FIG. 6 is a front perspective view thereof.

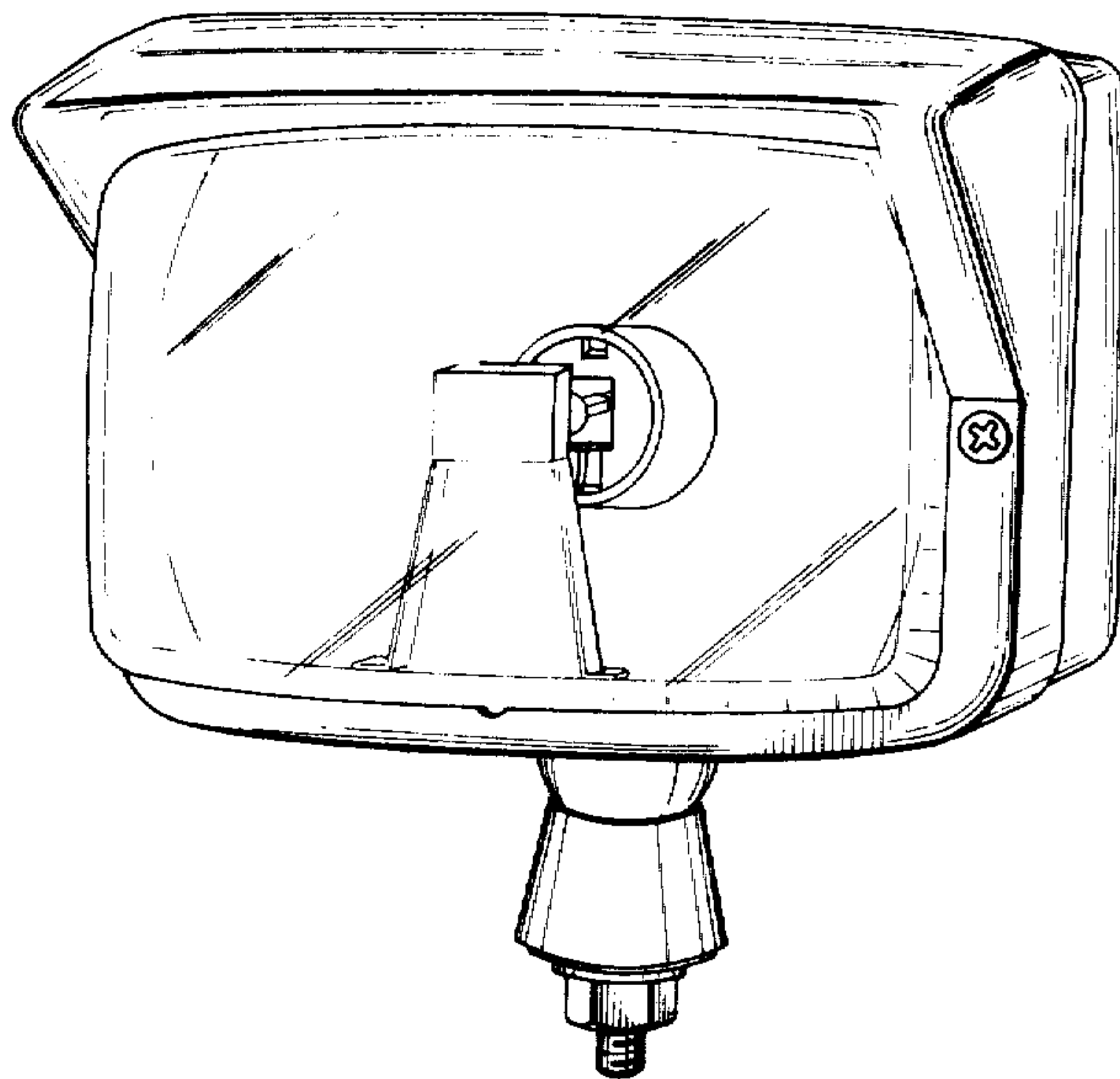

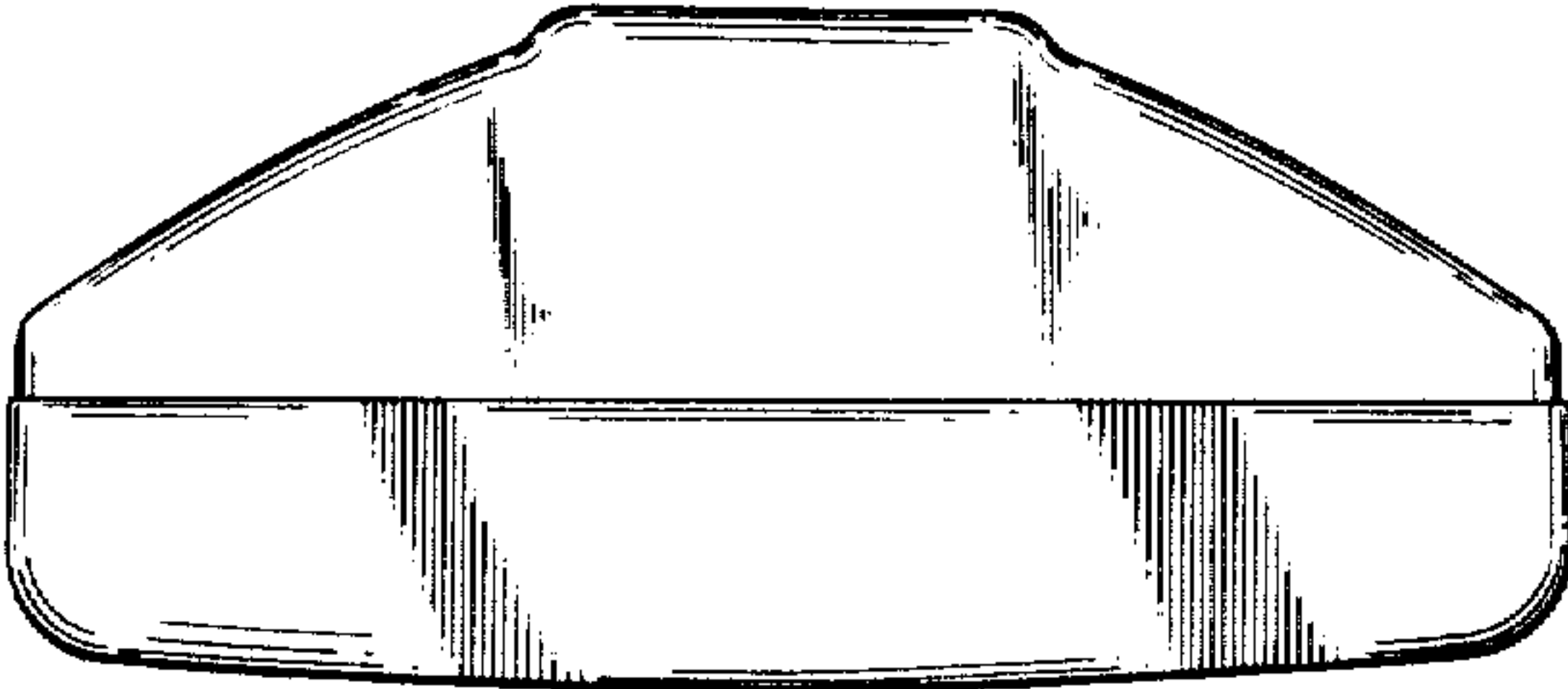

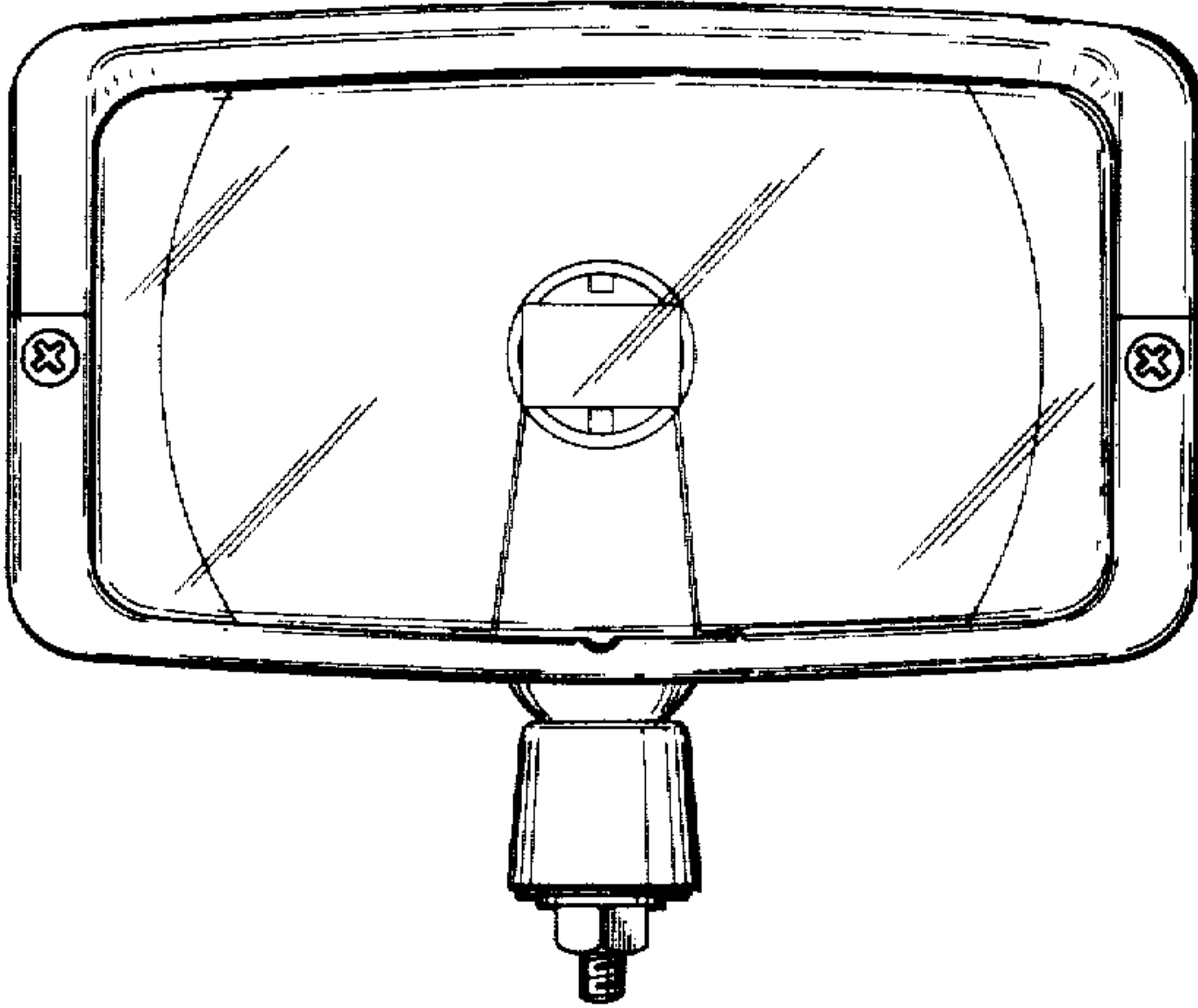

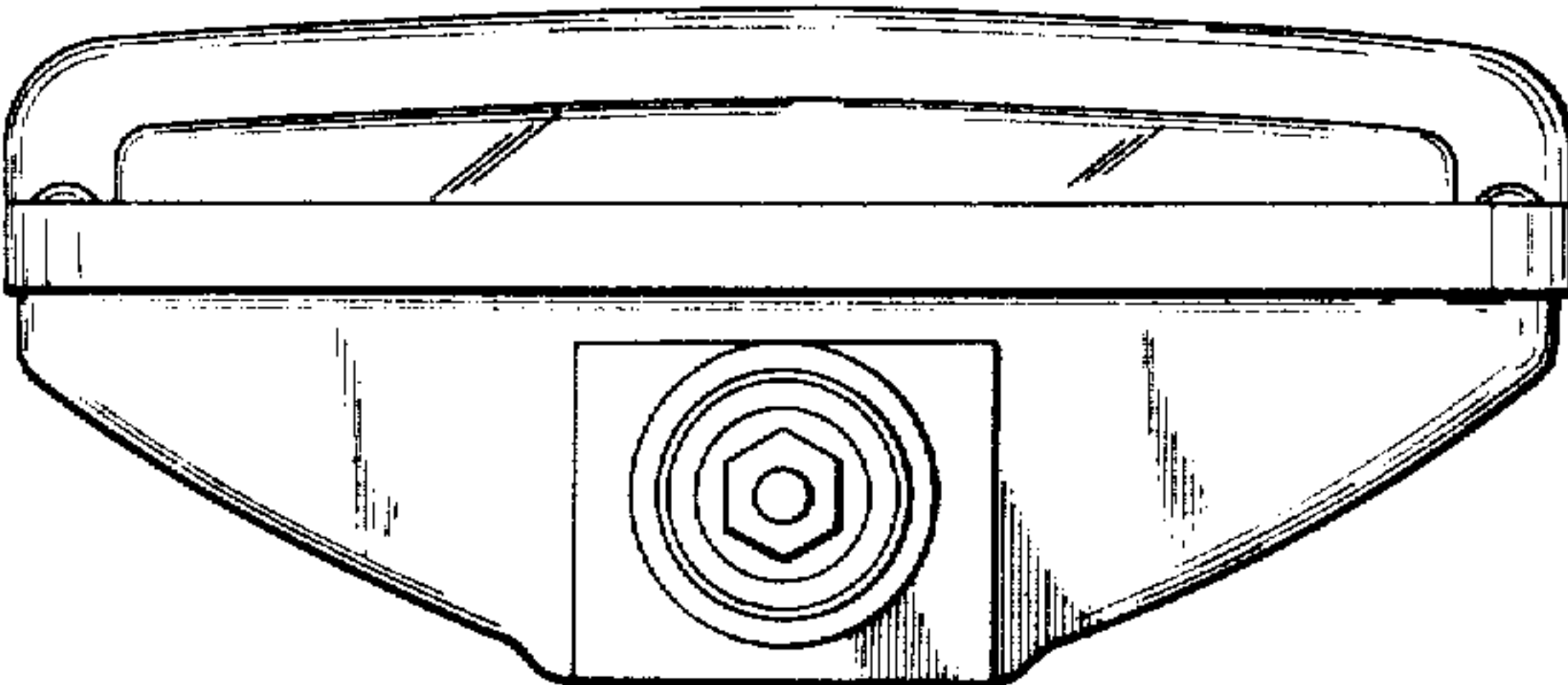

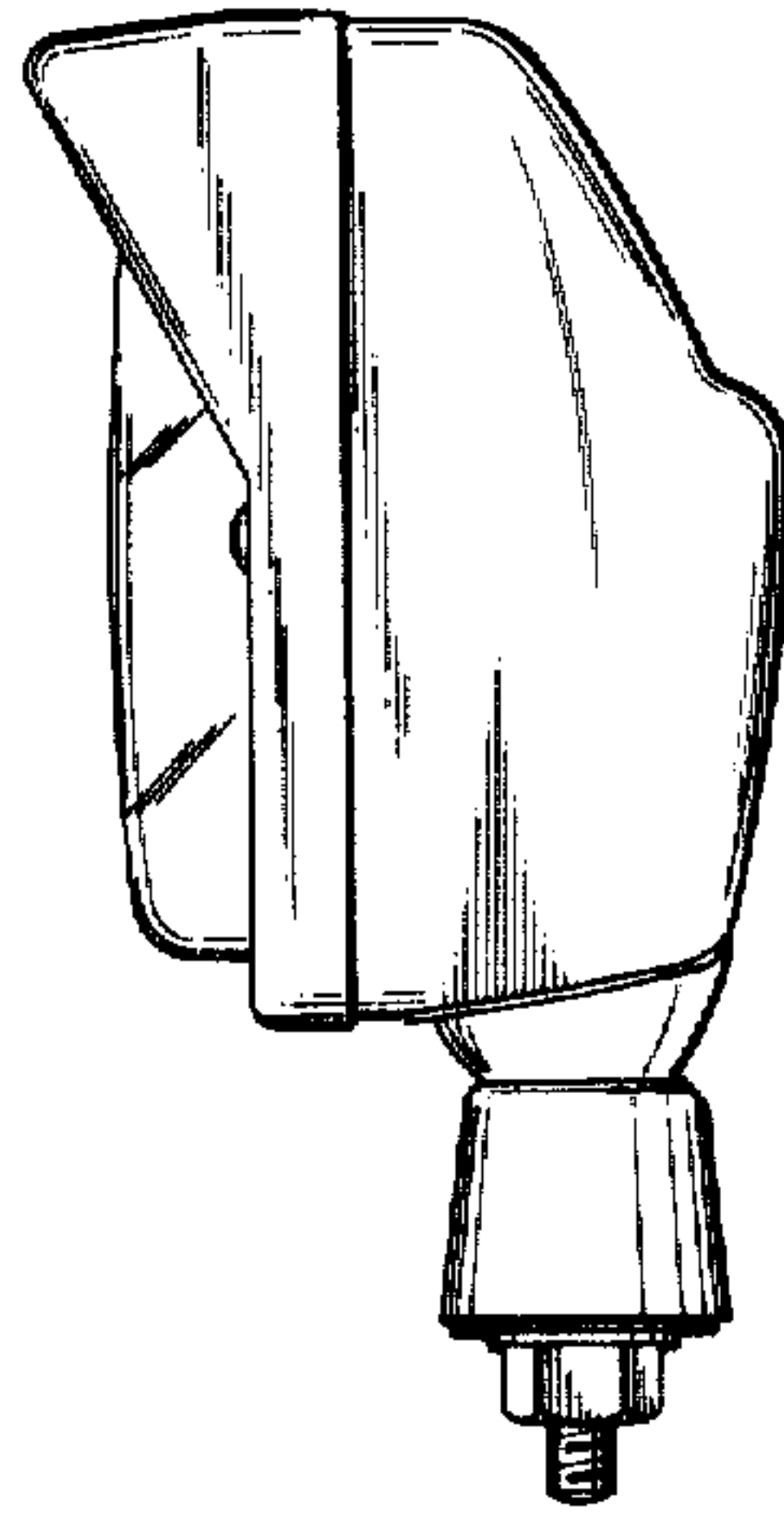

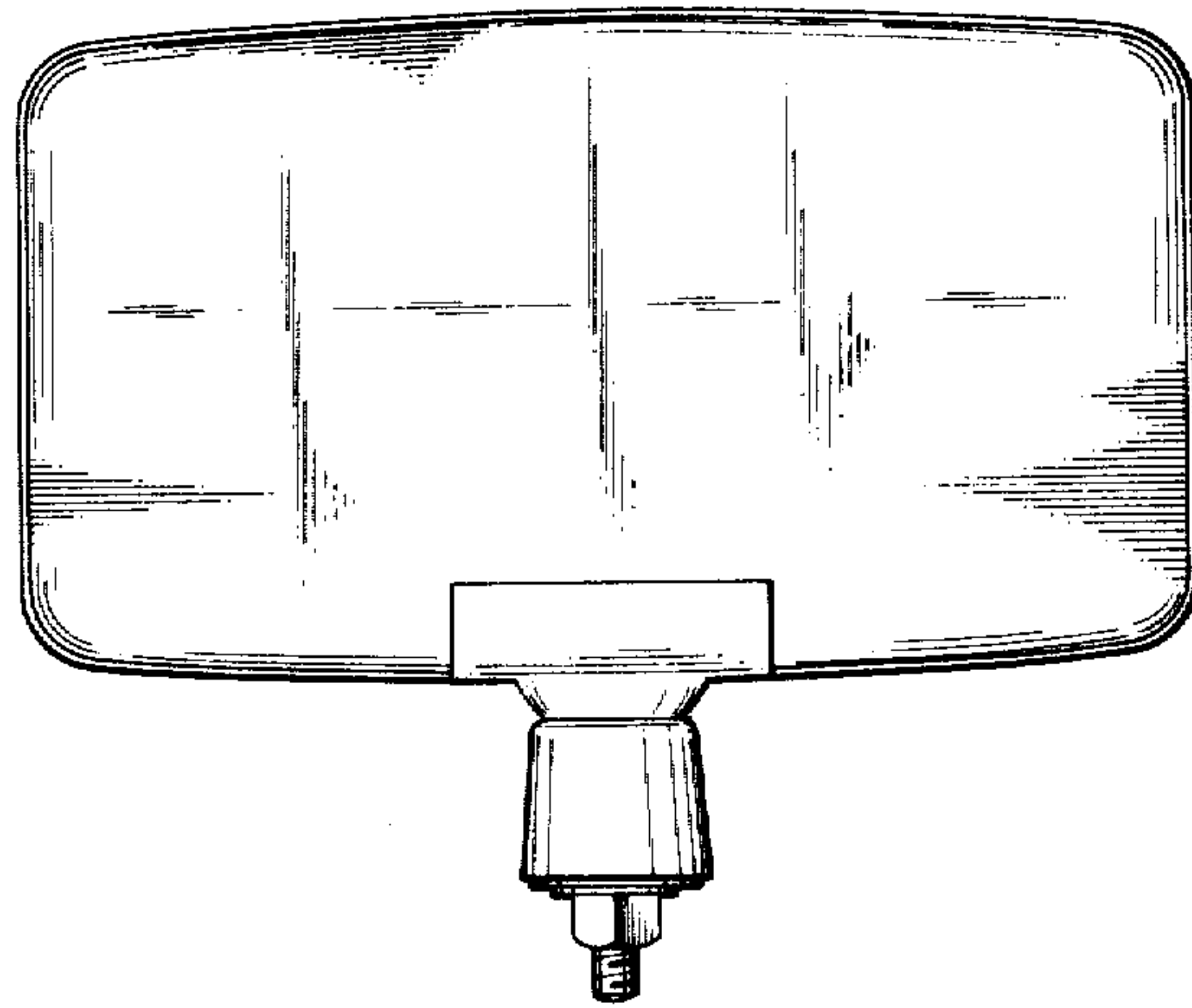
