[57] **CLAIM**

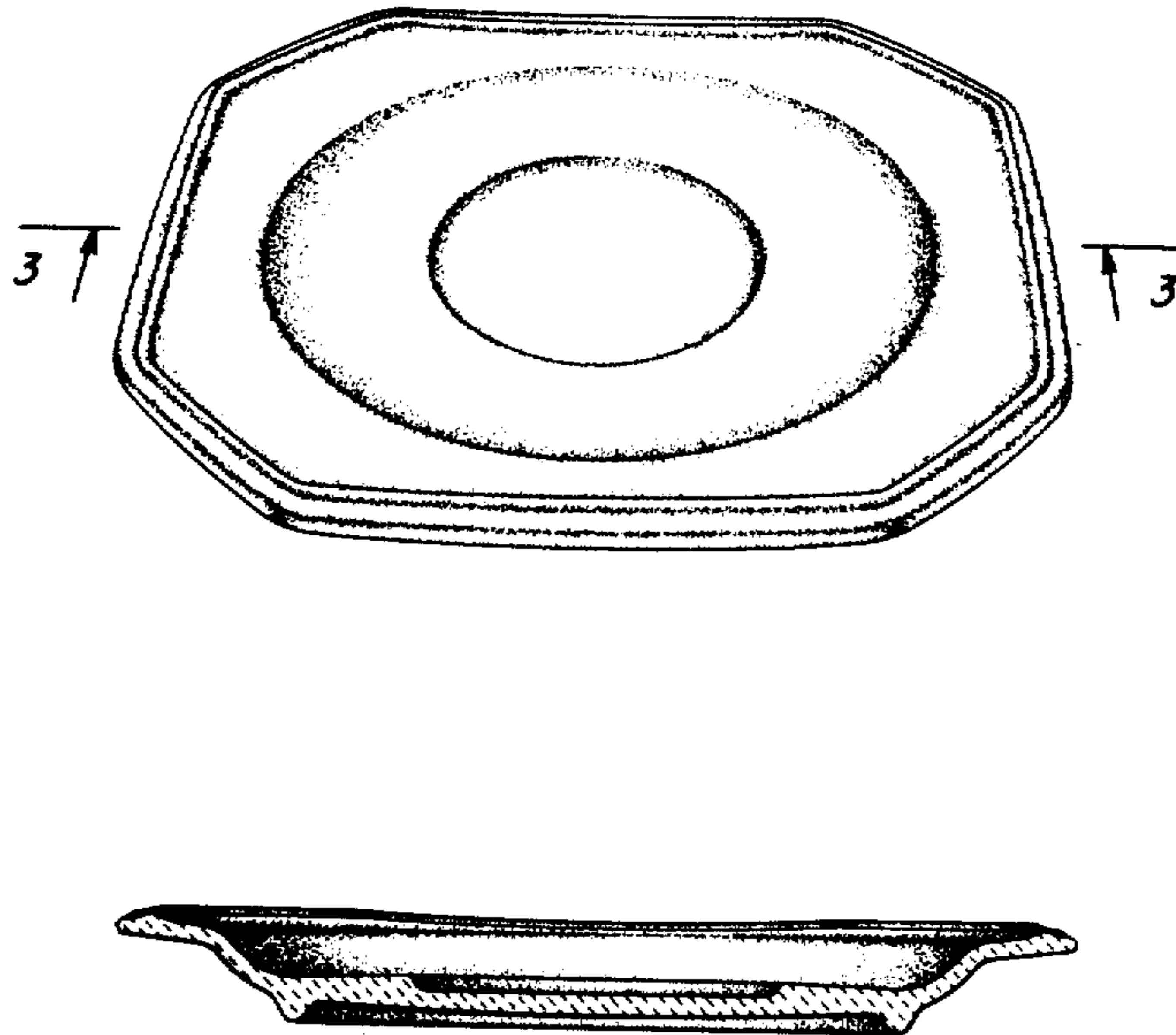
The ornamental design for a saucer, as shown, and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a saucer showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite and adjacent sides being the same in appearance; and

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken on the line 3—3 in FIG. 1.



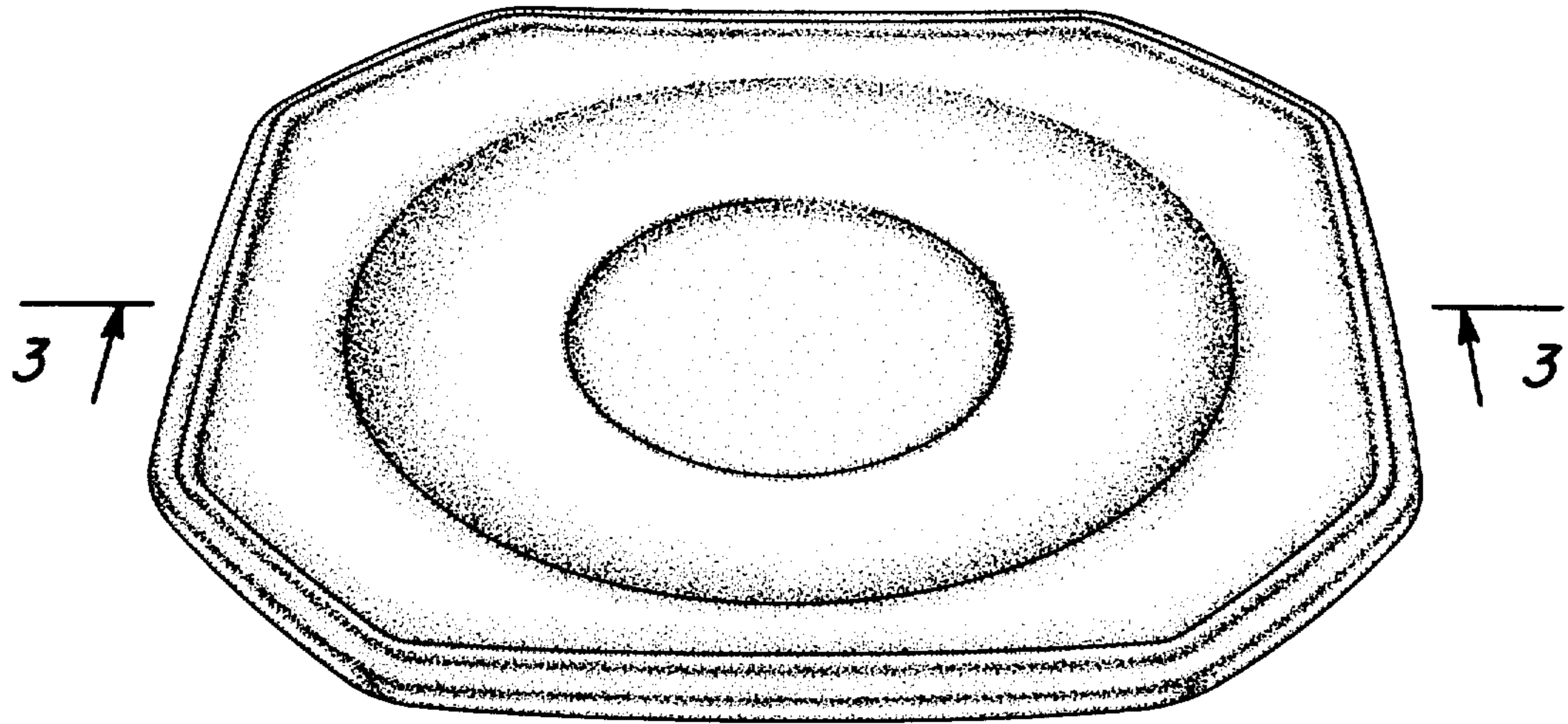

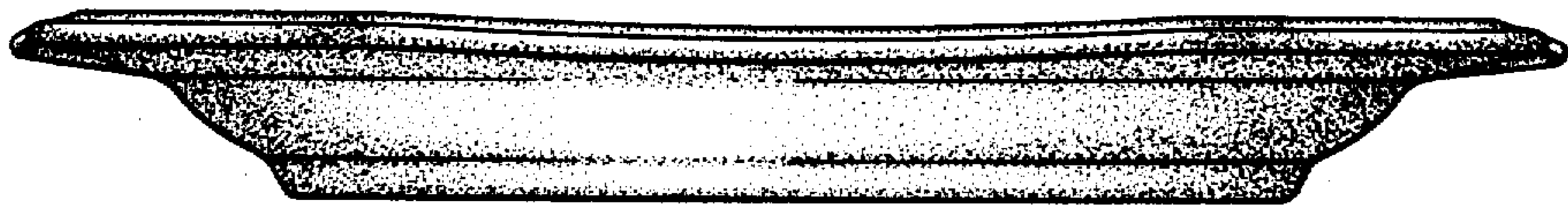

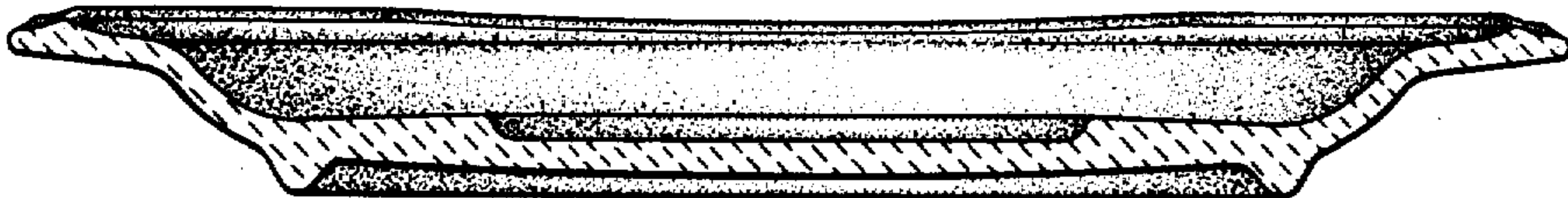
