DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a multiple elevated funeral dome for four corpses, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof.

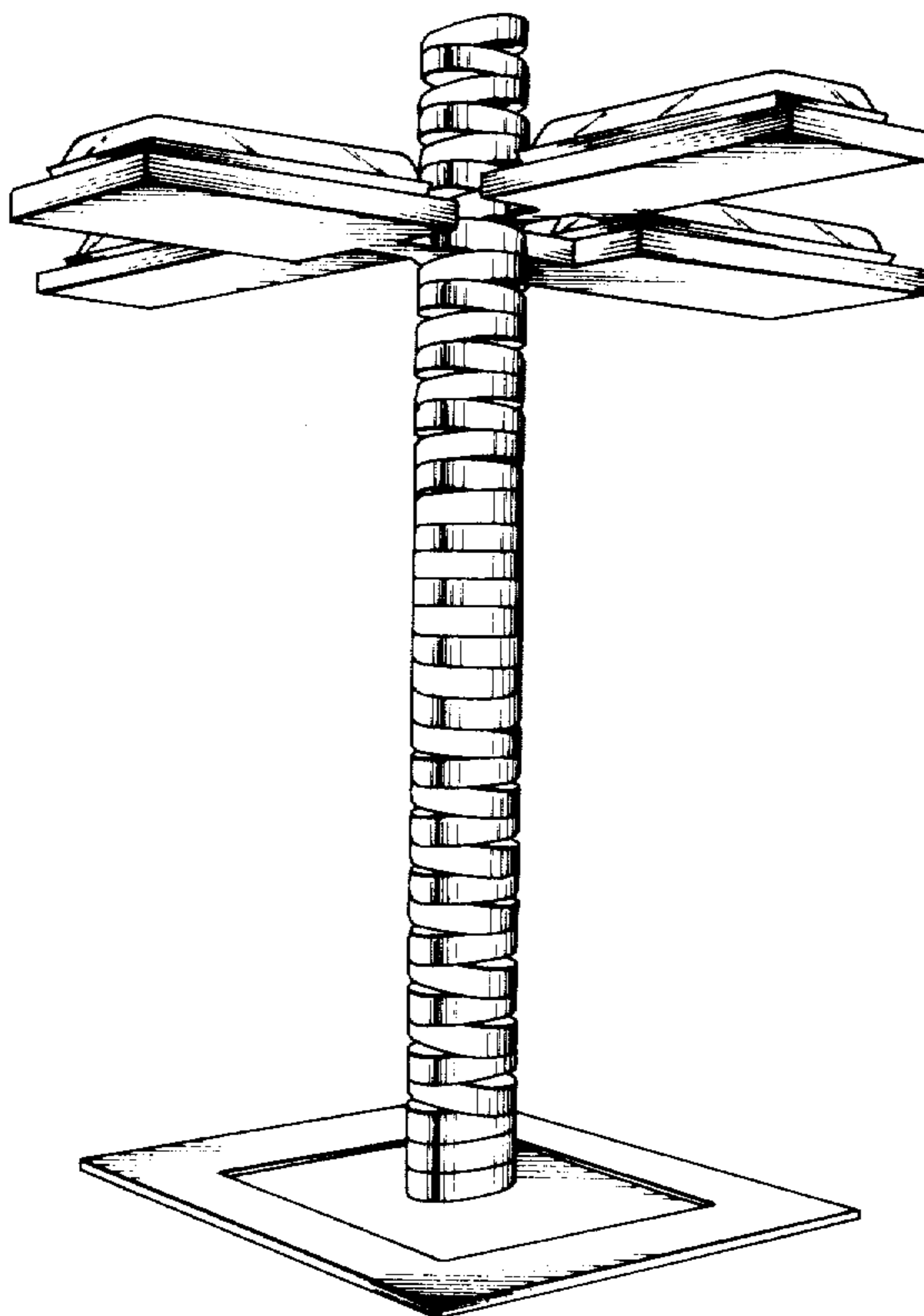

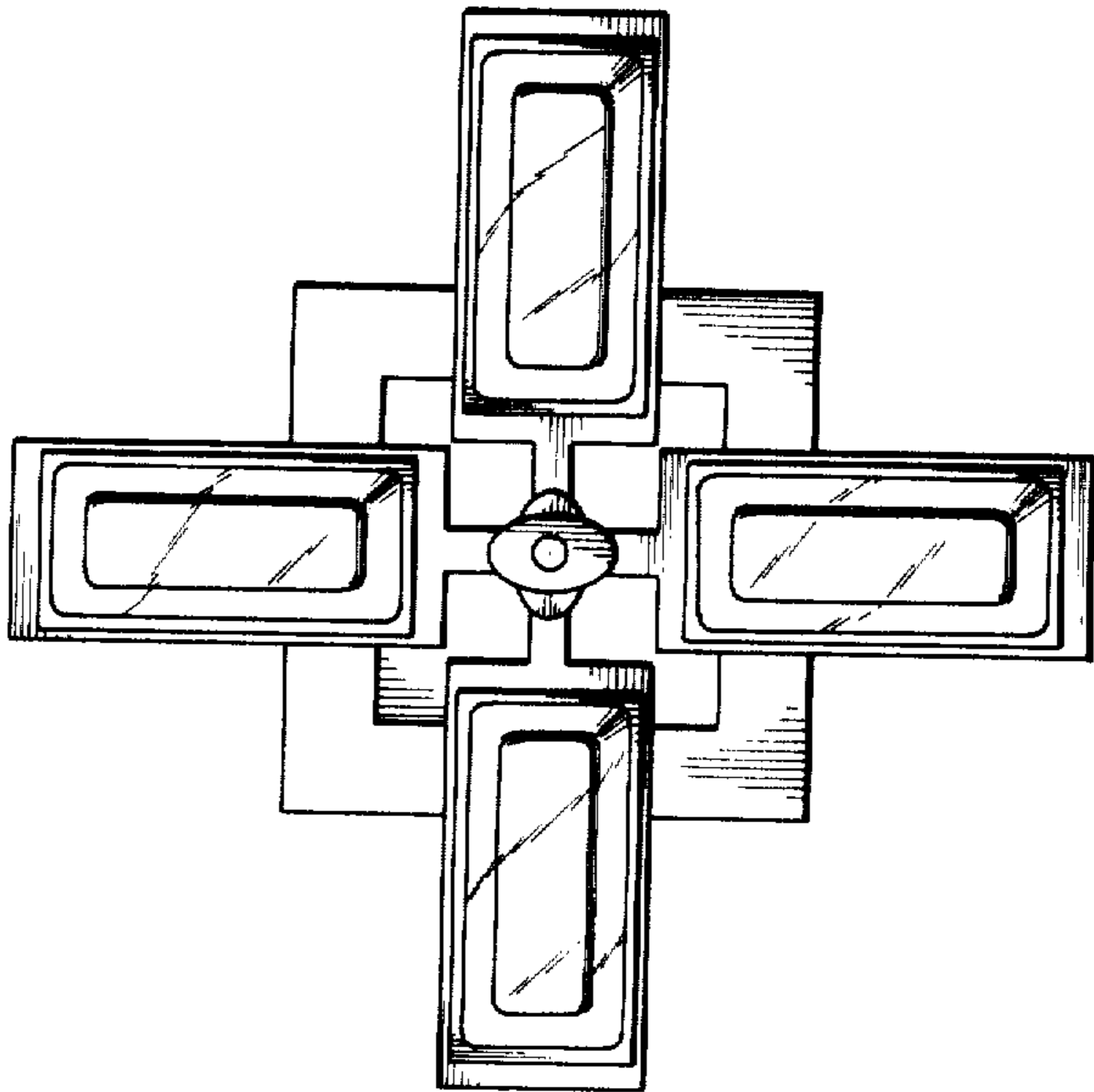

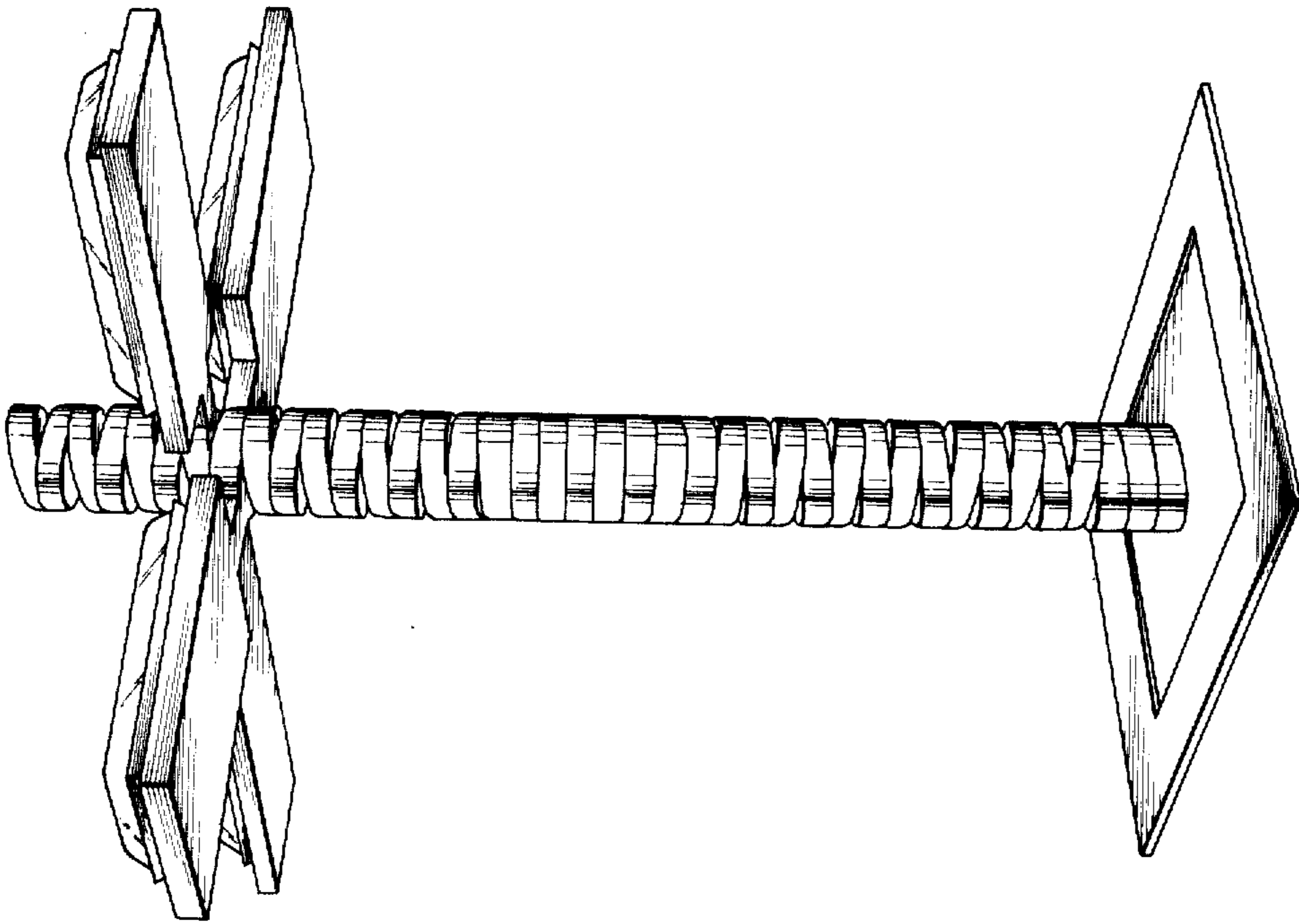

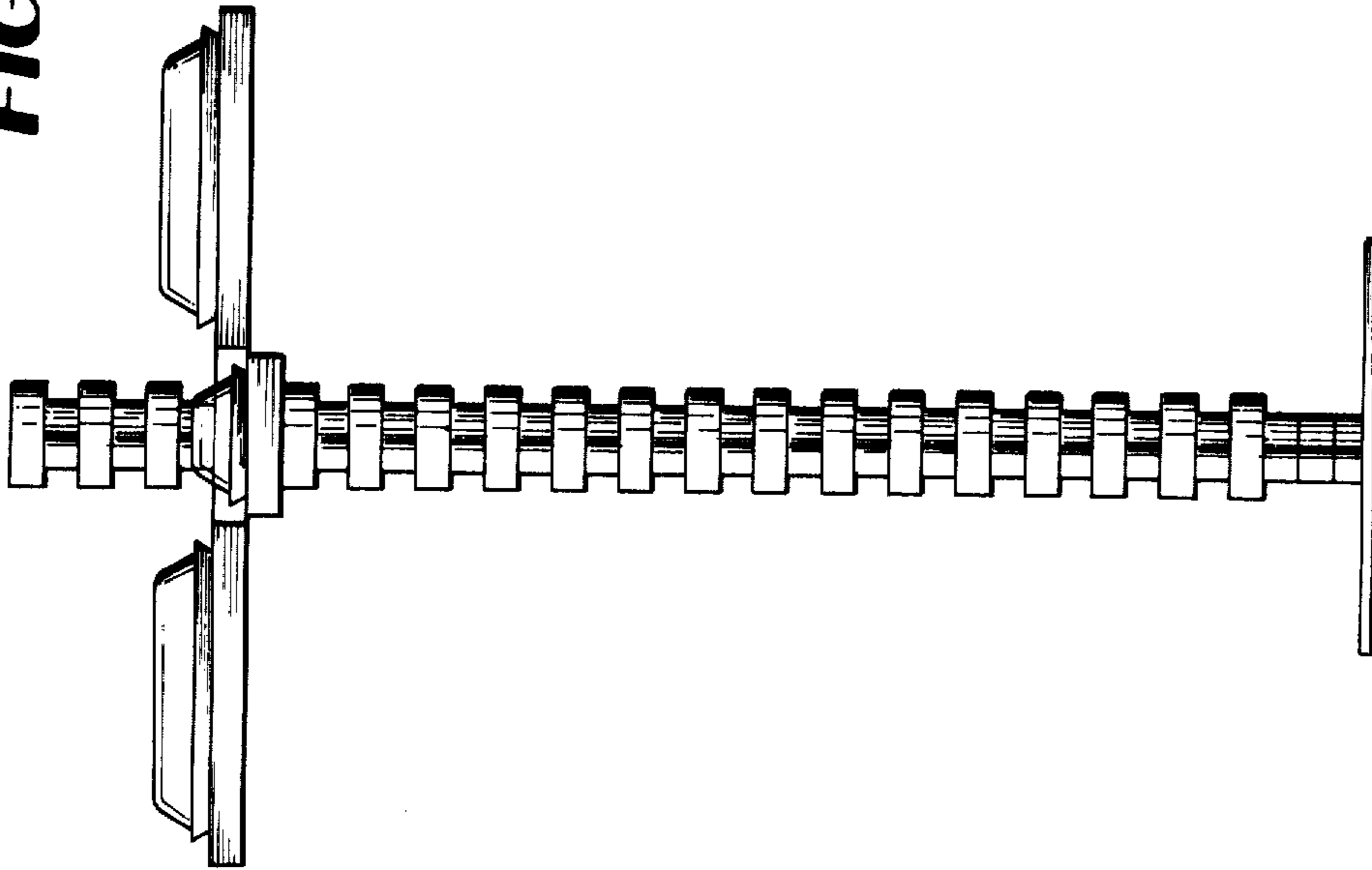
