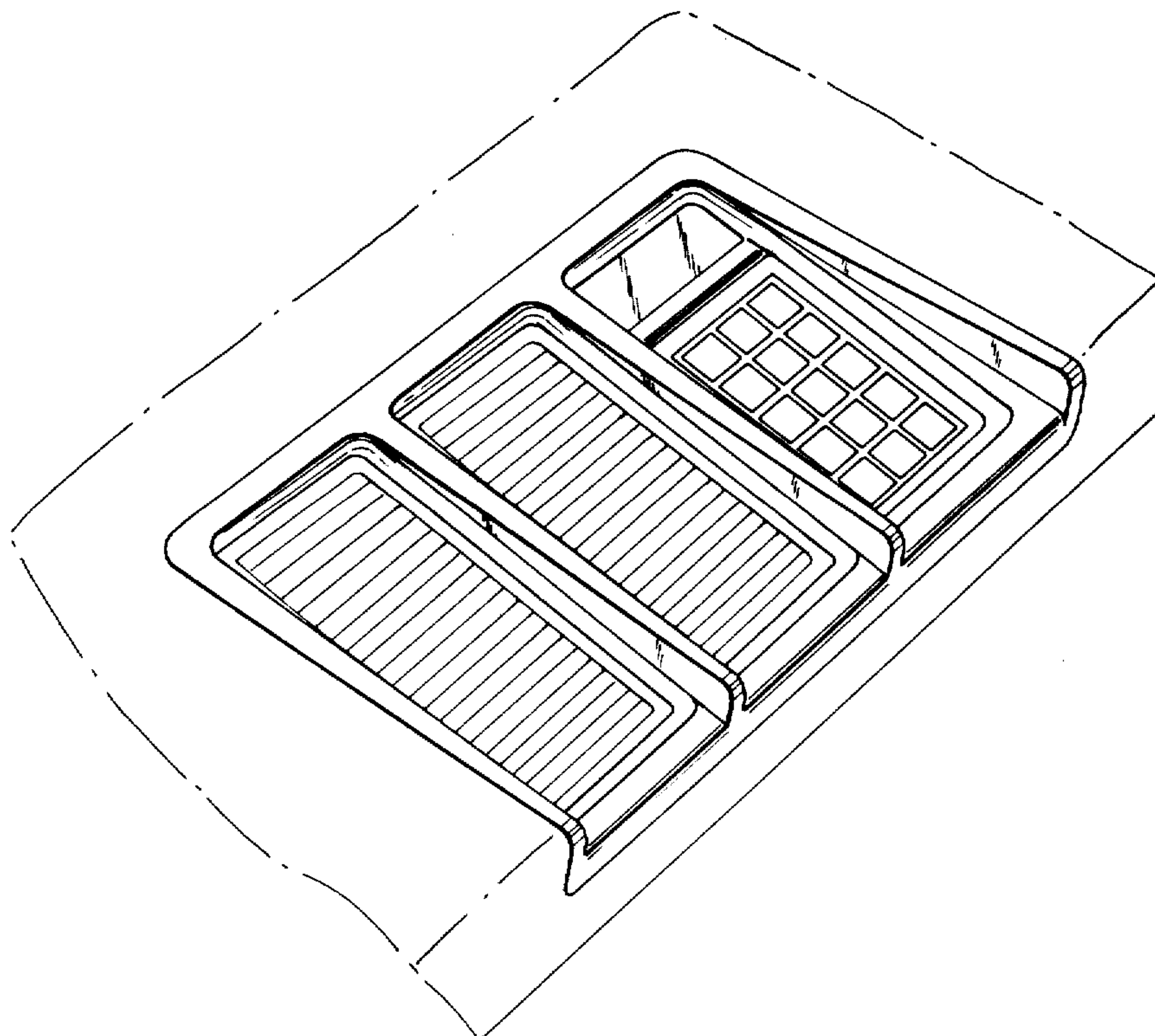

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined shelf index and keyboard for a file retrieval system showing my new design. The broken line showing of a shelf is environment only.



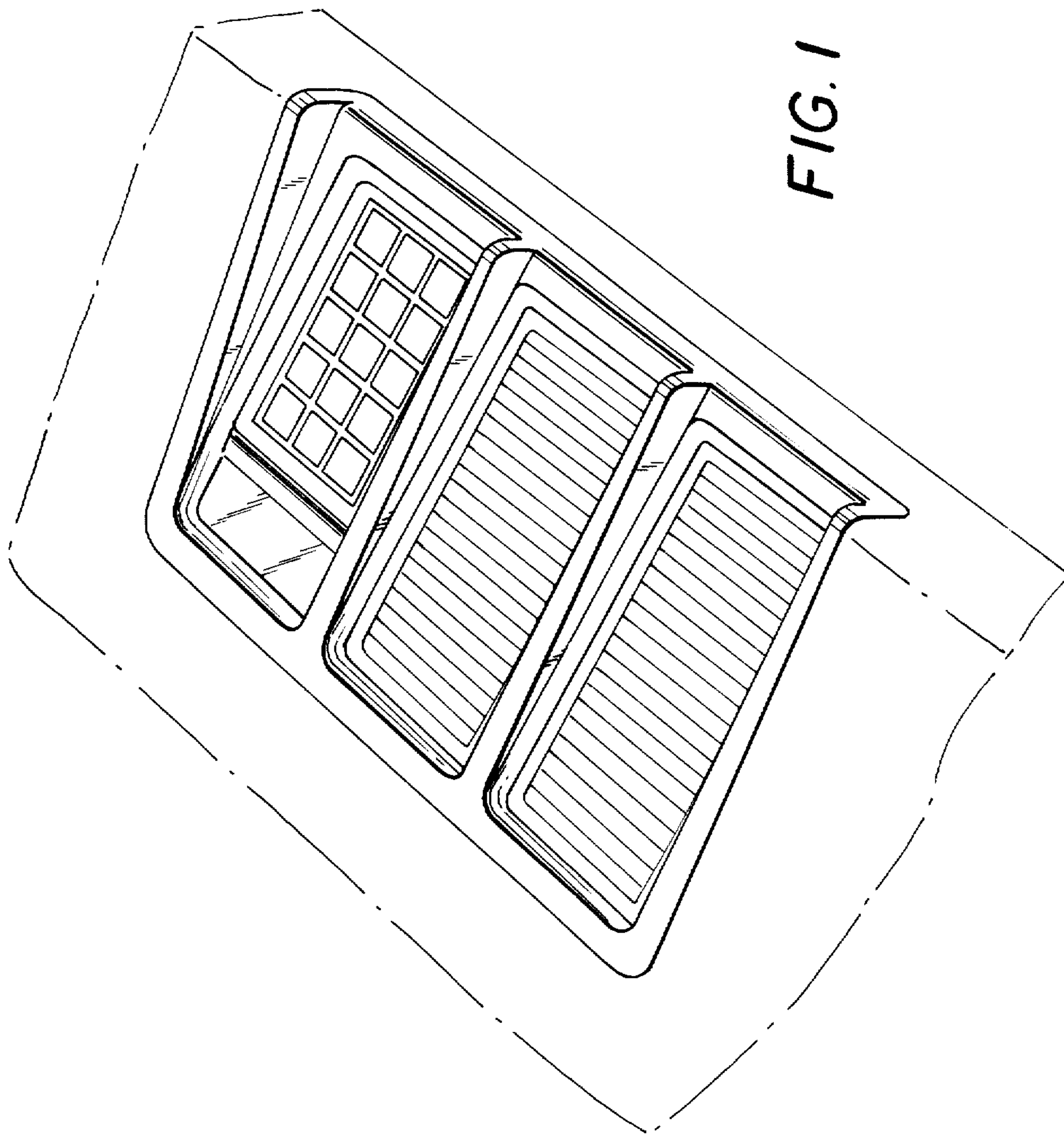
