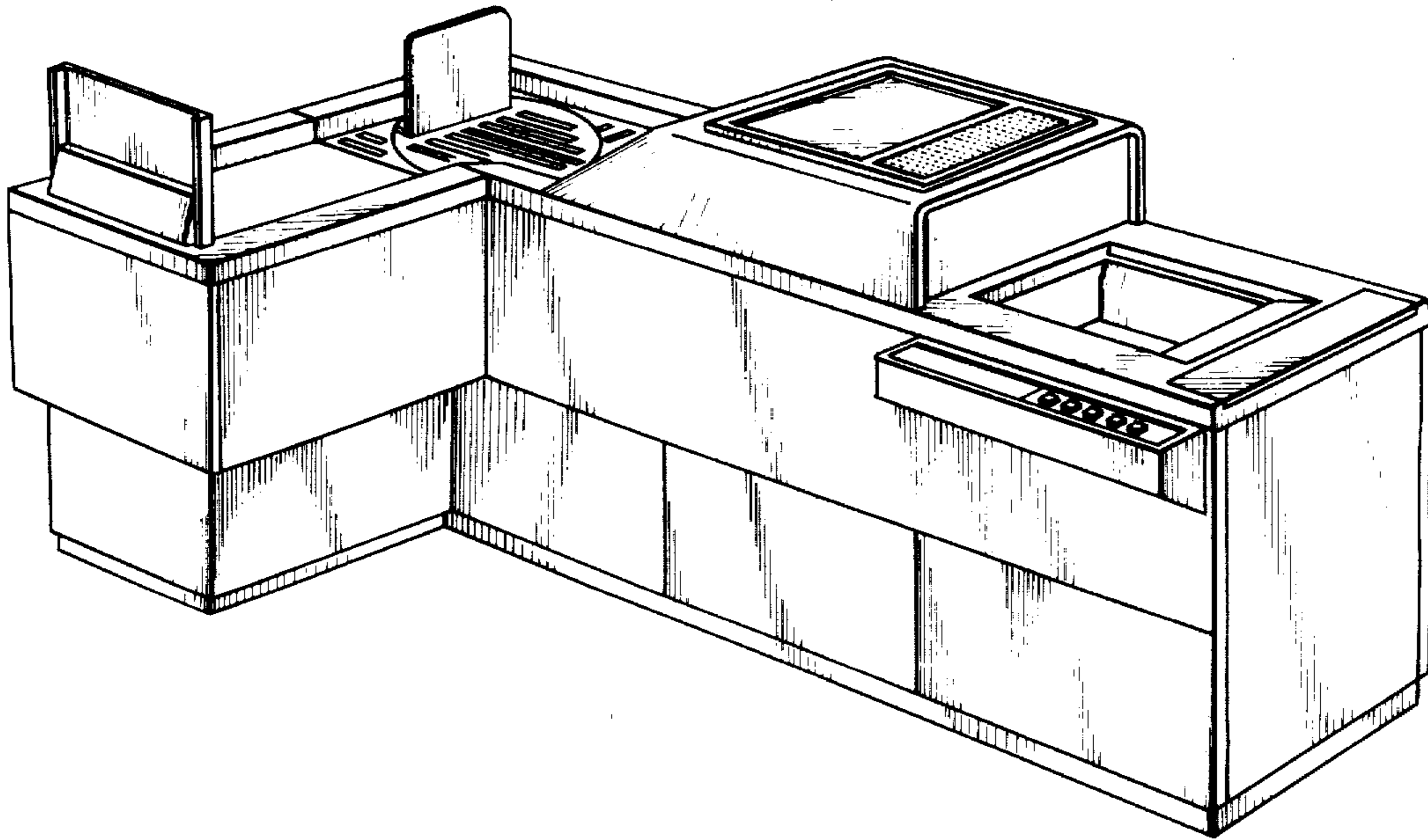

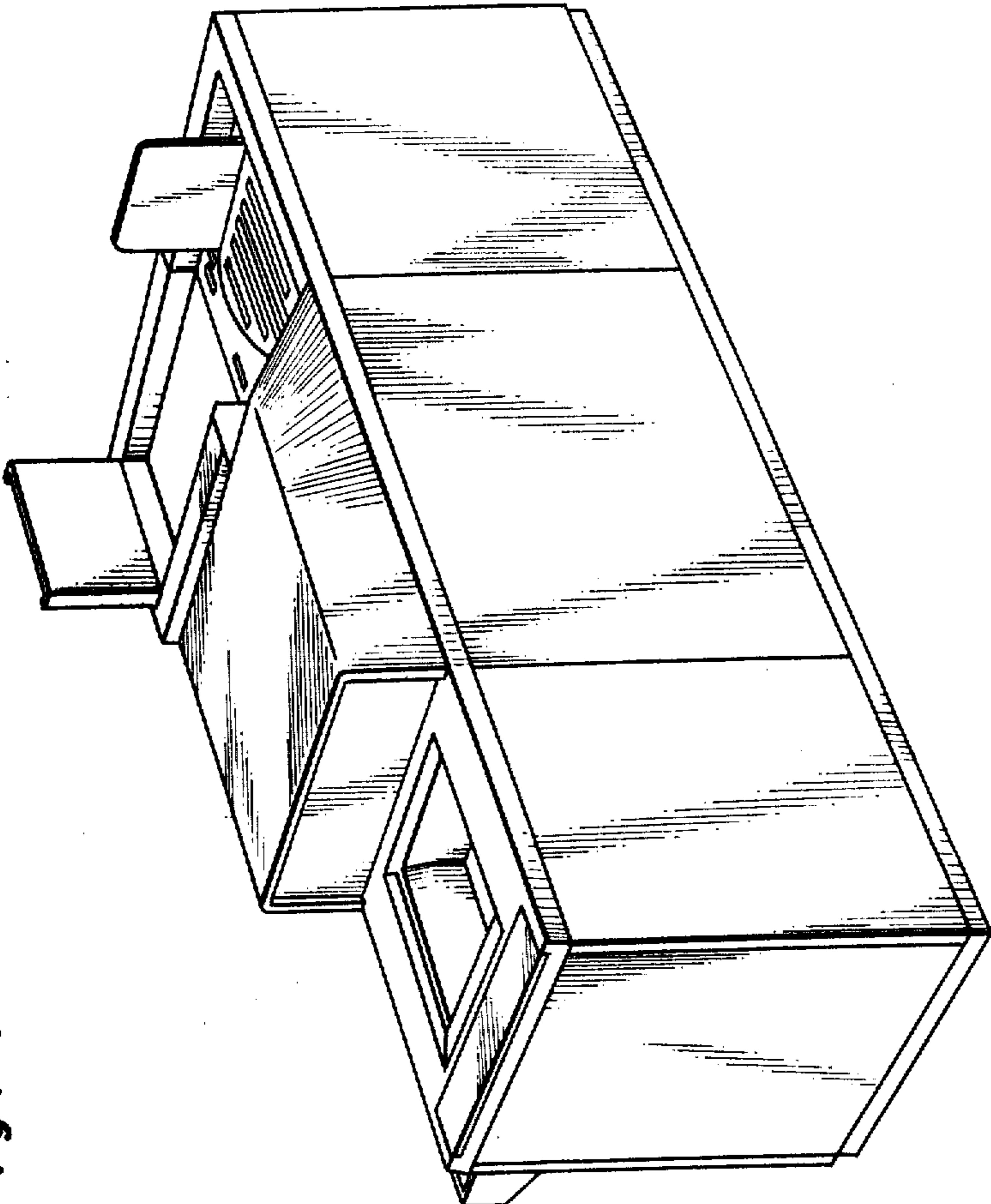
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a merchandise bagging machine, as shown and described.

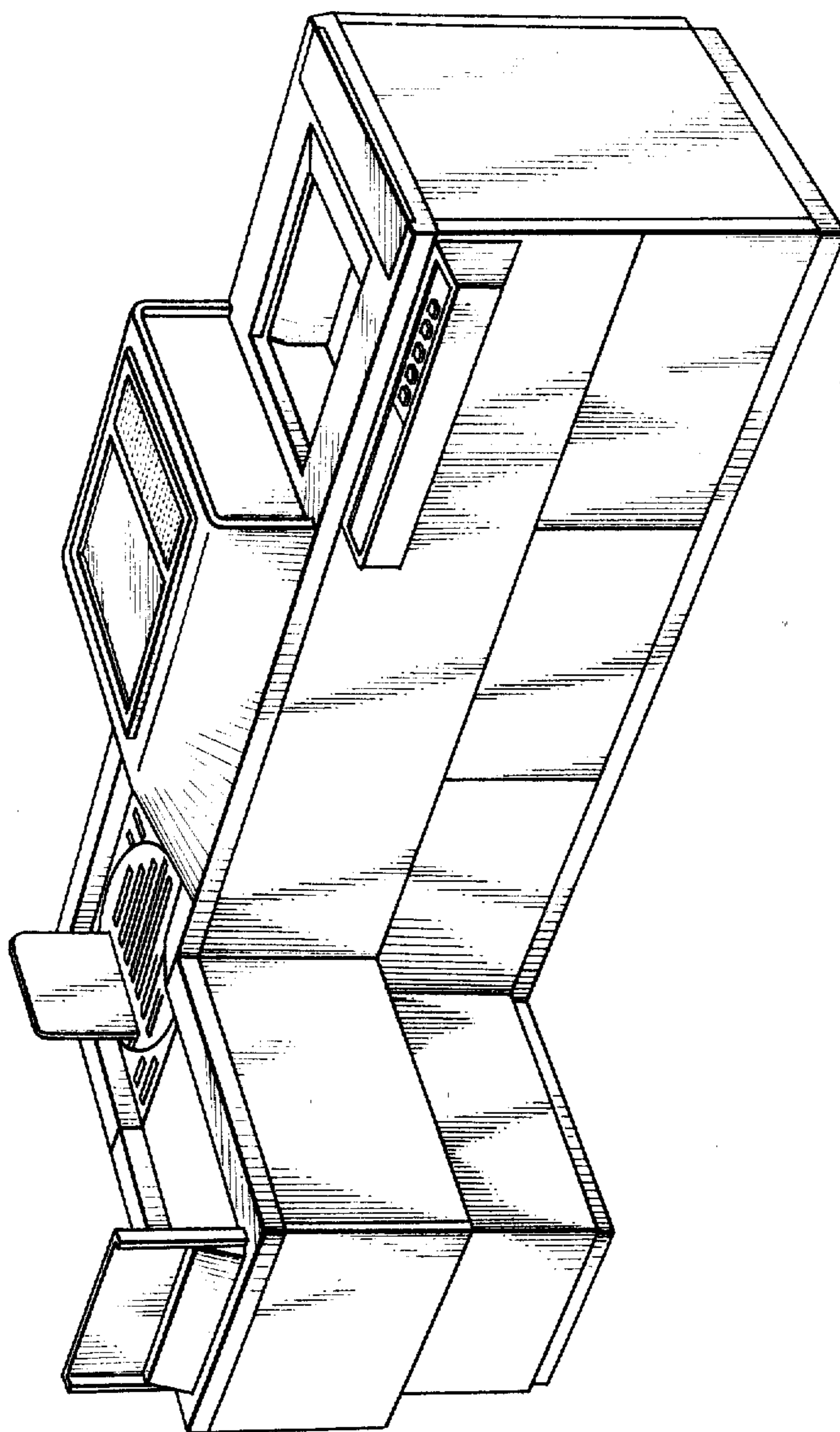
DESCRIPTION
