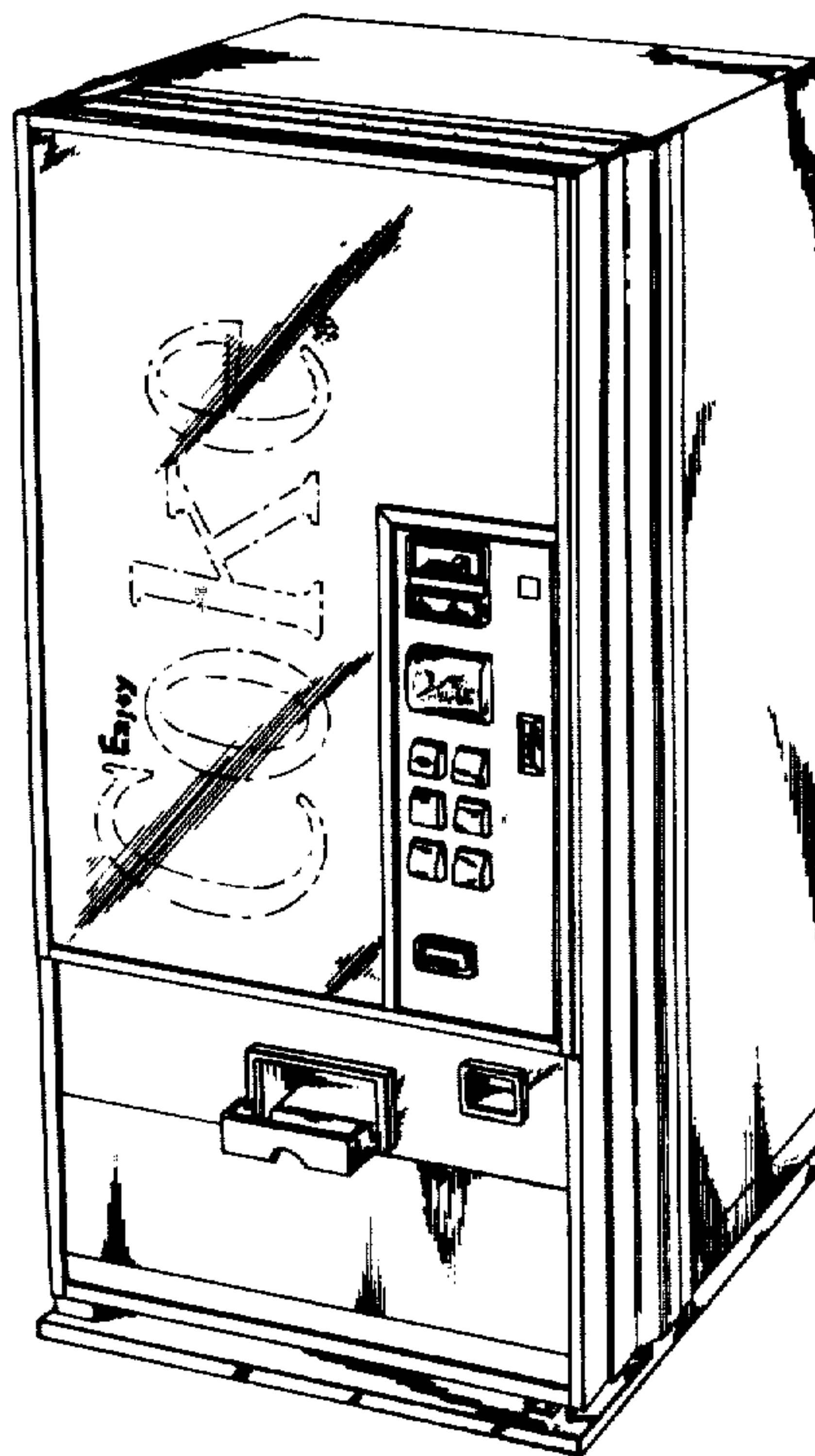
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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and right front perspective view of a vending machine showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

The broken line showings of FIGS. 1-3 are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.



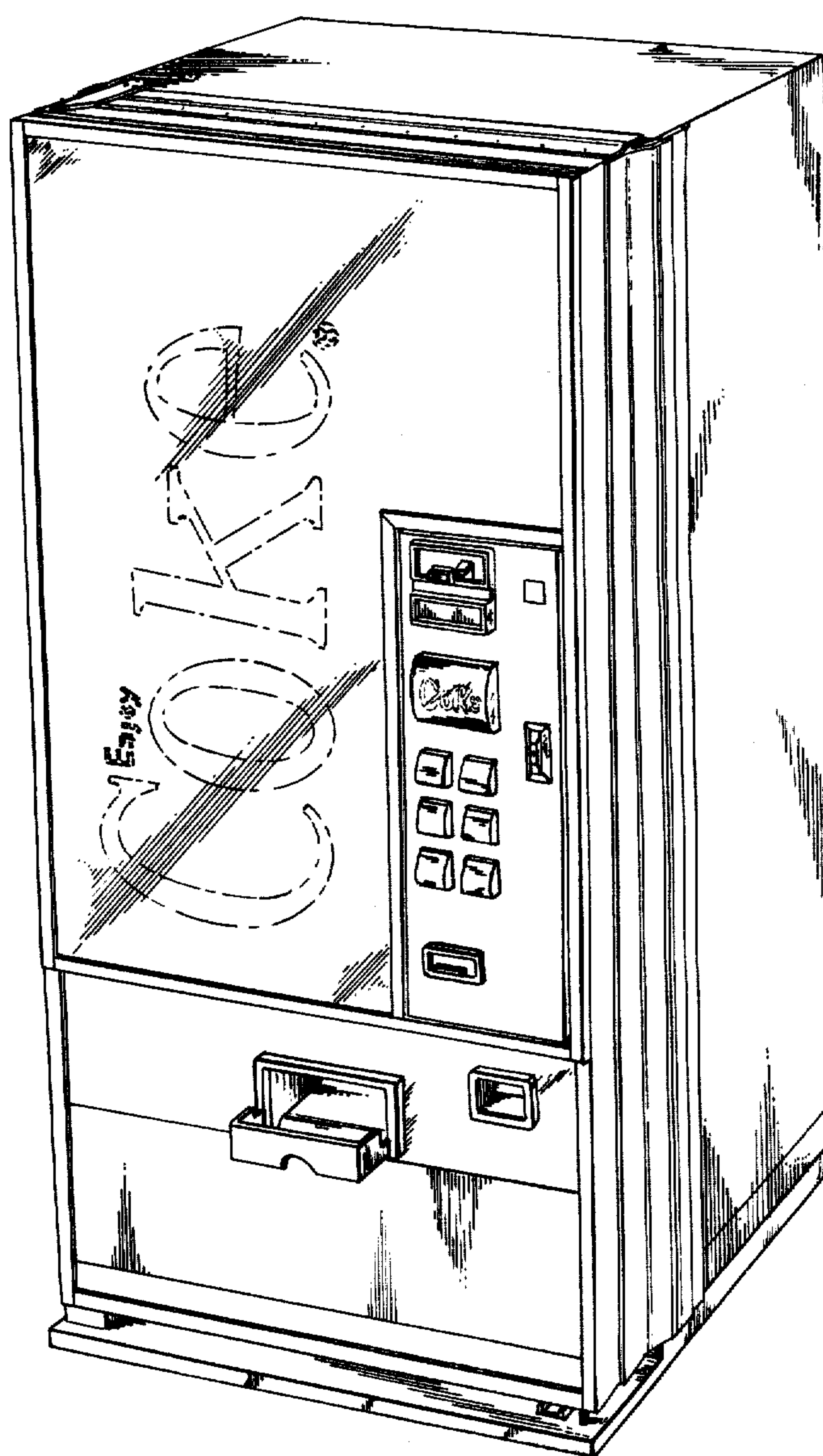
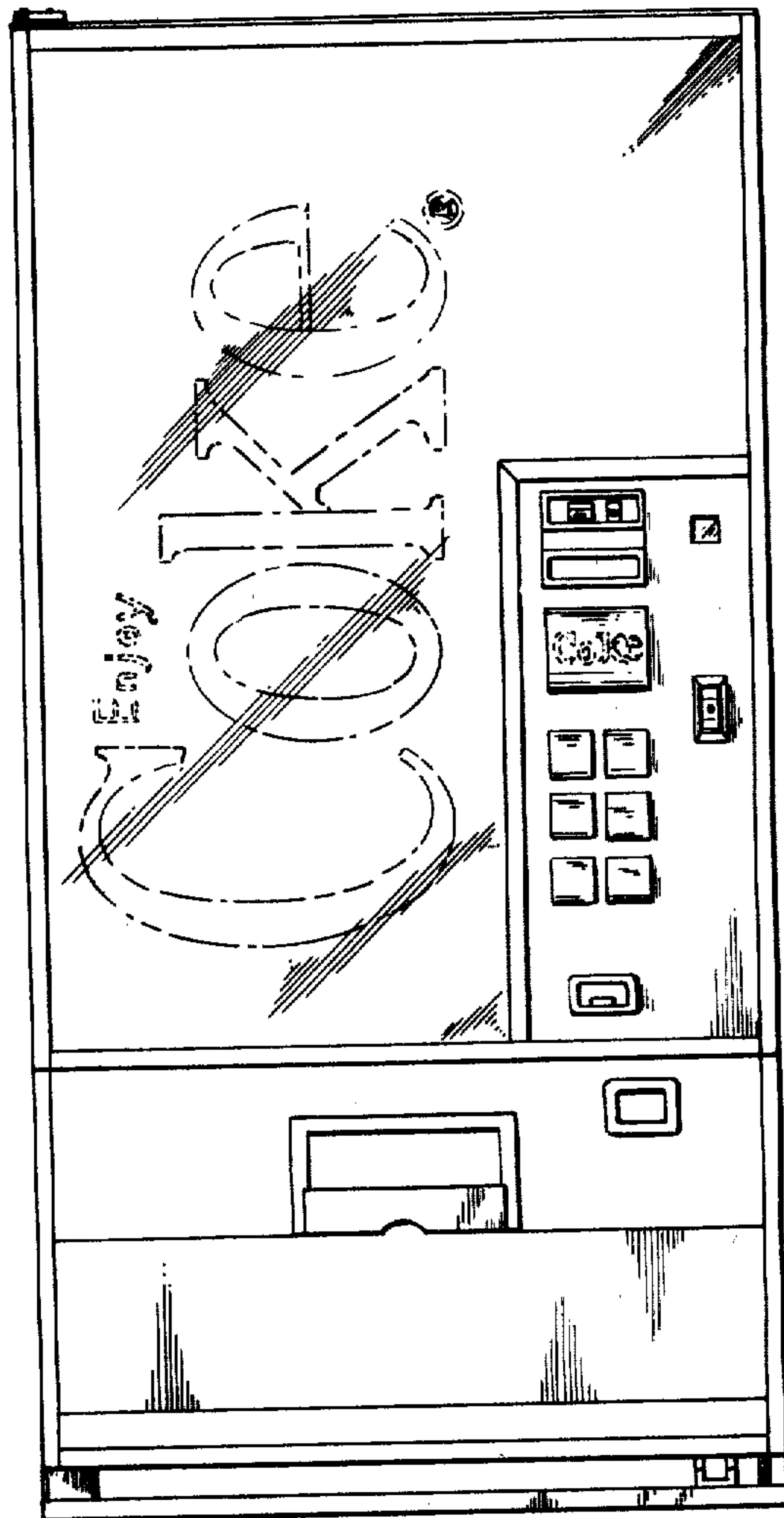

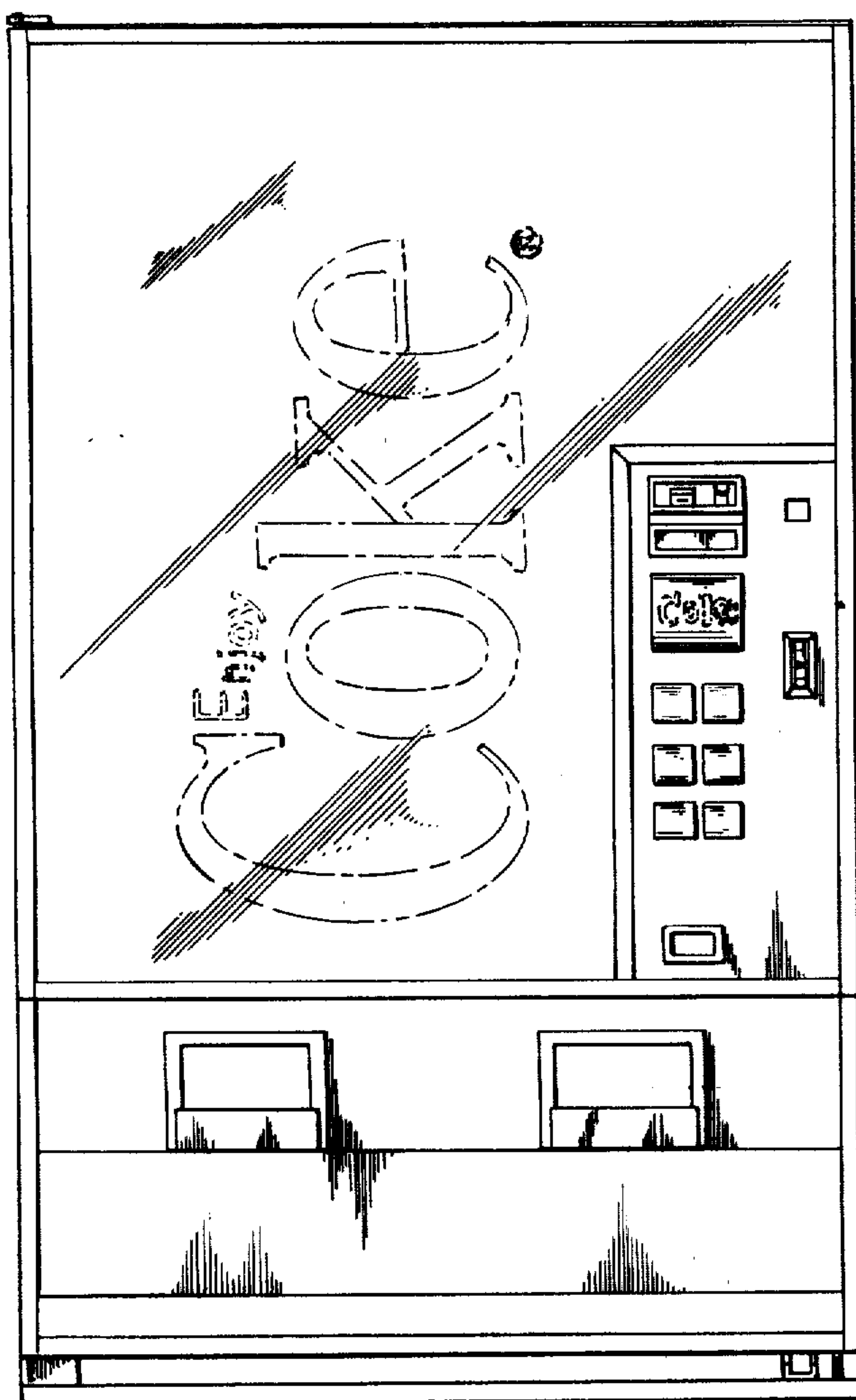

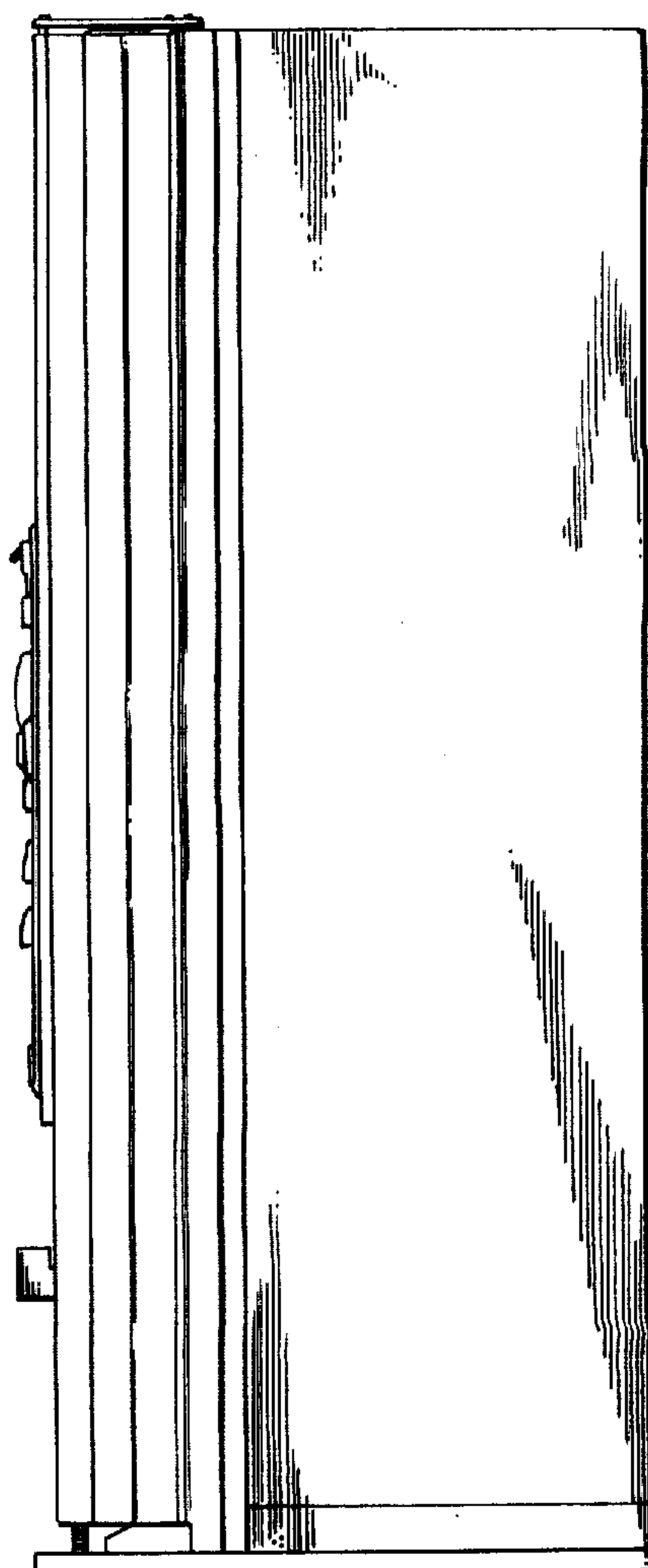
