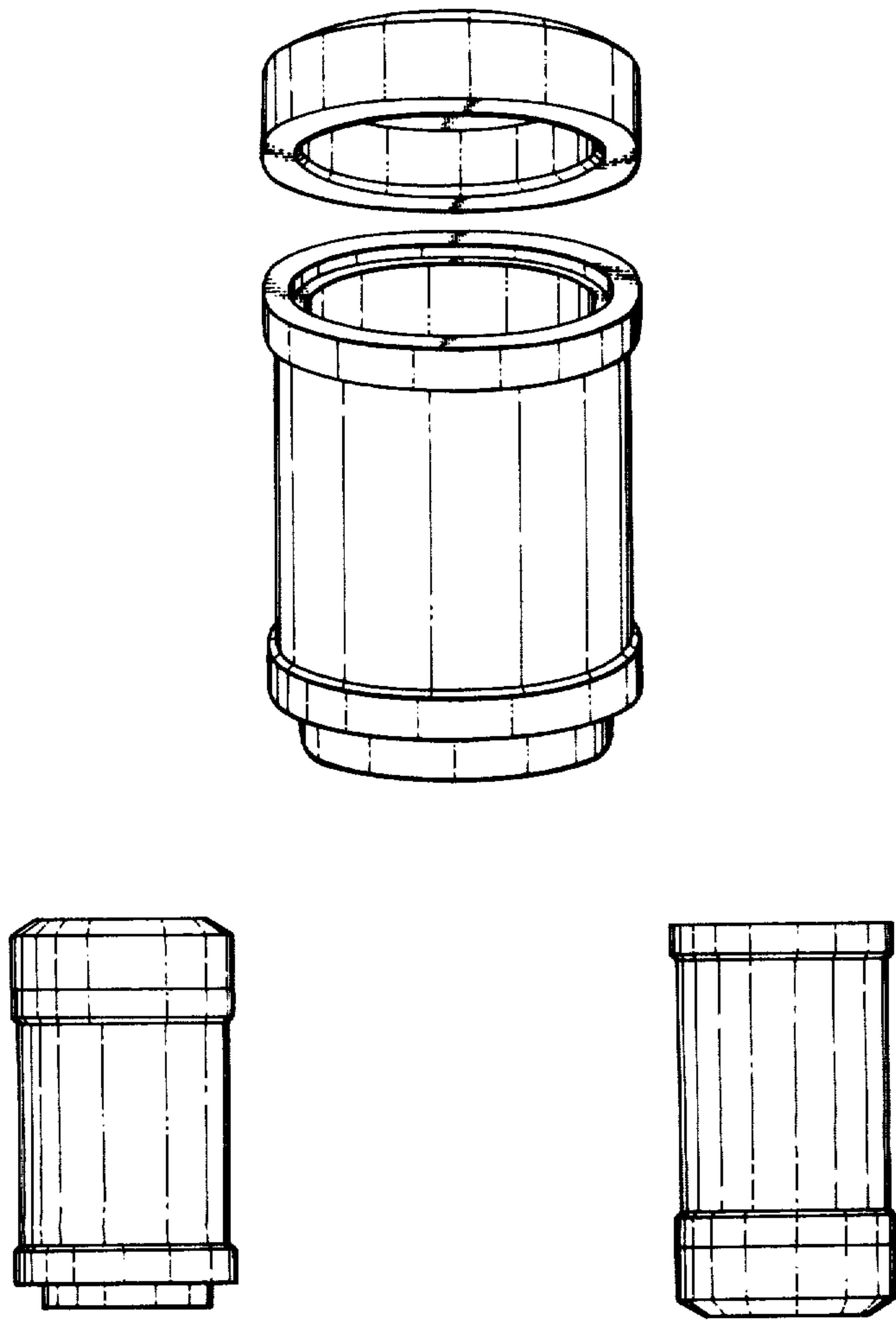
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[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for an insulated can holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of an insulated can holder showing my new design, FIG. 2 is a side elevational view with the cap in operative position, all side elevational views being identical thereto, FIG. 3 is a top plan view, FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view, and FIG. 5 is a side elevational view with the cap mounted upon the underside of the base, all side elevational views being identical thereto.



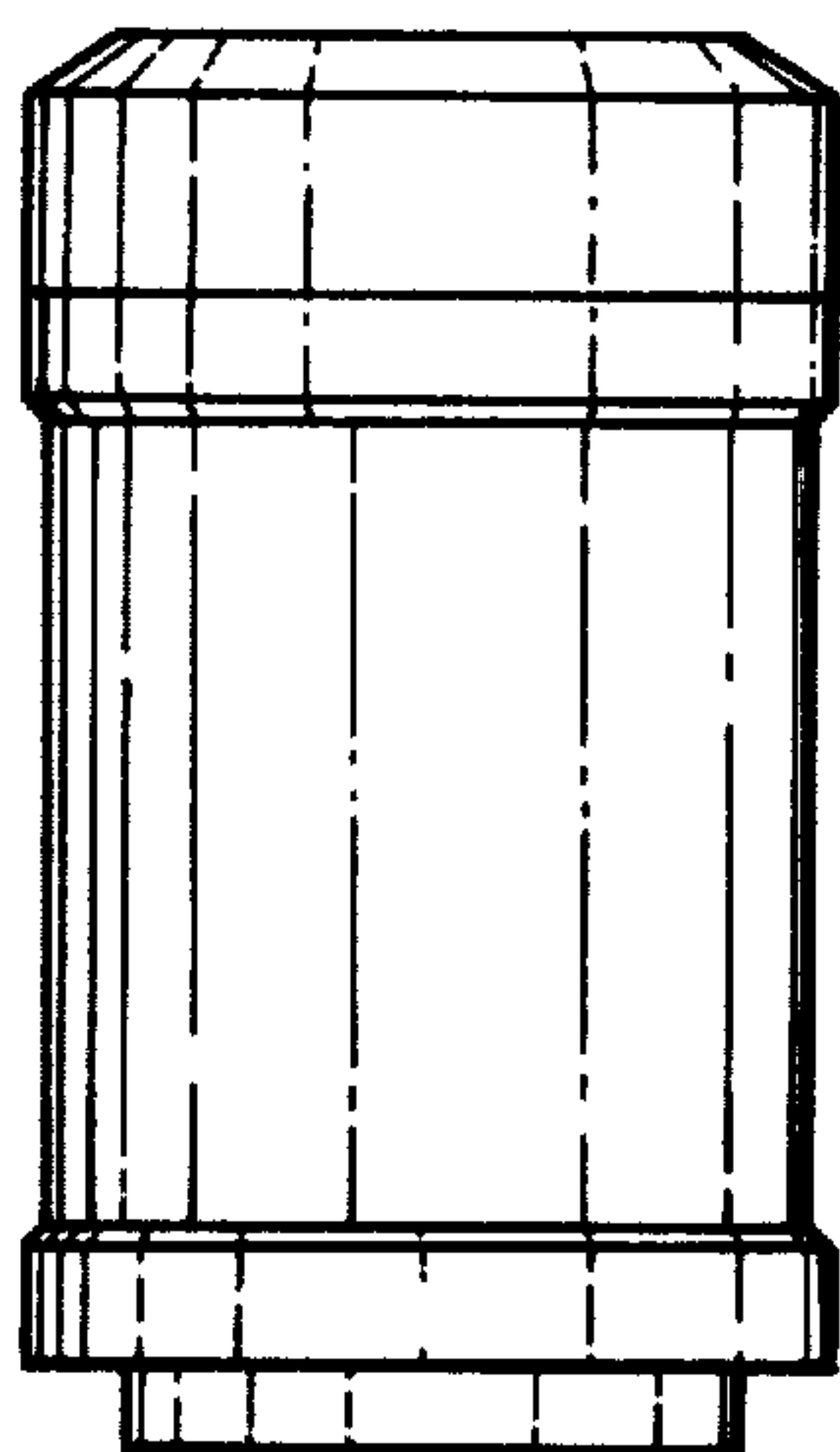

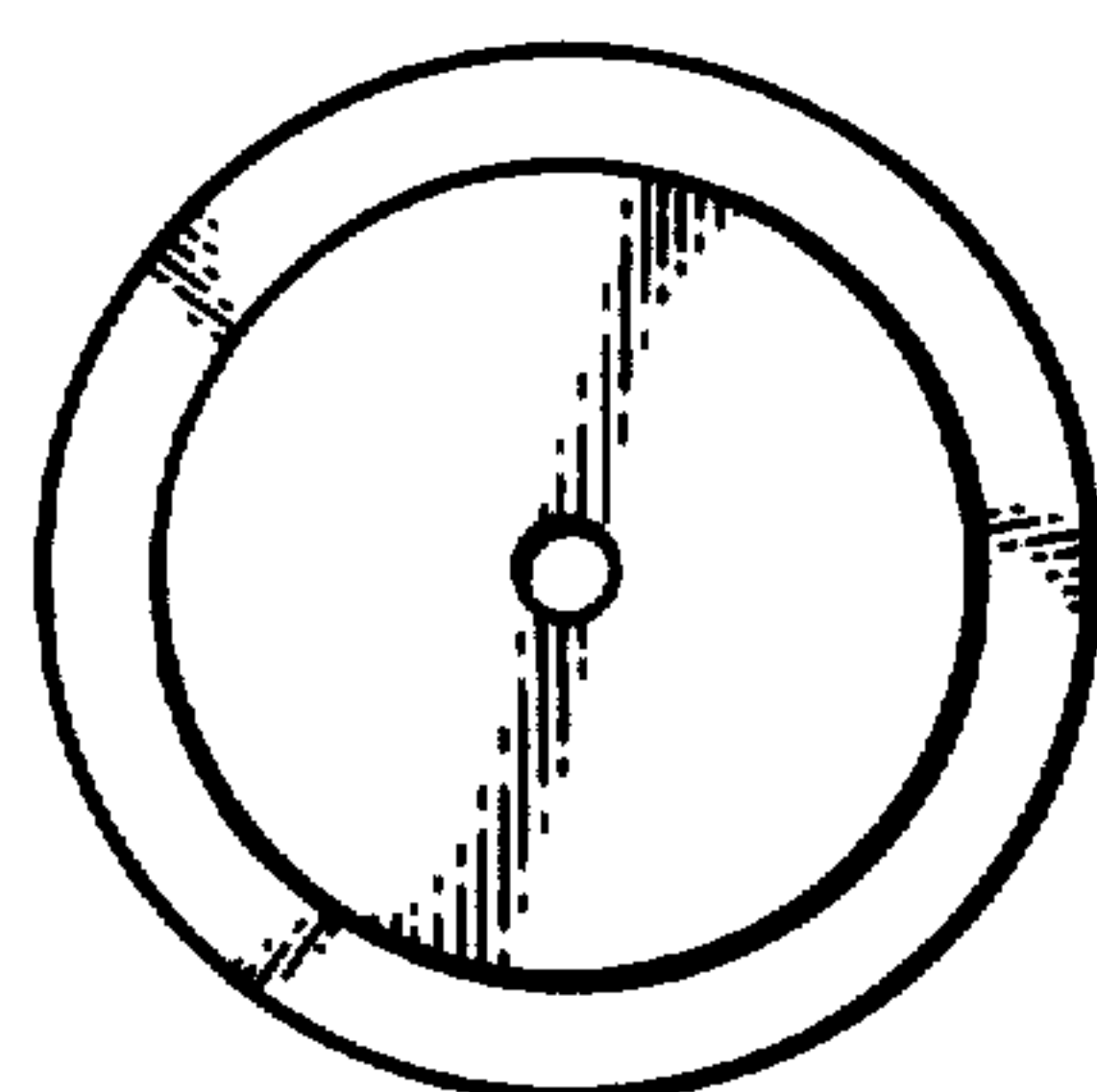

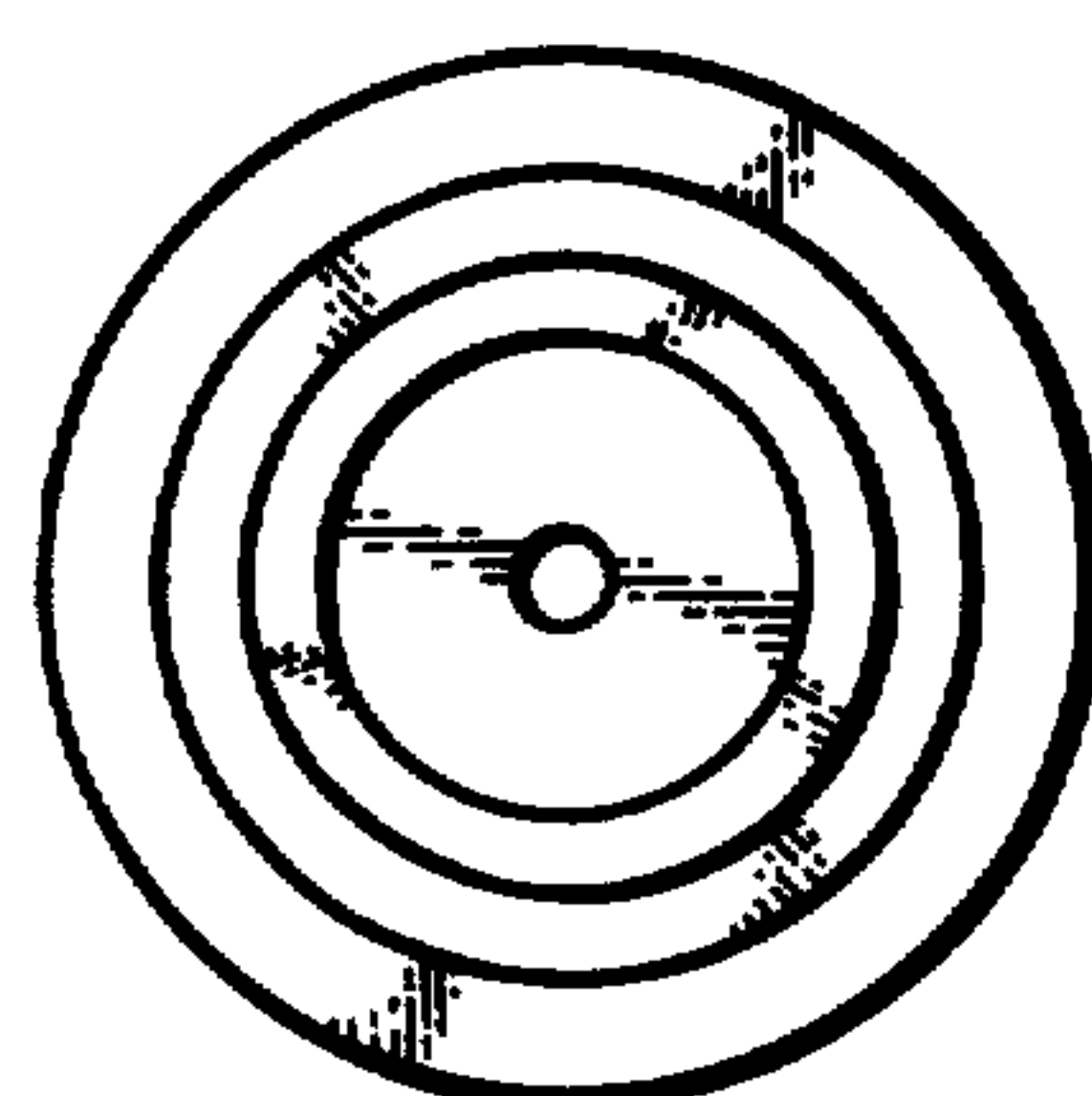

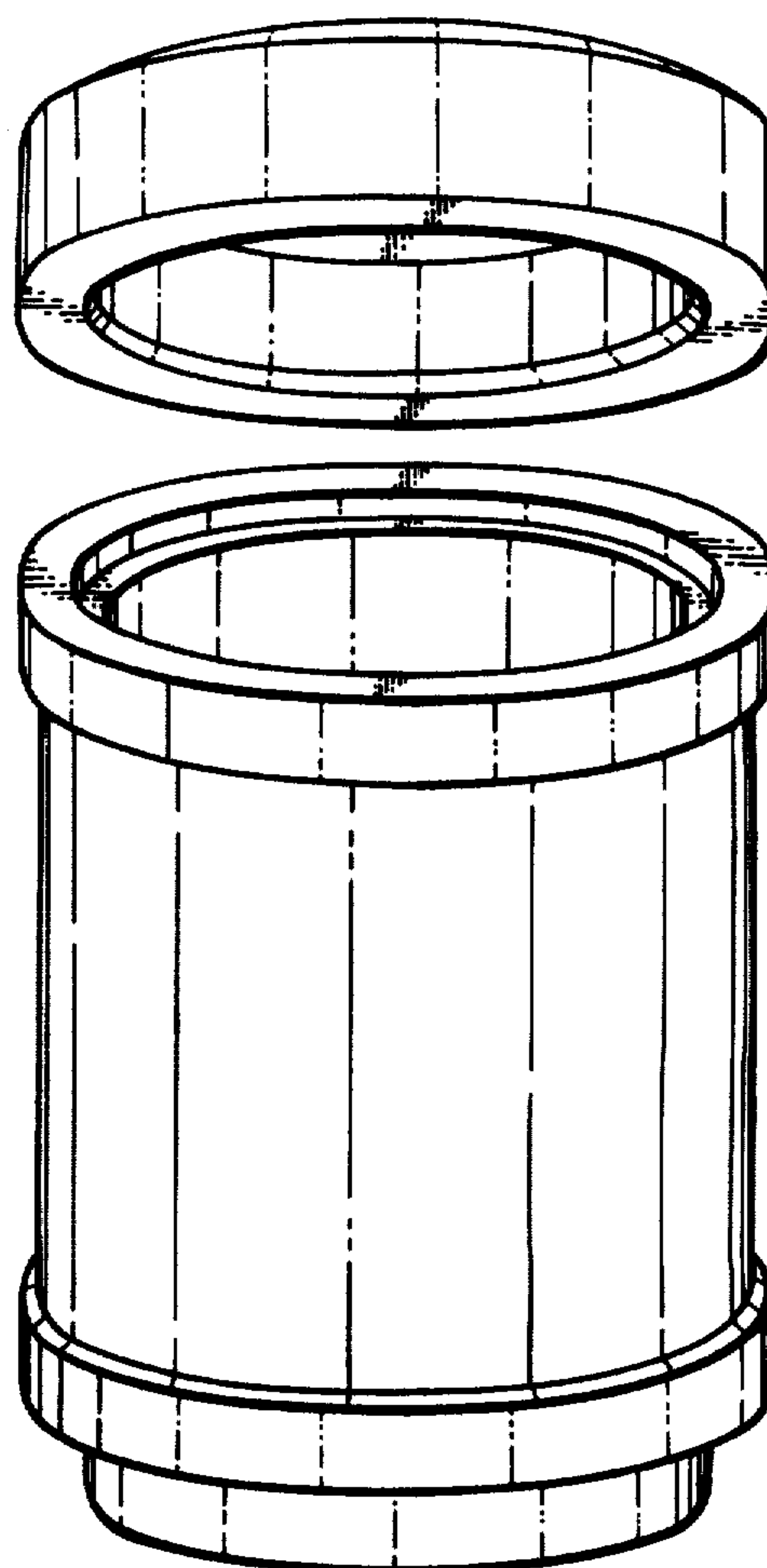

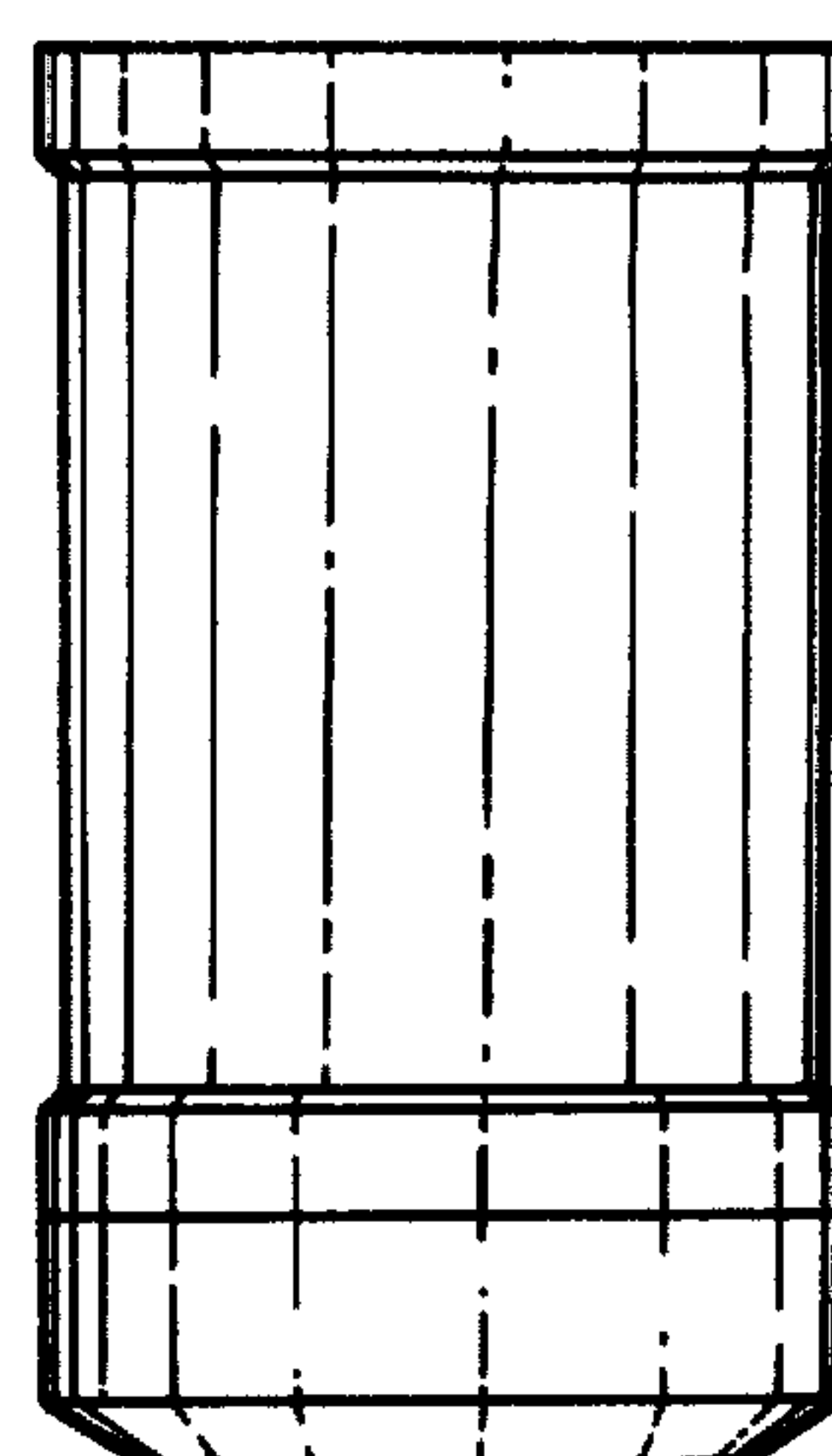
