FIG. 3 is a side perspective view thereof.

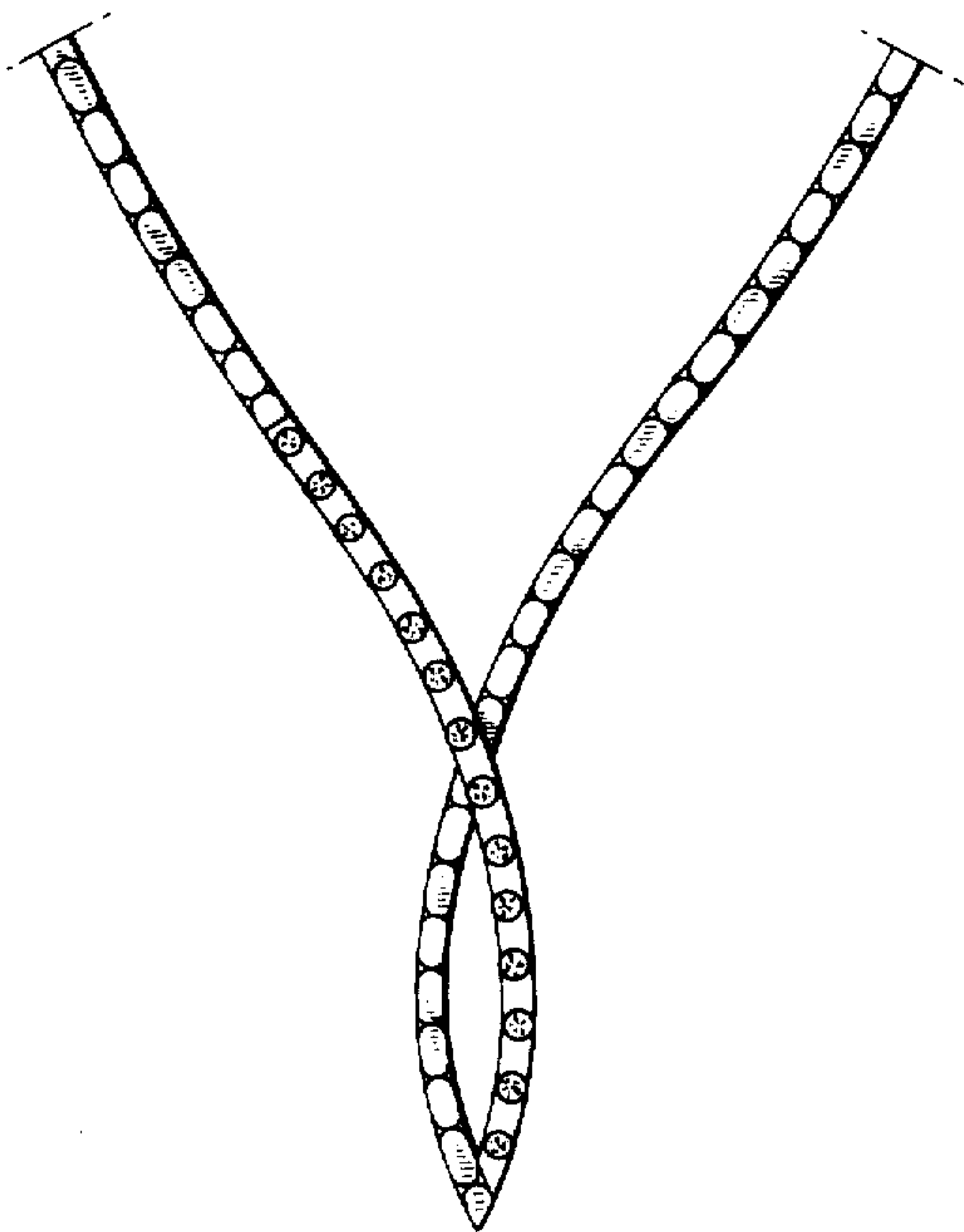

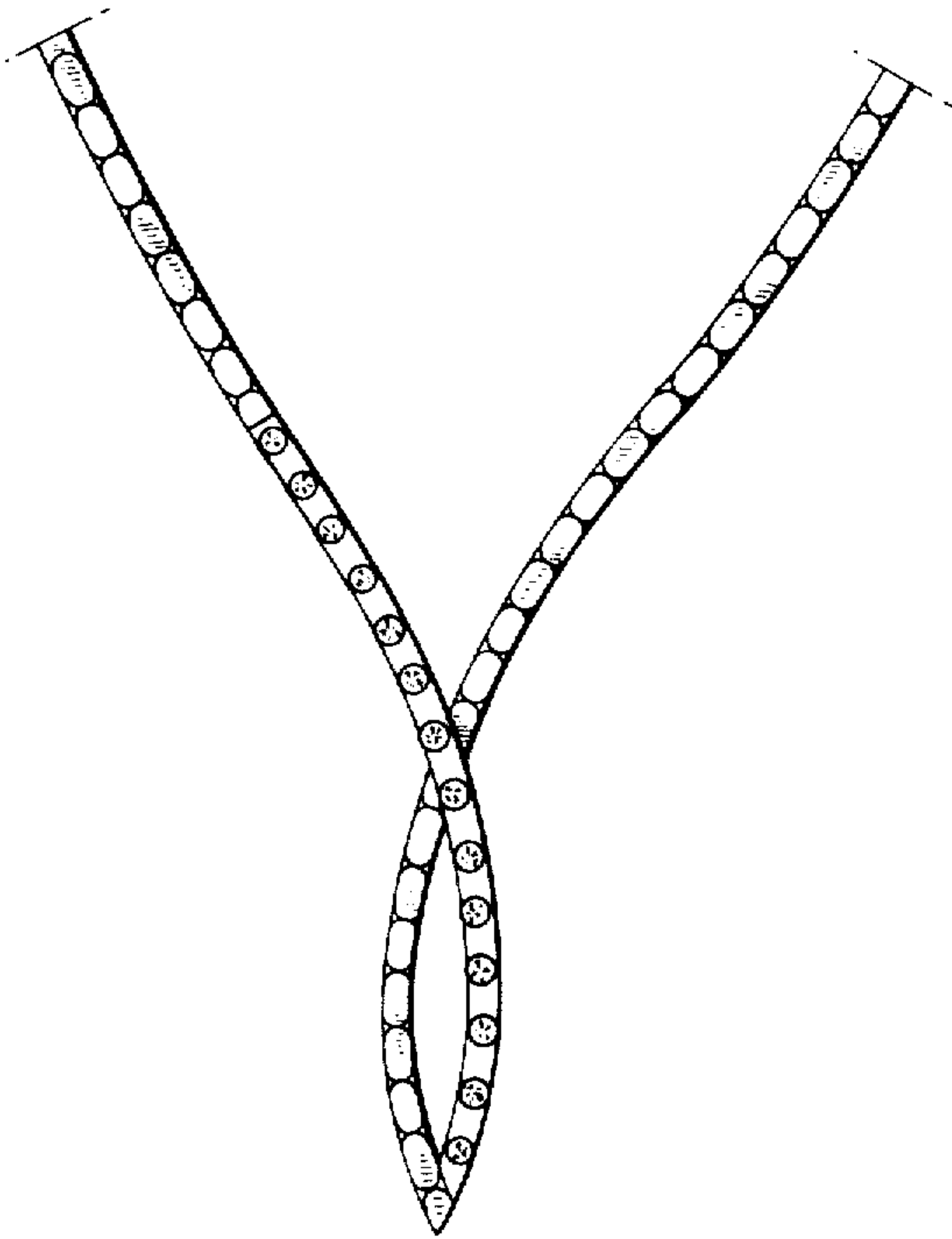

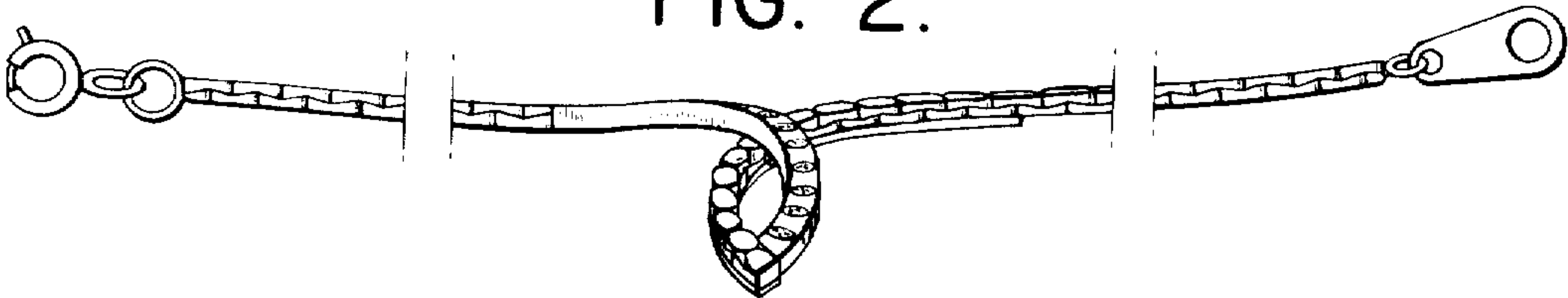
