The ornamental design for a mug, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a mug showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along the line 4-4 in FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.
