[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a manually held body massager, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a manually held body massager showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevation thereof;
FIG. 4 is an elevation of the side opposite FIG. 3;
FIG. 5 is an elevation thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a fragmentary perspective view of a second modified embodiment of the form illustrated in FIG. 1;
FIG. 8 is a fragmentary perspective view of a third modified embodiment of the form illustrated in FIG. 1;
FIG. 9 is a fragmentary perspective view of a fourth modified embodiment of the form illustrated in FIG. 1; and
FIG. 10 is a fragmentary perspective view of a fifth modified embodiment in FIG. 1.

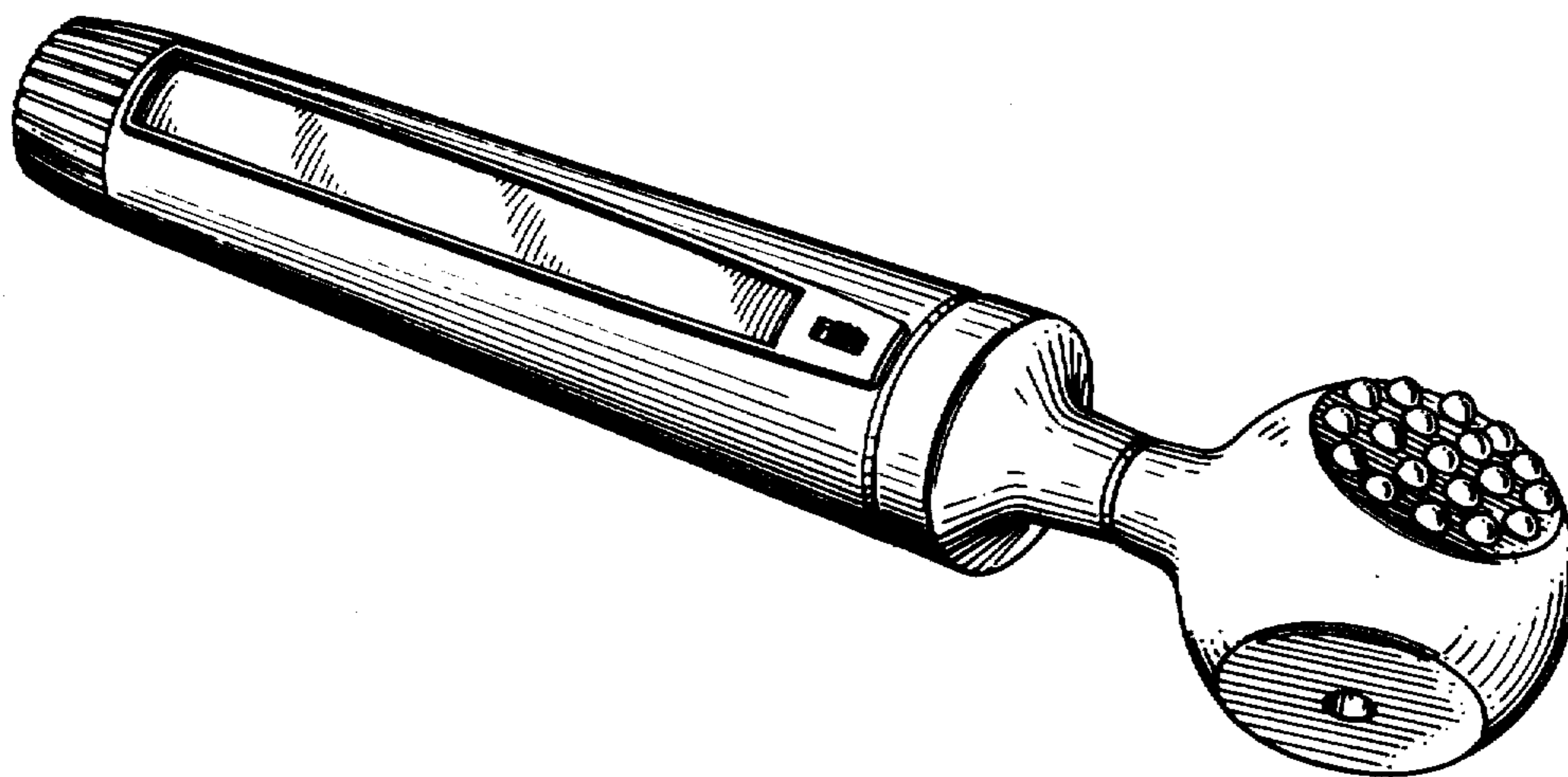

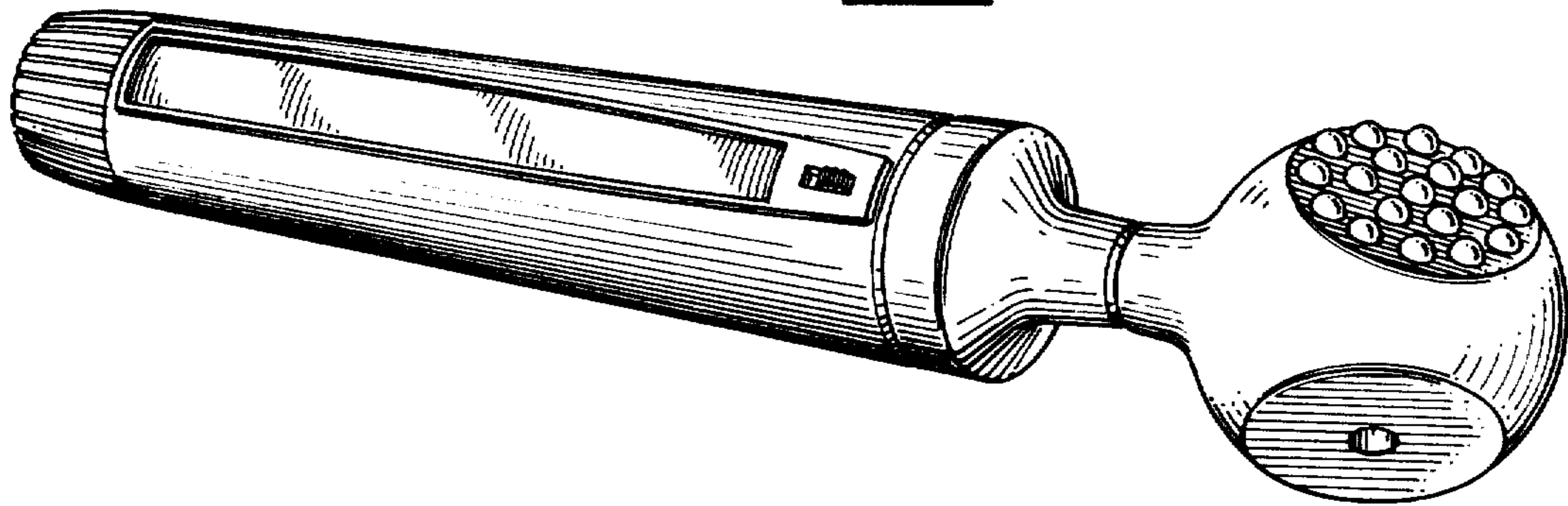

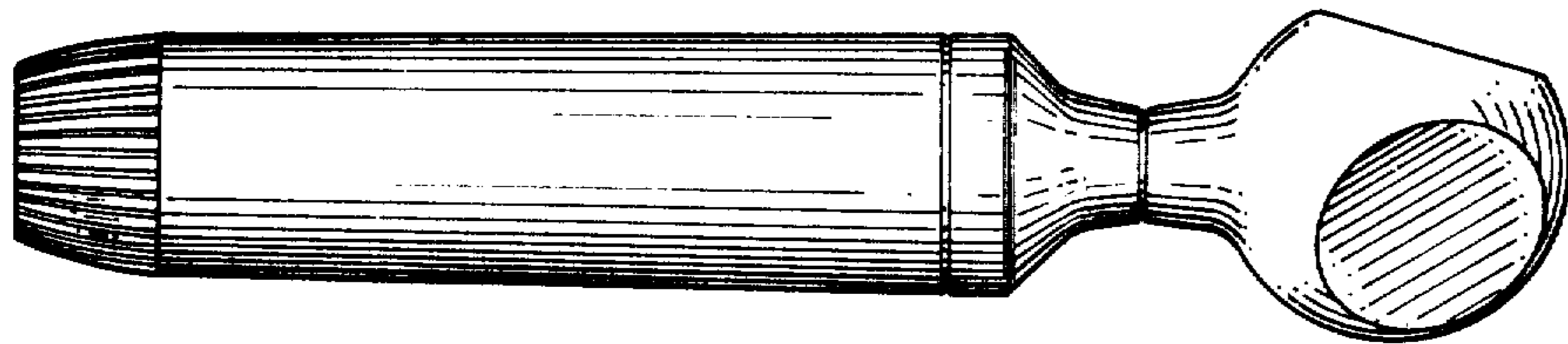

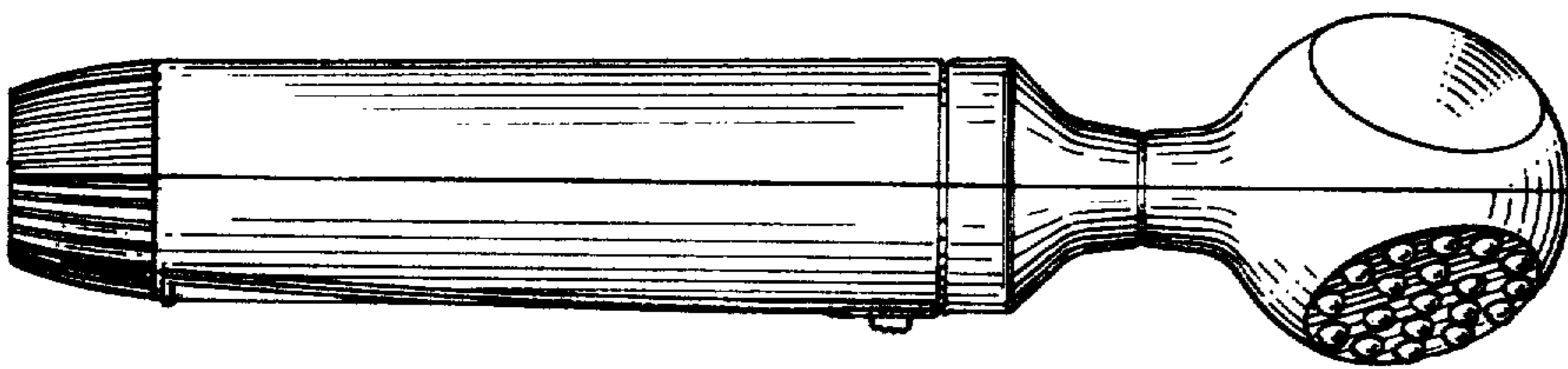

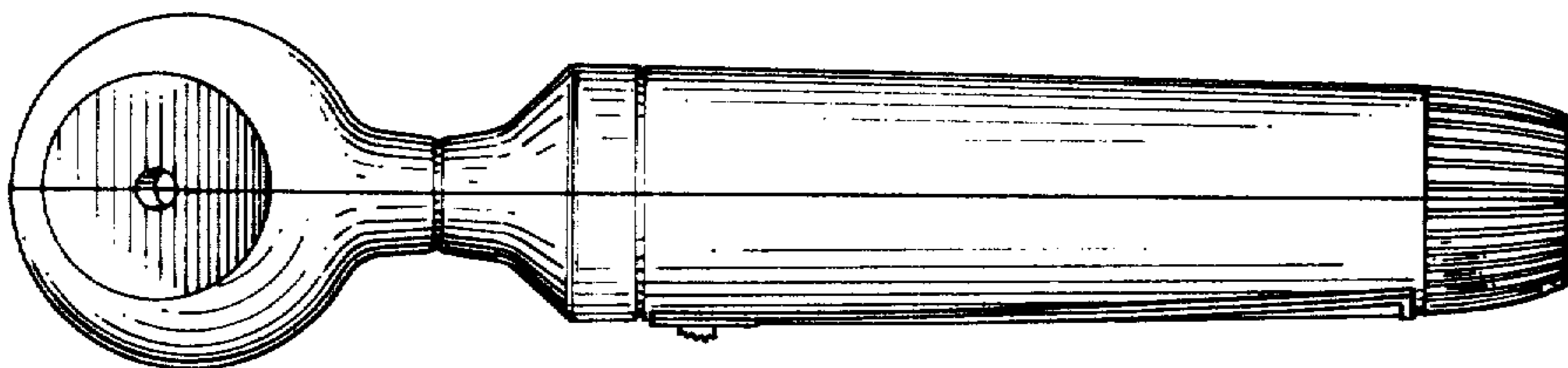

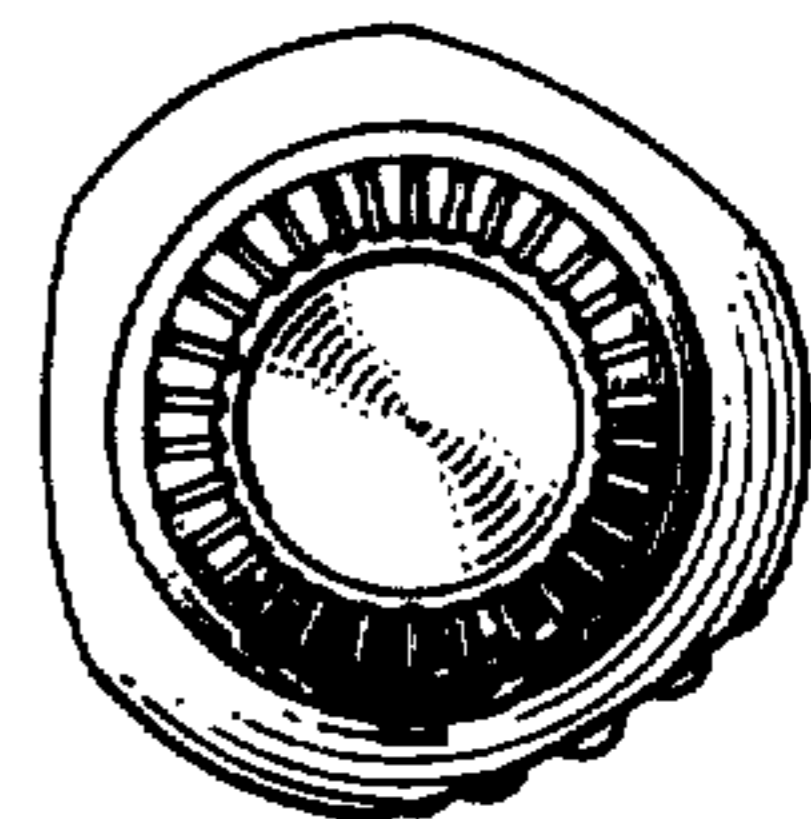

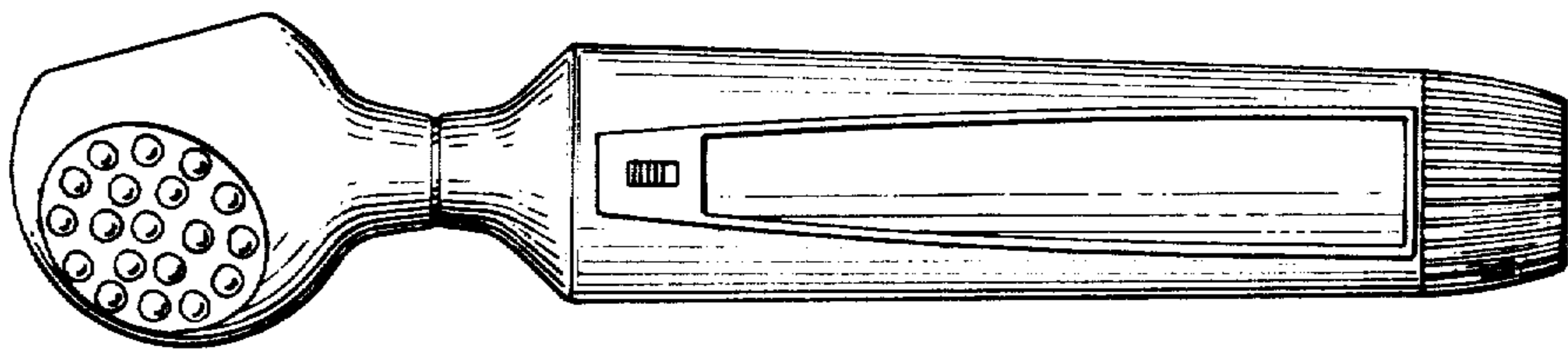

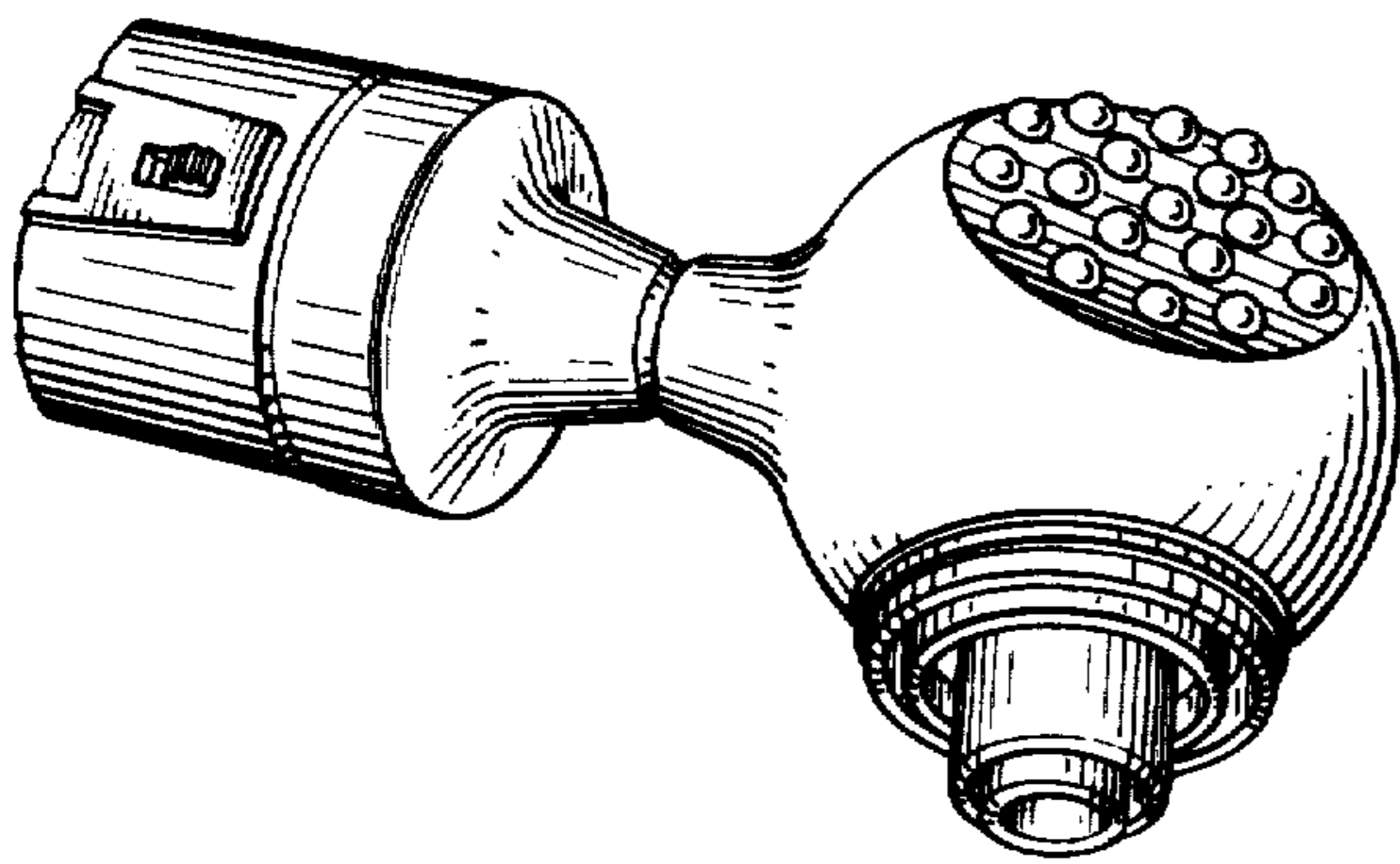

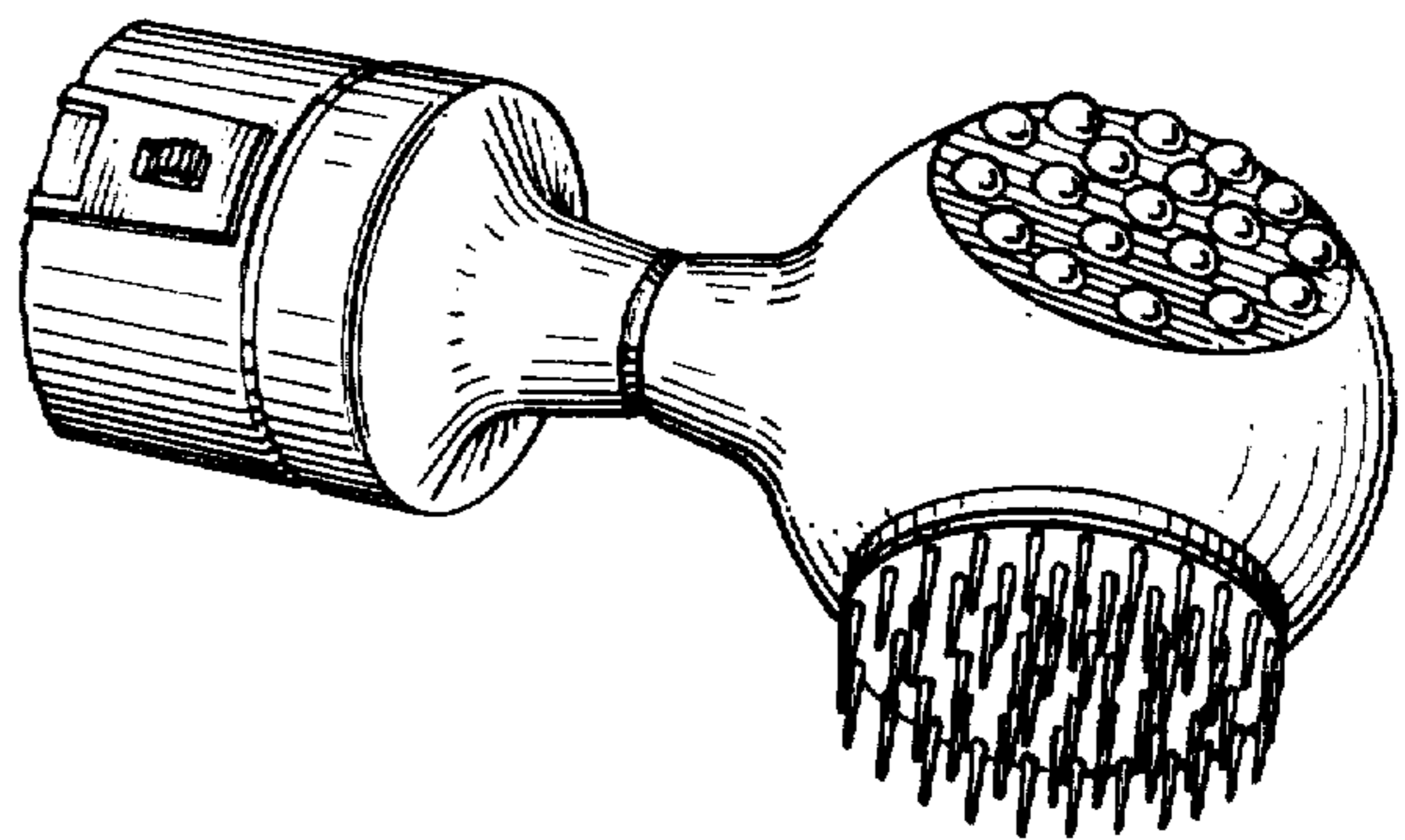

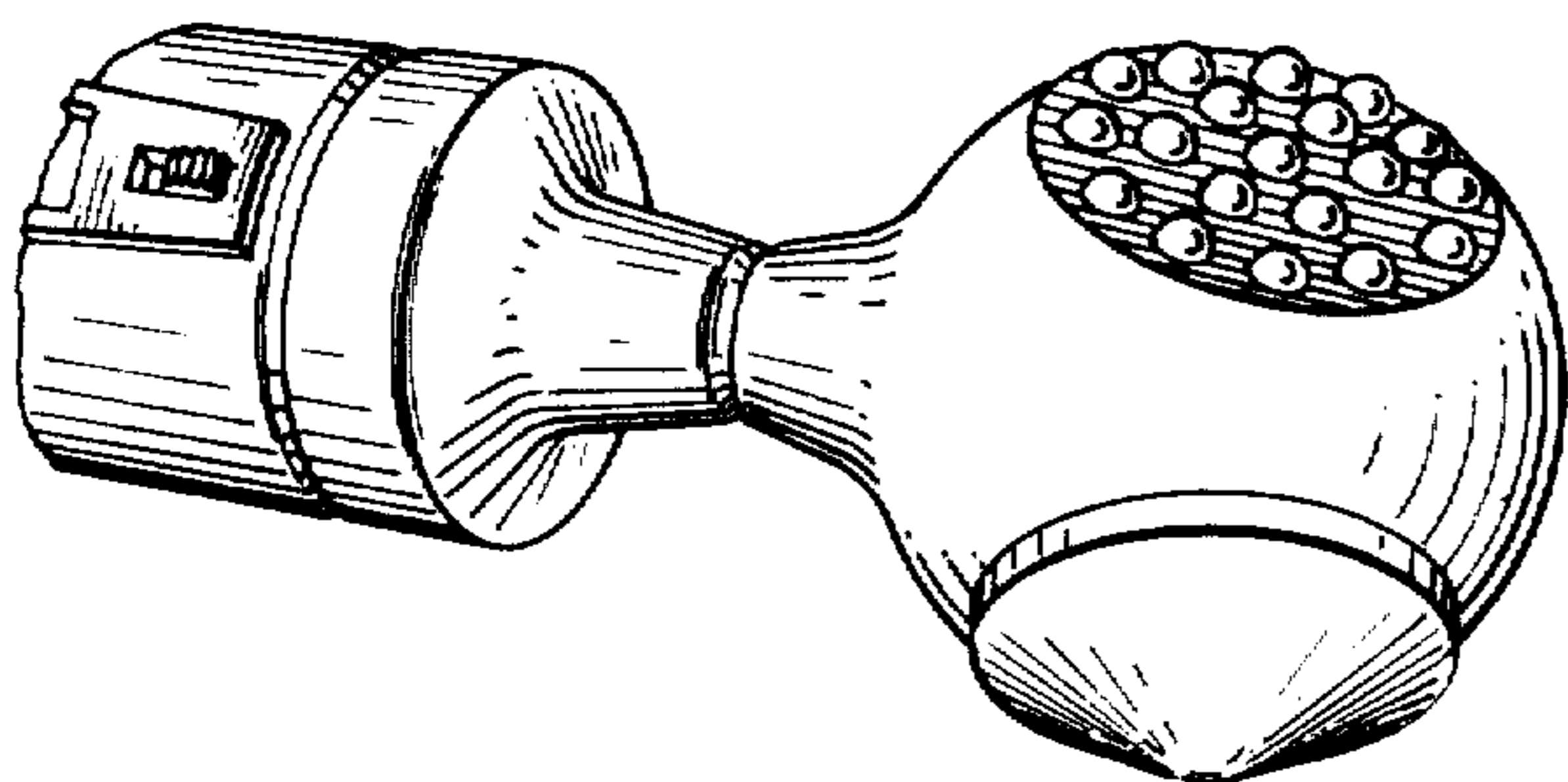
