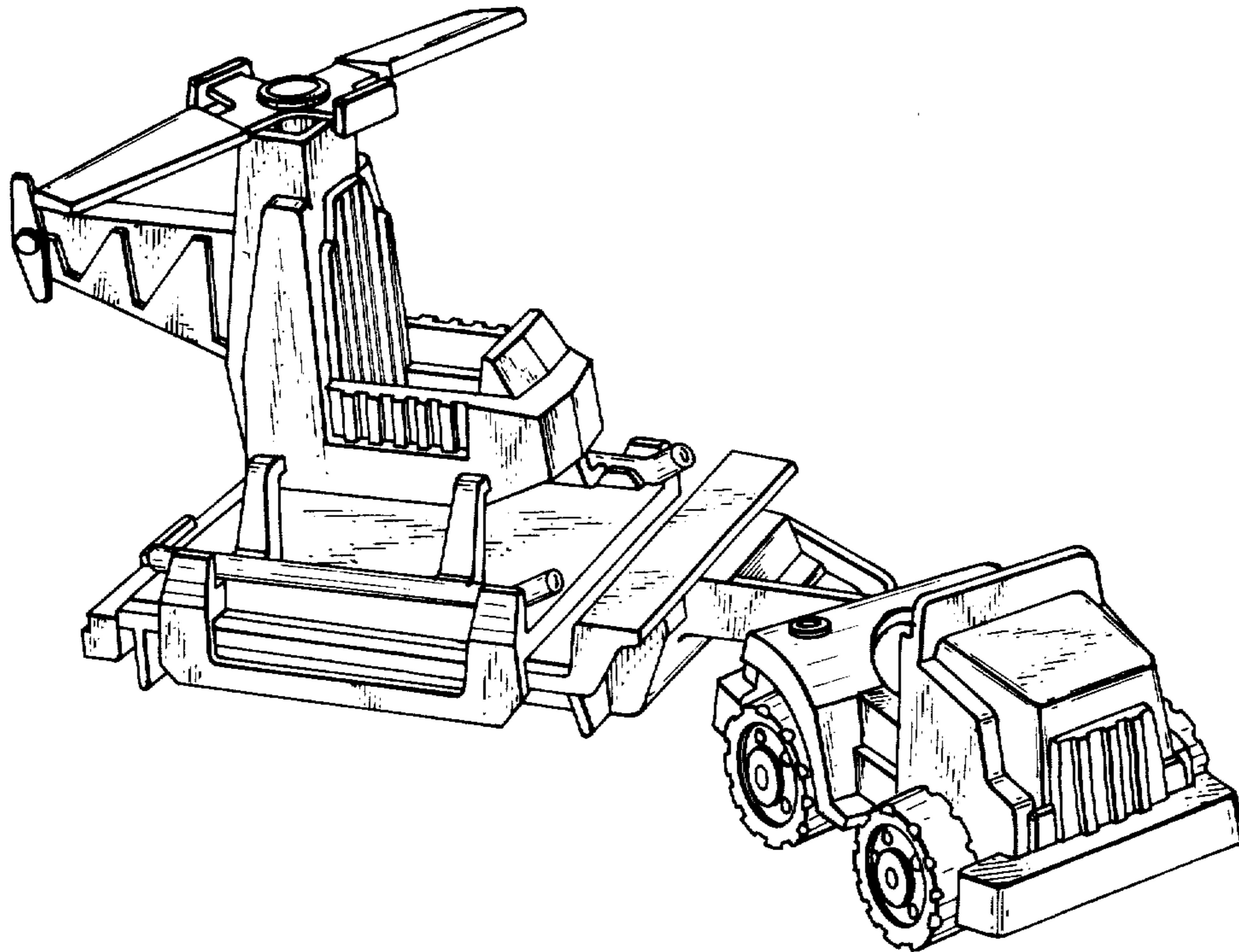

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy helicopter rig, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy helicopter rig showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the helicopter and trailer portions thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the truck portion thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



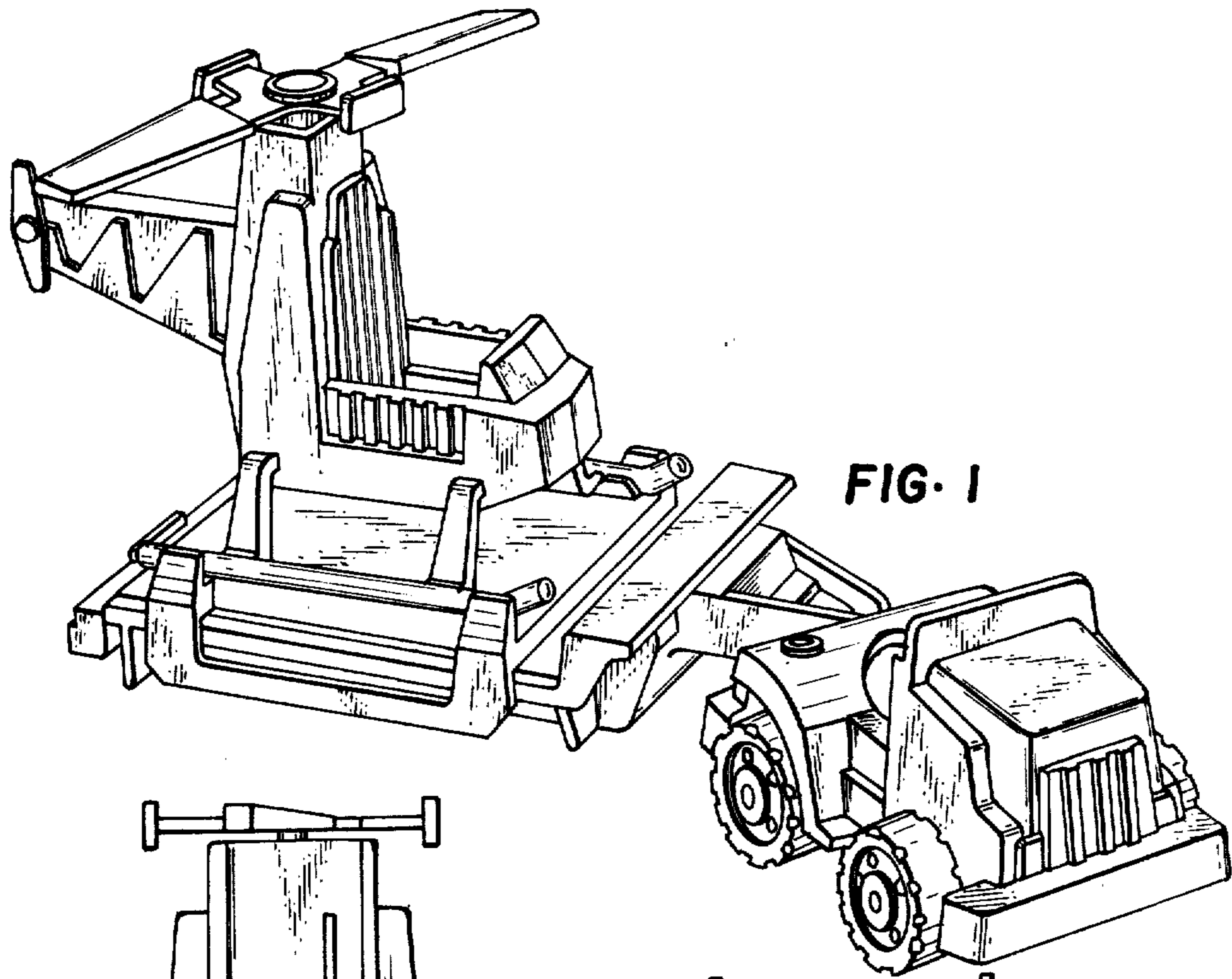

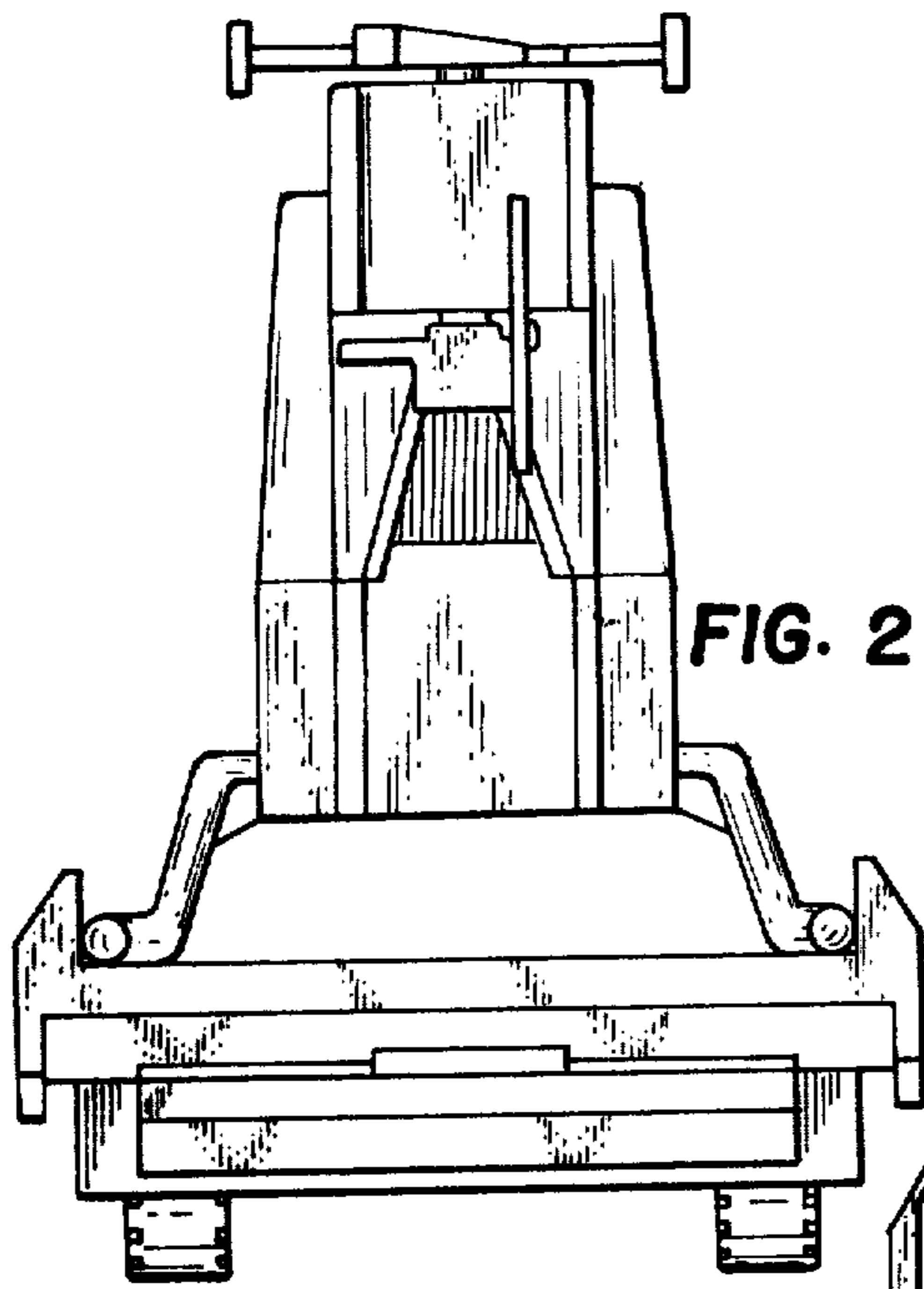

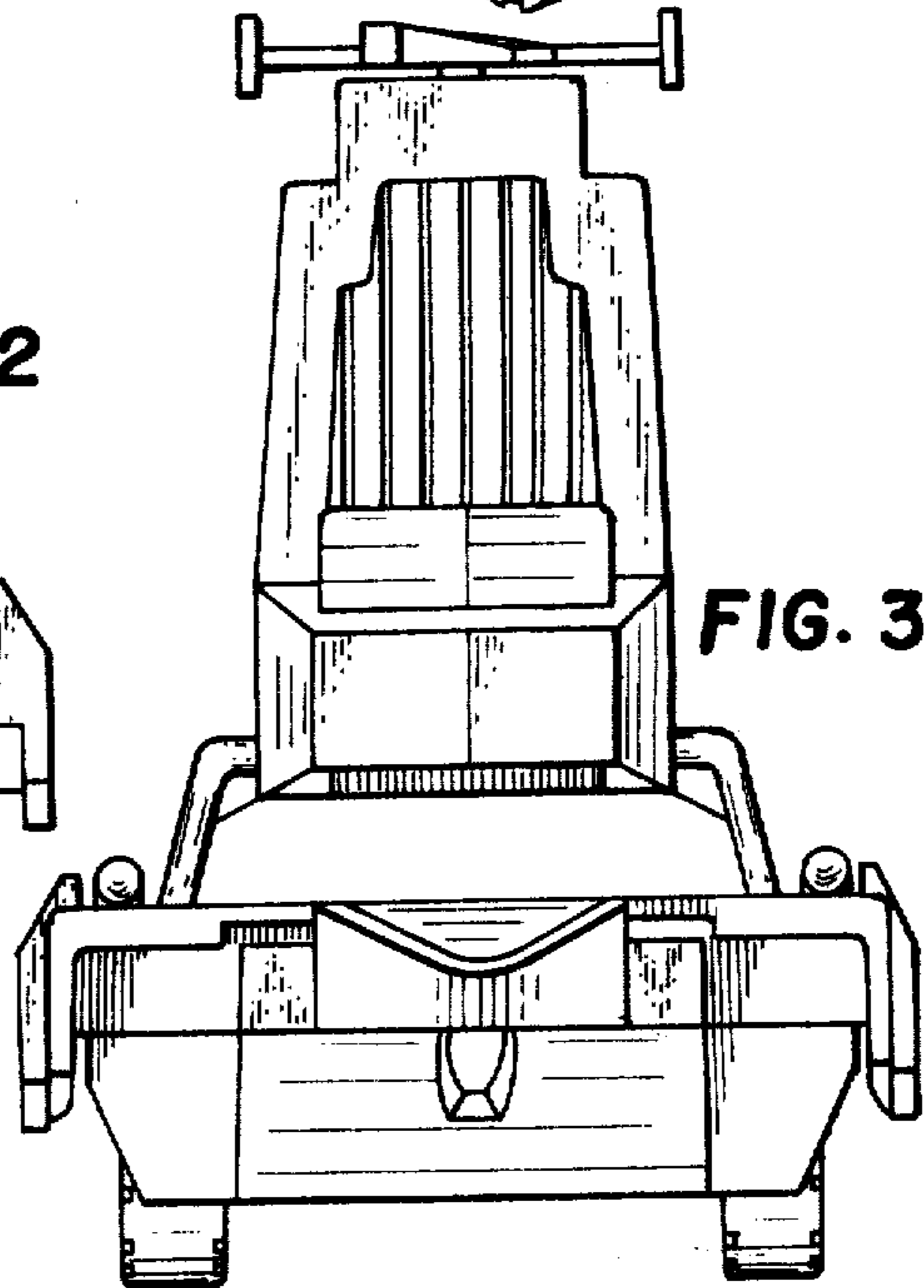

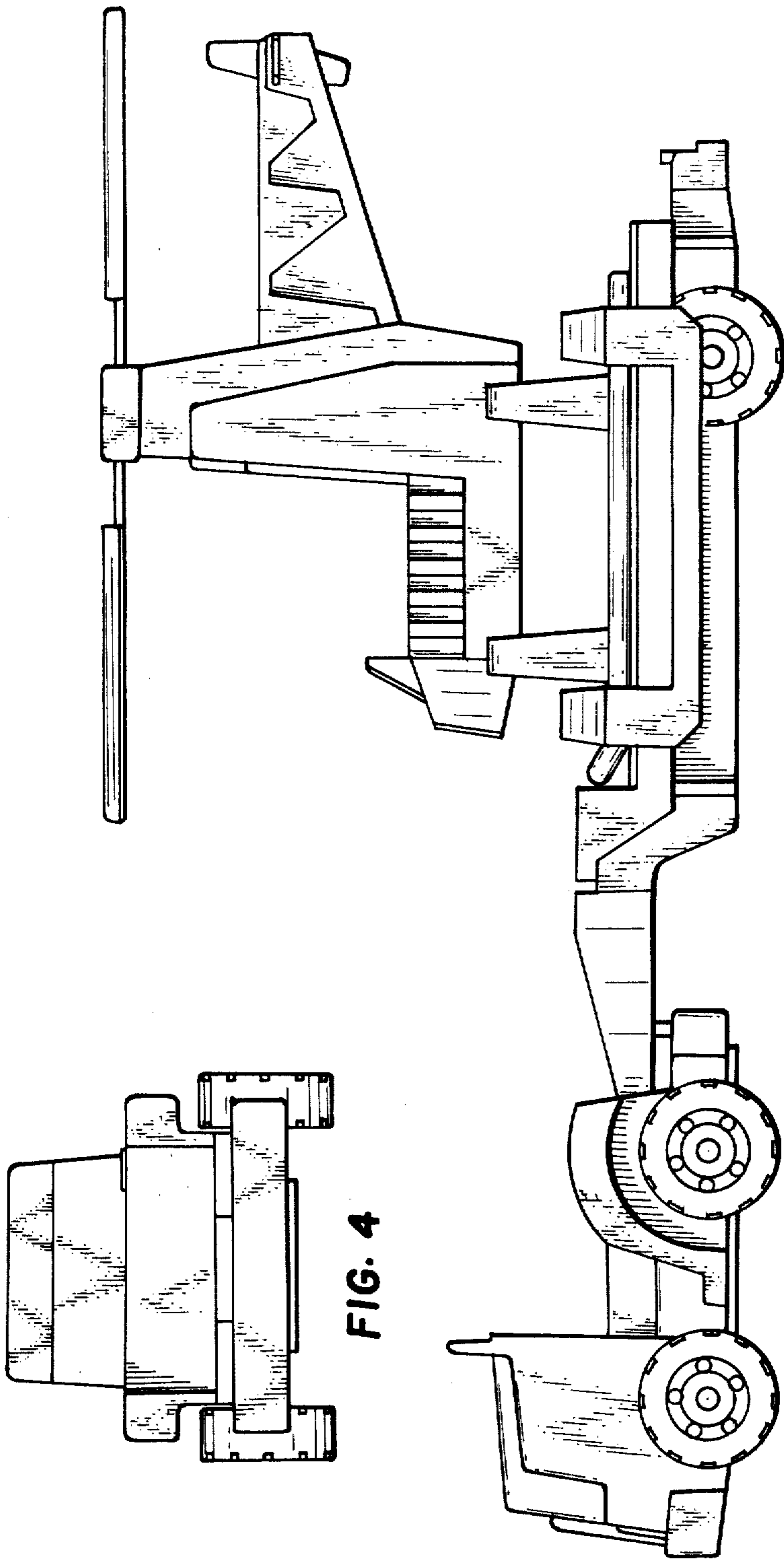

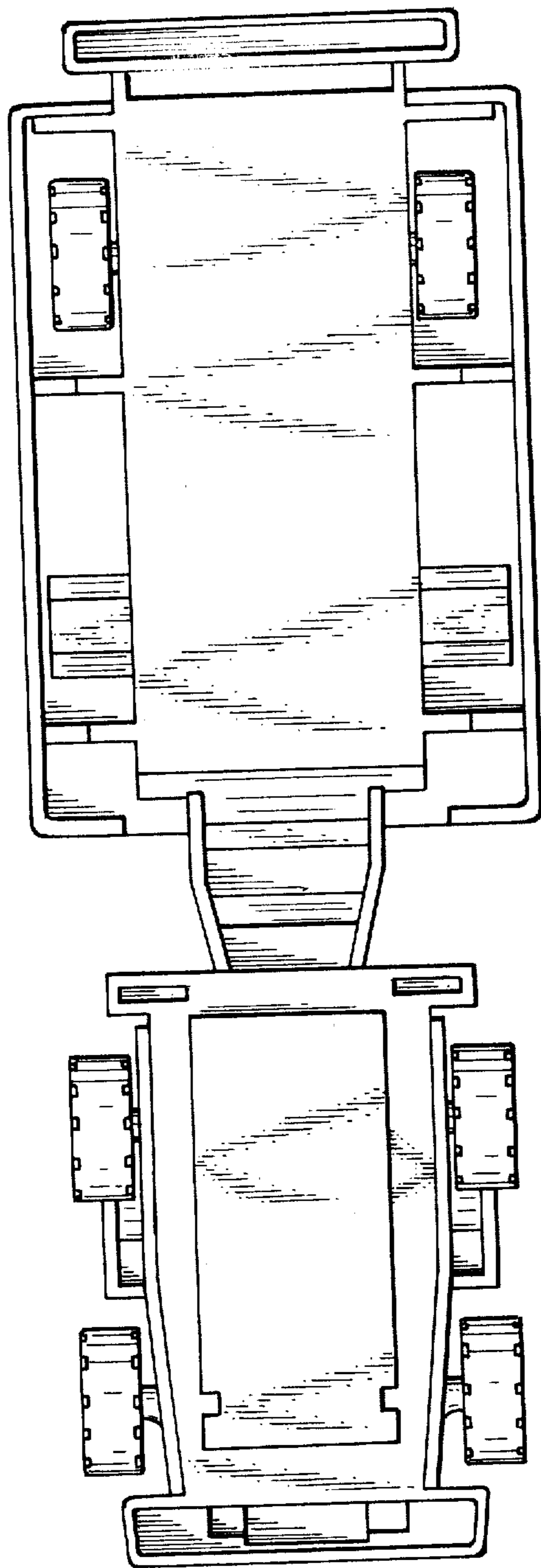
