[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a treaded shoe bottom, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a treaded shoe bottom showing my new design, the top being plain and unornamented;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is an enlarged perspective view of a portion of my treaded shoe bottom.

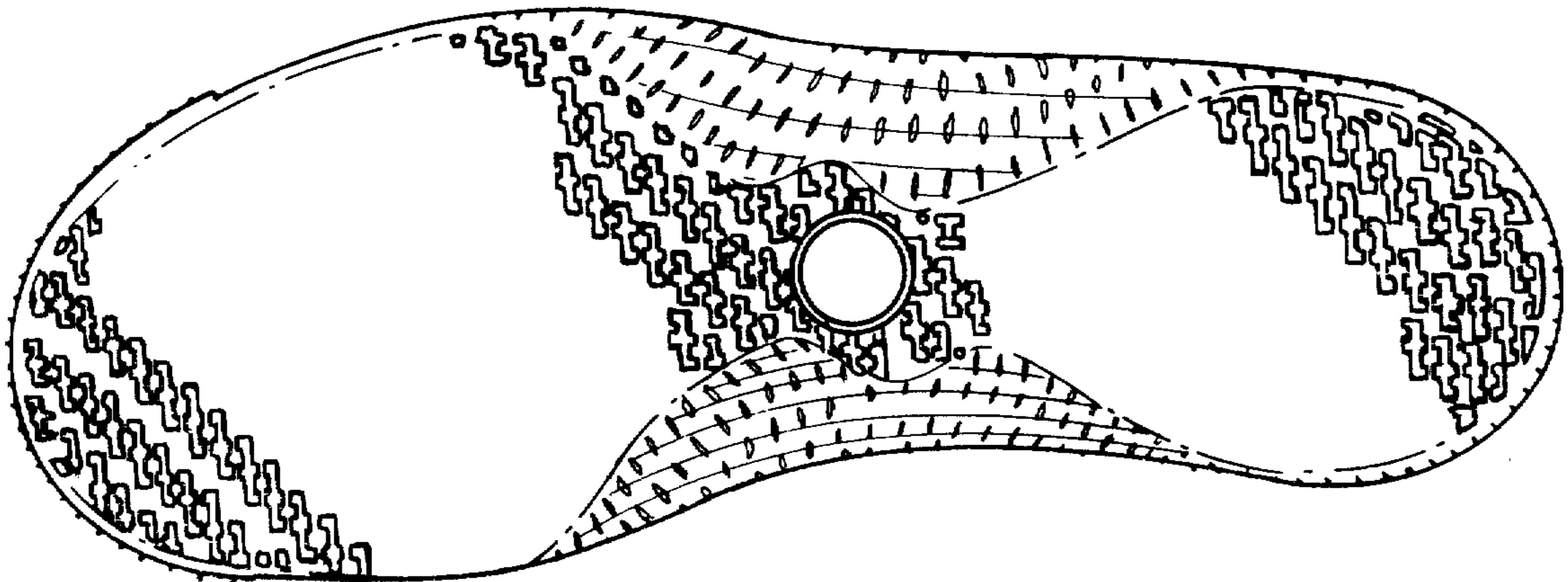

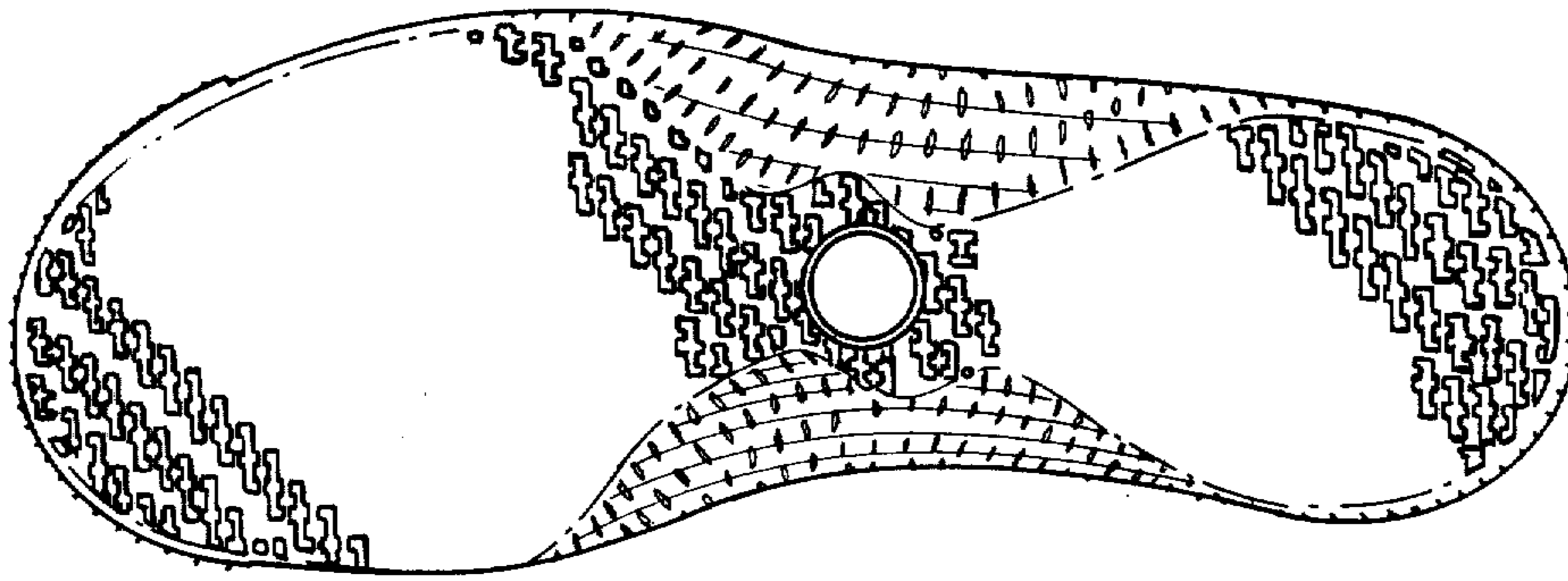

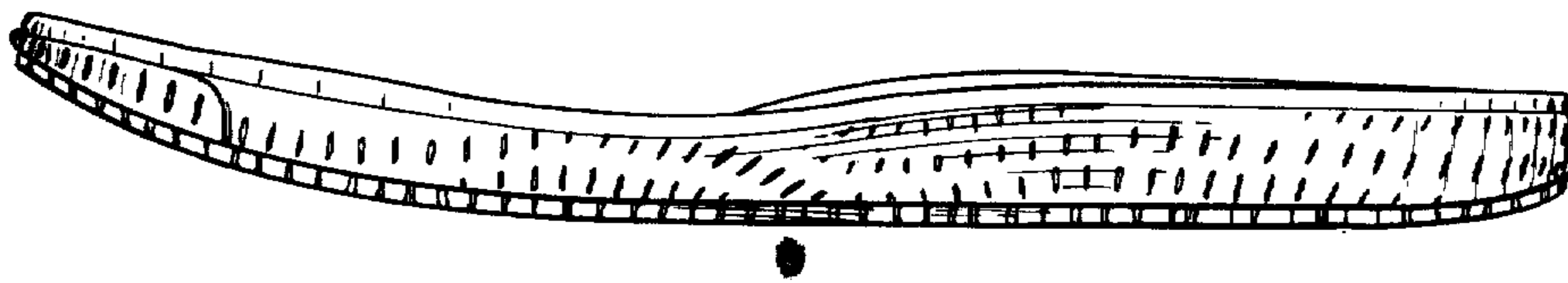

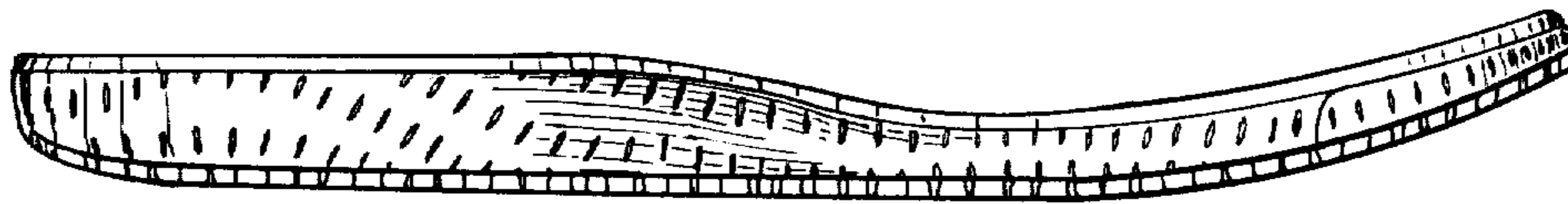

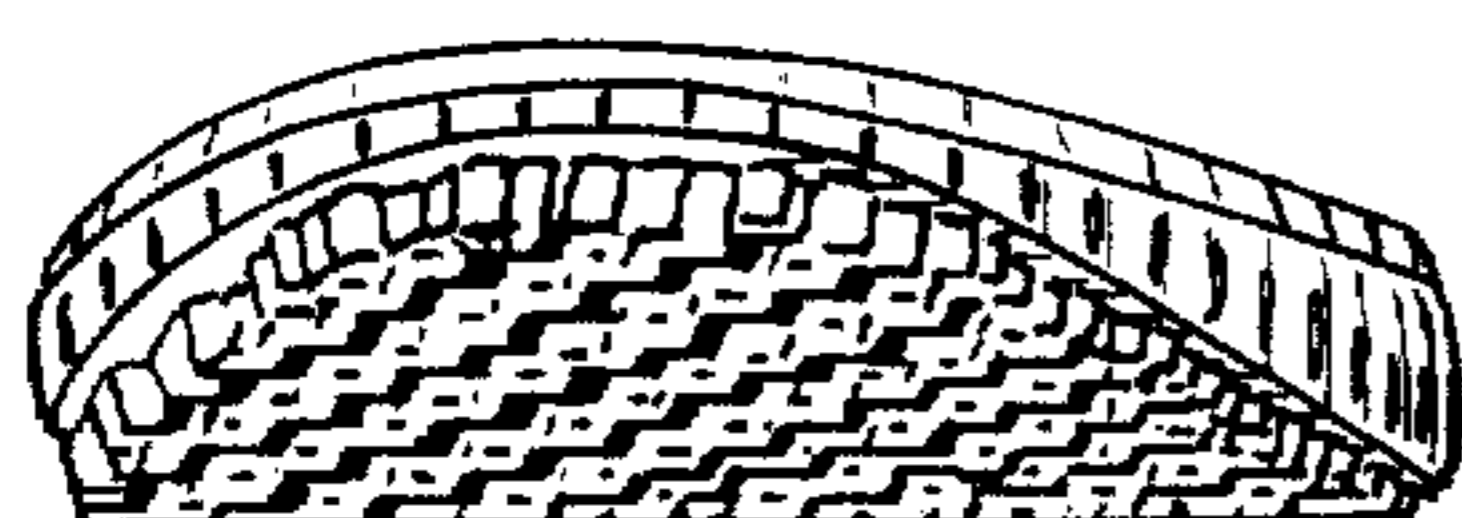

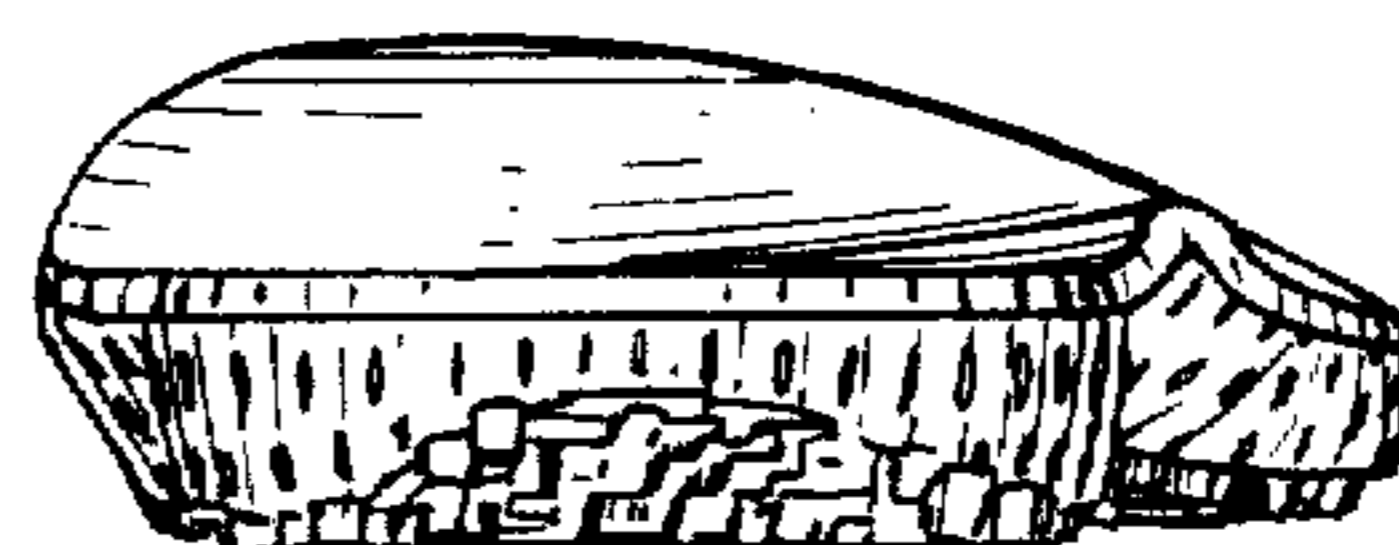
