DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a master control for television and video recorder system showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof, both sides being identical.

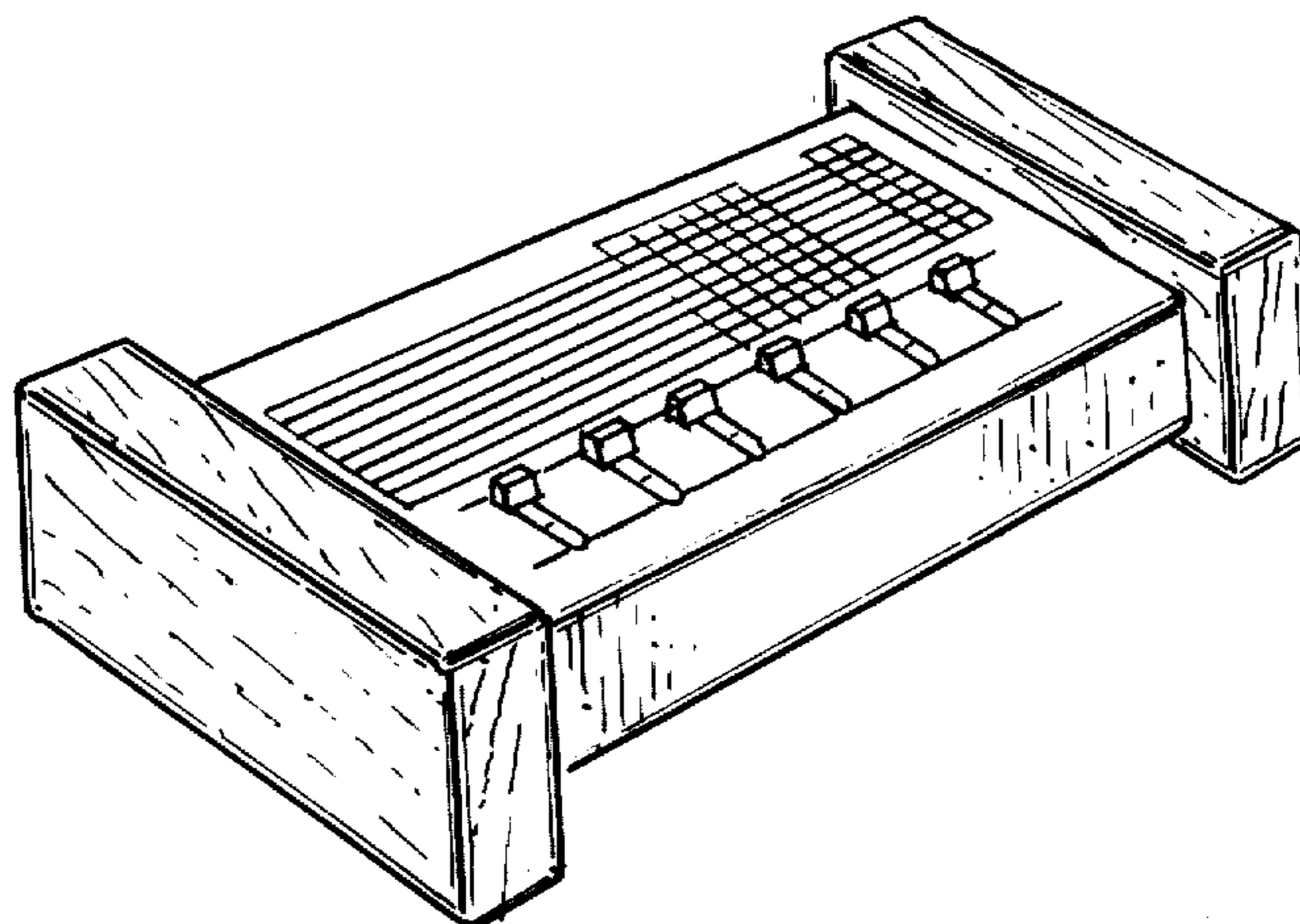

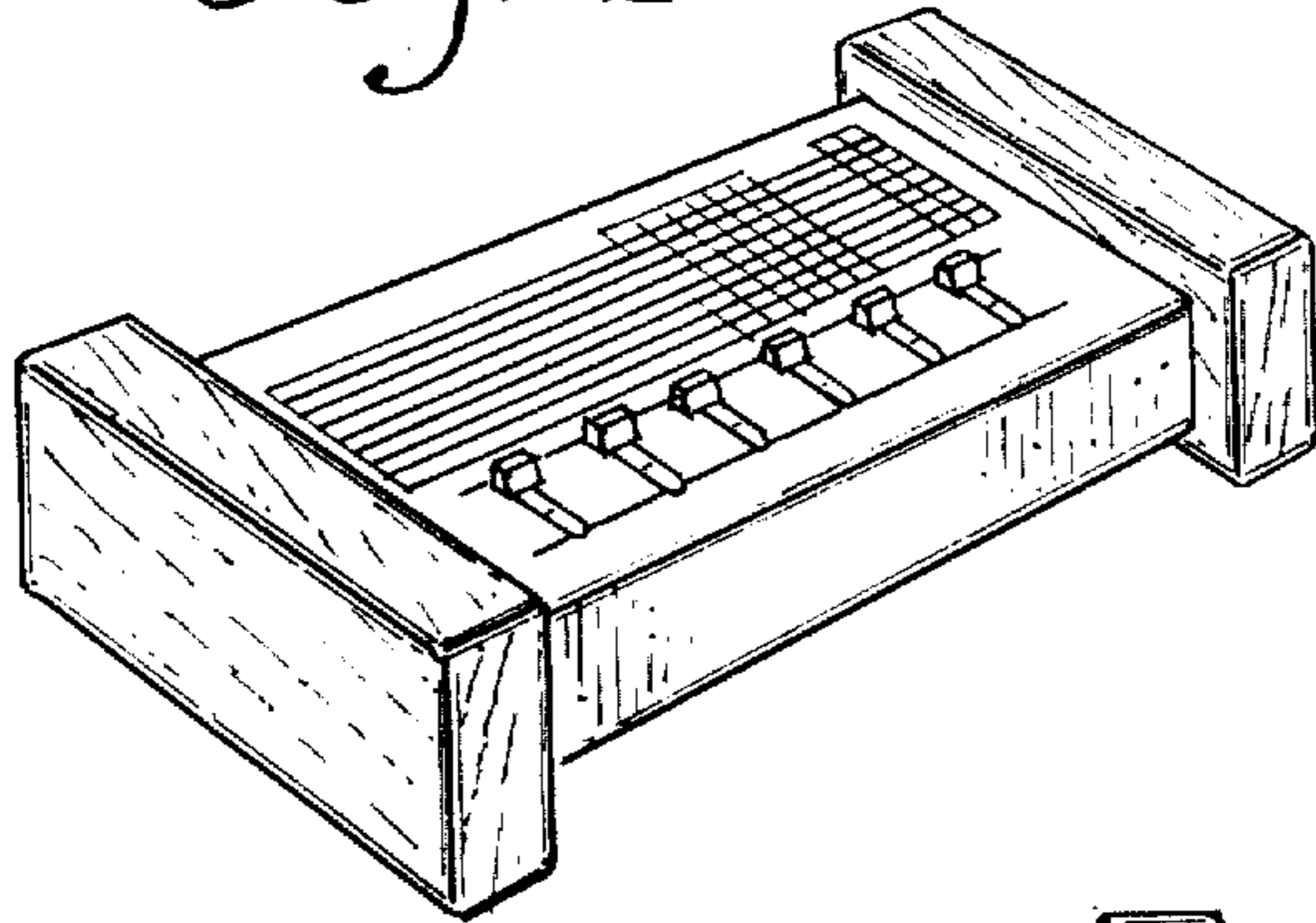

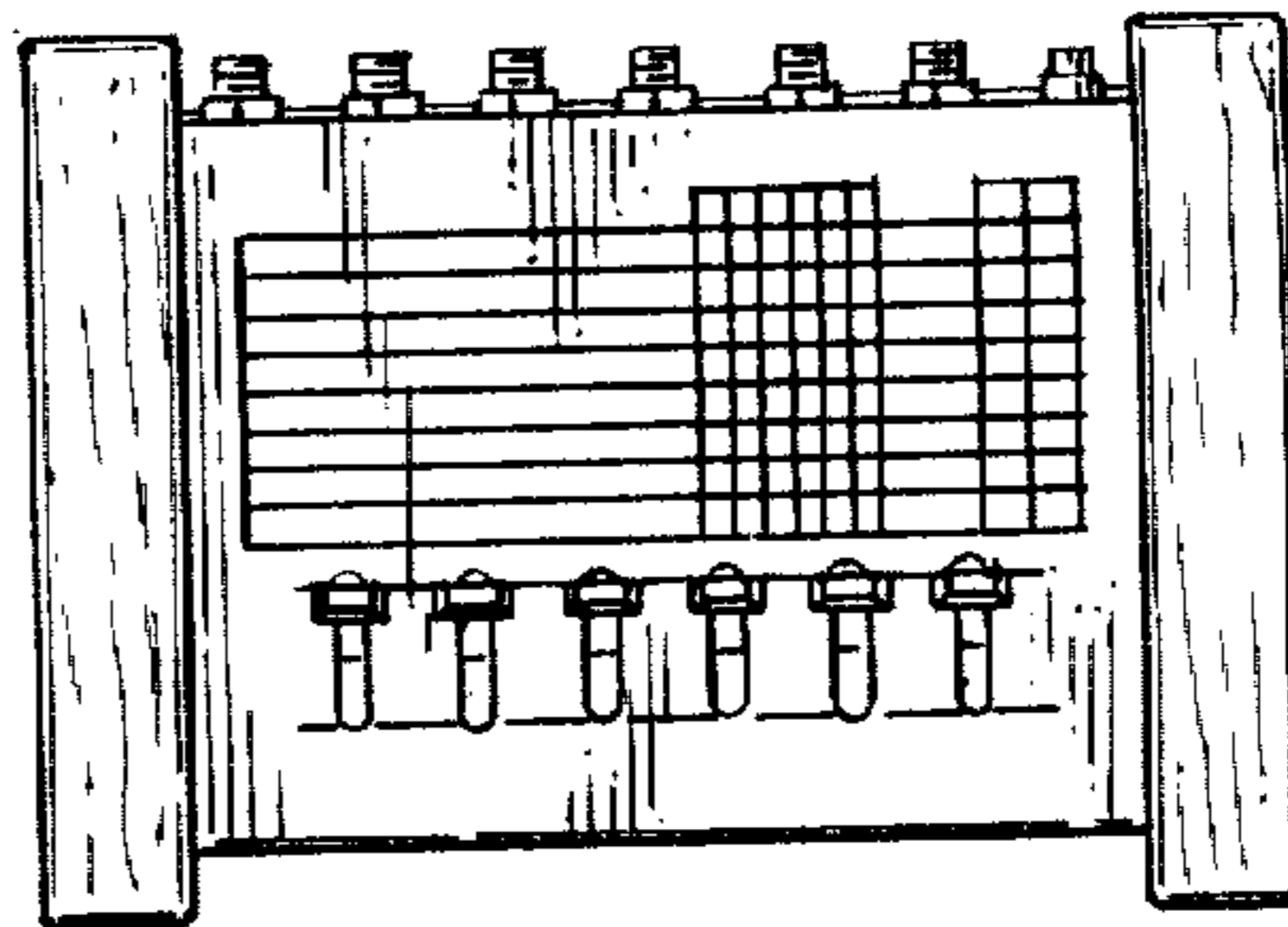

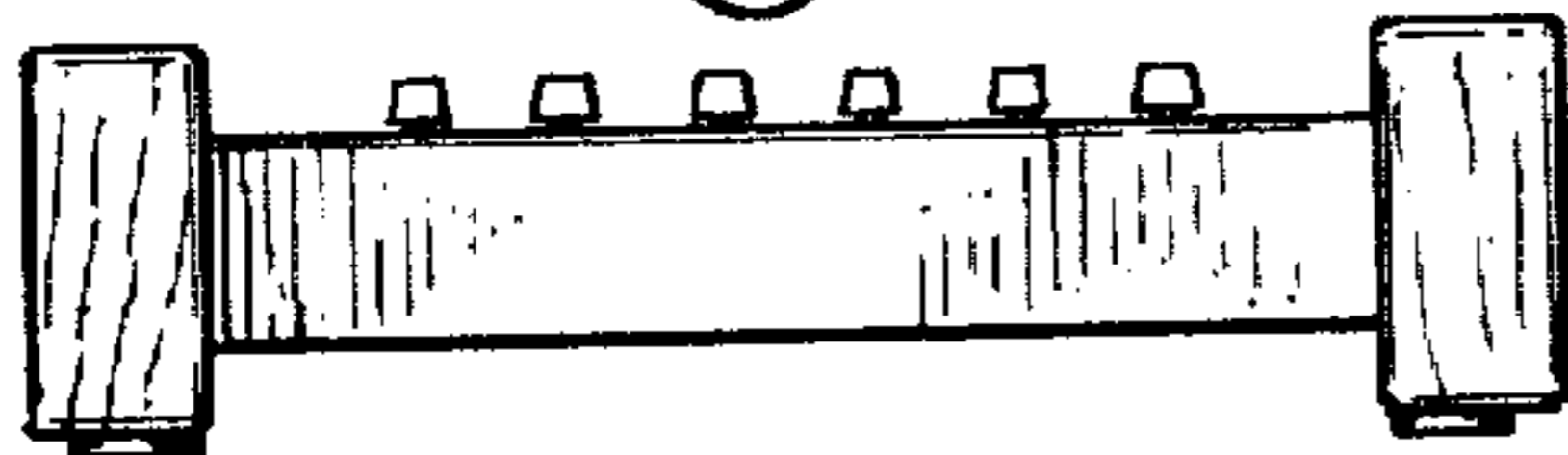

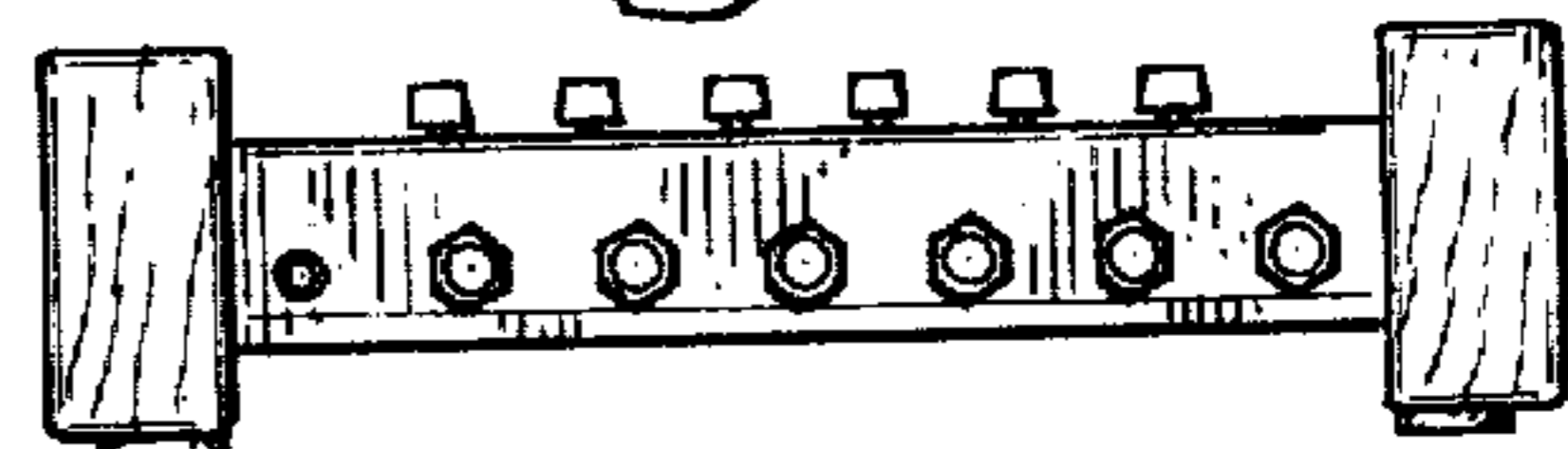

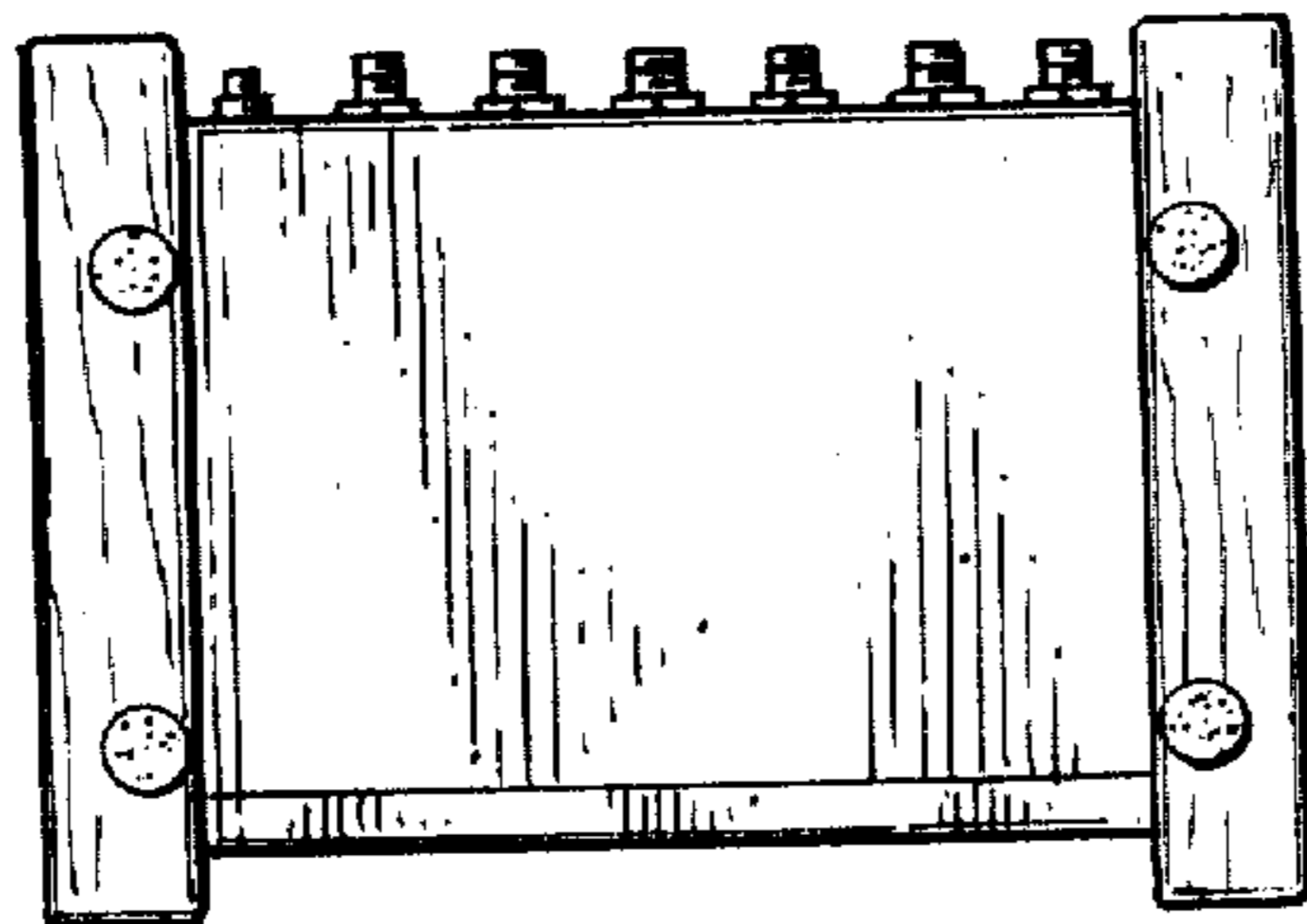
