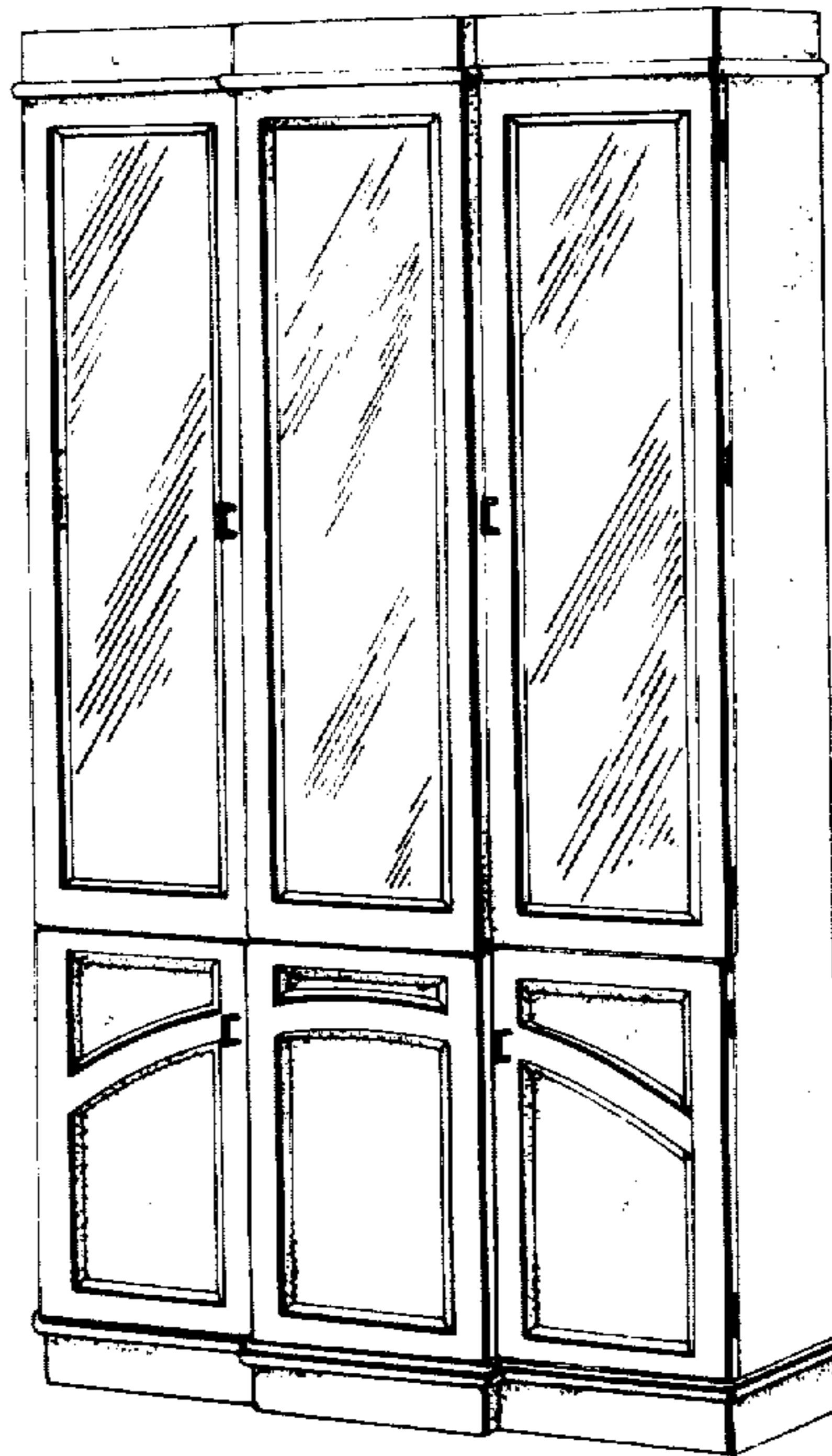

The ornamental design for a china cabinet or the like, as  
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the china cabinet  
or the like showing my new design, the rear and top  
thereof being substantially plain and unornamented; and  
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the oppo-  
site side being substantially a mirror image of that  
shown.



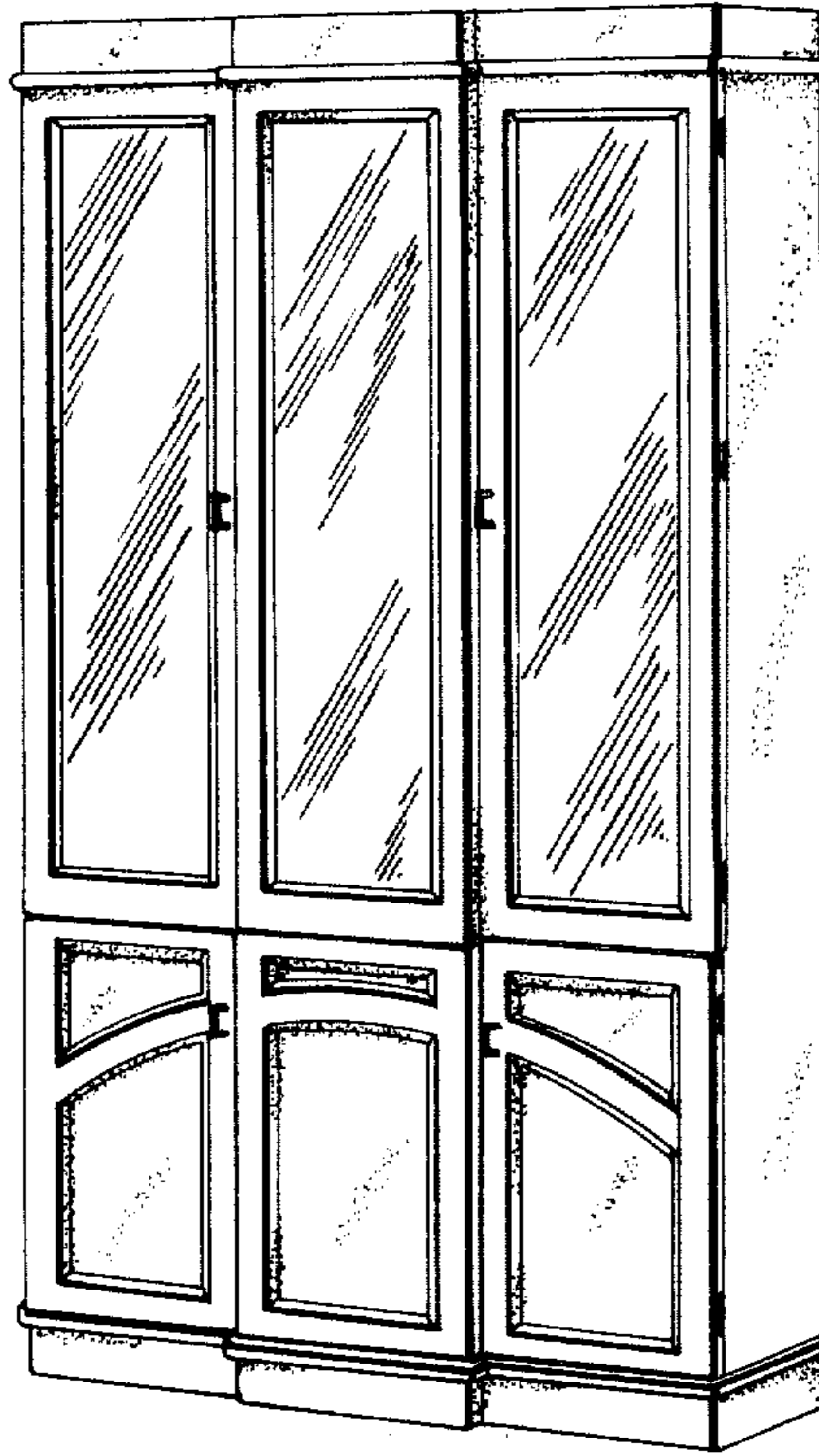

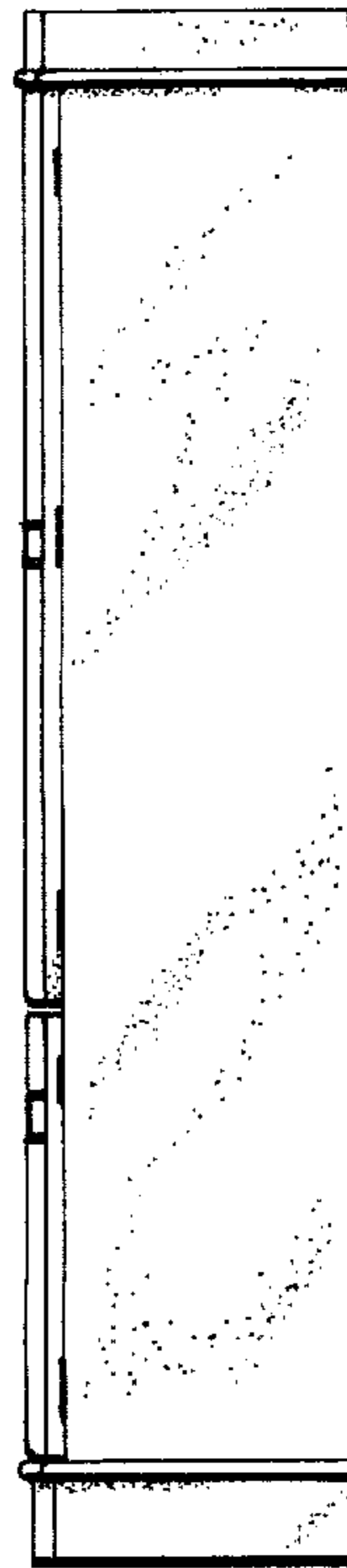
