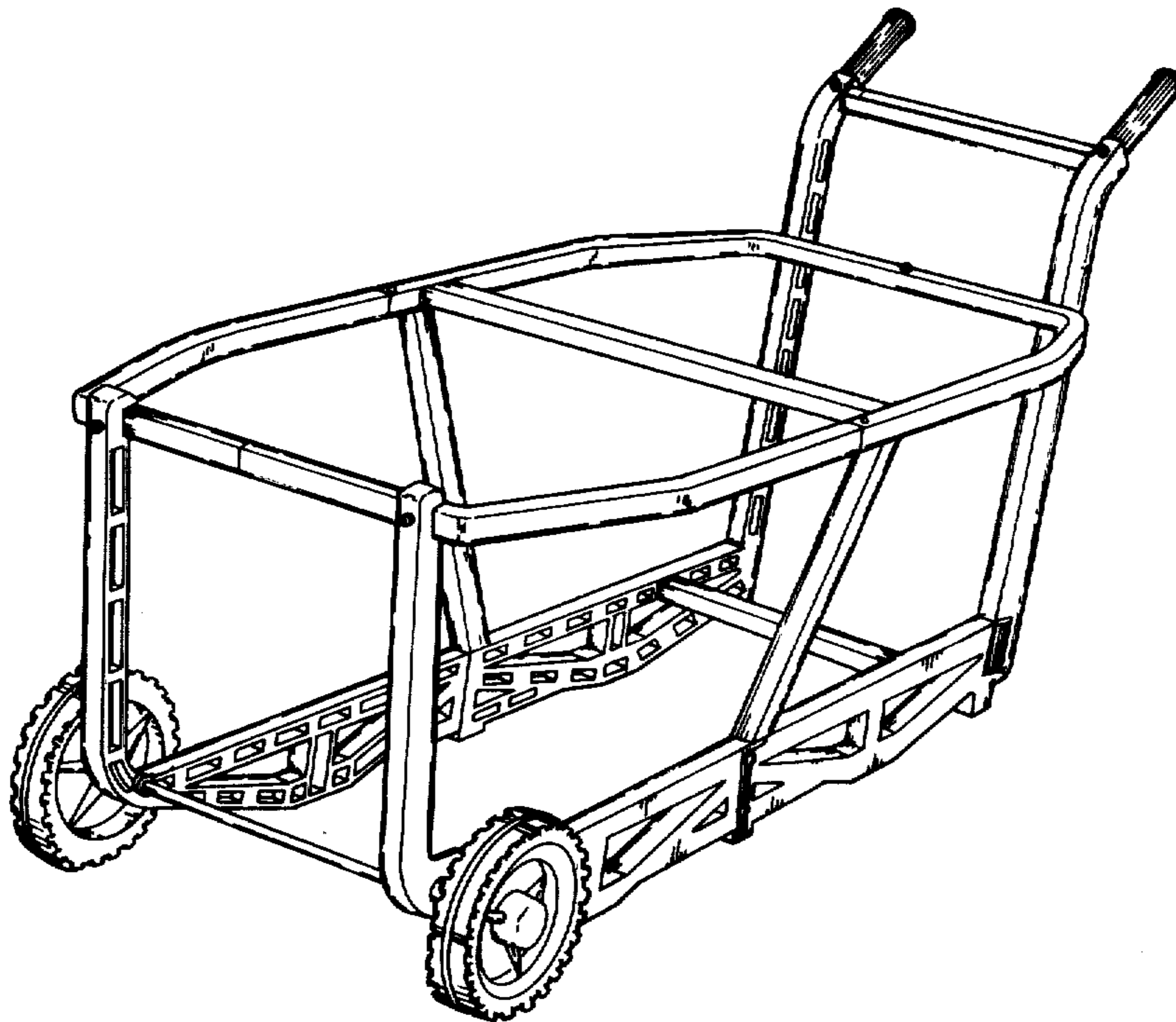

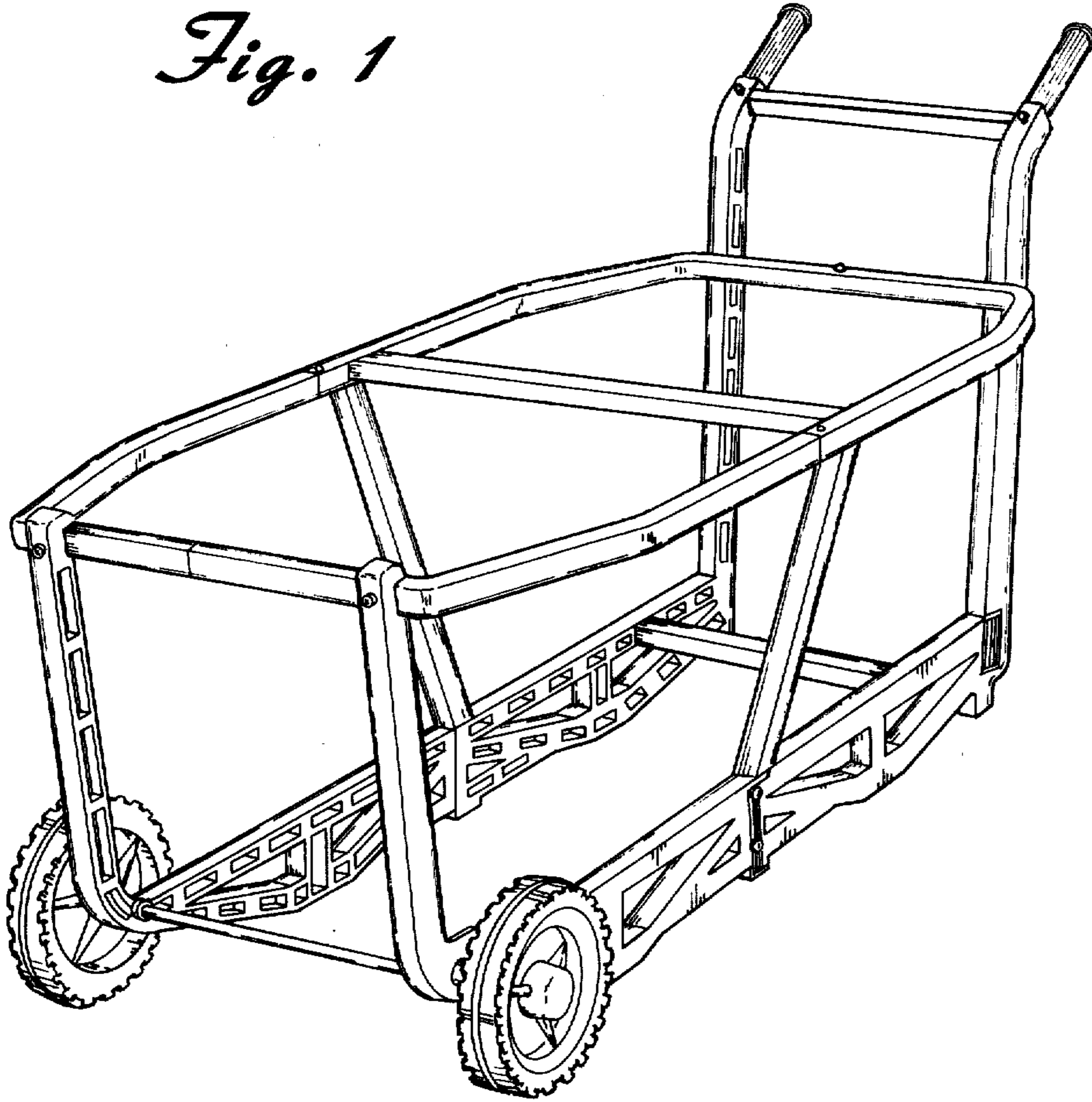
The ornamental design for a trash cart, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

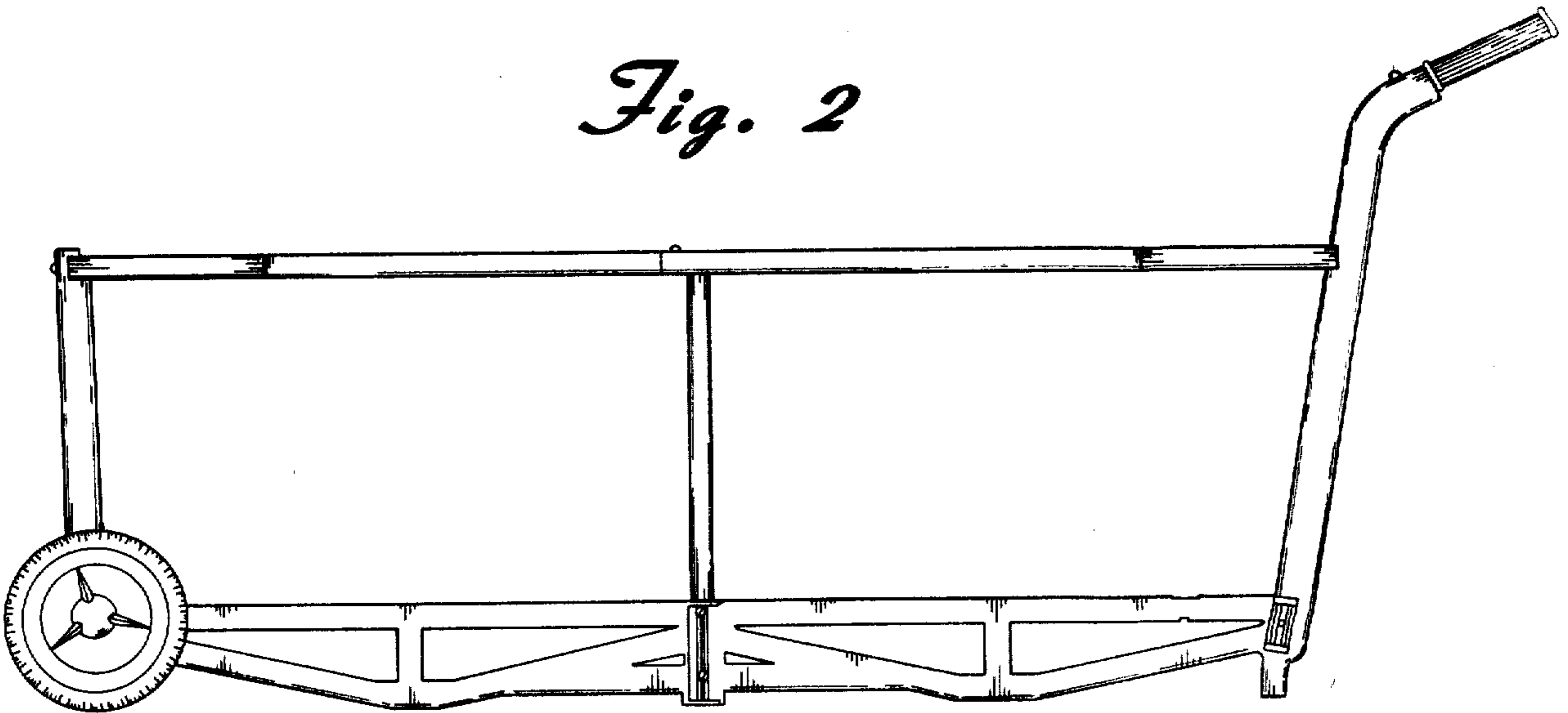
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a "trash cart" showing our new design;

The left side, not shown, is a mirror image of the right side shown in FIG. 2.



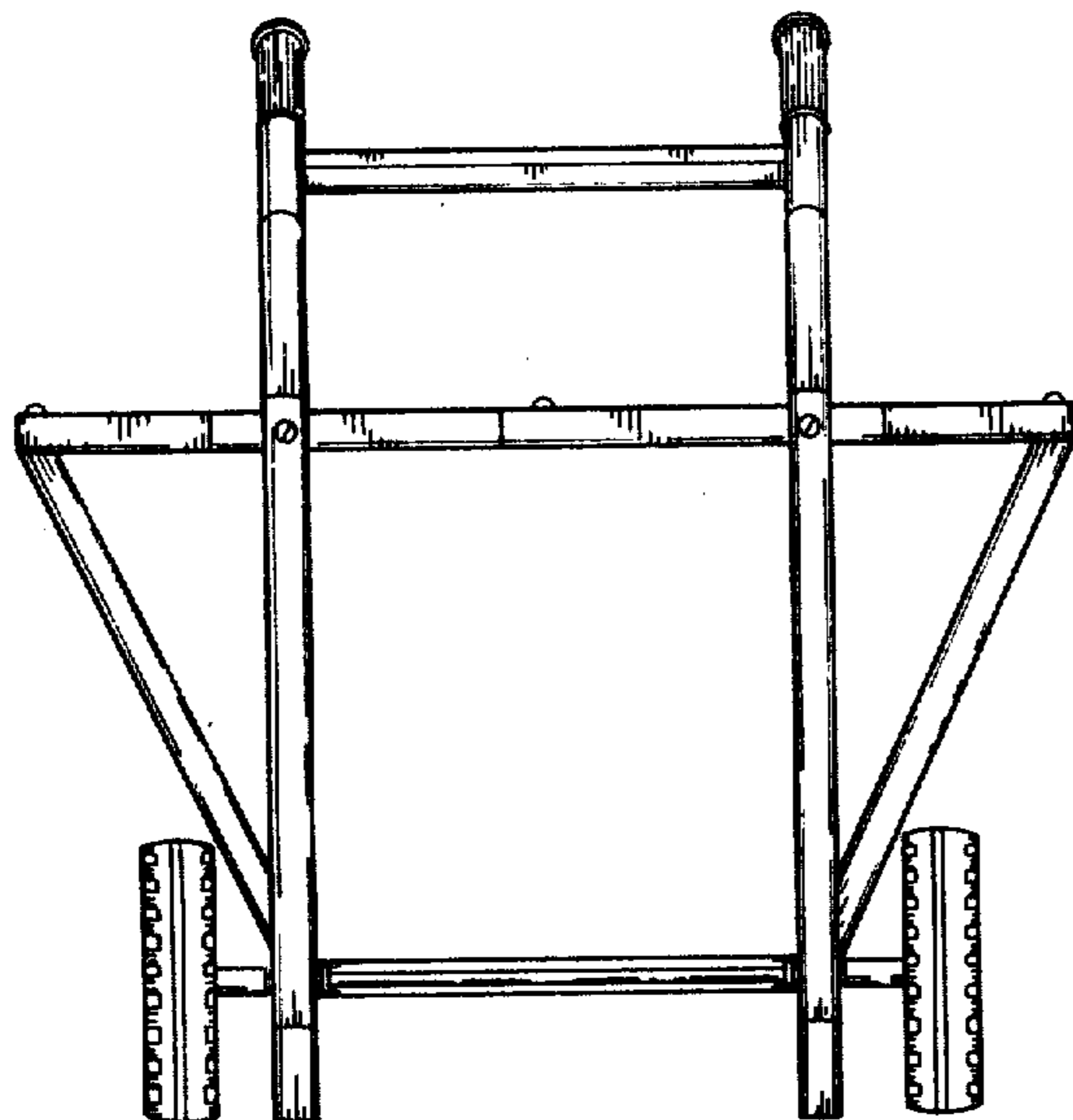

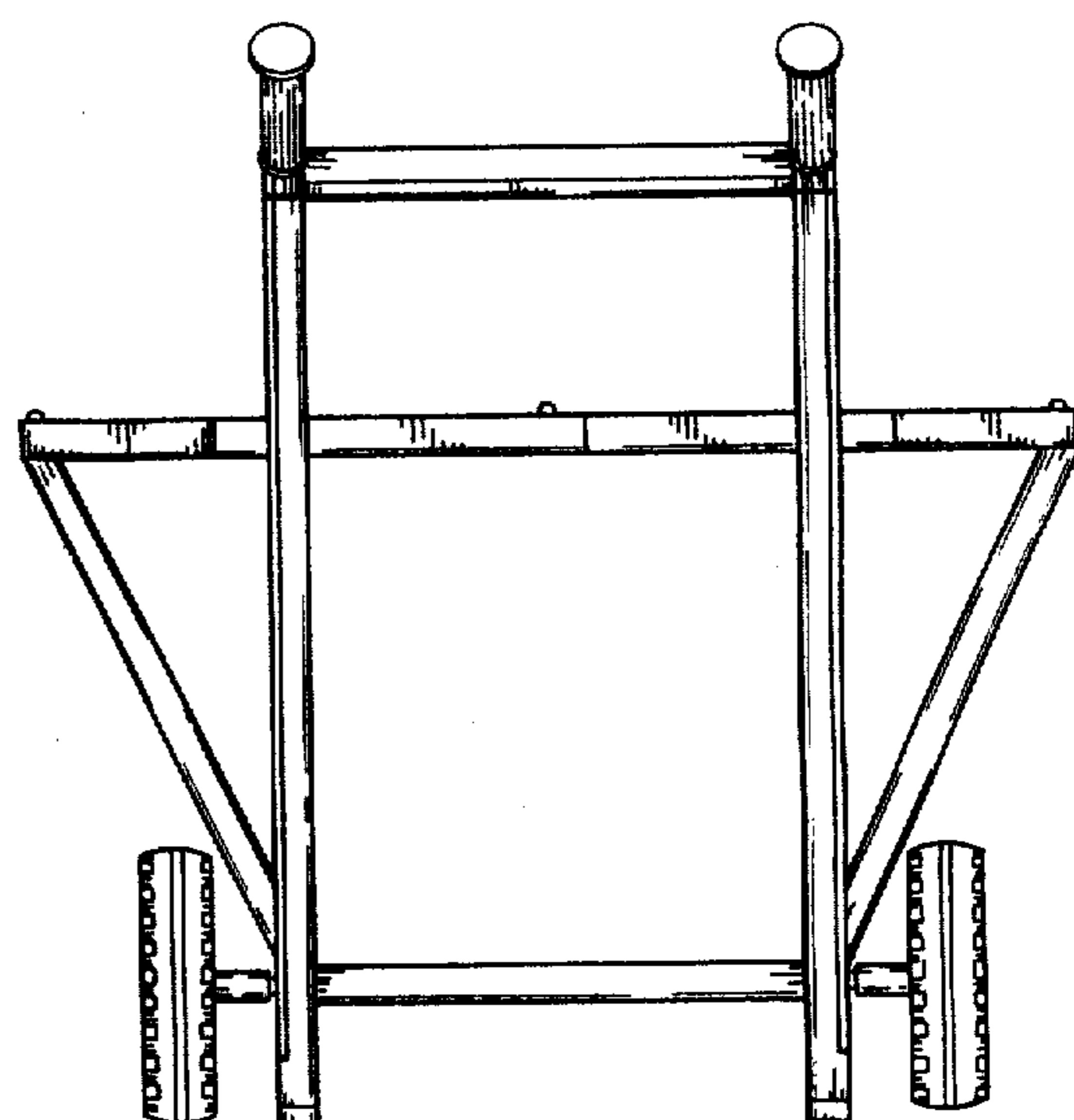
