FIG. 8 is a top plan view showing the closure in an open position.

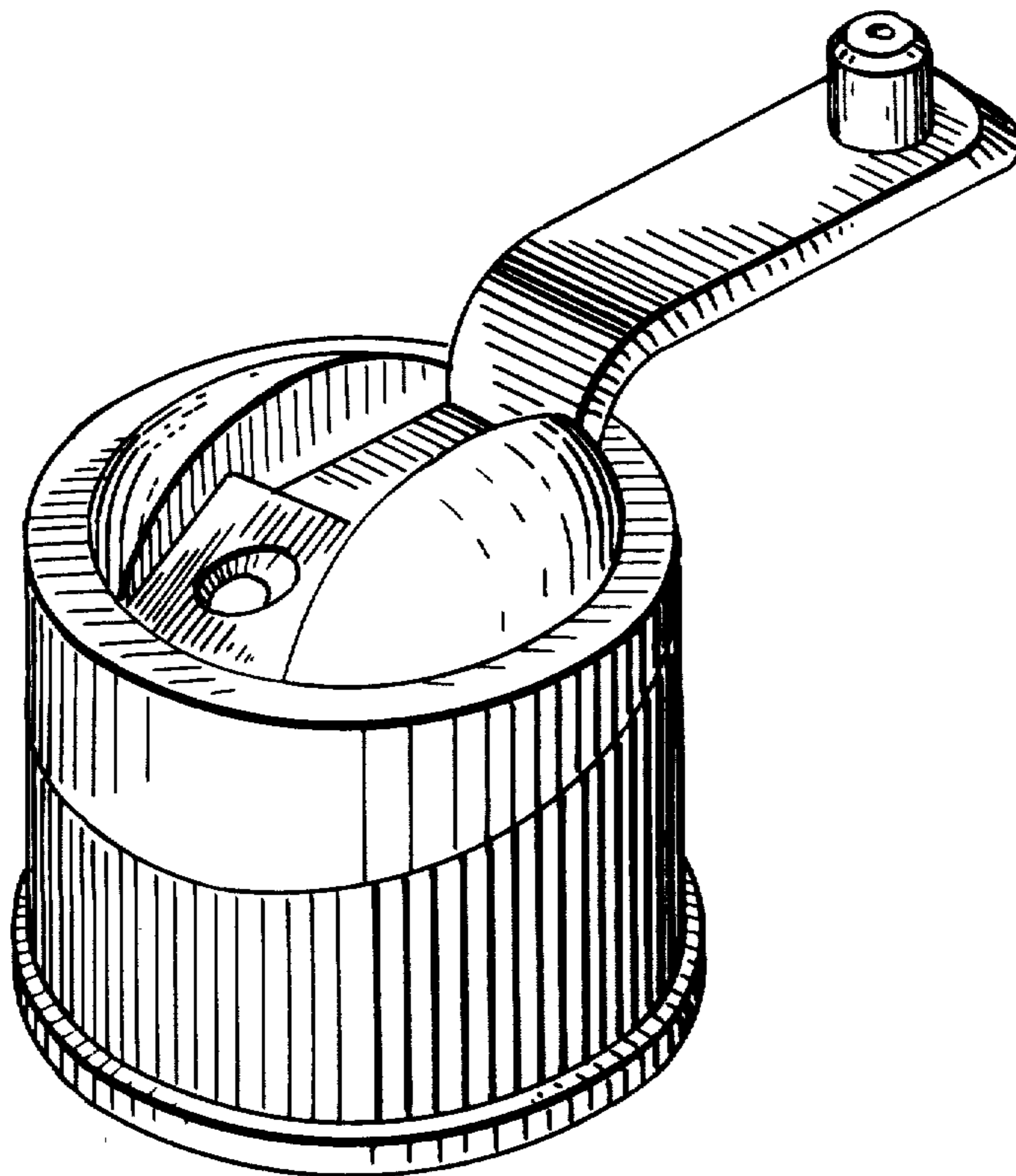

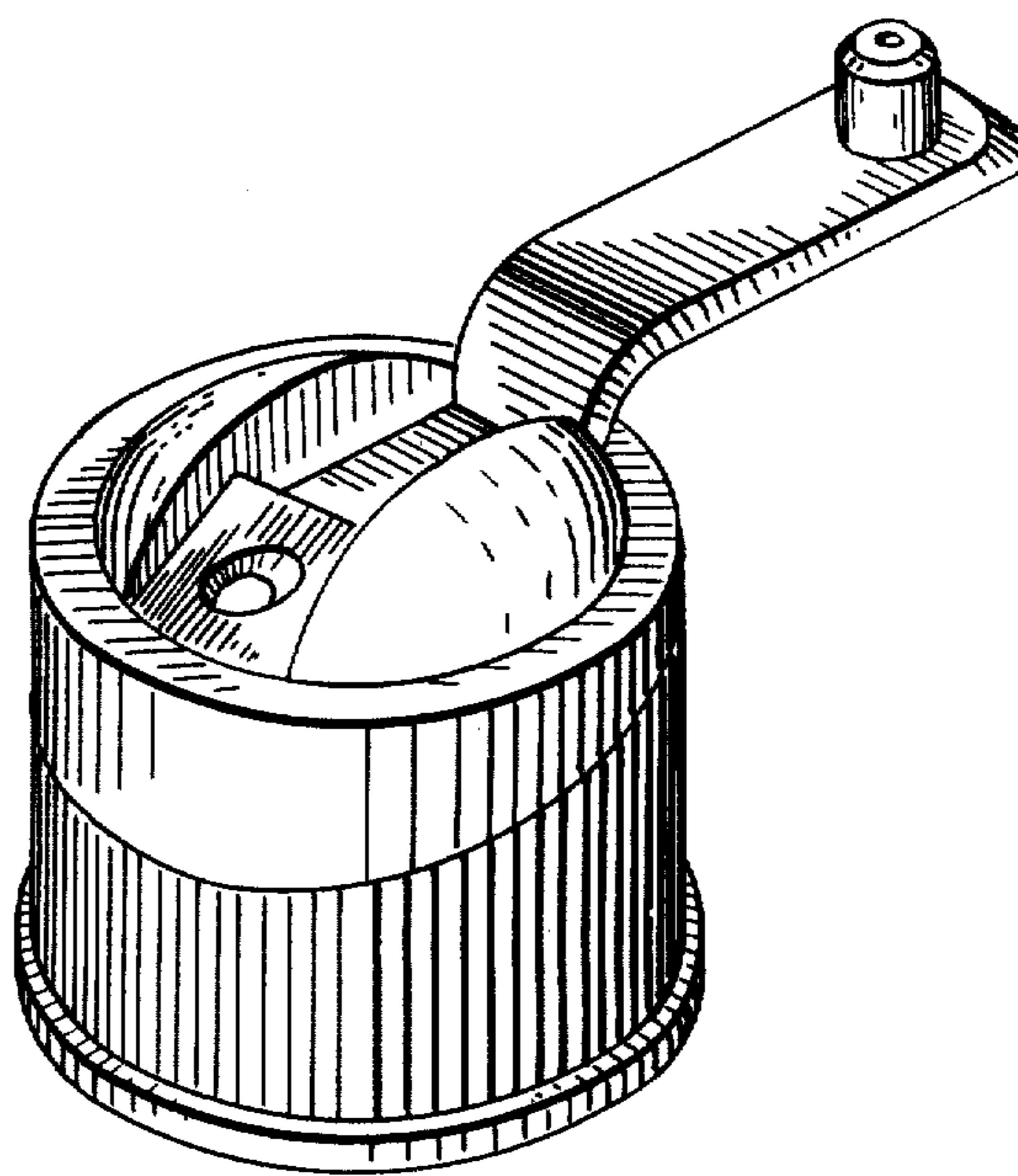
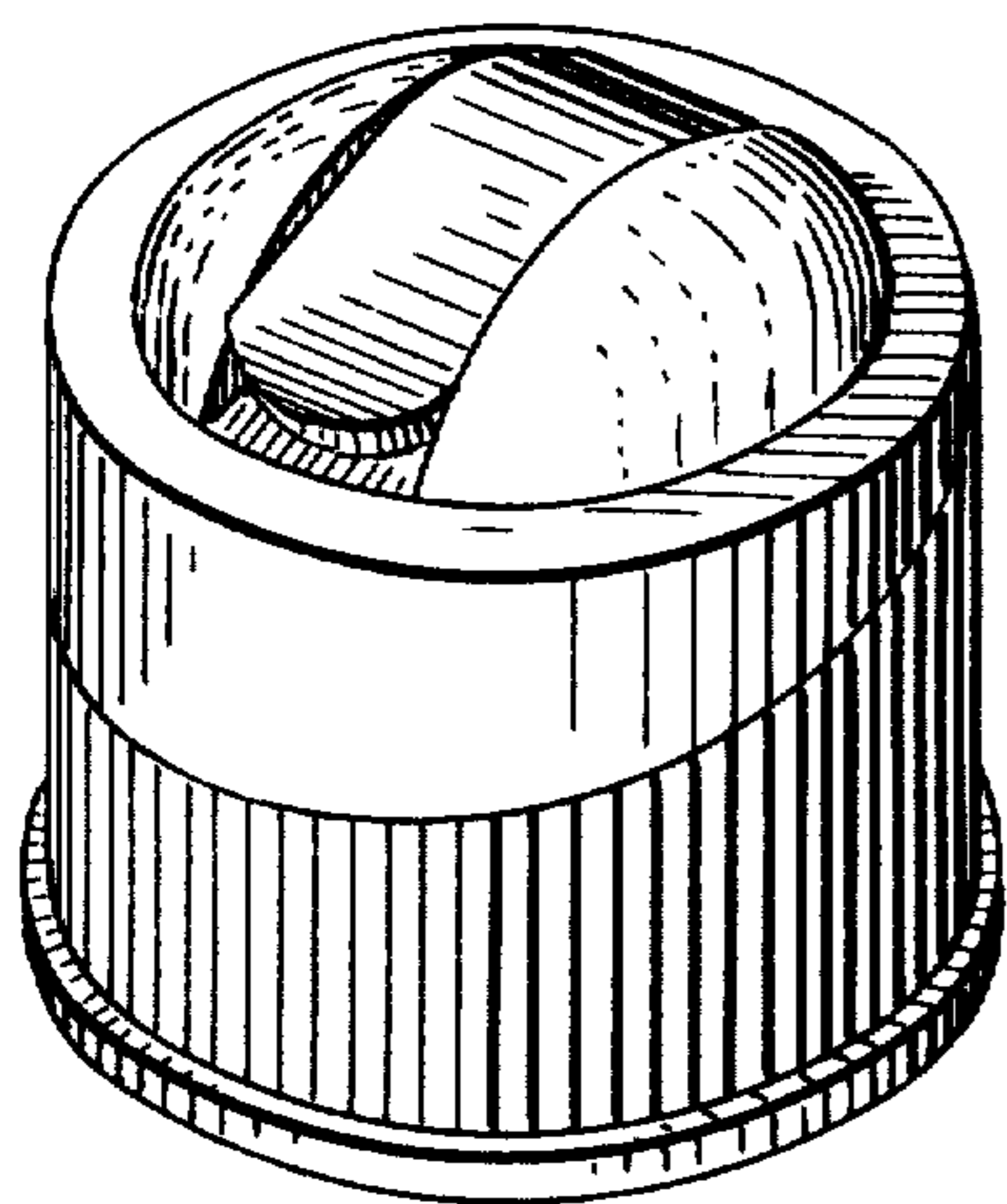

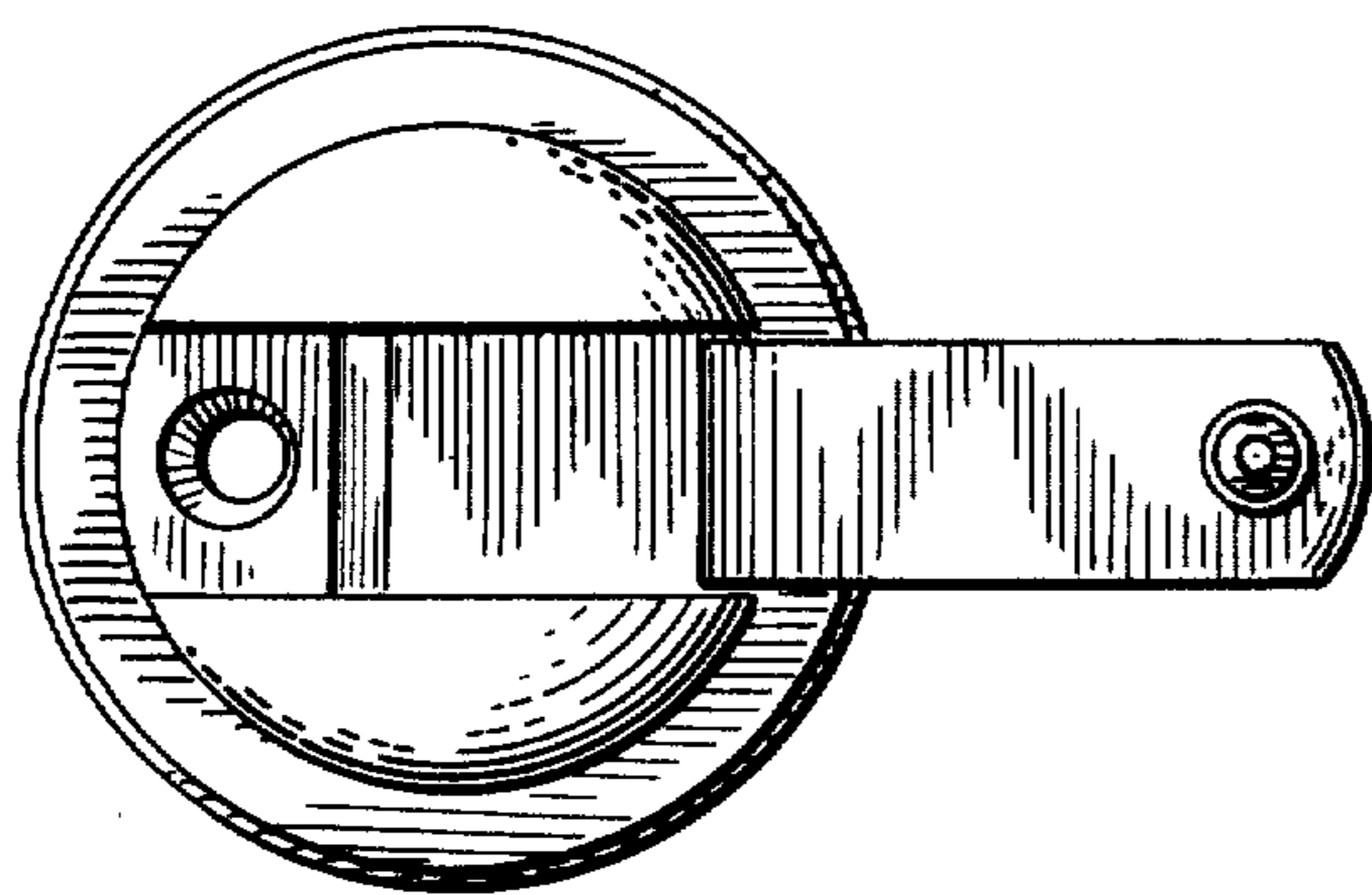

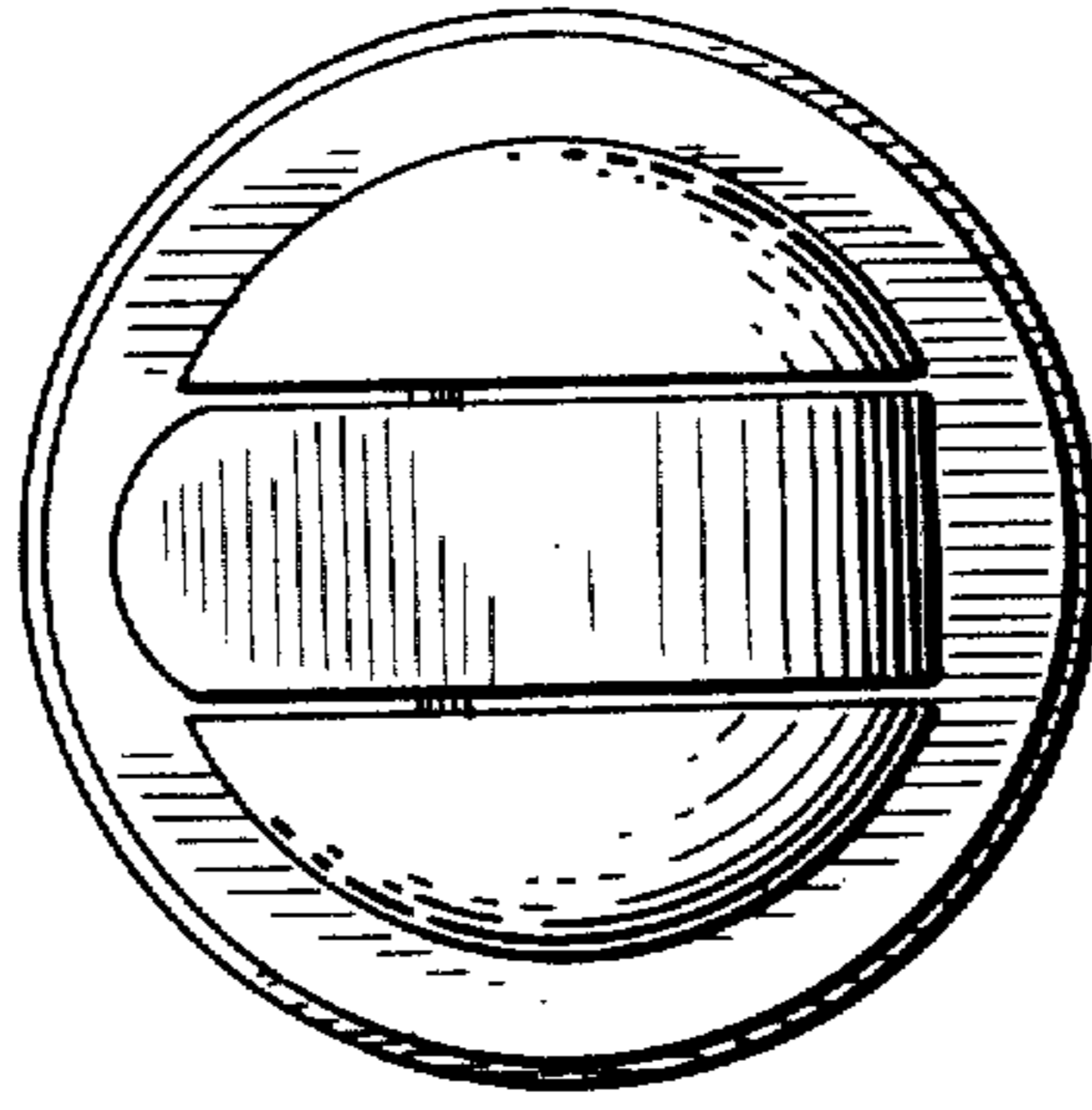

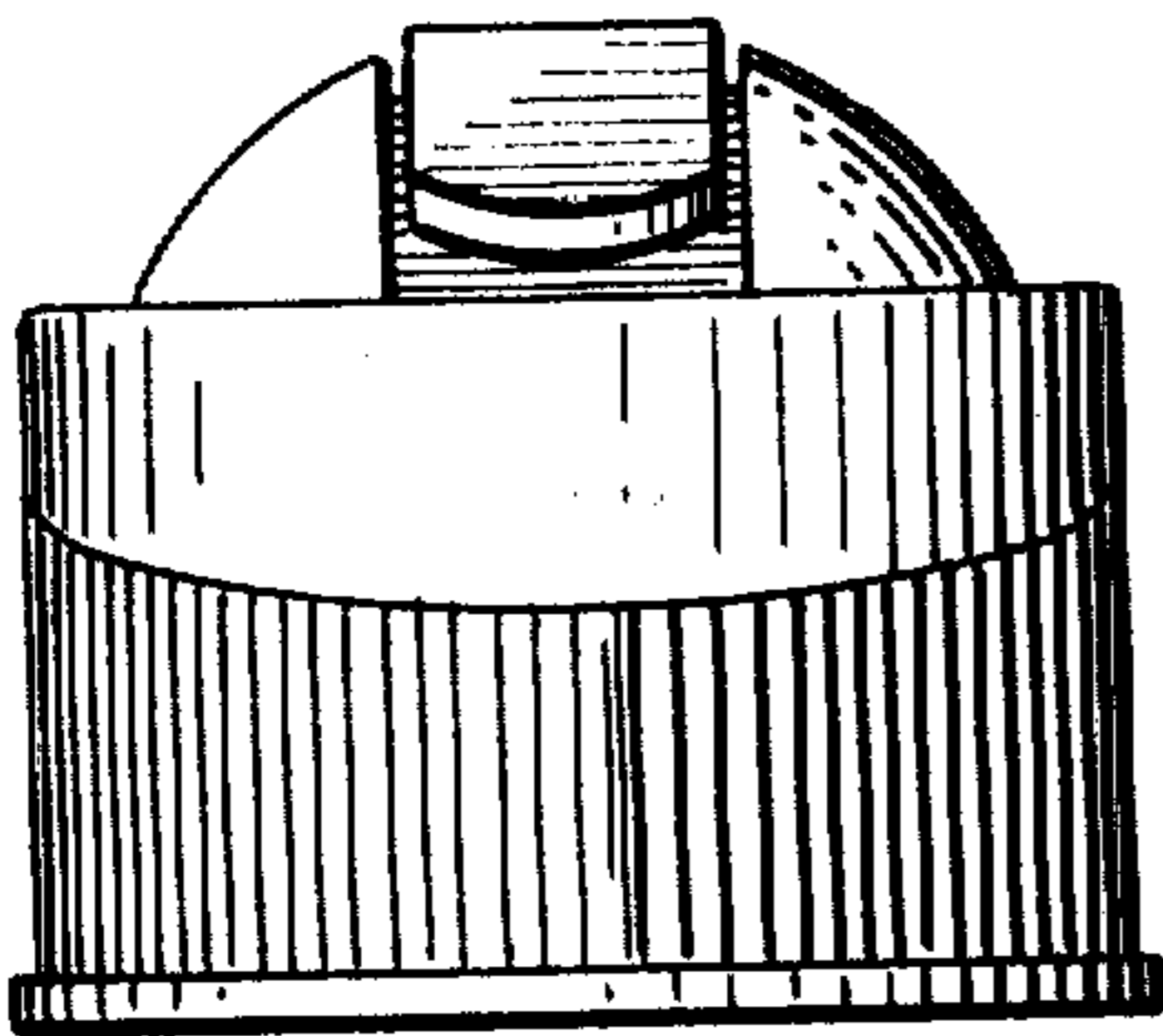

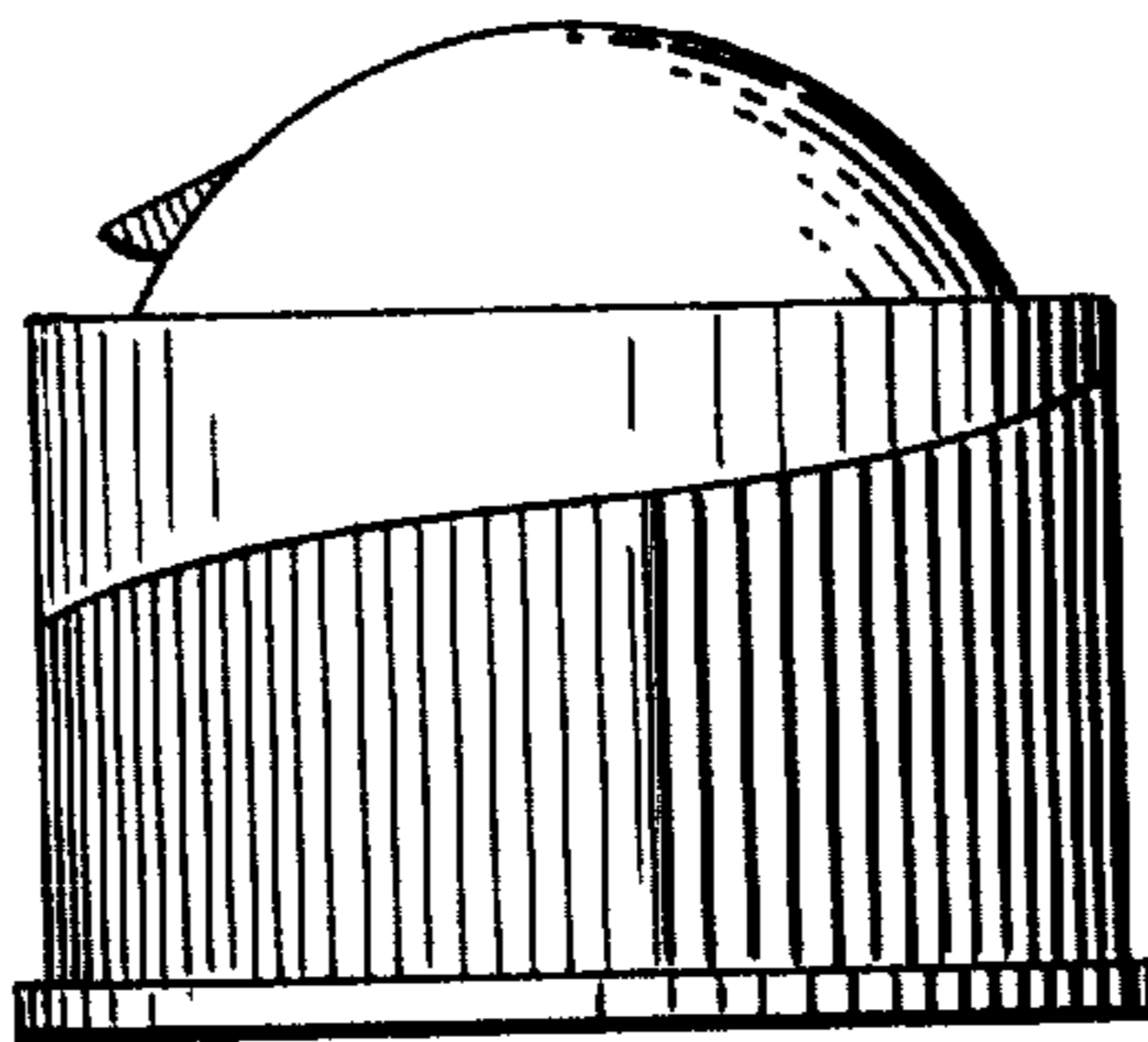

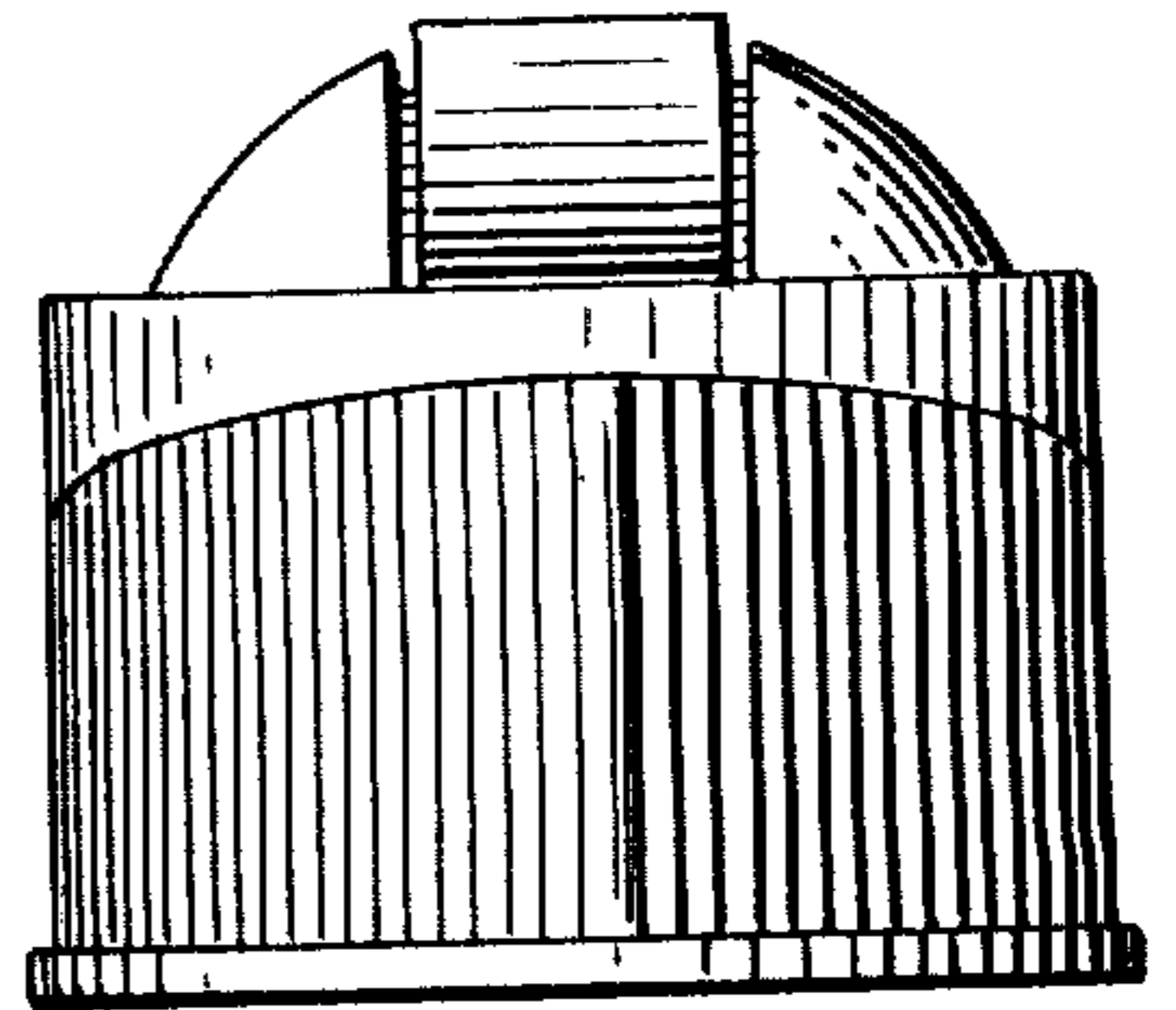
