CLAIM [57]

The ornamental design for a covered sugar bowl or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a covered sugar bowl or the like showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is an elevational view in section taken along line 2-2 of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view.

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the cover shown in FIGS. 1 and 2.
