The broken line representation of a wet/dry vacuum cleaner in FIG. 7 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no part of the claimed design.

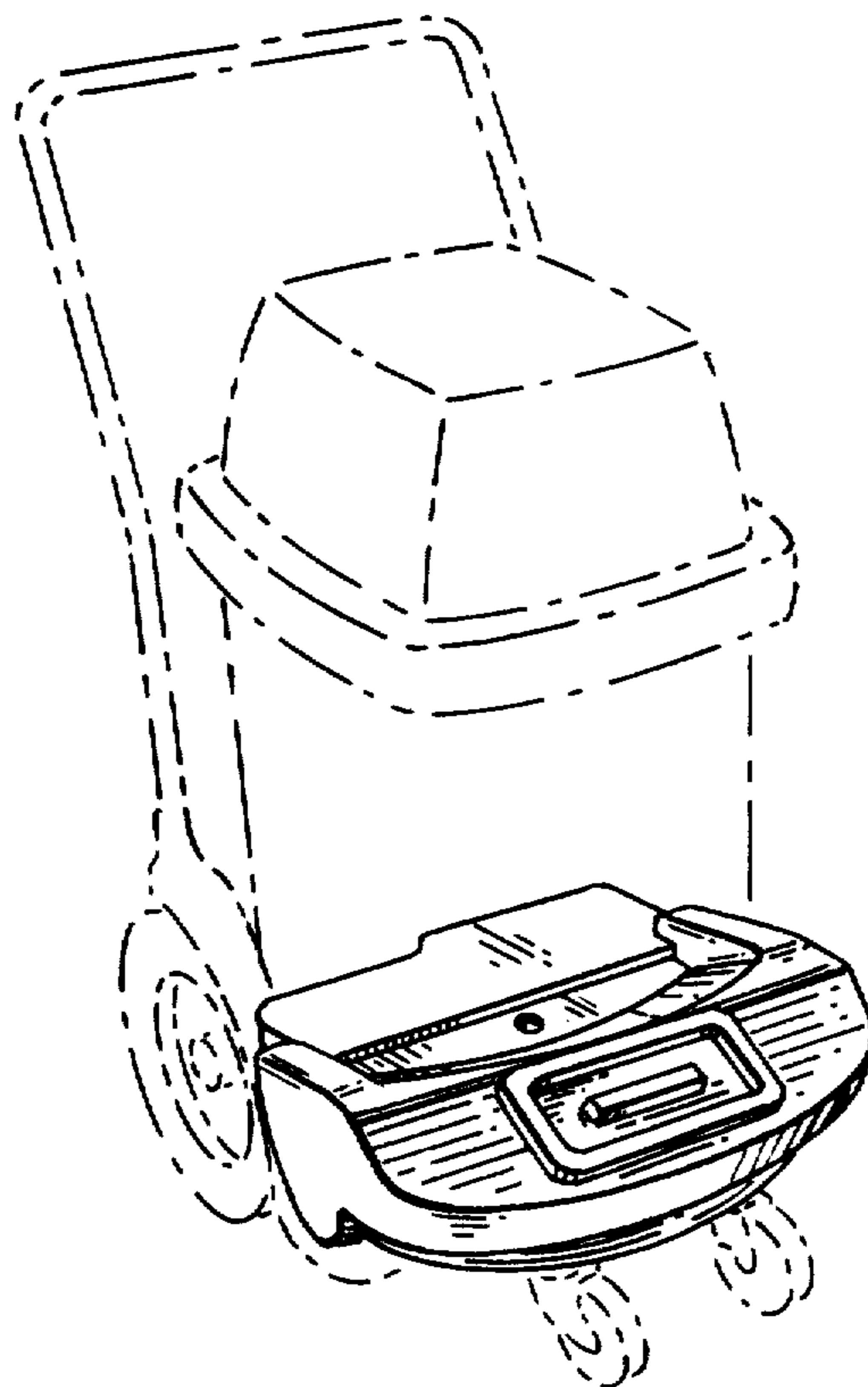

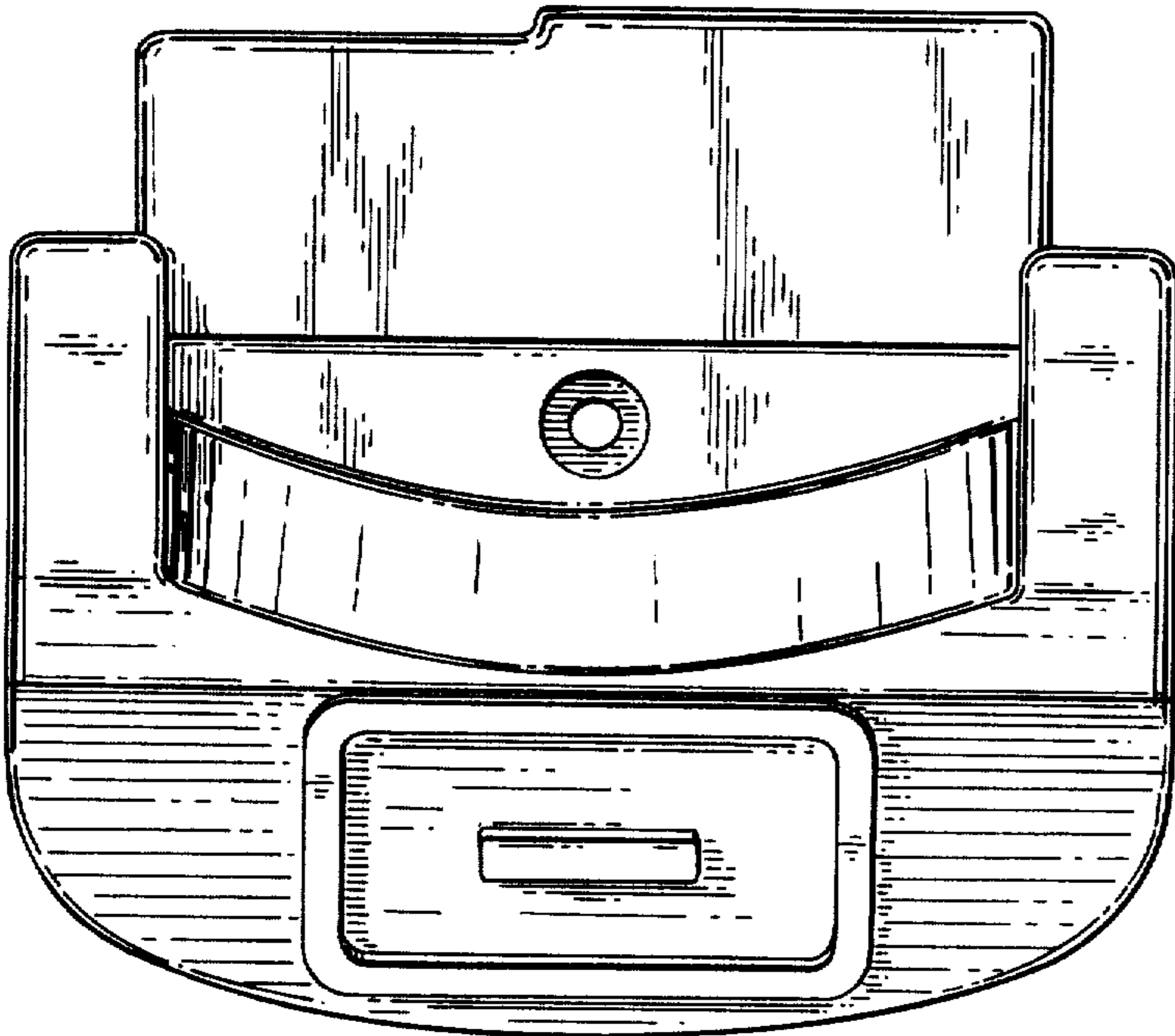

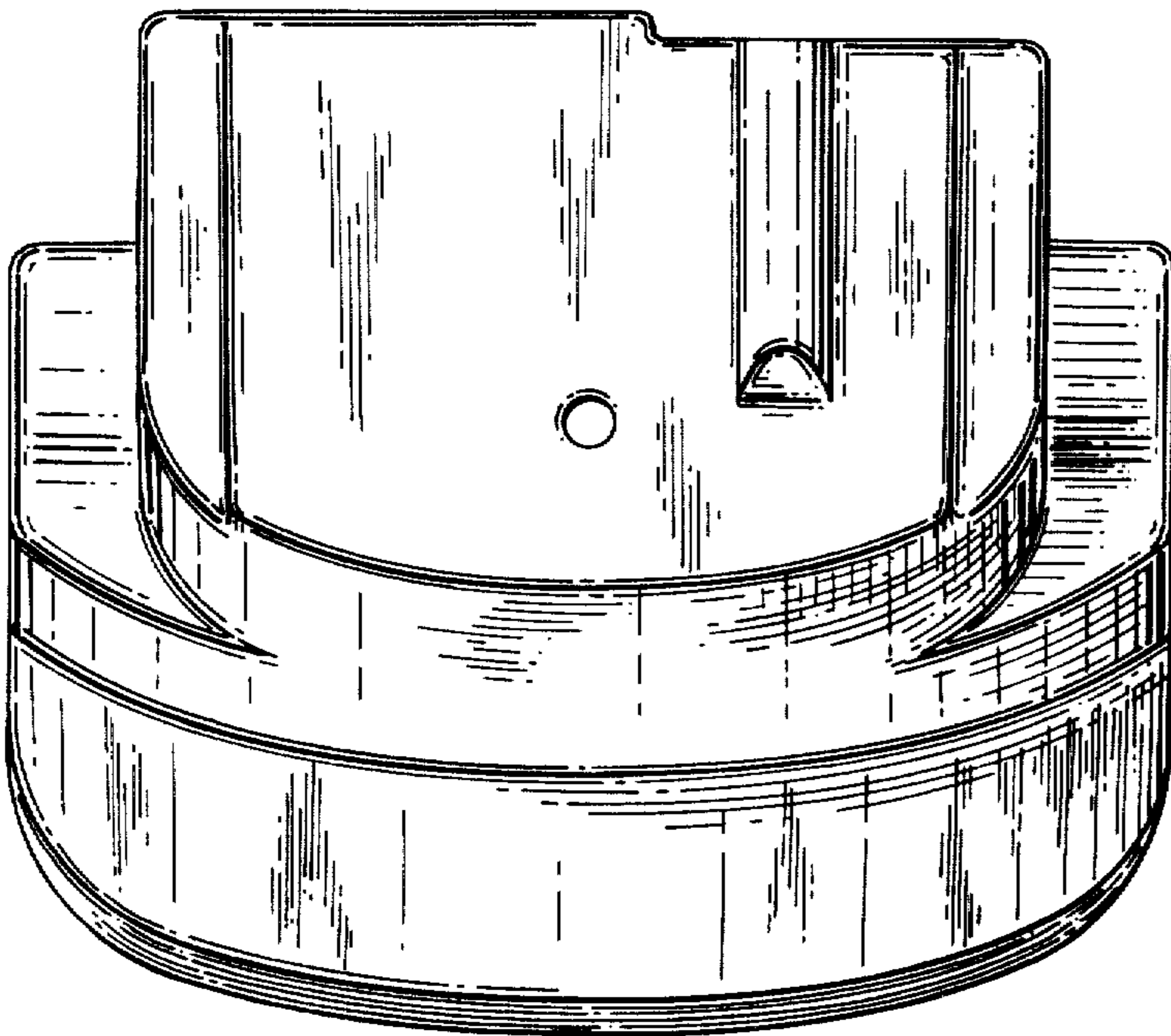

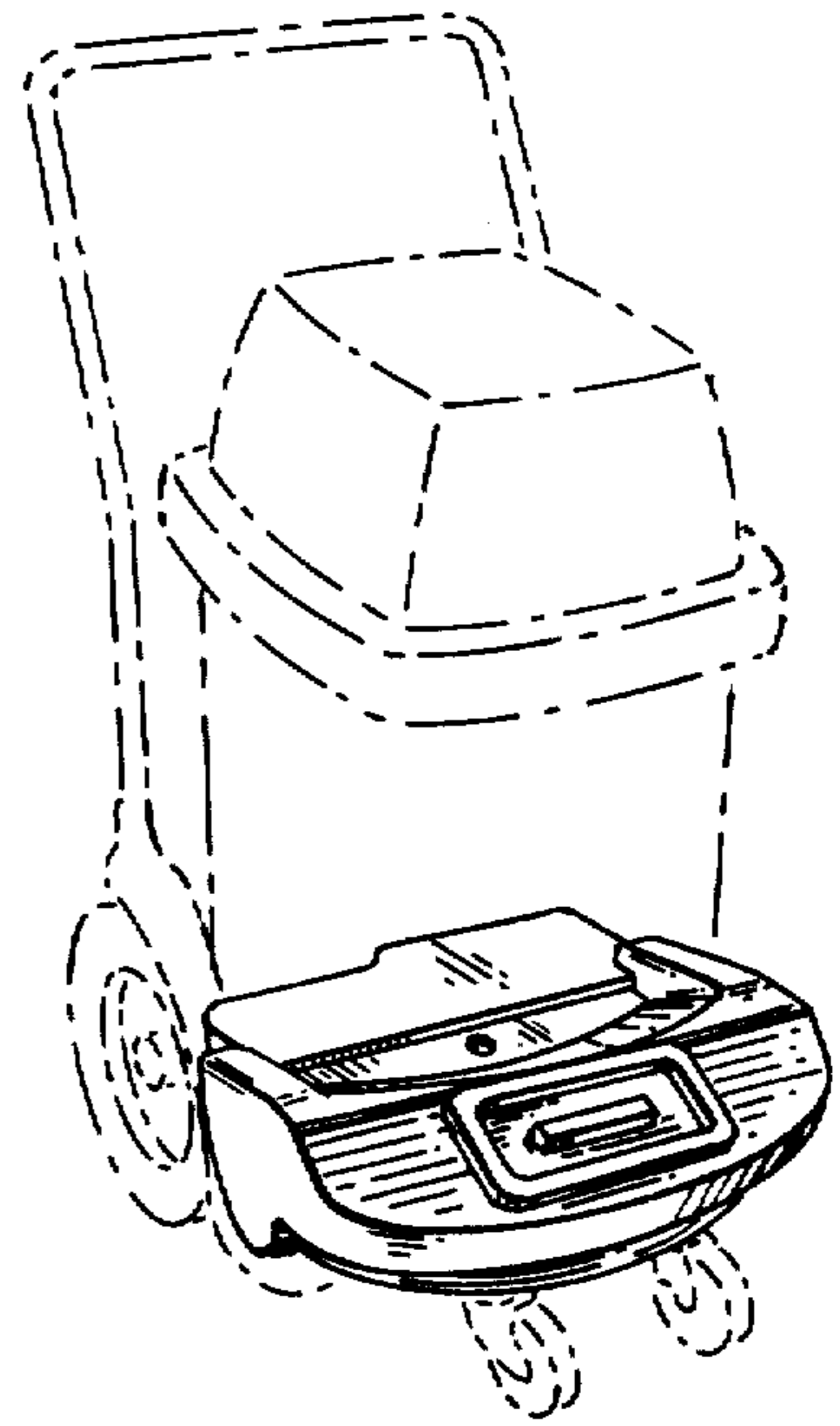

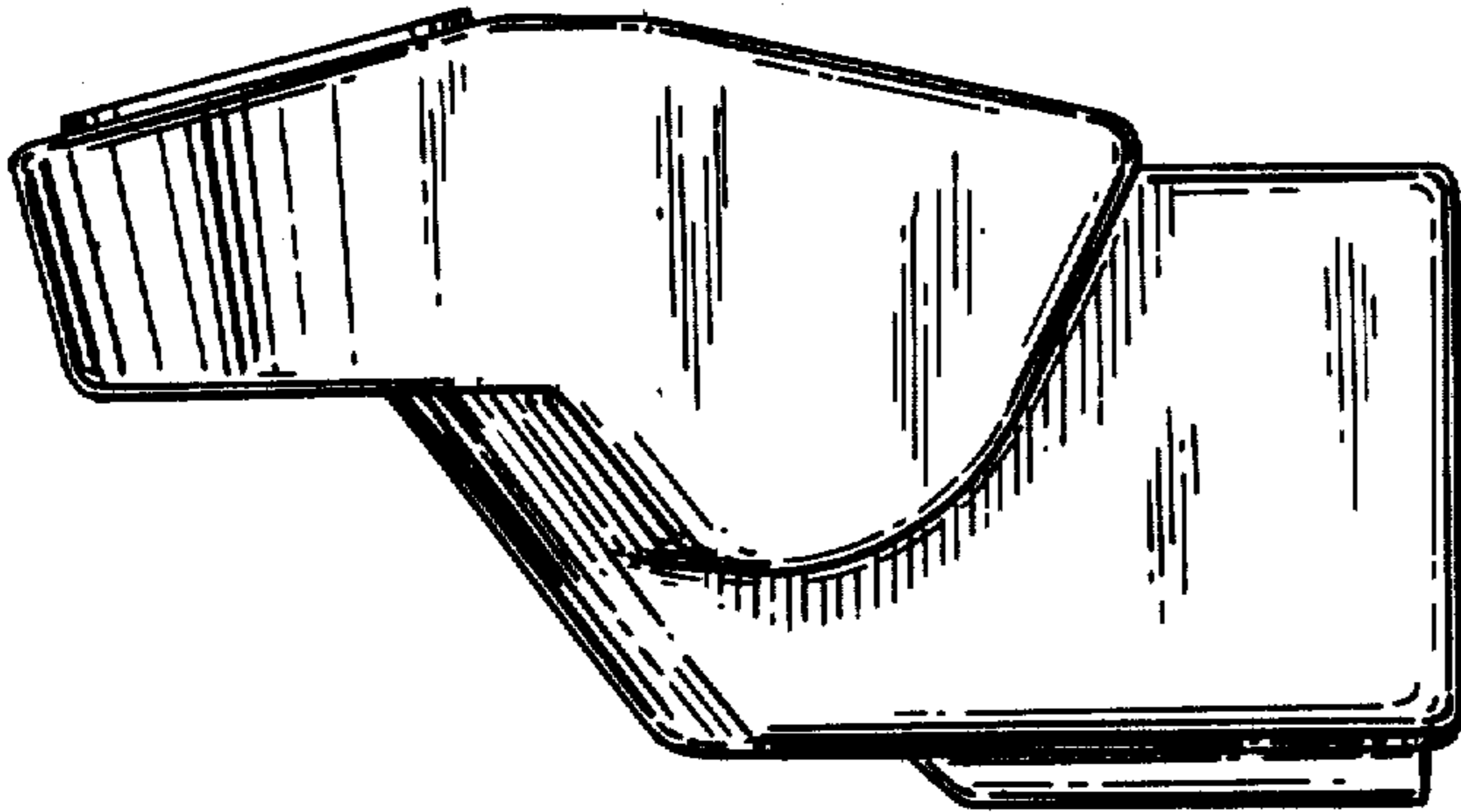

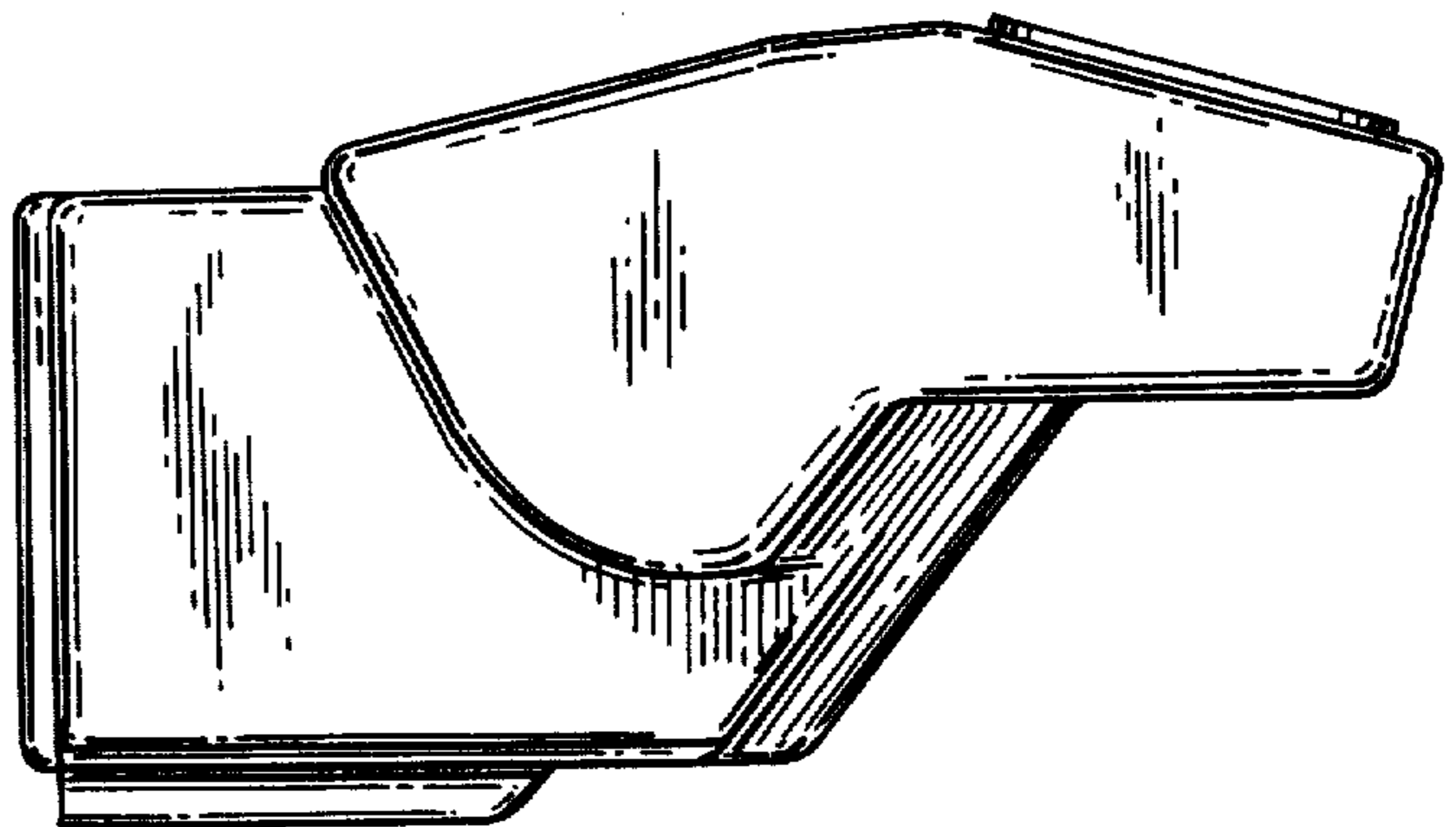

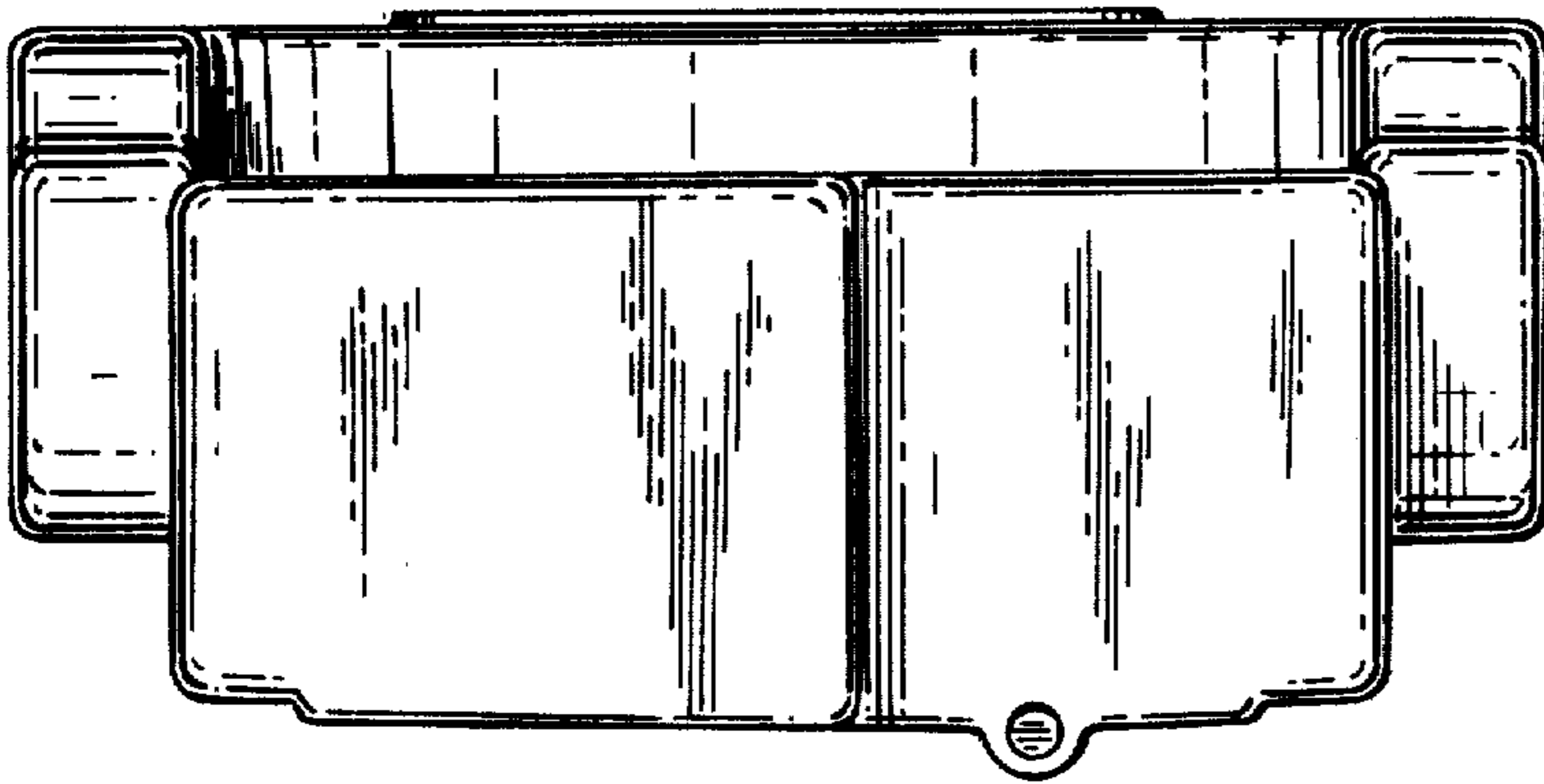
