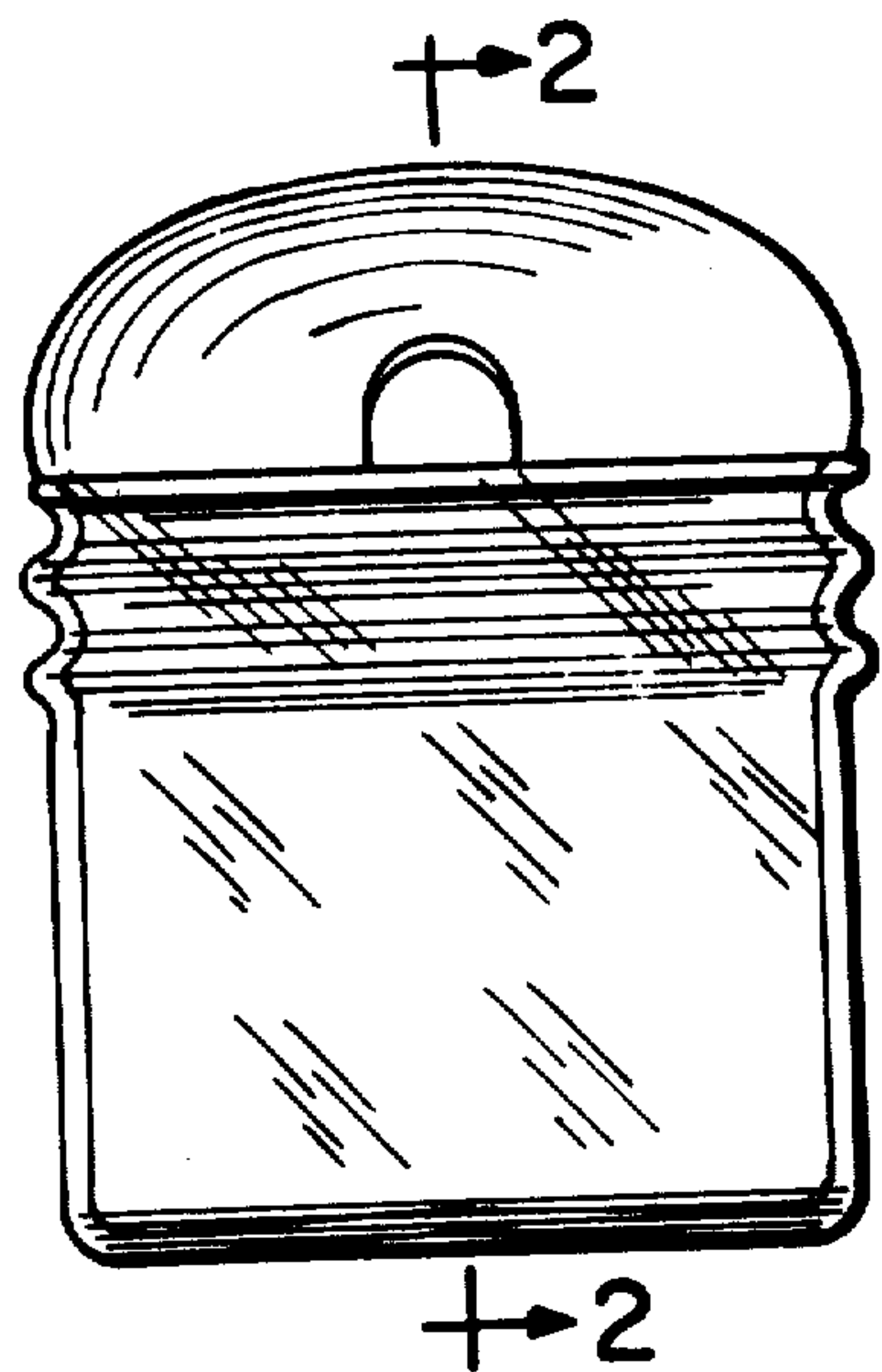
FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a covered sugar bowl or the like showing my new design.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the cover shown in FIGS. 1 and 2.



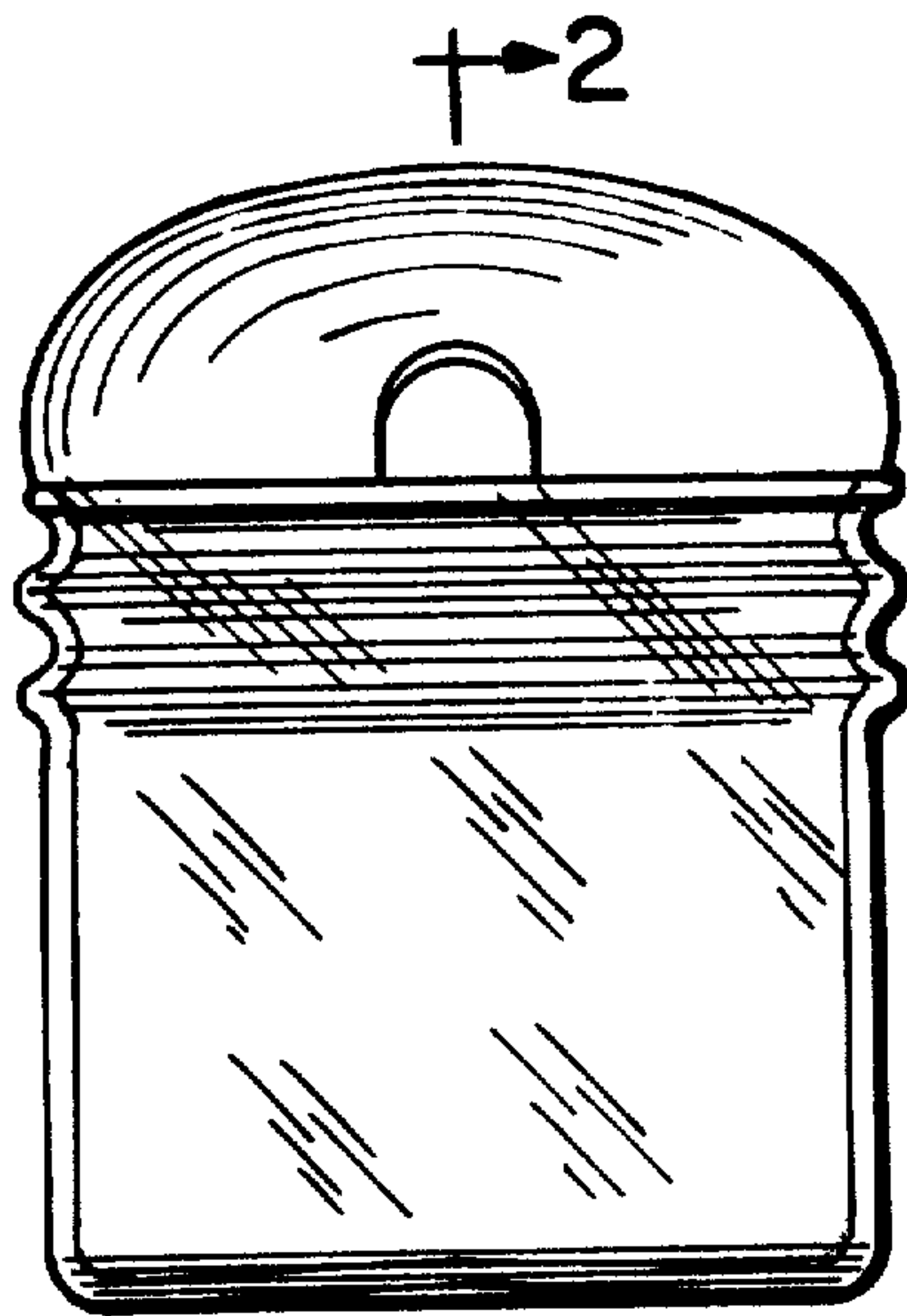

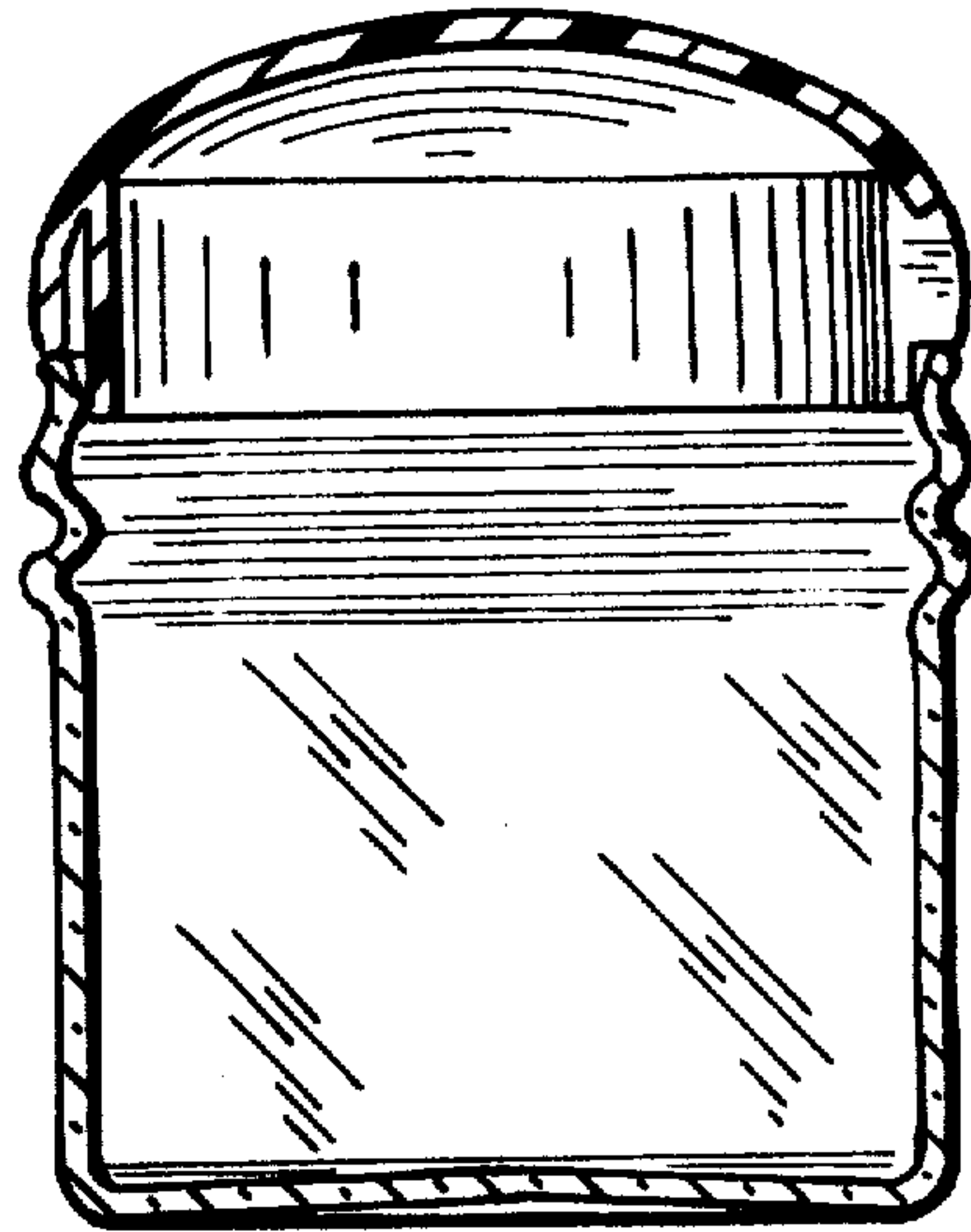

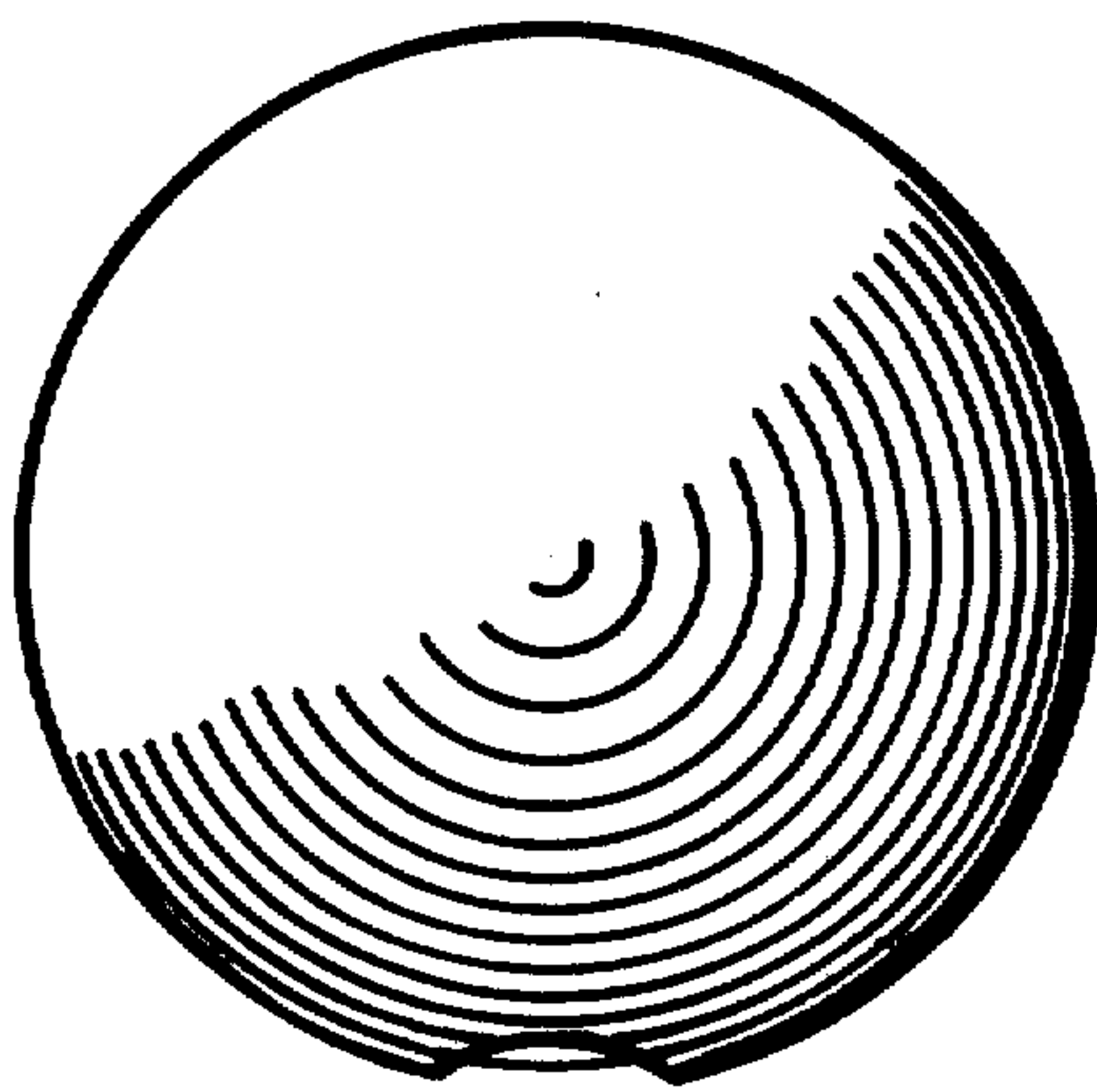

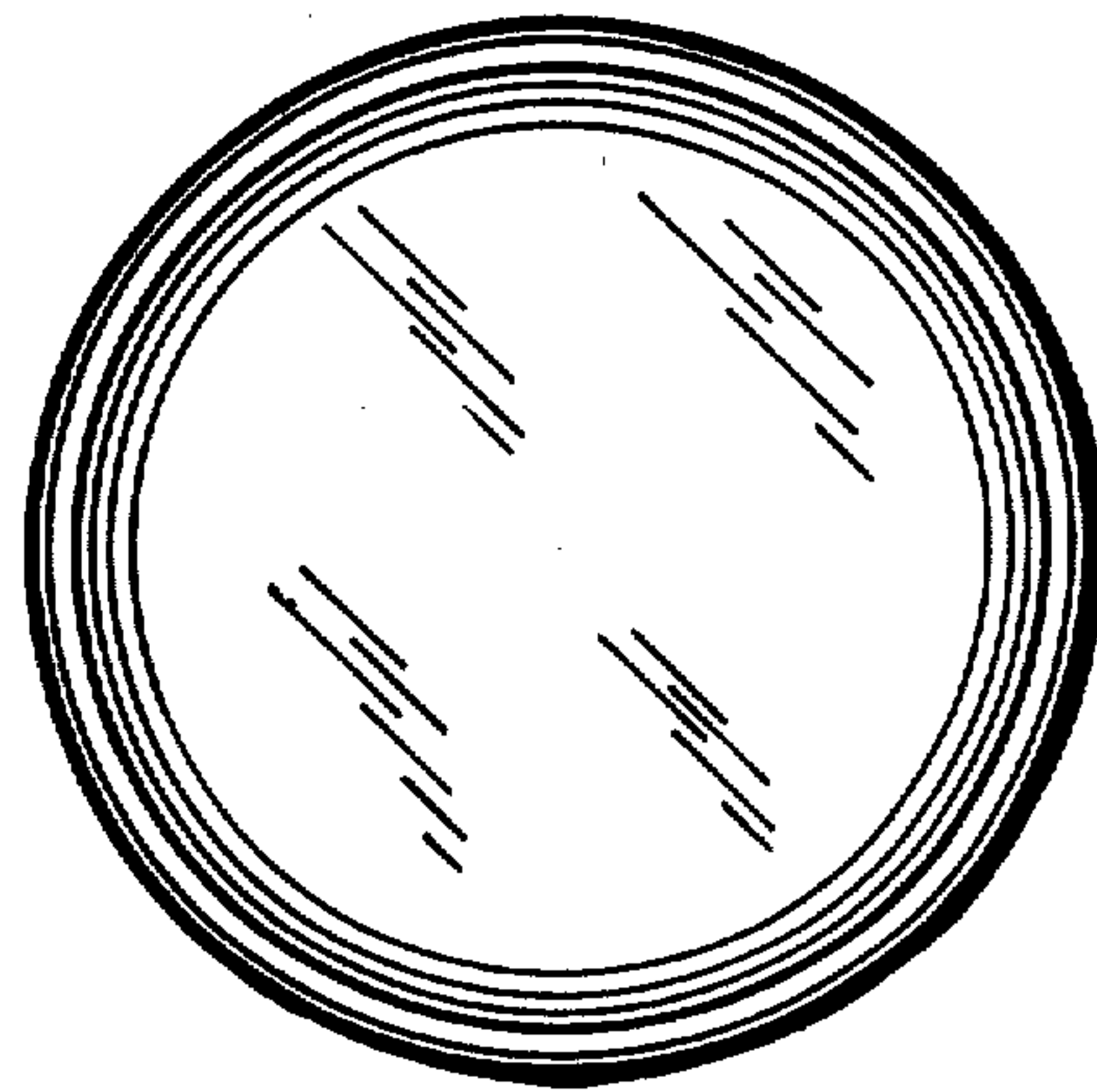

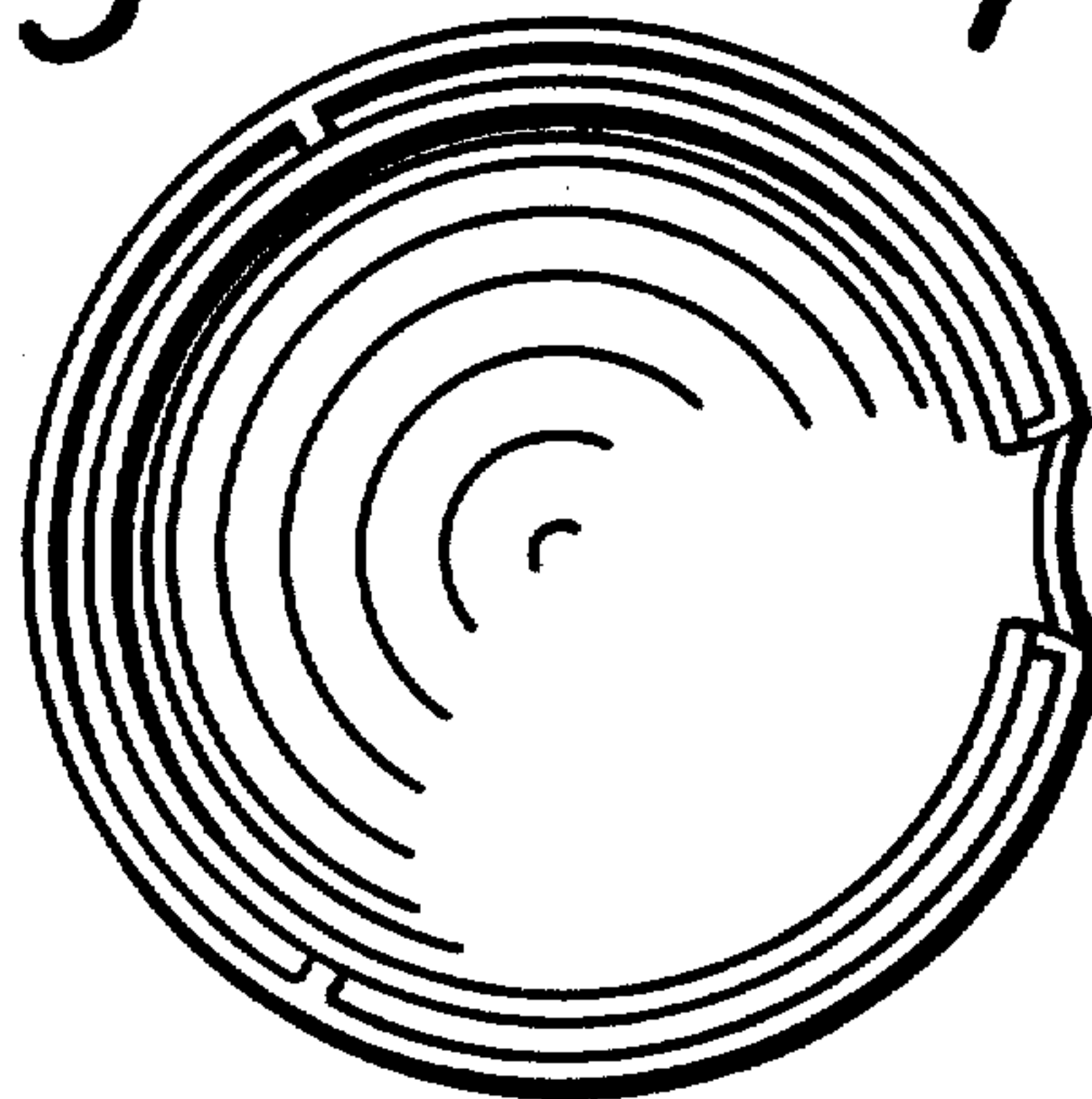
