DESCRIPTION
 FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a prenatal support pillow showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view;
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view; and
 FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along line 7—7 in FIG. 2.

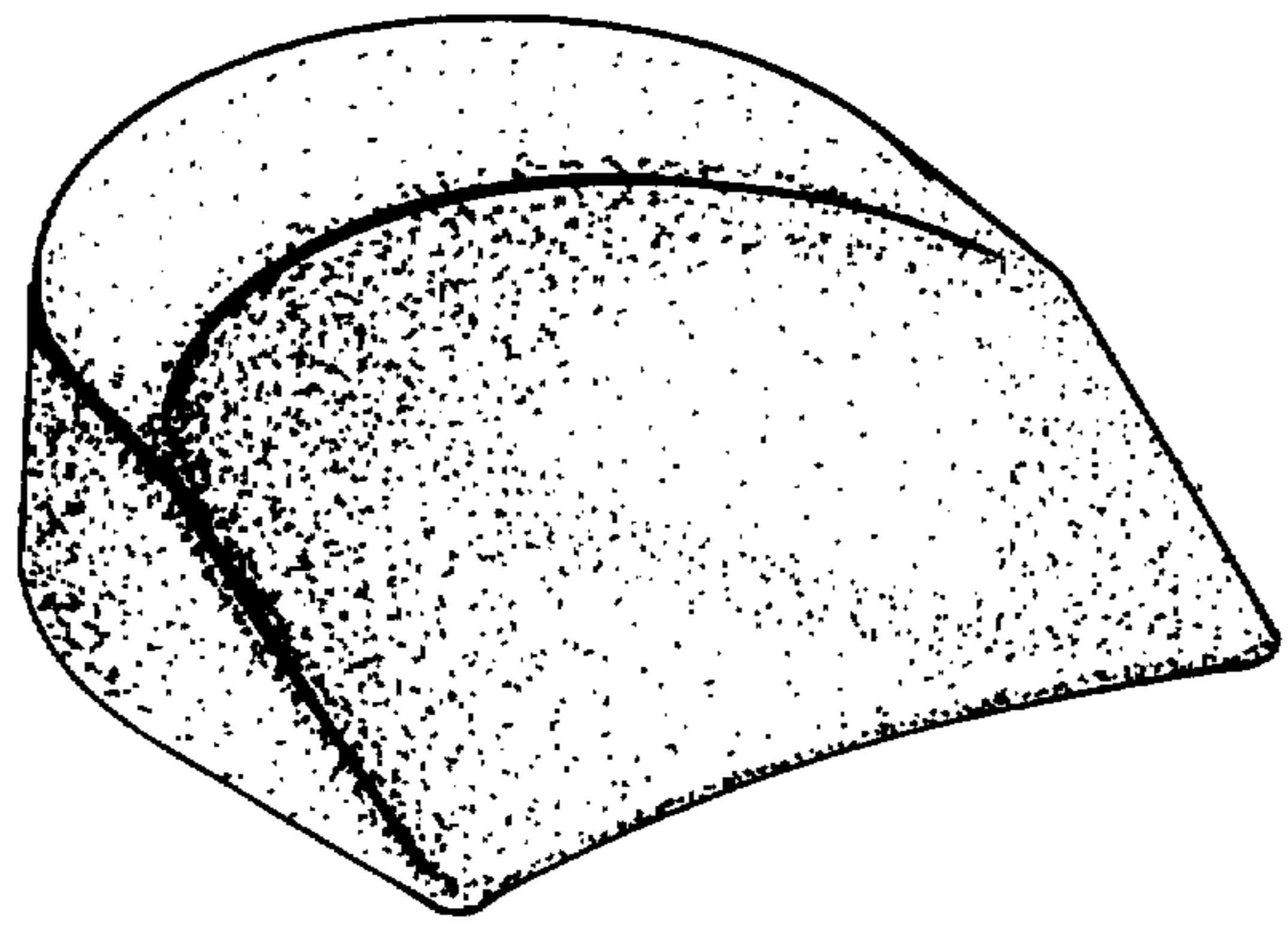

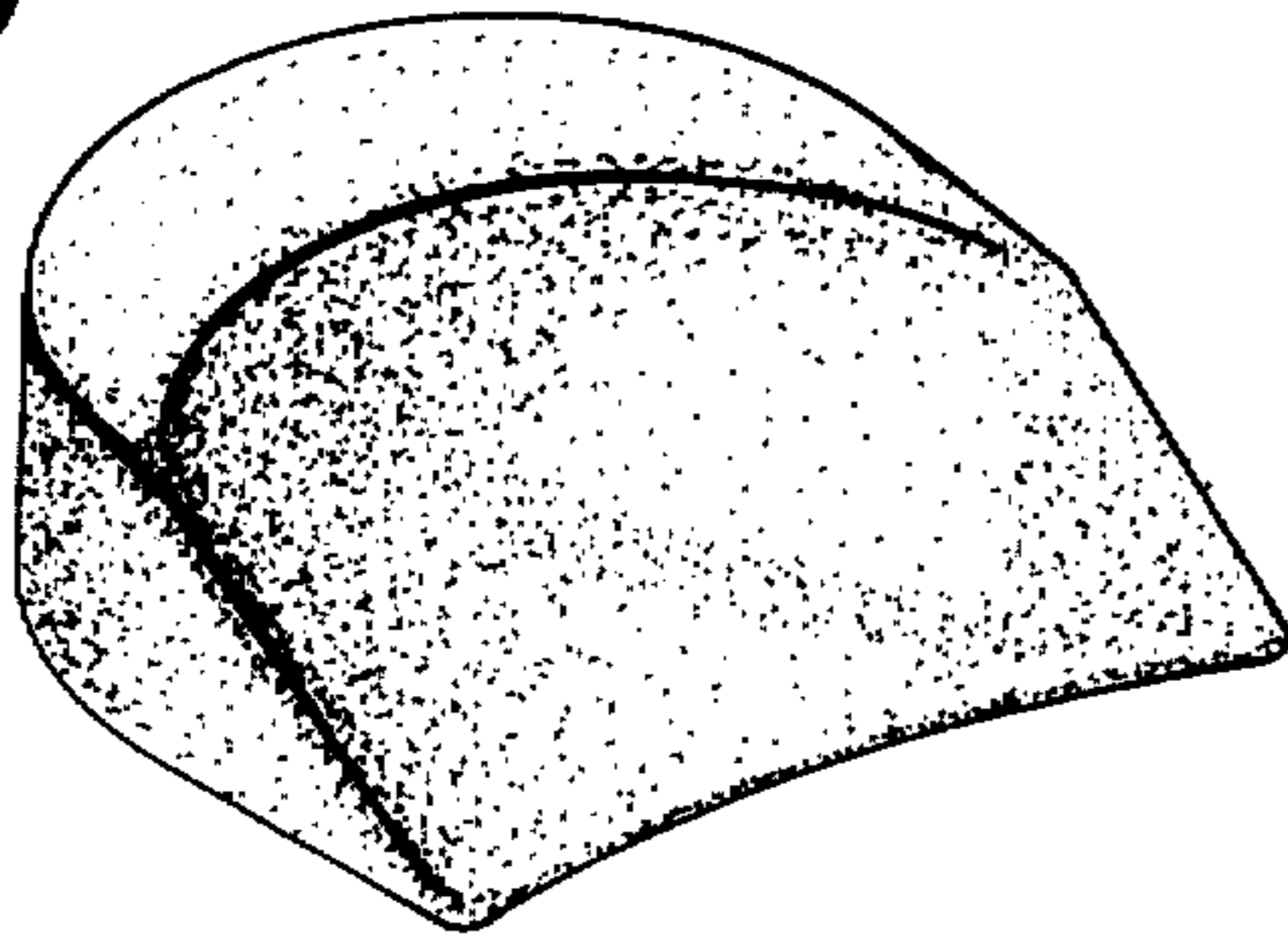

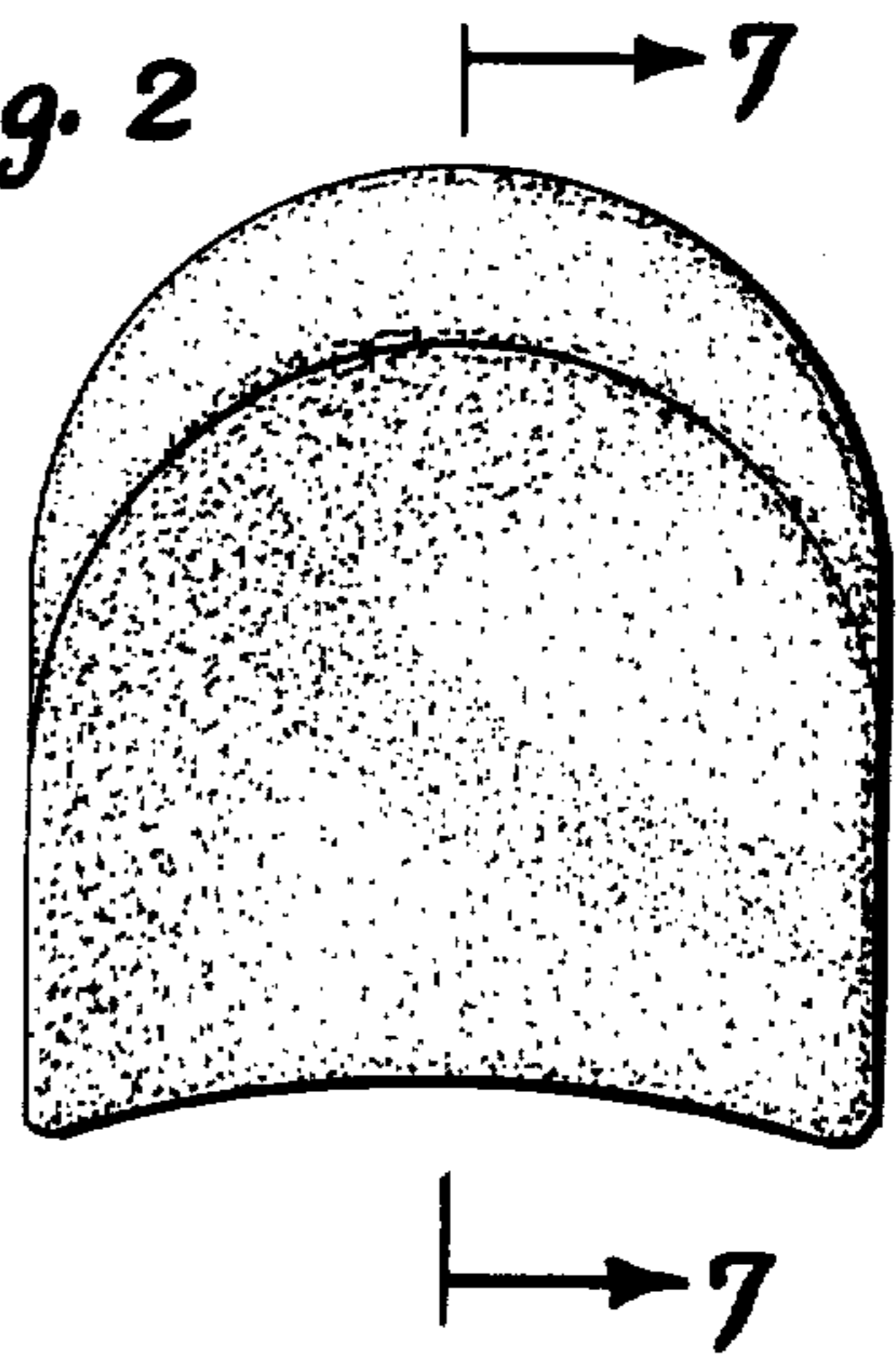

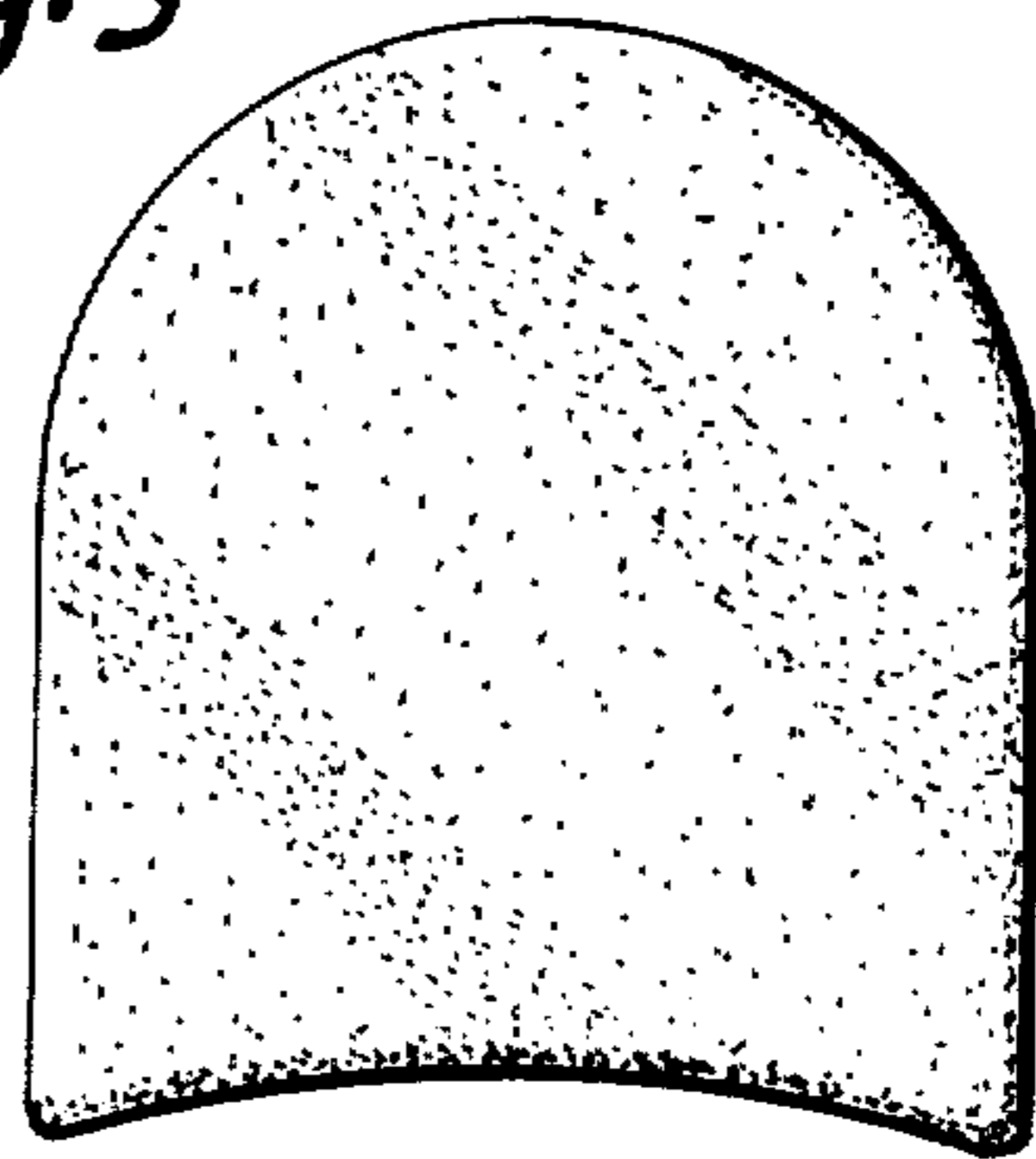

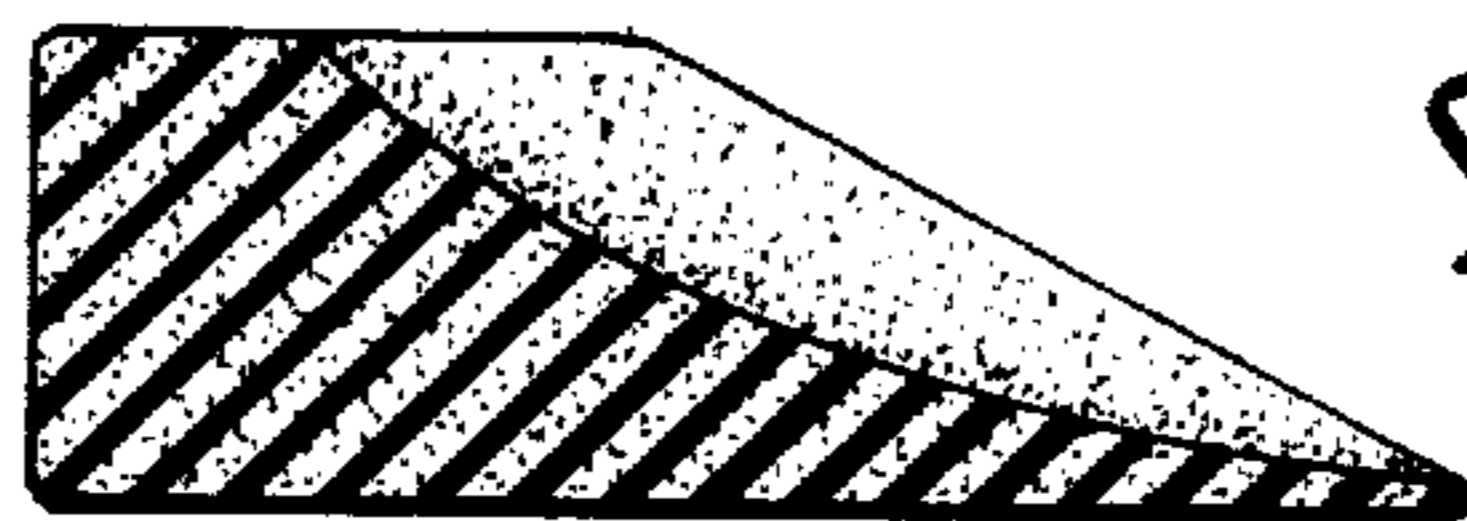
