[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wristwatch, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wristwatch showing my new design in a non-activated condition;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right, front perspective view thereof in an activated condition showing a typical time indication of 10:08.42 AM.










